MOONEY NAMED TO PRESEASON ALL-ACC FIRST TEAM

Senior forward John Mooney was named to the 2019-20 Preseason All-ACC First Team, by a vote of the attendees of ACC Media Day on October 8, 2019.

Mooney posted a remarkable junior year campaign for the Irish in 2018-19, his superlatives included:

- One of just seven major conference players to average a double-double (14.1 ppg, 11.2 rpg)
- Leading all major conference players in rebounds per game (12.6) in conference play
- Becoming the third Notre Dame player in the past four seasons to lead the ACC in rebounding
- Leading the ACC in double-doubles, both overall (20) and in conference play (13)
- Posting the second-most double-doubles in ACC conference play ever, behind Tim Duncan's 15 in 1996-97
- His 12.6 rebounds-per-game average in ACC play is the second-highest total since Tim Duncan posted a 14.9 number in 1996-97
- He is the leading rebounder, second-leading field-goal percentage and sixth-leading scorer returning to the ACC this season

MOONEY PUTS UP NUMBERS IN DEAN DOME

Senior forward John Mooney has posted two of his best performances in an Irish uniform against North Carolina in the Smith Center. As a sophomore, Mooney went six-for-six from three point range to score a then career-high 18 points. He followed up last season by grabbing a career-best 19 rebounds while scoring a team-high 16 points.

In his last two game in Chapel Hill, Mooney has shot .650 from the field, .857 from three point range while averaging 12.5 rebounds and 17.0 points per game.

Notre Dame finished third in the NCAA last season in turnovers per game – posting the fifth consecutive season of ranking in the ation's top-10 for least amount of turnovers in a game.

Hubb is the fourth Mike Brey-era guard to reach 100 assists in his rookie season.

DURHAM RIM PROTECTION MAKES AN IMPRESSION

Even though Juwan Durham is listed as a senior on the Notre Dame roster, he actually just finished off his first season of full action in 2018-19. Durham saw limited minutes in his freshman season at UConn (2016-17) after sitting out his senior year of high school to recover from an ACL tear in his right knee. He also had wrist surgery while sitting out during his transfer season last year with the Irish.

In his first game in a Notre Dame uniform against UIC (11/6/18) he became the first Notre Dame player since 2012 to block six shots in a game. Durham also sparked the Irish with 10 points and five blocks in the second half of a victory over Illinois (11/27/18).

During the Mike Brey era (2000-01 - present) only six other players have blocked five or more shots multiple times, putting the Tampa, Florida, native - with two full years of eligibility remaining starting in 2019-20 - among some noteworthy Irish players.

Durham combined to block nine shots in Notre Dame's two exhibition game victories this season.

In 19 full seasons as the men's basketball coach at the University of Notre Dame, Mike Brey has guided the Fighting Irish to 417 victories and is the all-time winningest men's basketball coach in school history.

The Irish are enjoying a recent stretch of success that ranks among the best in the basketball under the Golden Dome. Notre Dame was the only school in the nation to m appearances in the NCAA Championship Elite Eight at the end of the 2015 and 2016 sea Atlantic Coast Conference title in 2015 and has made two ACC title game appearances ACC competition.

Brey was named head coach at Notre Dame on July 14, 2000. In his first season with team claimed the 2001 BIG EAST West Division championship and returned to the NCA for the first time in 12 seasons. Notre Dame soon became a regular in the NCAA tourna 12 appearances in 17 seasons with Brey on the sidelines.

In 2011, Brey was the recipient of both the Associated Press and the Henry Iba/USE Coach of the Year award. He was named BIG EAST Coach of the Year in 2007, 2008 and his players have been named BIG EAST Player of the Year.

Before arriving at Notre Dame, Brey was the head basketball coach at the Universit where he compiled a 99-52 mark from 1995-2000 and won America East Co-Coach of in 1998. Prior to his time at Delaware, he was an assistant coach at Duke University. Du years at Duke, the Blue Devils advanced to the Final Four six times and won back-to-ba championships in 1991 and 1992.

Brey graduated from George Washington University in 1982. He played for and colegendary high school coach Morgan Wootten at DeMatha High School.

Brey serves on the Coaches vs. Cancer National Council and has helped raise over three million dollars for the organization. He has also partnered with the American Heart Association to create the Men of Heart initiative, raising funds and awareness for men's heart health. Brey is on the National Advisory Board of the Positive Coaching Alliance and is midway through his one-year term as the president of the NABC. He has been inducted into the Delaware and George Washington Halls of Fame.

Glenn and Stacey Murphy Head Men's Basketball Coach Mike Brey has announced the addition of Cormac Ryan to the 2019–20 University of Notre Dame men's basketball roster. A 6–5 guard out of New York, New York, who spent his prep career at Milton Academy (Massachusetts), Ryan will sit out the 2019–20 season after transferring from Stanford.

"Cormac is the consummate all-around guard," Brey said. "He is the total package you look for in a player in terms of skills, basketball IQ and competitiveness. I am very excited to have him in our program and he will play a key role in our team's development as a practice player this season."

Ryan appeared in 24 games for Stanford in 2018–19, starting 17 contests (including the season opener) and finished with an 8.7 points-per-game average while leading the team with 49 three-point field goals. He also posted 83 rebounds (3.5 per game) and 45 assists (1.8 per game) while shooting .737 at the free throw line. Ryan scored 10 or more points 10 times during his freshman season, including 19 points against UCLA and 18 against Southern Cal.

"I'm fired up to be joining the Notre Dame family," Ryan said. "From the coaching staff to the guys on the team, I feel at home here and I can't wait to see what the future holds for us."

A consensus four-star prospect out of Milton Academy in Milton, Massachusetts, Ryan was a two-time New England Prep School Athletic Conference (NEP-SAC) Class A Player of the Year (2017, 2018). He scored 1,423 in three seasons at Milton, joining the team as a sophomore after playing his freshman season at Collegiate Prep in New York City.

Ryan will arrived on campus in August of 2019 for the start of the 2019-20 academic year at Notre Dame.

• All interviews with Notre Dame student-athlete or coaches must be arranged through the Athletic Communications Office.

GAME DAY PARKING

 Parking for all Notre Dame men's basketball games is free and open on a first-come first-served basis. Parking south of Notre Dame Stadium is recommended for easy access to the media entrance.

MEDIA ENTRANCE/CREDENTIAL WILL CALL

• Media Will Call will open two hours before the public game tip time.

• The University of Notre Dame has instituted a clear bag policy for fans attending events at men's and women's basketball games in 2018-19. This policy does not apply to credentialed media members covering the game.

• All credentialed media members must pick up credentials at Door 4 of Corbett Hall (the eastern-most building attached to Notre Dame Stadium. This is the same place at the media entrance for Notre Dame football games).

• All credentialed media will be required to enter Gate 1 of Purcell Pavilion at the Joyce Center.

• Media members attempting to enter any other gate of the Joyce Center will be redirected to Gate 1 for entrance.

MEDIA SEATING

• All non-live-broadcast media seating is located in the press box of Purcell Pavilion. For access to the press box, enter Gate 1, take the stairs, then enter the arena through the double doors leading to Section 109.

• The entrance to the press box is to the left (see map for further details).

PHOTOGRAPHER SEATING/WORK AREA

• Purcell Pavilion offers two areas for photographers and videographers to shoot the game from the baseline. Please check for your assigned photo position at Media Will Call (Gate 1) and in the Photo Work Room.

• Due to the relocation of working media to the upper press box, photographers are asked to utilize the Photo Work Room, located between the Gate 10 and Gate 1 entrances, for equipment storage and post game uploading.

• To access the Photo Work Room from Gate 1, enter Purcell

Pavilion thorugh the doors on the first level, take the first right and the Photo Work Room will be on your left just past the tunnel access to courtside.

• Selected Notre Dame student-athletes will be brought to the Hammes Basketball Auditorium immediately following the completion of the game.


• The visiting head coach will follow the Notre Dame student-athletes, followed by Glenn and Stacey Murphy head men's basketball coach Mike Brey.
