Hat Trick History — Notre Dame players have combined to score 53 hat tricks in the program's previous 17 seasons, including at least once every year from 1988-2000. Jenny Heft had three hat tricks in '98 to bring her career total to five, tying Monica Gerardo and Rosella Guerrero for most in ND history. Heft then broke the record with a hat trick in '99 vs. Georgetown. Amy Warner in 2000 set the record for earliest hat trick by a Notre Dame freshman, based on date (Sept. 3, vs. Providence) while Rosella Guerrero remains the only Irish freshman to notch a hat trick in the season opener (vs. North Carolina State in 1992).
