THE GAME

- Boston College (8-6, 1-2 ACC) will travel to South Bend to play Notre Dame (6-9, 1-2 ACC) on Thursday at 7 p.m. Fans can view the game on the ACC Network.
- Boston College improved to 1-2 in the ACC with a 79-70 road win at Pittsburgh on Sunday. The Eagles were led by sophomore **Makayla Dickens** with 26 points and eight assists, while **Marnelle Garraud** pitched in with 18 points, including eight points in the final three minutes to seal the win. Sophomore **Taylor Soule** added nine points and 10 rebounds.
- Notre Dame now 1-2 in the conference and 6-9 overall.
- The Irish lost at Syracuse, 74-63 in overtime. Their only other ACC loss was to Clemson.
- Katlyn Gilbert is averaging a team-high 14 points and 5.2 rebounds a game, while Destinee Walker is averaging 13.9 points and 4.2 rebounds a game.

THE SERIES

- This will be the 30th meeting between Boston College and Notre Dame.
- The two teams first played in the 1983-84 season.
- BC's last victory against Notre Dame came on March 19, 2006 in the NCAA Tournament.
- The Irish have won the last 14 meetings.
- In the 2018-19 season, Notre Dame won both games against the Eagles.
- In the first meeting in January, 2019 - Taylor Soule had 18 points and five rebounds but Notre Dame won, 92-63. Arike Ogunbowale led the Irish with 26 points.
- In the second game BC lost, 97-47, as Jessica Sheppard and Jackie Young recorded double-doubles (16-12, 15-10) while Ogunbowale had 23 points. Taylor Soule had 11 points while Emma Guy had eight points in the loss for BC.

NEED TO KNOW

- Senior **Taylor Ortlepp** returned to action vs. Delaware St. on Dec. 20 after missing 10 games with an injury. She has played limited minutes in the last three games.
- Head Coach **Joanna Bernabei-McNamee** is 2-0 at Pitt.
- BC has had the same starting lineup in the last four games - **Taylor Soule, Emma Guy, Marnelle Garraud, Makayla Dickens, Cameron Swartz.**
- **Taylor Soule** has recorded double-figures in rebounding in the last 3 games. She is currently averaging a career-high 6.9 boards a game. She has led the team on the boards in 8 games, including the last 7.
- **Marnelle Garraud** went 3-for-6 from the 3-point line in the win over Pitt. She is 10-for-16 in the last 3 games. She has tallied double-figures in nine games.
- BC has hit a 3-pointer in every game dating back to Jan. 26, 2017. The streak stands at 82 straight games.

Coch Joanna Bernabei-McNamee

- This is Coach Mac's second season at the Heights as she was hired in April 2018 after a two-year stint at Albany.
- Prior to Albany, Coach Mac was a Pikeville. She is not a stranger to the ACC or Boston. She was an assistant coach at Maryland when they won the 2005-06 NCAA Tournament in Boston. After working as an assistant at West Virginia, she took a four year hiatus to have a family. Once the two boys were old enough (Luke and Caden), Coach Mac return to coach at Pikeville.
- Assistant Coach George Porcha coached at Virginia Tech as well as West Virginia. He was at Ole Miss before arriving at the Heights.
- Coach Yolanda Griffith is an WNBA legend. Griffith played professionally for 11 years, won the WNBA title with the Monarchs in 1999, and has two gold medals. She was with Coach Mac at Albany.
- Coach AJ Cohen is a graduate of the University of Louisville. He started his women's basketball career as a practice player then turned to the video department. Cohen started coaching with Coach Mac at Pikeville, then Albany before coming to Boston College.

LAST TIME OUT

- Sophomore Marnelle Garraud scored 8 points in the final three minutes as BC defeated Pitt, 79-70, on the road on Sunday.
- With the game tied at 66-66, BC went on a 13-4 run behind two three-pointers and two foul shots from Garraud.
- Sophomore Makayla Dickens led BC with a season-high 26 points and 8 assists, while Garraud had 18.
- Boston College led 37-36 and kept a one-point lead after three, 57-56.
- BC shot 50 percent in the game and had a 41-35 edge on the boards. The Eagles also had 23 assists on 32 field goals in the game.

LAST FIVE GAMES

- BC is 3-2 in the last five games.
- The Eagles are averaging 80.6 points, 42.8 rebounds while shooting 44.2 percent from the floor.
- BC has averaged 18.4 assists in the last five games.
- In the five games, sophomore **Taylor Soule** is averaging 15 points, 10.4 rebounds while shooting 57 percent from the floor. Sophomore **Marnelle Garraud** is averaging 13.8 points and 3.8 assists while shooting 50 percent from the floor and 48 percent from the three-point line.
- In the five games, **Makayla Dickens** is averaging 13.2 points, 4.4 rebounds and 3.8 assists a game.
- Senior **Emma Guy** is shooting 60 percent from the field, while averaging 10.6 points and 4.6 rebounds in five games.
- Opponents are averaging 70.6 points, 37.4 rebounds, 18.8 turnovers and shooting 40 percent from the floor.

HEART AND SOULE

- Sophomore **Taylor Soule** is not only the Eagles energy & defensive player - she has developed into an offensive threat.
- Soule is averaging 12.2 points, 6.9 rebounds while shooting 55 percent from the floor.
- She has tallied double-figures in points in eight games, and four time on the boards.
- Soule has led BC in scoring in 5 games. She scored a career-high 24 points vs. St. Francis, 22 at Duke and 23 vs. Delaware St.
- Soule is also developing into a rebound machine. She has led the team in rebounding in eight games, including the last seven games.
- She has grabbed double-figures on the boards in four games - 10 vs. Northwestern, a career-high 16 vs. Delaware State and 10 vs. NC State, 10 at Pittsburgh.
- Soule recorded her first career double-double vs. Delaware St (23 points, career-high 16 rebounds).

HONORING A LEGEND

- The women's basketball team will honor former BC Head Coach **Cathy Inglese** by wearing a CI patch on their uniforms for all ACC games this season. Her family and former players will be on hand on Alumni Day (Jan. 12 vs. UVA) to take part in honoring the legendary coach.
- Inglese was the head coach for Boston College for 13 seasons from 1993-2008. She guided the Eagles to a 239-151 record during her tenure. Inglese led the Eagles to seven NCAA Tournament appearances, including three trips to the Sweet 16.
- Inglese was inducted into the Boston College Varsity Hall of Fame in 2014.
- Inglese passed away suddenly in July.

ACC BIG TEN CHALLENGE

- Boston College lost to Northwestern, 66-63, in the Big Ten/ACC Challenge on Dec. 4
- Northwestern leads the overall series, 4-2.

JUST THE FACTS

- The Eagles had 23 assists on 32 field goals vs. Pitt on Sunday.
- BC is 15 three-pointers in the last two games. The Eagles tallied 9 at Pittsburgh. The Eagles are 95-for-286 (33.2%) for the season.
- On Sunday at Pitt, it was the first game this season BC pulled out after being down with five minutes left in the game (66-65). BC went on a 13-4 run in the final 3:44 to win the game.
- After missing 10 games, senior **Taylor Ortlepp** has returned to action.
- Senior **Emma Guy** is the lone player on the roster to start every game this season. R-sophomore **Cameron Swartz** and sophomore **Taylor Soule** have started 13 games.
- BC is averaging 68.7 points and 37.7 rebounds in the last three games. **Makayla Dickens** leads BC in scoring (15.3 ppg.) in the last three games.
- Taylor Soule** has led BC in rebounding in the last seven games.

SENIOR STATUS

- Emma Guy** is coming off her most successful season as an Eagle. She led the team in points (14.1 ppg.) and rebounding (6.7 rpg.). She shot a career-high 59% from the floor.
- A native of Penfield, New York, Guy tallied double-figures in scoring in 23 games last season, including the final five games.
- Guy led the Eagles in scoring in 12 games and on the boards in 11 games. She tallied her career-high in points at Syracuse as he posted a 30-point, 14-rebound effort on Feb. 10. It was also the first season she started and played in every game. She now has 87 games played and 70 starts.
- Guy opened this season with her ninth career double-double (20 pts.-10 rebs.) vs. Lowell.
- She has reached double-figures in 10 games, including 14 vs. #9 NC State. She had 11 points and 9 boards at Pittsburgh. She now has 501 rebounds and 899 career points in 90 career games.

FRESH FACES

- Boston College welcomed two freshmen to the program - **Jaelyn Batts** and **Akunna Konkwo** - and sophomore transfer **Cameron Swartz**.
- In summer session, Konkwo went down with an Achilles injury and will miss the remainder of the season.
- Batts, a native of South Riding, Va, is a 6-foot off guard with athleticism and length.
- She opened up her career with an impressive 4-for-4 from the floor with eight points before fouling out vs. Lowell. Batts had a career-high eight rebounds vs. URI. The rookie has started the six games this season.
- Swartz, a native of Marietta, Ga., played 7 games with Colorado before arriving at the Heights in January.
- A guard, Swartz tallied her career-high with 27 points vs. Tulane at the Puerto Rico Clasico.

She has reached double-figures 10 games. Swartz tallied a career-high 8 assists vs. Delaware St.

HIGHLIGHTS

- Sophomore **Marnelle Garraud** has swiped a career-high six steals in two games this season - vs. Lowell, vs. Tulane. She is one of three ACC players to record six steals this season, though she has done it twice.
- BC set a new program record with 63 points at the half vs. St. Francis. The old record was 61 points set by last year's team vs. Rider and the 1997 team vs. Marist.
- Sophomore **Milan Bolden-Morris** has a team-high 24 three's this season - she now has 141 career three-pointers, enough for 10th place on the all-time list. Bolden-Morris made five three's in the win over VCU. It was the 4th time in her career she hit 5 three's in a game.
- BC scored 106 points vs. St. Francis. The last time the Eagles scored over 100 points was at the St. Joseph's Thanksgiving Tournament in the 112-61 victory vs. Rider in the 2018-19 season. The program record is 113 points in an OT win vs. Penn State in 2010.
- BC had 19 steals vs. Lowell, one away tying the program record of 20 steals set against Holy Cross in November 26, 2002.
- BC is 9-5 in season openers since the Eagles joined the ACC in 2005-06. The program is 33-14 in season openers since the 1972-73.

INCOMING CLASS

- Jo Jo Lacey, Kaylah Ivey and Sydney McQuietor** will join the Eagles in 2020. The class is ranked 31st in the country and 6th overall in the ACC by the Blue Star Basketball Report.
- Jo Jo Lacey**, a 6-foot-1 guard, averaged 12.3 points, 6.9 rebounds and 2.2 steals a game at Westtown as a junior. She is a three time Friends League First Tam honoree.
- A member of the AAU program, the Philadelphia Belles 17U EYBL team, Lacey played for the team that won the 2019 Indianapolis section of the EYBL Championship.
- She is ranked 39th in the country and sixth in her position according to The Blue Star Basketball Report. She is 55th overall and sixth in her position as reported by ESPN.
- Kaylah Ivey** plays both point and shooting guard at Riverdale Baptist in Maryland.
- As a junior she averaged 13.8 points and 3.8 rebounds a game. A native of Forestville, Maryland, Ivey plays AAU for Boo Williams 17-U EYBL team.
- The Blue Star Basketball Report ranks Ivey 14th in her position and 75th nationally.
- Sydney McQuietor**, a 6-foot-2 forward, plays at Keller in Texas. She compiled 533 points, 497 rebounds and 98 blocks last year.
- She was an All-District 6A First Team honoree.
- The Texas native is ranked 167th overall and 17th in per position according to The Blue Star Basketball Report.

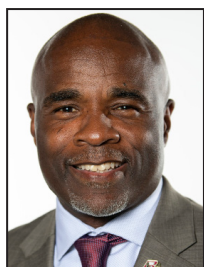

BC IN THE ACC - ACC HISTORY

- Boston College finished the 2019-20 season at 14-16 and 3-13 in the conference. Since joining the ACC in the 2005-06 season, BC is 58-156.
- In the 1st season BC went 6-8 for a 7th place finish.
- The best finish for the Eagles took place in 08-09 and 09-10. The team finished with identical 7-7 records and in fifth place.
- In 2008-09, BC won its first ACC Tournament game vs. Virginia Tech (57-47).
- The first ACC victory in program history took place on Jan. 26, 2006 as the Eagles defeated Virginia at Conte Forum, 57-43. That was the start of a 6-game ACC win streak, the longest in program history.
- The 2012-13 team was the first to win two ACC road games - The Eagles defeated Virginia Tech, 53-46 on Jan. 10 and followed it up with a 66-43 win at Clemson on Jan. 13. The 2018-19 team repeated that feat by beating Wake Forest on Jan. 10 and Pittsburgh on Jan. 13.
