Linda Gallo, a 1998 graduate who was tabbed the BIG EAST Championships Most Outstanding Swimmer as a senior, remains the most prolific distance freestyler in Notre Dame history, holding the Irish records in the 500 (4:47.04), 1,000 (9:56.34), and 1,650 (16:24.48).



Kristen Van Saun broke the Notre Dame record in the 200-yard freestyle at the 1999 BIG EAST Championships and that time of 1:49.29 still stands tops in program history.



Heather Mattingly, a 2002 graduate, was one of the top divers in Notre Dame history, and she still holds school records for dual-meet three-meter competition (351.15), as well as for the now-defunct 10-dive one-meter format (425.40).

Irish All-America Honors

In the history of women's swimming and diving varsity competition at Notre Dame, 21 different student-athletes have combined for a total of 65 All-America accolades. When the program gained varsity status in 1981-82, it actually already had six All-America honors to its credit. Competing as part of the men's swimming and diving team, distance freestyler Jeanine Blatt and diver Besty Shadley finished in the top 16 of the AIAW Division III National Championships, earning All-America status in both 1979 and '80. They were joined in the latter season by two of their teammates, backstroker Lee Ann Brislaw and butterfly Kathleen Latino.

Notre Dame's first Division I All-American – and only before the arrival of current head coach Bailey Weathers in 1995-96 – was Tanya Williams, who first gained mention in the 200 individual medley in 1990-91 before garnering honors in both backstroke events in her final season, 1992-93.

Since Weathers' arrival on campus, Notre Dame has garnered at least one All-America accolade every year, with 14 swimmers and two divers combining for 56 awards. Leading that group is current assistant coach Carrie Nixon ('02), who 12 times gained All-America accolades, including twice being tabbed an All-American

(2000 and '02 in the 50 freestyle). Breaststroker Shannon Suddarth ('00) was an All-American in the 100-yard race in 1998, and she also was tabbed honorable mention eight times to bring her total to nine All-America citations, while backstroker Kelly Hecking ('02) was an eight-time honoree. Tanya Williams, Notre Dame's first Division I All-American, was a nine-time honoree (five-time All-American) under the old All-America system. The most decorated diver in Irish history is Heather Mattingly ('02), who five times gained All-America mention, including being a three-meter All-American in her final year. In 2004, current sophomore Katie Carroll became the first Irish student-athlete ever to earn All-America honors in multiple individual events as a freshman (under the current format), gaining honorable mention in both the 200 and 400 IM.

Under the current system, the top eight finishers in each event at the NCAA Championships are named All-Americans, while the next eight (places nine through 16) are recognized as honorable mention All-America. Previously, the top 16 were All-Americans and the next 16 were honorable mention.

Irish in the NCAA Championships

Notre Dame has become a staple in the NCAA Swimming & Diving Championships over the past 15 years, as the Irish have qualified student-athletes for every meet but one since 1990. Notre Dame has finished in the top 25 five times in the past eight seasons, highlighted by its only two top-20 results. In 2000, the Irish turned in their best-ever performance in the meet, scoring 74.5 points to take 18th, while the '02 squad finished 19th with 52 points.

Diver Meghan Perry-Eaton registered the best-ever individual finish for a Notre Dame competitor in the NCAA meet when she fin-

ished third in one-meter-springboard action in 2004 with a score of 303.90 that was just 3.30 points behind the national champion. The best individual performance by an Irish swimmer was a fourth-place result turned in by current assistant coach Carrie Nixon in the 50-meter freestyle in 2000. In preliminaries, Nixon posted a time of 24.99 that set an NCAA record. The top finish for an Irish relay team also came in that meet, as Kelly Hecking, Shannon Suddarth, Elizabeth Barger, and Nixon took ninth in the 400-meter medley relay with a time of 4:07.00.

A total of 22 different Irish student-athletes (20 swimmers, two divers) have earned invitations to the NCAA Championships. Leading that group is a quintet of four-time qualifiers: Hecking, diver Heather Mattingly, Nixon, Suddarth, and Tanya Williams. Marie Labosky, a 2004 graduate, was a three-time NCAA qualifier.

The 2005 NCAA Division I Women's Swimming & Diving Championships will take place March 17-19 in the Boilermaker Aquatic Center in West Lafayette, Ind. For a full explanation of the qualifying procedures, please see page 8.

Notre Dame in the BIG EAST Championships

Notre Dame women's swimming and diving boasts an incredible – and near-perfect – record in conference meets. In 20 years of competing in league championships, the Irish have captured 19 titles, including each of the last eight in the BIG EAST Conference. After being an independent in the program's first two years, Notre Dame joined the North Star Conference from 1983-84 to 1985-86 – long enough to win three championships – before moving on to the Midwestern Collegiate Conference from 1987-88 until 1994-95 to claim eight titles in a row. The first year in the BIG EAST, 1995-96, stands as the lone blemish on Notre Dame's resume. The Irish finished third in the league championships with 492 points, just 59 behind champion Villanova (551 points), who edged Miami (548.5) for the crown. In 1997, Notre Dame won its first BIG EAST championship with 661 points, which was 113.5 ahead of runner-up Miami. Since then, Notre Dame has won every title, all by larger margins than that. The most dominating performance came in 2000, when the Irish won 14 events to finish with 827.5 points and second-place Rutgers had 437.

Notre Dame's current streak of dominance is tied for the fourth-longest string of BIG EAST titles in conference history by any school in any sport. The only longer streaks were 10 consecutive championships for Pittsburgh in men's swimming and diving from 1983-92 and nine in a row for the Panthers' women's team from 1983-91 and nine straight by Connecticut's women's

basketball squad from 1994-2002. Boston College also won eight straight in men's tennis from 1981-88 and Pittsburgh's men's swimming and diving team also has currently won eight in a row.

The Irish dominance of the BIG EAST meet has extended to race victories, as Notre Dame has taken first 70 times over the past nine years, an average of nearly eight wins per meet. Leading the way in BIG EAST titles is 2002 graduate Kelly Hecking, a 19-time conference champion who won the 100 backstroke during all four of her seasons. Current assistant coach Carrie Nixon ('02) was an 18-time BIG EAST champion, while 2000 graduate Elizabeth Barger won 11 titles and her classmate, Shannon Suddarth, was victorious eight times.

The Irish also have been recognized for excellence by the conference on various occasions, as Bailey Weathers has been tabbed the BIG EAST Coach of the Year five times (1997-99, 2001-02) and Caiming Xie was the 2004 conference diving coach of the year. Three Irish student-athletes – Linda Gallo (1998), Nixon (2000), and Katie Carroll (2004) – have been the BIG EAST Championships Most Outstanding Swimmer, while current fifth-year senior Meghan Perry-Eaton was the meet's Most Outstanding Diver in each of the last two years (2003 and '04).

The most prestigious honor awarded to a Notre Dame student-athlete, the Byron V. Kanaley Award has been presented each year since 1927 to the senior monogram athletes who have been most exemplary as both students and leaders. The awards, presented by the Faculty Board on Athletics, are named in honor of a 1904 Notre Dame graduate who was a member of the Irish baseball team as an undergraduate. Kanaley went on to a successful banking career in Chicago and served the University as a lay trustee from 1915 until his death in 1960. Women's swimming and diving Kanaley recipients are below:

Jilen Siroky, who graduated in 2004 after an injury-plagued Notre Dame career, was the United States champion in the 100-meter breaststroke in 1996 en route to finishing 15th in the Athens Olympics in the 200 breast.

In addition to their many accomplishments in collegiate action, Notre Dame women's swimmers and divers have a history of also competing in various prestigious national and international meets, including in each of the last three Olympics. In 1996, Jilen Siroky ('04), then just 15 years of age, represented the United States in the Atlanta games, finishing 15th in the 200-meter breaststroke. Siroky also was the '96 U.S. champion in the 100 breast. In 2000, current junior Christel Bouvron represented her native Singapore in the Sydney games, finishing 32nd in the 200-meter butterfly and 36th in the 400 freestyle. Four years later, she became just the second current Notre Dame student-ath-

lete ever – and first in 84 years – to take part in the Olympics, matching her 32nd-place finish in the 200 fly.

In addition to that pair of Olympians, 26 Irish student-athletes have competed in U.S. Olympic Trials and four more have swum in their native country's trials. Backstroker Erin Brooks, a 1997 graduate, represented the U.S. in the '97 World University Games and came home with a bronze medal in the 200 backstroke. Notre Dame also has a long history of swimmers and divers who have qualified or competed in the USA Swimming Senior National Championships, as nearly 60 future, current, or former Irish competitors have done so.

Erin Brooks represented the United States and Notre Dame in the 1997 World University Games and came home with a bronze medal in the 200 backstroke.

The University of Notre Dame is the nation's leading example that academic and athletic excellence can go hand in hand, and the Irish women's swimming and diving team does its part in upholding that tradition.

Notre Dame is ranked in the Top 20 of the *U.S. News & World Report* survey of America's best national universities and was 19th in the 2003-04 NACDA Directors' Cup standings of the top all-around collegiate athletic programs in the nation. A 2003 report by the National Collegiate Scouting Association listed Notre Dame second (behind Stanford) in Division I-A rankings for top academic and athletic schools, based on graduation percentages, *U.S. News & World Report* academic rankings, and NACDA Directors' Cup results.

In 2003, Notre Dame was the recipient of the *USA Today/NCAA Academic Achievement Award* for having the highest overall student-athlete graduation rate among Division I schools, 92 percent. The University boasts an amazing 99 percent graduation rate for student-athletes who exhaust their eligibility at Notre Dame and the overall student body graduates at a 95 percent clip – the second-highest mark in the country, behind only Harvard.

Among all of their academic accomplishments, the Irish rank second all-time in the number of student-athletes honored as Academic All-Americans, with 152.

The women's swimming and diving team has traditionally been a strong link in the Irish chain of academic excellence, as it is regularly honored with the Collegiate Swimming Coaches Association of America (CSCAA) academic awards for their high team grade-point averages. Most recently, Notre Dame garnered the distinction for the fall 2003 semester, when it finished 37th in Division I in team GPA (3.247).

The Irish men's swimming and diving team also has been strong in this area. In the spring semester of 1999, Notre Dame held the distinction of boasting the highest team grade-point average among all Division I men's swimming and diving programs, a 3.352 mark. That was part of a string of seven consecutive semesters in which Notre Dame was in the top 10 on that list.

The Irish also have regularly had swimmers recognized by the CSCAA for their individual academic achievement. Seven times Irish student-athletes have been named CSCAA Academic All-Americans for posting a 3.50+ GPA and qualifying for the NCAA Championships. Most recently, current seniors Kelli Barton and Kristen Peterson gained the honor in 2002. Both also finished among the top 20 in that group in GPA; Barton was ninth (3.902) and Peterson was 16th (3.867). Elizabeth Barger ('00) and Brittany Kline ('99) are the only Irish student-athletes to be multiple-time honorees, as they both were Academic All-Americans in their final two seasons, while Shannon Suddarth gained the accolade in 1999. Additionally, Notre Dame has 12 times had swimmers tabbed honorable mention Academic All-America by the CSCAA, a distinction awarded to all swimmers who post a 3.50+ GPA for the year and also register at least one NCAA "B" time (without earning a bid to the NCAA Championships).

A unique opportunity to participate in a special honors program is available for student-athletes who excel both athletically and academically. The Notre Dame Academic Honors Program for Student-Athletes, which assists high academic achievers in a variety of areas so student-athletes can achieve their highest potential while attending the University, relies heavily on the recommendations of head coaches. The program matches student-athletes with mentors in their desired field of study and creates a network base which the students can use as they approach graduation. Former Irish football player Grant Irons had Tom Mendoza, for whom the Notre Dame Mendoza College of Business was named, as a mentor. Mendoza, in turn, introduced Irons to investment wizard Warren Buffet, who also has taken Irons under his wing.

Six members of the Irish women's swimming and diving program have taken part in the honors program, including Barton and Peterson.

Irish women's swimmers and divers also have been tabbed BIG EAST Conference Academic All-Stars on 158 occasions since joining the league in 1995-96. To qualify for that honor, one must earn a monogram and post a 3.00 GPA for the academic year.

The Irish swimming and diving teams compete in the state-of-the-art Rolfs Aquatic Center. After four years of varsity intercollegiate swimming competition in the Rockne Memorial Pool, the Notre Dame women's swimming and diving program entered a new era in 1985, as they moved to the \$4.5-million natatorium located in the Joyce Center.

Donated by brothers Thomas and Robert Rolf of West Bend, Wis., the Rolfs Aquatic Center provides Notre Dame with a modern, innovative facility on par with any other in the country. Ellerbe Architects and Engineers of Bloomington, Minn., the architects used in the planning of the Joyce Center, also were commissioned to design the 45,000-square-foot facility which houses a 50-meter Olympic pool (25 yards in width), spectator seating for 400 and support facilities.

The facility features two movable bulkheads to allow sections of the pool to be blocked off, allowing swimming competition and warm-up swimming to occur simultaneously. The design also allows recreational swimming, water polo, instructional swimming and other aquatic

activities. Diving is accommodated with two one-meter boards and two three-meter boards.

Support functions housed in the center of the facility just below the spectator seating include men's and women's locker rooms, men's and women's varsity locker rooms, and men's and women's staff locker rooms. Offices for the Notre Dame swimming staff, aquatics directors, and lifeguards are deckside and glass-fronted with a view of the pool.

Several deckside instructional areas are located around the pool and feature infrared heat lamps, designed to keep wet swimmers warm between events. The pool features a stainless steel racing gutter which is designed

to absorb the bow waves of a swimmer, allowing faster swimming times.

Another instructional feature is the presence of two underwater windows which allow critiquing of a diver's or swimmer's underwater technique. The unique structural system consists of three trusses which span 120 feet, with the roof suspended below the trusses. In addition, the white exterior trusses provide an interesting and athletic character to the building. The lighting system is designed to be adjusted from maximum brightness for television to nearly dark for dramatic synchronized swimming presentations.

The center was officially dedicated on November 13, 1985.
