## FRONT PAGE NEWS

### THE SERIES

- This meeting marks the 31st between the two programs all-time with the Fighting Irish owning the 27-3 advantage in the series.
- Notre Dame has won 10 straight in the series including last season in South Bend, 100-44.
- The last win for Pitt came on Feb. 3, 2009 as they downed the Irish 82-70 in Pittsburgh.

### A WIN WOULD...

- Give Pitt their fourth all-time against Notre Dame.
- Be the Panthers 631st victory in program history.
- Give the Panthers their first home opening ACC win ever.

### STORYLINES

- After undergoing successful surgery to remove cancer in October, junior guard **Kyla Nelson** returned to the Pitt lineup on December 17. The sharpshooter has appeared in each of the last three games for the Panthers and adds a much needed threat from behind the arc as ACC play begins.
- The new-look Pitt lineup has been relying heavily on the production of newcomers as the six newcomers have combined to average 40.4 points and 26.7 rebounds per game. They are accounting for 64.8% of the Pitt scoring this season.

### THE OPENING TIP

- The Panthers welcome Notre Dame on Thursday night in their first game of 2020. Tip is set for 7:00 pm inside the Petersen Events Center.
- Pitt is being led offensively by **Aysia Bugg** who is averaging 14.5 points while connecting on a team-high 29 three-pointers.
- Freshman forward **Amber Brown** is excelling for the Panthers as she is averaging 11.6 points and a team-high 8.3 rebounds. She has recorded four double-doubles and six games with 10+ rebounds this season.
- Point guard **Dayshyanette Harris** is continuing to make strides for Pitt as she is averaging 9.8 points, 3.8 rebounds and a team-high 2.8 assists per game.

**TEAM NOTES**

**LAST TIME OUT**

- » After a strong start that saw the Panthers race out to a 8-2 lead, the North Carolina Tar Heels fought back and regained the lead in the first quarter and never looked back, downing Pitt 70-62.
- » Pitt was led offensively by **Aysia Bugg** who netted 11 points and three assists while freshman **Dayshyanette Harris** came off the bench for the first time in her career and netted 11 points, four rebounds and three steals.
- » Freshman **Amber Brown** had a monster game on the glass on Monday as she grabbed a career-high 13 rebounds, her sixth game with 10+ rebounds this season.
- » The difference in the game came on the free throw line as the Panthers went just 8-for-19 while UNC went 11-for-14. The Tar Heels also outrebounded Pitt 47-39 and posted 20 second chance points in the win.

**ACC HOME OPENERS**

- » The Panthers are looking for their first ACC home opening victory on Thursday as they are 0-6 in conference openers on their home court since joining the ACC IN 2013-14.
- » Pitt is averaging just 55.8 points per game in ACC home openers while allowing an average of 67.5 ppg.

**BUGGIN' OUT**

- » After receiving a waiver for her sixth season of eligibility in the summer, graduate student **Aysia Bugg** has been the best player on the court for the Panthers across the first 12 games.
- » Last time out, Bugg led the Panthers in scoring for the sixth time this season as she netted 11 points and three assists across 33 minutes of work.
- » For the season, Bugg leads the team averaging 33.6 minutes, 14.5 points and 2.5 assists while connecting on a team-high 29 three pointers and shooting 36.7% from deep. She ranks 14th in the ACC in scoring (14.5 ppg), sixth in three-pointers made (29), sixth in free throw percentage (.818), sixth in three-point percentage (.367), and 11th in minutes player per game (33.6 mpg).

- » Bugg opened the season with four straight games with 17+ points scored, marking the first time in her career she has recorded four straight games of 17+ points scored.
- » The team captain entered this season as the lone player in the ACC to have 700+ points, 300+ assists and 200+ rebounds in her career.
- » Bugg missed all of the 2017-18 campaign due to a torn ACL and after a strong start to her 2018-19 campaign, she missed the final 26 games after suffering from blood clots. Prior to her blood clot diagnosis, Bugg was averaging a team-high 14.0 points, 3.4 assists and 2.4 rebounds across 29.6 minutes/game.
- » Bugg is just 127 points shy 1,000 for her career as she would become the 20th member of the Panthers 1,000 point club. She is also just 31 assists away from 10th place (366) on the Panthers all-time assists charts.

**WHAT CAN BROWN DO FOR YOU**

- » Freshman forward **Amber Brown** will be asked to play big minutes down low for the Panthers this season and she seems ready for the challenge.
- » Last time out, Brown had a monster game on the glass as she grabbed a career-high 13 rebounds in the loss at North Carolina. She was held out of double figures for the first time in her last eight games as she netted just seven points.
- » On the year, Brown is averaging 11.6 points and a team-high 8.3 rebounds while connecting on 45.7% of her field goal attempts. Her 8.3 rebounds ranks 11th in the ACC overall and second among ACC freshman.
- » Brown has grabbed at least four boards in all 12 of her career games while grabbing 10+ boards a team-leading six times and leading Pitt in rebounds six times.
- » Brown was tabbed ACC Freshman of the Week (Dec. 9) for the first time in her Pitt career after averaging a double-double (15.5 ppg, 10.0 rpg) over a two-game span. Brown is the second Pitt Freshman to earn the ACC weekly recognition.
- » Earlier this season, Brown became the first Panther since Stasha Carey in 2015-16 to notch three straight games with 10+ rebounds. She is also the first freshman to do so since Carey did it in the 2014-15 season.
- » Brown has recorded four double-doubles so far this season, fourth most by any player in the ACC and second most among freshman in the NCAA. She is also the first Pitt freshman to record at least four double-doubles in a season since Brenna Wise had six in 2015-16.

### ABOUT NOTRE DAME

- The Notre Dame Fighting Irish enter Thursday's ACC game with a 5-8 overall record and a 0-1 conference mark. The Irish opened ACC play with a 71-55 home loss to Clemson and have lost four straight games.
- Notre Dame is led offensively by Katlyn Gilbert who is averaging 15.1 points, 5.4 rebounds and 1.9 steals while freshman Anaya Peoples is averaging 14.5 points, a team-high 8.2 rebounds and shooting 50% from the floor.
- Freshman forward Sam Brunelle is enjoying a strong start to her first season as she is averaging 13.8 points and 6.3 rebounds while starting all 13 games.
- As a team, Notre Dame is averaging 66.5 ppg and allowing 69.3 ppg.

### ALL DAY LONG

- » Playing the point guard position as a freshman is one of the most difficult things to do but to come in and start at point guard is almost unheard of.
- » **Dayshyanette Harris** has handled the reins of the Pitt offense since her first day on campus and she is showing flashes of becoming a star for the Panthers.
- » Last time out, Harris came off the bench for the first time in her career and played a solid game. The crafty guard finished with a team-high 11 points, four rebounds and three steals across 21 minutes of work.
- » On the year, Harris is averaging 26.5 minutes, 9.8 points, 3.8 rebounds, 2.8 assists and 1.8 steals while starting 11 of 12 games at point.
- » Earlier this season, Harris exploded for a career-high 26 points, six rebounds, four assists and four steals against Penn State, the most points scored by a Pitt freshman in a game since Kalista Walters posted 26 points in 2015-16.
- » Harris is the first Pitt freshman since Kalista Walters in 2015-16 to post at least two 20+ scoring efforts in a season.

### IGBOKWE MAKING AN IMPACT

- » Freshman forward **Rita Igbokwe** has continued to show major growth down low for the Panthers and her development will be a key for Pitt this season and in the future.
- » The athletically gifted Igbokwe has become a problem for opponents down low as her length is causing players to adjust all shots inside the paint.
- » Last time out, Igbokwe was quiet in the loss at UNC as she grabbed three rebounds and a block in just six minutes of action.
- » So far this season, she is averaging 15.4 minutes, 3.5 points, 6.4 rebounds and 2.0 blocks while shooting 47.2% from the floor. She ranks second among ACC freshman in offensive rebounds per game (2.5 rpg).
- » She ranks second in the ACC in blocked shots (24, 2.0 bpg) so far this season. She also leads all freshman in the ACC in blocks.
- » She has six multi-block games so far this season including a career-high six against Ohio.
- » Earlier this year, Igbokwe posted a monster game with 18 rebounds against Ohio. The 18 boards marked the most in a game by a Pitt player since 2010 and the most by a Pitt freshman since 2005.
- » The Jonesboro, Ga. native has three games with 10+ rebounds this season.

### NEWCOMERS MAKING A DIFFERENCE

- » Entering the 2019-20 campaign, the Panthers knew they were going to have to rely heavily on a handful of newcomers to make an impact and they have done a nice job so far this season.
- » The six newcomers for the Panthers are averaging a combined 40.4 points and 26.7 rebounds per game so far this season.

**TEAM NOTES...**

- » The newcomers production has accounted for 64.8% of the Panthers scoring efforts this season and 66.1% of their rebounding efforts.
- » The freshman duo of **Dayshanette Harris** and **Amber Brown** have combined to score 21.4 points per game, the second best freshman duo in the ACC behind Notre Dame's duo of Sam Brunelle and Anaya Peoples (28.3 ppg).
- » The freshman duo of Brown and **Rita Igbokwe** currently lead all ACC freshman in combined rebounds (14.7 rpg). The Notre Dame duo of Ayana Peoples and Sam Brunelle (14.5 rpg) rank second.
- » Entering this season, Pitt had to replace 70.4% of their scoring from last season when they averaged 57.5 points/game and the newcomers have stepped in nicely.

**CRASHING THE GLASS**

- » Coach White has preached all season long that the Panthers needed to improve their rebounding and they have done just that through 12 games.
- » So far this season, Pitt is averaging 40.3 rebounds/game. The Panthers are averaging 4.8 rebounds/game more than they did a season ago (35.5 rpg).
- » Pitt has recorded 40+ rebounds six times this season after doing so just six times through 31 games a season ago.
- » Earlier this season, Pitt grabbed 41+ rebounds in six straight games for the first time since the 2009-10 season.

- » Last time out, Pitt lost the rebounding battle for the second straight game, 47-39.
- » Earlier this season, Pitt snagged a season-high 51 rebounds against Penn State, the most in a game since 3/2/16. They also totaled a season-high 23 offensive rebounds and turned those chances into 24 second chance points.

**NELSON MAKES EMOTIONAL RETURN**

- » After being diagnosed with a Neuroendocrine Tumor of the Appendix (cancer of the appendix) on September 25 and undergoing successful surgery to remove the cancer, junior sharpshooter **Kyla Nelson** made her season debut on Tuesday, Dec. 17 vs. Miami (OH).
- » Prior to returning to the court for her first game back, Nelson was surprised in the locker room by ESPN's Holly Rowe who changed flight plans to Pittsburgh to see Nelson's return. Rowe, a cancer survivor herself, has been in contact with Nelson throughout her fight and made an emotional surprise visit for the game.
- » The England native finished off her first game of the season with three points and two assists across 12 minutes of work. Nelson has appeared in three straight games off the Pitt bench.
- » Nelson is coming off of a career year for the Panthers as a sophomore as she netted a career-high 6.0 points and 2.2 rebounds while ranking first on the team and fourth in the ACC in three-point field goal percentage (40.4%).

**LAST MEETING WITH NOTRE DAME**

**SOUTH BEND, IN** – Opening up their Atlantic Coast Conference slate against the defending national champions and No. 2 team in the nation, Notre Dame, the University of Pittsburgh women's basketball team (9-6, 0-1 ACC) suffered a 100-44 defeat in front of 8,566 fans at the Purcell Pavilion.

Danielle Garven was able to open the scoring for the Panthers on the first possession of the game but the Fighting Irish then took control, running out to a 13-2 lead that forced Pitt to use their first timeout of the game. Senior Cassidy Walsh gave the Panthers a little spark over the final four minutes of the quarter as she netted back-to-back triples as the teams went to the second quarter with the Fighting Irish leading Pitt 32-10.

The defending national champions then took control of the game in the second quarter after Jasmine Whitney opened the scoring in the quarter with a runner in the lane. The Fighting Irish used a 21-0 run over the next three minutes to extend their lead out to 60-14 at halftime.

The Notre Dame offense continued their high energy attack in the third quarter as the Panthers were limited to 10 points in the quarter. Garven was able to score five points in the quarter while Kauai Bradley netted her first triple of the game as the Panthers entered the final 10 minutes trailing 85-24.

The panthers never gave up on Thursday night as they were able to outscore the Fighting Irish over the final 10 minutes of the game, 20-15. Whitney opened the scoring with five straight while Kalista Walters netted back-to-back layups and Kyla Nelson drilled a pair of triples as Notre Dame came away with the 100-44 victory.

Whitney led the way for the Panthers with nine points, four assists and two steals while Bradley finished off her night with eight points and Garven netted seven in the loss. Walters had a strong game off the bench as she grabbed a team-high nine rebounds (five offensive) and four points across 18 minutes of work.

# LANCE WHITE

HEAD COACH | 2ND SEASON | TEXAS TECH '96

Lance White enters his second season at the helm of the Panthers in 2019-20 after being named as the ninth head coach in Pitt women's basketball history on April 19, 2018.

Heading into the 2019-20 campaign, White will be looking for major impacts from his first signing class, a highly-touted class of seven student-athletes. A pair of transfers and five freshman highlight a class that White is hoping will turn the Pitt program back into an ACC and national contender.

The five player freshmen class consists of 2000+ point scorer Dayshyanette Harris, Arkansas State Champion and All-State performer Amber Brown, three star forward Rita Igbokwe and a pair of International student-athletes, Emy Hayford (Netherlands) and Cynthia Ezeja (Greece).

The two transfers include NJCAA All-American Gabbie Green and center Marcel-la Lamark who comes to Pitt from Texas Tech.

White notched his first career head coaching victory in the Panthers second game of the season on Nov. 9, 2018 as he led Pitt to the dominant 90-38 victory over New Orleans, their seventh largest defeat in program history and their largest in over a decade.

White collected his first ACC victory on Feb. 14, 2019 when the Panthers knocked off the North Carolina Tar Heels inside the Petersen Events Center, 91-78. The 91 points scored for the Panthers were their most scored in a game since 2014 and their most ever in an ACC contest. Another historic win for the Panthers during White's first season was the road victory over Duquesne in the City Game as they downed the Dukes by the score of 66-58.

With White at the helm, Pitt upped its offensive efficiency as they had four players average over 9.5 points/game including leading scorer Danielle Garven who finished off her impressive senior campaign averaging a career-high 11.8 points and 4.3 rebounds. Fellow senior Cassidy Walsh also had a great season under White's watchful eye as she quadrupled her scoring production from her junior season, averaging a career-high 9.7 points/game for the Panthers. Pitt also posted the fourth best season in school history from behind the arc as they connected on 32.7% from behind the arc while also bumping up their rebounding average to 35.5 rebounds/game.

Off the court, White had a pair of student-athletes, Jasmine Whitney and Cassidy Walsh, named to the All-ACC Academic Team, the most for Pitt since 2015 when they placed three on the team.

White came to Pitt after spending 15 years at Florida State, where he helped the Seminoles to a 350-145 (.707) record, including 12 seasons of 20+ wins.

During his final season at Florida State (2017-18), the Seminoles posted 25 or more wins for the fourth consecutive season, finishing with a 26-7 overall record and averaged the second-most points in a season in program history with 81.0 points per game. It was just the second time FSU averaged 80 or more points per game in a season. The team ranked in the Top 20 nationally in field goal percentage (20th), offensive rebounds per game (16th), rebound margin (sixth), rebounds per game (11th), scoring margin (10th) and scoring offense (13th). The Seminoles led the ACC in rebounding offense (42.8), rebounding margin (+10.0) and offensive rebounding percentage (41.4 percent).

During his time at FSU, 10 players were selected in the WNBA Draft, eight earned ACC All-Defensive team honors and 37 earned all-conference awards. He helped the Seminoles reach the NCAA Tournament in 13 of the past 14 years, while the team won at least one NCAA Tournament game in each of its past 15 appearances.

For his standout coaching efforts during the 2016-17 season, White was named the Women's Basketball Coaches Association (WBCA) National Assistant Coach of the Year.

White helped FSU reach new levels of success and brought an infectious energy to the program. He directed the Seminole defense and offense during his tenure in addition to being one of the country's top recruiters.

Florida State captured back-to-back regular season ACC co-titles in 2010 and 2011, and advanced to the 2010 NCAA Tournament Elite Eight. After serving as assistant coach for the first nine seasons in Tallahassee, White was promoted to associate head coach in advance of the 2012-13 campaign.

Prior to FSU, White spent 11 seasons at Texas Tech, including five years as an assistant coach with the Lady Raiders' top-10 program under legendary head coach Marsha Sharp. With White on staff, Texas Tech won three Big 12 championships and advanced to seven consecutive NCAA Tournaments, including five Sweet 16 and two Elite Eight appearances. He was a student assistant on Tech's 1993 national championship team and a graduate assistant coach for two seasons before being elevated to a full-time coach in 1998.

While in Lubbock, White worked with some of the best players the game has ever seen, including National Player of the Year and three-time WNBA MVP Sheryl Swoopes as well as Plenette Pierson, who was named 2007 WNBA Sixth Woman of the Year.

A 1996 graduate of Texas Tech, White earned his bachelor's degree in exercise and sports science. He went on to receive a master's degree in sports administration in August 1998. He attended Lubbock Christian University for three semesters before transferring to Texas Tech in January 1993.

He is married to the former Melanie Smith. The Whites are the proud parents of Quentin and Vivian.

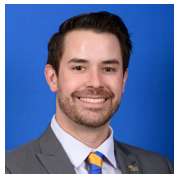

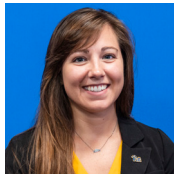

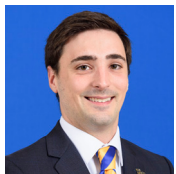
