One of the top distance freestylers in school history aims for a return to the NCAA Championships ... will serve as a co-captain of the Irish in 2004-05, along with Georgia Healey ... biggest contributions in final season could come in the 400 individual medley and 200 breast-stroke ... ranks as the third-fastest in school history in both the 1,000-yard freestyle (career-best 9:57.80) and the

1,650 free (16:37.77) ... holds the Notre Dame record in the 1,500-meter freestyle, with a mark of 17:01.00 in the 2003 Texas A&M Invitational ...

owns two of the top five 1,000-yard times in Irish history, as well as three of the top eight in the 1,650 free ... swam 1.650 (finished 29th) and 500 free (56th) in 2002 NCAA meet ... also ranks as seventh-fastest all-time in the 500 free (4:54.84), ninth in the 400 individual medlev (4:23.77), and 10th in the 200 breaststroke (2:19.76) ... tabbed Academic A11-America by the College Swim Coaches Association (CSCAA) as a rookie, boasting the ninth-highest gradepoint average of all honorees (3.91) ... a member of Notre Dame's Academic Honors Program Student-Athletes ... carries team-best 3.94 cumulative GPA ... has been named to

The top diver in Notre Dame history returns for fifth year of collegiate competition in search of an NCAA title ... posted the highest-ever finish for an Irish student-athlete in the NCAA Championships in 2004, α third-place result in one-meter diving ... ended up just 3.30 points behind national champion Allison Brennan of South Carolina and was named an All-American ... tabbed honorable mention All-America off the onemeter board in 2003 for a ninth-place finish \dots threetime conference champ was named BIG EAST Championships Most Outstanding Diver in 2003 and '04 ... five-time all-conference selection won league title in '03 in one-meter action before sweeping both springboard competitions by more than 40 points in '04 ... also was BIG EAST runner-up in one-meter diving in '02 and three-meter in '03 ... became first Irish diver ever to capture a title at the NCAA Zone C Diving Championships, beating the field off the one-meter board in 2004 \dots was undefeated in three-meter action and had been beaten just once off the lower board heading into the zone meet in '04 ... holds four of Notre Dame's six diving records: six-dive, one-meter dual (322.64); six-dive, one-meter championship (331.58); 11dive, three-meter dual (586.43); and six-dive, platform championship (336.60) ... boasts all of the top 10 championship one-meter scores since the six-dive format was adopted ... boasts four of the top six scores in onemeter dual action ... has accounted for five of the top eight performances in dual-meet competition off the three-meter board, but is still looking to break Heather Mattingly's record of 351.15 ... took 20th ('03) and 28th ('04) at the NCAAs in three-meter action \dots holds Rolfs Aquatic Center records for dual-meet, one-meter action (322.64); six-dive, championship-meet one-meter competition (315.25); and three-meter dual-meet action (333.82) \dots brings greater intensity to the board this season ... challenge will be to dominate on both boards ... also will face stiffer competition in NCAAs, as the 2004 field was without some top divers who took off the collegiate season to train for the Olympics ... could improve the degree of difficulty in her program ... powerful and has ability to perform beautiful dives ... consistent, precise, and clean in the air ... sometimes arches during entry ... qualified for 2004 U.S. Olympic Trials but could not compete due to injury \dots graduated in May 2004 with a degree in mechanical engineering and is now pursuing a master's degree in chemical engineering ... three-time monogram winner.

AS A SENIOR: Turned in the most impressive season ever for a Notre Dame diver, which was capped off by a third-place finish off the one-meter board at the NCAA Championships ... posted score of 303.90 points to finish just 3.30 points behind national champion Allison Brennan of South Carolina, while being named

an All-American ... swept springboard events at the conference meet, winning both by more than 40 points en route to being named the BIG EAST Championships Most Outstanding Diver for the second year in a row ... became the first Irish diver ever to finish first in αn event at the NCAA Zone C Diving Championships, defeating the field off the lower board to punch her ticket to a second consecutive NCAA meet ... became the first diver ever to be named Notre Dame's team MVP ... was beaten just one time prior to the NCAA zone meet ... through the Texas A&M Invitational, Notre Dame Invitational, Michigan Invitational, BIG EAST Championships, and dual-meet competition against 11 schools, was undefeated in three-meter action and lost just once off the lower board \dots her lone non-victory was a runner-up finish at the Michigan Invitational with a score of 295.20 that was 8.10 points behind Wolverine Tealin Keleman ... gained revenge over her three times, winning in a dual meet at Notre Dame by 38.63 points (302.63-264.00) and then by 28.95 points (564.30-535.35) in the NCAA zone meet, and finally by 50.50 (290.40-239.90) in prelims at the NCAAs ... for the season only three divers finished ahead of her in one-meter competition: Keleman, Brennan, and NCAA runner-up Lane Bassham of Alabama ... of those three only Brennan is back in 2004-05 ... headed into the zone meet perfect off the three-meter board, but then finished sixth in that meet and 28th at the NCAA Championships ... set Rolfs Aquatic Center and meet records for six-dive, one-meter competition in a championship meet with a first-place score of 315.25 in the Notre Dame Invitational ... contributed 40 points in helping Notre Dame to its eighth consecutive BIG EAST championship ... posted scores of 509.05 off the threemeter board and 297.95 in one-meter action to top runner-up Emily Spychala of Miami by 49.25 and 41.80 points, respectively ... earned all-BIG EAST honors in both events ... season-best score in one-meter dualmeet action was 315.82 against Pittsburgh, while her three-meter tally of 335.85 at the Michigan Invitational was the second-highest six-dive score in Irish history ... season-high in three-meter championship action was 516.60 at the Notre Dame Invitational

AS A IUNIOR: Earned honorable mention All-America honors on the one-meter diving board after placing ninth at the 2003 NCAA Championships ... finished 20th in the three-meter event with 461.95 points ... joined Heather Mattingly as the only Irish divers to earn All-America status for the Irish ... became the first Irish diver to be named ${\tt BIG\,EAST\,Championships}$ Most Outstanding Diver after taking the title on the one-meter board and finishing second in three-meter competition ... also finished second in 10-meter platform diving at BIG EAST meet with school-record score






