## PACK FACTS

### A WIN ON SUNDAY WOULD...

- Be the 931st win in program history (930-468)
- Be the 713th win of head coach Wes Moore's career (712-228)
- Be Moore's 155th win at NC State (154-59)
- Be Moore's 67th ACC victory at NC State (66-34)
- Be the program's second-ever victory over the Fighting Irish and the Wolfpack's first time beating Notre Dame on the road

### NOTING THE WOLFPACK (14-1, 3-1 ACC)

- Ranked ninth in the AP Poll since Dec. 9. Moved up one spot to number eight in the USA Today Poll on Jan. 7
- Selected to finish second in the ACC this season
- Opened 2019-20 by matching the second-best start to a season with a 14-0 record before falling on the road to rival North Carolina in its 15th game of the year
- No. 3 nationally in defensive rebounds per game (32.1)
- No. 10 in rebounds per game (44.3)
- No. 11 in field-goal percentage defense (.336)
- No. 11 in three-pointers per game (9.3)
- No. 17 in scoring defense (54.7)
- No. 20 in scoring margin (+19.2)
- Owns conference lead in five of those categories: scoring margin, field-goal percentage defense, rebounding margin, defensive rebounds per game and three-pointers made per game

### SCOUTING THE FIGHTING IRISH (6-10, 1-3 ACC)

- Predicted to finish fourth in the conference this season
- Notre Dame entered the year coming off of two-straight NCAA Championships berths, including a title in 2018. The Fighting Irish lost all five of their 2018-19 starters for the 2019-20 season.
- Ranked atop the conference in turnovers forced (18.5 per game) and third in steals per game (8.8)
- 322nd nationally and last in the ACC in rebound margin (-7.4)
- 175th in scoring offense (65.8)

### SERIES HISTORY (Notre Dame leads 7-1)

- Sunday's game marks the ninth overall meeting between NC State and Notre Dame. The teams have played each other at least once a year since 2013-14, the Fighting Irish's first season as part of the ACC.
- The Wolfpack has defeated the Fighting Irish just once in nine games played in the series. NC State upset second-ranked Notre Dame at home on Dec. 29, 2016, winning by a 70-62 score after never trailing in the outing.
- NC State has made the trip to South Bend twice and has never won

inside the Purcell Pavilion.

- The squads last met on Feb. 18, 2019 inside Reynolds Coliseum. Notre Dame came away with the 95-72 victory in that matchup.

### PACK TRACKS

- Aislinn Konig matched a career mark with six three pointers against UNC on Jan. 9. She became the first Wolfpack player to have six or more threes in a game since Kiara Leslie did so against No. 16 Syracuse last season. Against North Carolina, Konig was just two points off of her career high of 26 points as she led all players on the floor with 24 (8-of-11 from the field and 6-of-9 from beyond the arc).
- Freshman Jakia Brown-Turner has made an immediate impact for the Wolfpack, especially during conference play. She has scored in double figures in three of her first four ACC games and averages 10.0 points and 3.3 assists per game against conference opponents.
- In addition to Brown-Turner, three other Wolfpack players are averaging double figures in conference play - Elissa Cunane (18.5), Konig (15.5) and Kayla Jones (10.0).
- Elissa Cunane posted two 26+ point games in a row against Virginia and Virginia Tech. She tallied a total of 54 points between those outings to average 27.0 points and 9.5 rebounds in the two victories.
- As a team, NC State has drawn 248 fouls this season. Cunane alone has drawn 83 of those fouls, just over 33 percent.
- In the first two games of conference play, Konig came up big for NC State in quite a few key moments. The senior went on a one-woman 8-0 run against Virginia Tech to help dig NC State out of its 14-point deficit. She did the same in the Pack's victory over Boston College when the Eagles got as close as five points in the middle of the third quarter.
- Kaile Ealey closed out non-conference play with one of her most productive outings since returning from last season's injury. She dished out eight assists in the Dec. 19 game against Chattanooga, just one assist off of her career high, and did not turn the ball over a single time in over 20 minutes of time on the court.

### THREE BALL

NC State has knocked down 11+ three-pointers on seven occasions, including three of its last five games and both of its most recent ACC games. In its meeting against UNC on Jan. 9, the Wolfpack tied its season high with 12 makes from long range.

### TAKING CARE OF BUSINESS ON THE ROAD

Now in season seven under head coach Wes Moore, the Wolfpack has earned 43 true road wins (averaging 7.0 per completed season) since the start of the 2013-14 season. In the prior eight seasons from

LAST MEETING - NC State vs. Notre Dame

February 18, 2019

RALEIGH - The No. 9/11 NC State women's basketball team (22-3, 9-3 ACC) endured a 95-72 defeat to visiting No. 5/6 Notre Dame (24-3, 11-2 ACC) Monday evening on Kay Yow Court inside Valvano Arena at Reynolds Coliseum.

A three-pointer by Aislinn Konig tied the game up at 47 apiece with 7:03 remaining in the third quarter, but Notre Dame scored 12 straight points in two-and-a-half minutes to take a lead that it would not relinquish.

Elissa Cunane had a fantastic game for the Wolfpack, scoring a career-high 28 points on 10-19 shooting and a 7-7 success rate from the free-throw line. She was joined in double figures by 17 points from Kiara Leslie. Konig and Leslie each tied for a team high with six assists.

All five Notre Dame starters achieved double figures. Arike Ogunbowale led her team with 22 points while teammates Marina Mabrey (21), Jessica Shepard (18), Jackie Young (16), and Brianna Turner (12) also had strong offensive performances. Shepard and Young added 13 and 12 rebounds, respectively, to record double-doubles on an evening during which the Fighting Irish out-rebounded the Wolfpack 45-28. It was just the third time all season NC State has been out-rebounded.

2005-06 to 2012-13, the Wolfpack earned 32 true road wins (4.0 per season).

CAN'T STOP CUNANE

Elissa Cunane has proven to be a force to be reckoned with to start her sophomore season. The center ranks 13th nationally in double-doubles (8), 9th in field goal percentage (.623), and 20th in rebounds per game (10.6). All three of those numbers, as well as her 16.9 points per game, lead the team, and her field-goal percentage paces the conference this season. The Summerfield, N.C., native has been named ACC Player of the Week twice this season (Dec. 16 and Jan. 6), becoming the first Wolfpack player to do so since Amber White during the 2010-11 campaign.

From Nov. 30 (vs. Hawaii) through Dec. 15 (vs. Elon), Cunane put together a streak of four-straight double-double performances. She has scored 20+ points in five of the Pack's last nine outings and hit a career-high mark of 28 points in two of those games (vs. Elon on Dec. 15 and vs. Virginia Tech on Jan. 2). Cunane has scored in double figures in all but three games this season.

IK ACE

With a step-back three at the end of the first quarter against Virginia, senior guard Aislinn Konig reached the 1,000-point milestone. The achievement made her the 34th player in program history and the 14th active ACC player to surpass 1,000 points in her NC State career. Konig reached the milestone in 102 career games played despite missing a good chunk of her freshman season with an injury.

SHARING SUCCESS

NC State averages 15.3 assists per game in 2019-20, but the Wolfpack dished out 19 or more in its first two home ACC games. The team assisted on 19 of its 27 made field goals against Virginia Tech before setting a season high with 24 assists on 28 made baskets against Virginia. In the Wolfpack's last three games (at UNC, vs. Virginia, vs. Virginia Tech), the team assisted on 63 percent or more of its made baskets in each outing.

DIVERSE SCORING ATTACK

NC State has managed to put together a well-balanced variety of scoring options from the field. The Pack averages 73.9 points per game this season, with 31.9 of those coming inside the paint and 27.8 generated from long range.

ALWAYS FIGHTING

The Wolfpack overcame its largest deficit of the season (14 points) in its thrilling Jan. 2 win over Virginia Tech. Prior to the game against the Hokies, NC State had never trailed after the first quarter and had only stared up at a halftime deficit on one occasion (Maryland led by two at the break on Dec. 5). The Pack went on to outscore the Hokies 20-7 out of the halftime break to regain its lead.

Despite a scoreless drought at the end of the first quarter, NC State fought back to put together 8-0 runs on two occasions during the second quarter, a 10-0 run in the third quarter and a 9-0 run towards the end of the fourth quarter to close out the game.

The Pack turned the ball over just three times in the second half of the victory and forced Virginia Tech into 10 turnovers, eight in the third quarter, in that same half.

CLIMBING THE CAREER THREES LIST

Aislinn Konig took sole possession of second place in program history for career three-pointers made in the Wolfpack's victory over Virginia Tech on Jan. 2. She nailed four from long range in that game and now has 252 threes in 103 career games played. Jennifer Howard owns the program's top mark of 315.

SHARING THE WEALTH

The Wolfpack had six players score 10+ points in the team's victory over Boston College on Dec. 29. It was the second time this season that NC State has accomplished this feat, as it also had six in double figures in its Nov. 24 win at Saint Mary's. Prior to this season, the last time the Wolfpack had more than five players score in double figures in a single game was a 102-49 victory over Longwood on Nov. 15, 2012. In that game, eight players posted 10 or more points.

PROWESS IN THE PAINT

Accompanying its strength in effectively shutting down the interior, the Pack has also displayed a tremendous ability to then score in the paint on the offensive end. Through 15 games, NC State is outscoring its opponents 478-296 (+182) in the category. The Pack has been bested in that category on just three occasions this season. In the nine non-conference games in which NC State won the points in the paint battle, the Pack averaged 20.2 points more in the category than its opponents.

THEN AND NOW

Kai Crutchfield as a freshman: 9.1 mpg, 2.0 ppg, 0.9 rpg.  
Kai Crutchfield as a junior: 31.2 mpg, 9.7 ppg, 4.0 rpg.

Kayla Jones as a freshman: 3.6 mpg, 0.6 ppg, 1.5 rpg.  
Kayla Jones as a junior: 27.4 mpg, 9.6 ppg, 7.3 rpg.

Both Jones and Crutchfield have started all 15 games this season with 10 and seven double-figure scoring outings, respectively. Jones' start in the Pack's season opener against North Carolina A&T was the first of her career, and she has since posted three double-doubles on the year.

WHO DO YOU GUARD?

NC State's entire starting lineup is averaging 8.8+ points per game this season, including two Wolfpack players (Elissa Cunane and Aislinn Konig) with scoring averages in double figures. Additionally, three of the Wolfpack's starters are shooting 40 percent or higher from the field.

NO PLACE LIKE HOME

Since the renovation of Reynolds Coliseum was completed in August 2016, NC State is 56-6 on Kay Yow Court. That record includes 36 consecutive victories over non-conference opponents and 20 out of 26 possible league wins.

WELCOME TO THE ACC

Freshmen Jakia Brown-Turner (8.6 points per game) and Jada Boyd (7.2 points, 5.6 rebounds per game) both found double digits in the scoring column as they made their ACC debuts against Boston College on Dec. 29. Boyd was extremely efficient, tallying 11 points (4-of-4 shooting) in just 13 minutes of action. Brown-Turner posted 10, her first time in double figures since scoring 10+ points in three of her first five games as a member of the Pack.

MILESTONE MOMENTS FOR MOORE

With an 80-40 win over UNCW on Nov. 10, NC State's Wes Moore earned the 700th victory of his head coaching career. He became just the 11th active and 22nd ever NCAA Division I women's basketball coach to do so. Coach Moore's .757 career winning percentage ranks No. 10 among all active NCAA Division I head coaches. The Pack's win over Elon on Dec. 15 was Moore's 150th victory as head coach at NC State.

REGULARLY EXCEEDING EXPECTATIONS

NC State has exceeded ACC coaches' preseason expectations in five of the last six seasons.

During head coach Wes Moore's first six seasons in Raleigh, the Wolfpack has posted an impressive 64-33 (.660) record in league games that includes a 34-14 (.708) mark in Raleigh.

IMPRESSIVE SIGNING CLASS

NC State welcomed its strongest signing class in recent memory to Raleigh for this season. The class was ranked as high as seventh nationally by ESPNW in November of 2018 and only improved since with the addition of reclassified 2020 forward Elle Sutphin. The current freshman class features the following five student-athletes:

DOMINANT REBOUNDING

In NC State's win over #9 Maryland on Dec. 5, Kayla Jones and Elissa Cunane combined to outrebound the entire Terrapins team by a 29-27 margin. NC State outrebounded the Terrapins 51-27 and scored 16 second-chance points.

POSTSEASON PROGRESS

During the 2019 postseason, NC State participated in NCAA Tournament games in Raleigh for the second consecutive year. The Wolfpack is 16-2 in NCAA Tournament games played in Raleigh and has not lost a home game in the tournament since 1983.

NC State made its fourth NCAA Tournament appearance during head coach Wes Moore's sixth season in Raleigh. This marked the first time that the Wolfpack has made three consecutive NCAA Tournaments since the program did so in 2005, 2006, and 2007. With the first-round victory over Maine on March 23, NC State has won at least one game in three straight tournaments for the first time since the program did so in 1989, 1990, and 1991.

The Wolfpack concluded the 2018-19 season in the Sweet 16 of the NCAA Tournament, making its second consecutive appearance in this round for the first time since 1990 and 1991.

CANADIAN SHARPSHOOTER

Konig has set new three-point records in two consecutive seasons. The Vancouver, B.C., native made 91 3FG during the 2017-18 season and followed this up with 93 made 3FG in the 2018-19 season. The previous mark of 90 was held by Jennifer Howard since the 1995-96 season.

FRESHMAN PHENOM

Cunane turned heads during her debut season with the Wolfpack in 2018-19. The Summerfield, N.C., averaged 13.6 points and 6.3 rebounds per game while shooting 54.9 percent from the field and 76.0 percent from the free-throw line. Cunane's point total of 464 ranked second among all freshmen in program history, while her rebounding total of 213 ranked sixth and her shooting percentage ranked seventh. She also set new freshman program records in FTs made (136) and attempted (179).

One of the top head coaches in NCAA women's basketball, Wes Moore began his seventh season as the head coach of NC State with the start of the 2019-20 campaign.

Since taking over the Wolfpack in April of 2013, Moore has posted an 154-59 (.723) record and led NC State to three NCAA Tournament appearances and postseason invitations each year. He has coached the Wolfpack to a 66-34 (.667) record in ACC games, a league that consistently ranks among the top conferences in NCAA Division I basketball. Five of Moore's six seasons have included significantly surpassing preseason league projections and five have concluded in top-four finishes in the 15-member league. All six of his seasons in Raleigh have been winning seasons, and five have included 20 wins or more.

In his first season at NC State (2013-14), Moore led the Wolfpack to a 25-8 record, a fourth-place finish in the ACC standings, and an NCAA Tournament appearance. For his efforts, he was named the ESPNW ACC Coach of the Year. After an 18-15 campaign in 2014-15 and a 20-11 season in 2015-16, Moore led the Wolfpack to the NCAA Tournament Round of 32 in 2016-17 with an impressive 23-9 record (12-4 ACC). On March 1, 2017, he earned the official ACC Coach of the Year honor in votes by both the league's Blue Ribbon Panel and head coaches, earning the first such honor in the 43-year history of the NC State women's basketball program. He was also named a Naismith Women's College Coach of the Year Semifinalist after authoring upsets of four top-15 teams throughout the season: No. 2/2 Notre Dame, at No. 6/7 Florida State, No. 12/15 Duke, and at No. 9/7 Louisville.

Moore led NC State to a tremendous 2017-18 season, winning 26 games and returning to the Sweet 16 of the NCAA Tournament for the first time since 2007. The Wolfpack posted a 16-2 record on Kay Yow Court that included two NCAA Tournament victories. The achievement of going 16-2 at Reynolds Coliseum marked the second best home record in 44 completed seasons of Wolfpack basketball.

The 2018-19 season was one of the best in program history. NC State spent 14 weeks this season in the top 10 of the USA Today Coaches Poll. Led by Moore, the Associated Press runner-up for National Coach of the Year, the Wolfpack advanced to its second straight NCAA Tournament Sweet 16, achieved the longest winning streak in program history (21 games), and recorded the best start to a season in program history (21-0) while tying for the second most wins (28) ever achieved in 45 years of NC State women's basketball.

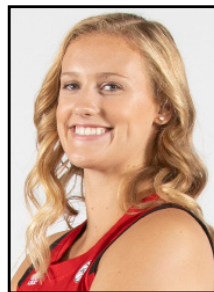
