#### AT THE HELM

Karen and Kevin Keyes head coach Muffet McGraw completed her 32nd season at the helm of the Irish (840-238) and 37th year overall as a head coach (928-279). With 928 career wins, McGraw ranks seventh alltime among Division I coaches. McGraw also ranks fifth among active coaches, trailing Tara VanDerveer, Geno Auriemma, Barbara Stevens and Vivian Stringer.

McGraw is also just one of four coaches (men's or women's basketball) in NCAA Division I history with over 900 wins, nine Final Fours and multiple national championships. The prestigious list includes Pat Summitt, Geno Auriemma and Duke men's coach Mike Krzyzewski.

In September of 2017, McGraw was enshrined into the Naismith Memorial Basketball Hall of Fame, becoming the 32nd woman ever to do so and 13th female coach.

Coach McGraw boasts nine Final Fours (third behind Auriemma and Summit), seven NCAA title game appearances and the third most NCAA Tournament wins with 67. Coach McGraw is also the sixth different coach with multiple NCAA titles, joining Auriemma, Summit, Linda Sharp, Tara VanDerveer and Kim Mulkey.

Finally, against the very school in which she began her head coaching career, Coach McGraw joined the 900-win club when the Irish defeated Lehigh on Dec. 30, 2018. McGraw became the fourth fastest Division I coach to

reach the 900 win milestone, doing so in 1,172 games:

Geno Auriemma 1,034 games 1,072 games Pat Summitt 1,104 games Tara VanDerveer

#### NCAA HISTORY

Notre Dame wrapped its 26th NCAA Championship appearance and 24th in a row. Their 24 straight appearances are the fourth longest active streak in the country and fifth best all-time.

The Irish are 67-24 all-time in the NCAA Tournament, as their 67 wins rank fourth all-time.

Notre Dame joins Louisiana Tech, USC and Stanford with two NCAA titles behind UConn (11), Tennessee (8) and Baylor (3).

Notre Dame is one of three schools (Tennessee & UConn) to reach seven NCAA Title games. Their nine Final Four appearances are the fifth-most of any school behind Tennessee (18), UConn (18), Stanford (13) and La Tech

The Irish have reached 10 Elite Eights. In fact, Notre Dame and UConn are the only teams to reach the Elite Eight eight times in the last nine years. Yet, the Irish have been more successful than any other regularly-appearing school at that stage, as their .900 winning percentage (9-1) is the best of any program to play in at least five Elite Eights.

Finally, Notre Dame has advanced to 17 Sweet 16s. The Irish are one of four schools to make the last 10 straight Sweet 16s, joining UConn, Stanford and Baylor.

#### AGAINST THE BIG TEN

For the past decade, the Irish have been absolutely dominant against the Big Ten conference. Since the 2009-10 season, the Irish have gone 23-1 against Big Ten opposition, with the one blip being Michigan State on Nov. 14 of this season.

#### ACC/B1G CHALLENGE

With a 105-71 win over No. 14 lowa last season, the Irish moved to 6-0 in the ACC/B1G Challenge.

Last year's Challenge was among the most competitive in the event's history, with the ACC edging the Big Ten, 8-6. The title was the ninth in league history for the ACC, which owns a 9-0-3 advantage in the Challenge.

#### PEOPLES - ACC ROOKIE OF THE WEEK

When the Cancun Challenge wrapped, freshman Anaya Peoples had garnered two major accolades: the Cancun All-Tournament Team and ACC Rookie of the Week.

Peoples averaged 17.3 points and 8.7 rebounds over three games in Cancun. Peoples led the Irish in both scoring and rebounding against No. 21 USF with 18 points and nine boards, helping Notre Dame earn its second ranked victory on the season.

Peoples also tallied a career-high tying 19 points against FGCU and pulled down nine boards. Against South Dakota State, the Danville, Illinois native logged 15 points and eight boards. Thus, Peoples came just shy in the rebounding department in all three games of potential double-doubles (9/8/9 rebounds).

Furthermore, Peoples boasted the best shooting percentage on the team this past week, converting 20-of-32 from the floor, a.k.a. 62.5 percent of her shots.

#### **YOU ARE MY DESTINEE**

When looking at 'wins-only' stats versus 'losses-only' stats, one starter's stat-line is noticeably different. The lesson - when Destinee Walker goes, the Irish go.

In games the Irish have won, Walker leads the team in scoring with 17.0 ppg, knocking down 42.9 percent from the field. The Orlando native is also more active on the glass, averaging 5.6 rpg.

In losses only, Walker averages 9.5 ppg on 28.9 percent shooting to go along with her 2.3 rpg.

#### **COSGROVE - GOOD LUCK CHARM?**

Coincidence or good luck charm? But Danielle Cosgrove has started two games this season for the Irish and in both contests, the Irish have picked up ranked wins: No. 21 Michigan and No. 21 South Florida.

#### **IF ONLY THEY KEPT THE STAT**

If charges taken was an official NCAA kept stat, Marta Sniezek could very well be atop the list in the nation. Just in Cancun alone, Sniezek took one against FGCU, four against South Dakota State, then took four again the very next day versus No. 21 South Florida for a weekly total of nine.

Earlier in the season, Sniezek took two charges vs. Tennessee and one vs. Michigan State for a season total of 12.

#### **GRITTING OUT A WIN**

The new-look Irish are certainly learning and growing together during the early portion of the season. Notre Dame has already recorded four games that finished in five points or less, and are 3-1 in said instances.

The Irish trailed by nine points late in the second quarter against Toledo on Nov. 20 before rallying to win 54-51. Then three days later the Irish stormed back from 11 down midway through the second quarter at No. 21 Michigan to gut out a 76-72 victory - their first ranked win on the year.

The last time the Irish trailed by double digits and won was when Notre Dame rallied down 14 against Oregon State in the Vancouver Showcase on Nov. 24, 2018. The Irish ultimately won 91-81.

#### **BRUNELLE SETS FRESHMAN RECORD**

Never in the history of the Fighting Irish women's basketball program has a player started her ND career with five straight games in double figures ... until now.

Freshman Sam Brunelle did just that with her 19-point performance in the win over Toledo, picking up her first career double-double as well with 13 boards.

Brunelle continued to add to her record, as she made it seven straight before her streak ended at vs. South Dakota State on Nov. 29.

#### **TURNOVER TURMOIL**

One has to give props to the Irish defense where it is due. In five of the last seven games, Notre Dame has forced at least 20 turnovers:

Tennessee – 28 Michigan State - 20 Toledo – 21 Michigan – 24 South Dakota State – 22

Notre Dame ranks third in the ACC in turnovers forced and 78th in the nation, averaging 19.8 on the year. Furthermore, the Irish boast a +3.0 turnover margin, which ranks third in the ACC. The Irish also rank fourth in the league in steals per game with a 9.2 average.

Speaking of steals, both Katlyn Gilbert and Anaya Peoples rank third in the ACC in steals/game with a 2.0 average each. Destinee Walker ranks 11th in the league at 1.8 while Marta Sniezek ranks 13th at 1.7.

#### HIGHEST RANKED RECRUITING CLASS

Coach McGraw just signed her highest ranked recruiting class during her time at Notre Dame, reeling in the No. 3 ranked group in the 2020 recruiting class. The Irish received NLI's from Amirah Abdur-Rahim, No. 25 Alli Campbell, No. 44 Alasia Hayes, No. 32 Natalija Marshall and No. 23 Maddy Westbeld. It not only marks the highest ranked recruiting class in her tenure, but also ties the most commits as well.

"This is one of the best classes we've ever had," Coach McGraw stated. "Obviously down to six scholarship players right now so numbers was our first priority. We got four kids ranked in the top-50 and a top-3 recruiting class. All such a great fit for our program."

In addition, the Atlanta Tipoff Club announced those student-athletes on the 2020 Jersey Mike's Naismith Girls High School Trophy Watch List. Campbell, Marshall and Westbeld were all recognized as top-50 player of the year candidates.

#### **AN IMPRESSIVE STREAK ENDED**

A 12-year streak ended on Monday, Nov. 18, when Notre Dame exited the A.P. Top-25 poll. At the time, the Irish boasted the third highest active streak in the country with 234 straight weeks in the poll - only UConn and Baylor were higher. The streak dates back to the start of the 2007-08 season.

#### PROTECTING THE HOUSE

Purcell Pavilion continues to be one of the toughest venues to play in women's hoops. Before the back-to-back losses at home against Tennessee and Michigan State, the Irish were 110-3 over their last 113 games, which dates back to the 2012-13 season. The only three losses suffered in that stretch came at the hands of the UConn Huskies.

Notre Dame is now 484-95 all-time inside Purcell Pavilion. The Irish have sold out Purcell Pavilion 56 times and boasts a 46-10 record in those instances.

Most notably, however, has been how dominant the Irish have been in league play at home. Notre Dame has won a school-record 58 consecutive home conference games, beginning with a 66-47 win over Providence on Feb. 14, 2012, in BIG EAST play.

#### **WELCOME BACK GILBERT**

Last season, Gilbert played in six full games, including a breakout Vancouver Showcase, before suffering a season-ending shoulder injury against lowa on Nov. 29, 2018. Nearly a year later, Gilbert has returned in full force, leading the team in scoring with her 14.9 ppg, which ranks 15th in the ACC. In fact, Gilbert is riding a career best stretch of nine consecutive double-digit scoring performances - also a team best.

Gilbert also leads the Irish in steals/game (2.0) and made field goals (54), as the latter ranks 22nd in the country. Gilbert also has one 20+ scoring effort under her belt, recording a career high of 24 points against Loyola.

#### **GILBERT-PEOPLES CONNECTION**

The on-the-court chemistry between guards Katlyn Gilbert and Anaya Peoples has been immediate and there's no wonder way. Gilbert, from the Indianapolis area, and Peoples from Danville, Illinois, have played together every summer since they were seven and six years old, respectively. The duo first played on FBC together and later finished playing with Midwest Elite in Chicago.

The two spearheaded the big win over Loyola in the home opener, combining for 26 of the team's 44 second half points.

#### **BRUNELLE 4TH QUARTER SURGES**

Trailing by seven points in the fourth quarter to Michigan State, Sam Brunelle tried spearheading the rally by scoring 11 of her 19 points in the final period alone. Brunelle connected on two treys in the quarter, including one with 10 seconds left to cut the deficit to one. Brunelle also got a final three-point attempt up at the buzzer to tie the game, but the shot came up just short.

Then at No. 21 Michigan on Nov. 23, Brunelle recorded a stretch in the fourth quarter in which she scored nine of the team's next 11 points, ultimately finishing with 12 points for the game.

#### **#24 CONTINUED**

Putting on the No. 24 jersey in 2019 means big shoes to fill in South Bend. Though Arike's final two seasons with the Irish could never be replicated, grad transfer Destinee Walker is looking to step up to the plate.

It's been a long road back for Walker, who is competing in a full season for the first time in two years. Her only true injury-free season came her freshman year in 2015-16 at North Carolina, starting in 31-of-32 games played.

Walker debuted with the Irish with a 10-point, 10-rebound, double-double - just the second of her career. In game two, Walker came out hot, scoring 13 of her 19 points against Loyola MD in the first half. Walker then led the Irish in scoring against Tennessee with 18 points.

After the loss to the Lady Vols on Nov. 11, Coach Mc-Graw urged Walker to be confident and take more shots when she has open looks.

Next, Walker hit the game-winning basket for the Irish in the 54-51 win over Toledo (11/20), tallying 12 points in the game.

Then Walker exploded with a season high 27 points at No. 21 Michigan on Nov. 23, tying her career high from beyond the arc with five made three's (5-for-8). Walker scored nine of the team's 14 third quarter points.

In the Cancun Challenge, Walker scored seven of her 17 points against No. 21 USF (11/30) in the fourth quarter, helping the Irish to the ranked win. Thus, over the last two ranked games, Walker has tallied 44 points on 15-of-30 shooting (.500) with a 6-of-15 mark from three and an 8-of-13 mark from the free-throw line.

#### WHAT WE'VE LOST

Starters Ogunbowale, Young, Mabrey, Shepard and Turner went down as the most prolific scoring fivesome in NCAA Division I history. The ND quintet amassed a total of 10,230 points, becoming the first group to ever accumulate 10,000 points or more.

When you look at those who graduated/went to the WNBA, transferred or who are currently injured (Prohaska & Vaughn), the Irish have lost 3,384 points of their 3,454 team total from last season. That equates to 98 percent of their offense. Both the percentage and total rank as the most all-time lost for a power-five school.

Now last year's starters went on to make WNBA Draft history - becoming the first starting five to not only be drafted but do so in the first 20 picks. Jackie Young became the second Irish player in program history selected No. 1 overall, joining Jewell Loyd, when she was picked by the Las Vegas Aces. Notre Dame joined Stanford, Tennessee and UConn as the only programs with multiple No. 1 overall selections.

Moments later, the Dallas Wings selected Arike Ogunbowale fifth overall. This marked the first time the Irish had two first round picks within the top five. History continued with the 11th overall pick, where the Atlanta Dream selected Brianna Turner, thus marking the first time Notre Dame had three first round picks. However, shortly after, the Mercury traded for the rights of Turner, shipping the forward to Phoenix, Arizona. Next up, Jessica Shepard went 16th overall to the Minnesota Lynx. Then Marina Mabrey completed the group after going 19th overall to the Los Angeles Sparks.

Furthermore, Ogunbowale, Young and Turner were later named to the WNBA All-Rookie Team, as ND became the first program to have three selections.

#### **CHANGE IN COACHING**

Out of 349 NCAA Division I women's basketball programs at the start of the 2018-19 season, Notre Dame was one of just six, whose head coach and three



assistant coaches were together seven consecutive seasons. However, change met familiarity for the 2019-20 season. Just months after Coach McGraw's passionate Final Four speech about wanting more female leadership, Niele Ivey accepted an assistant coaching position with the Memphis Grizzlies, becoming the ninth active NBA female coach.

Enter a last name Notre Dame fans know all too well
- Mabrey. Michaela ensures that a Mabrey will be on
Notre Dame's campus for the eighth straight year. A
2016 alumna, her younger sister just graduated in 2019.
Mabrey has spent one year coaching stints at Miami,
Miami (Ohio) and LSU.

#### FRESHMEN STARTERS

A program rarity occurred in the season opener at Fordham, when Coach McGraw started freshmen Sam Brunelle and Anaya Peoples. It marked the first time two freshmen started a season opener for Notre Dame since the 2001-02 season opener in which Teresa Borton and Jacqueline Batteast started. And in that moment back in 2001, it marked the first time in 20 years two freshmen had started.

#### **FRESH FIVE**

With the exit of last year's starting five, the transfers of Nixon and Patterson, along with Prohaska's and Vaughn's injury, the Irish had a starting five who have never started in an Irish uniform: two grad transfers, two true freshmen and a redshirt freshman (sophomore Katlyn Gilbert).

In addition, Danielle Cosgrove made her first career start at No. 21 Michigan on Nov. 23.

#### 1,000 PROGRAM WINS

With the victory over Fordham on Nov. 5, the Irish became the 13th team to reach the 1,000-win milestone. The teams right in front of the Irish are:

No. 12 Maryland - 1,001 wins

No. 11 Western Kentucky - 1,004 wins

No. 10 Green Bay - 1,005 wins

#### RING OF HONOR

On November 8, Natalie Achonwa joined Notre Dame's prestigious Ring of Honor. Achonwa becomes the sixth player to have a banner raised in the rafters, joining Ruth Riley-Hunter, Skylar Diggins-Smith, Niele Ivey, Beth (Morgan) Cunningham and Kayla McBride.

Donning an Irish uniform from 2010-14, Achonwa-led squads reached four consecutive Final Fours, including three NCAA title games. Achonwa accumulated an impressive 138-15 overall record (second most by a senior class) with a 60-4 mark in conference play, in addition to winning five combined regular season and conference tournament championships.

The Guelph, Ontario, native was a two-time All-American, three-time All-NCAA Regional nod and a two-time All-Conference selection (2013 Big East / 2014 ACC). Achonwa, who captained the Irish her senior year, now ranks 16th on the Irish all-time scoring list, amassing 1,546 points over her storied career.

#### SEASON OPENERS

The victory against Fordham also kept intact an impressive winning streak in season openers, marking the 25th in a row, dating back to Nov. 30, 1994.

#### NOTRE DAME - UCONN EXTENDED

The top rivalry in NCAA Division I women's basketball, Notre Dame and Connecticut, will live on through the 2023-24 season, as both programs agreed to extend the series four more years. The final game of the previous contract will take place Dec. 8 of this year inside Gampel Pavilion in Storrs, Connecticut.

The new extension will see the Huskies visit Purcell Pavilion on both Dec. 6, 2020, and Dec. 4 of 2022. The Irish will then return the trips to Connecticut on Dec. 5 of 2021, and Dec. 3 of 2023.

The two sides have competed 50 times since their inaugural bout back in January of 1996, with UConn leading the series 37-13. However, over the last nine years, Notre Dame has defeated UConn nine times, while all other Division I teams have combined for eight wins.

#### ACC NEWCOMER WATCH LIST

The Atlantic Coast Conference named freshmen Anaya Peoples and Sam Brunelle to its Newcomer Watch List, claiming two of the five spots on both the Blue Ribbon media poll and the coaches poll.

Brunelle and Peoples were top-20 ranked recruits, who comprised yet another top-10 ranked recruiting class for Karen & Kevin Keyes head coach Muffet McGraw and company. Brunelle, who was ranked No. 6 overall by espnW, was a two-time Naismith High School All-American and 2019 McDonald's All-American — won the three-point contest at the latter. Brunelle was also both the 2018 Gatorade Virginia Player of the Year and USA Today Virginia Player of the Year. Ultimately, she finished her prep career with 2,229 points and 1,272 rebounds.

Peoples, who was ranked fourth at her position, was a

two-time Illinois Class 1A State champion at Dan Schlarman High, where she finished her prep career with 2,086 points. Peoples was a 2019 McDonald's All-American and Jordan Brand Classic member. In 2018, Peoples was a Naismith All-America honorable mention.

#### CHERYL MILLER AWARD WATCH LIST

The Naismith Memorial Basketball Hall of Fame and the Women's Basketball Coaches Association announced its watch list for the 2020 Cheryl Miller Award, with freshman Sam Brunelle making the cut. The Cheryl Miller Award Watch List recognizes the top 20 small forwards in the country.

This marks the second consecutive year the Irish have had a representative on the Cheryl Miller Award Watch List. Last season, Jackie Young was a top-five finalist for the award.

#### STATISTICAL CHAMPION

The 2018-19 version of the Fighting Irish earned a statistical championship by season's end for the country's top offense. Averaging a blistering 88.6 points per game, it marks the first time in which the Irish finished as the nation's top offense. All-in-all, the Irish totaled 3,454 points.

Notre Dame's scoring average will also go down as the program's top offense as well. The 2013-14 Irish squad led by Kayla McBride and Natalie Achonwa previously held the record at 86.1 ppg (3,271 points in 38 games).

#### RECORD BREAKER X 3

Three players --> Four different record holders. Arike Ogunbowale became Notre Dame's all-time scoring leader on Feb. 21 vs Duke. The senior surpassed Skylar Diggins-Smith's record of 2,357 career points. In addition, Ogunbowale was just 1-of-5 Irish greats to score over 2,000 points, joining Ruth Riley, Katryna Gaither, Beth (Morgan) Cunningham and of course Skylar Diggins-Smith. Ogunbowale ultimately finished with 2,626 career points, which ranked third all-time in the ACC.

On March 9 in the ACC Semis vs Syracuse, Marina Mabrey became Notre Dame's made three-pointers record holder. Mabrey went 4-for-9 from deep, surpassing Alicia Ratay (262). The senior finished with 274 career made threes, which ranks eighth all-time in the ACC.

Next, on March 25 vs Michigan State, Brianna Turner became the new rebounding leader at Notre Dame, surpassing Ruth Riley's mark of 1,007. Turner finished with 1,048 rebounds.

However, Turner wasn't done there, becoming the program's new blocks leader on the game-clinching play of the National Semifinal vs. UConn. Turner surpassed Ruth Riley's 370 mark to finish with 372 --> third all-time in the ACC.



\*Honorable Mention to Jessica Shepard, who after two years with the Irish, posted a 9.2 career rebounding average. That number qualifies for first all-time.

#### A 30-WIN CAMPAIGN

Notre Dame wrapped the 2018-19 year with a 35-4 overall record, marking the program's ninth consecutive 30-win season and 11th in school history. Nationally, only UConn has a longer active streak of 30-win seasons at 14, while Baylor matches the Irish with a streak that began in 2010-11.

#### ACC CHAMPS

Notre Dame earned its sixth straight ACC regular season title and eighth straight conference regular season title when dating back to the final two years of the Big East. The six consecutive regular season titles tie the all-time mark set by Virginia from 1991-96.

In addition, the eight in a row marks the second highest active streak in the country, only behind nine from Baylor. Green Bay lost its streak of 20 to Wright State this season in the Horizon League.
