## By the Numbers

- All five UNC starters are scoring in double figures, led by junior Janelle Bailey with 14.9 points per game.
- UNC leads the ACC in scoring (74.1 ppg) and in assist/turnover ratio (1.16), with 389 assists and a league-low 335 turnovers. The Tar Heels are second in turnover margin (+2.63) and in free throw percentage (.734).
- UNC is 27th in the NCAA in assist/turnover ratio and 30th in offense.
- Freshman Malu Tshitenge leads the league and ranks 13th in the nation in offensive rebounds (4.1 per game). Senior Shayla Bennett leads the league in assist/turnover ratio (2.04) and is third in assists (5.2). Bailey is third in total rebounds (9.5) and in defensive rebounds (7.2).
- Two Tar Heels rank in the league's top five in free throw shooting: Bennett at No. 4 (.819) and Bailey at No. 5 (.805). No other team has two among even the top 10.

## Notables

- Junior Janelle Bailey was announced on Feb. 14 as a top-10 finalist for the Lisa Leslie Award, which goes to the nation's top center. The list will be cut to five next month and the winner will be announced in April.
- Senior Taylor Koenen was announced on Feb. 21 as one of 50 senior conference student-athletes to receive ACC Weaver-James-Corrigan Postgraduate Scholarships/Awards. She's the only women's basketball player to earn the prestigious honor this year.
- Bailey is six points from becoming the 13th Tar Heel with 1,400 career points and 800 rebounds.
- All five UNC starters have led the scoring effort in at least two games this season.
- In this week's NCAA rankings, UNC is 13th in free throws made, 17th in turnovers per game, 27th in assist-turnover ratio and 30th in scoring offense
- Individually, freshman Malu Tshitenge ranks 13th nationally in offensive rebounds. Bailey is 19th in defensive rebounding and Shayla Bennett is 21sr in assists.
- UNC is 5-2 in Thursday ACC games and 1-7 on Sundays. (The opening conference game of the season, a win over Pitt, was on a Monday.)
- Taylor Koenen ranks 14th in the ACC with 46 three-pointers, but is 0 -for-12 over the past two games and 1-17 over the last four. She was 4 -for-8 against Clemson on Feb. 2, but is 3-23 in the five games since then.
- UNC has not won this year with fewer than three players scoring in double figures. The Tar Heels are 0-3 overall, 0-2 in ACC play, with two in double figures, and have had no games with just one in double figures.
- UNC is $1-10$ when allowing 70 or more points (with an 86-72 victory against Clemson the only win). The Tar Heels have lost just three times when scoring 70+ (83-77 at Alabama, 93-75 at BC, 82-79 at Wake).
- On 16 occasions this season a Tar Heel has played the entirety of a game. Shayla Bennett has done so eight times, Taylor Koenen four, Janelle Bailey three and Madinah Muhammad one.
- UNC is 0-9 when trailing at the end of the third quarter. All nine of those losses have come in ACC play (Virginia Tech, FSU, Louisville, at NC State, Duke, Virginia Tech, Syracuse, BC, Wake).
- UNC shot 50 percent from the field against Clemson, the first time the Tar Heels had hit or bettered that mark since a win over UNCW on Dec. 20 and just the third time all season. (The other was vs. Navy in the second game of the season.)
- UNC has lost just three times when shooting better than 40 percent from the field. The Tar Heels hit 46.2 percent of their shots in the loss to Louisville, 40.7 in the loss at NC State and 44.3 at BC.
- The NC State home game marked the largest UNC deficit in a win this season. The Tar Heels trailed by 14 in the second quarter before coming back to win, 66-60.
- Taylor Koenen is just the fifth player in program history to total 1,000 points, 700 rebounds and 300 assists. (The four players who previously reached those marks - Tonya Sampson, Erlana Larkins, Rashanda McCants and La'Tangela Atkinson - all went on to play professionally in the WNBA or ABL.) She's just the third who adds 100 three-pointers to those totals, with the others being Sampson and McCants.


## Tar Heels vs. Fighting Irish

The Tar Heels and Fighting Irish meet Thursday for the 11th time in a series that dates back to the 1999-2000 season. The teams have met just three times on Notre Dame's home court, with the host team winning all three:
Feb. 27, 2014 - ND 100, UNC 75
Jan. 10, 2016 - ND 88, UNC 54
Feb. 1, 2018 - ND 94, UNC 62

- UNC and Notre Dame split last year's matchups, with the Tar Heels beating the top-ranked Fighting Irish in Chapel Hill on Jan. 27, 2019, and the Fighting Irish winning 95-77 on March 8 in Greensboro, N.C., in the ACC Tournament quarterfinals.


## Scouting Notre Dame

Notre Dame is $11-17$ overall and $6-10$ in ACC play following a 72-70 homecourt win on Sunday against Syracuse. Prior to that, ND had lost three games in a row.

- Notre Dame is led in scoring by graduate guard Destinee Walker, a former Tar Heel who is averaging 14.7 points per game. Also in double figures are freshman forward Sam Brunelle at 13.4 points per game and sophomore guard Katlyn Gilbert at 13.2.

## Courtney Banghart <br> Head Coach • First Season



On April 30, Courtney Banghart was announced as UNC's head coach, the first new face in the position since 1986. She came to Chapel Hill after 12 years as the head coach at Princeton, where her teams won seven Ivy League crowns and made eight NCAA Tournament appearances. (Before her arrival, Princeton hadn't reached the tournament even once.)
A New Hampshire native, Banghart was a three-year starter at Dartmouth, where she twice earned All-Ivy honors. She still holds the Ivy League record for career threepointers (273) and as a senior competed in the three-point shooting contest at Butler's Hinkle Fieldhouse during the men's Final Four in Indianapolis.

## More on Banghart:

- She was the 2015 Naismith National Coach of the Year and is one of two current ACC coaches (the other is Notre Dame's Muffet McGraw) to have won that honor.
- In 2015 she was named to Fortune's list of the World's 50 Greatest Leaders. Others on the list that year: Pope Francis, Bill and Melinda Gates, Chief Justice John Roberts Jr., LeBron James, Elon Musk and Taylor Swift.
- She holds a bachelor's degree in neuroscience and a master's degree in writing and leadership, both from Dartmouth. Her graduate thesis was on sport leadership.
- She hitchhiked through Alaska after college, after ditching the outdoor leadership course in which she was enrolled.
- Right around the time she got the Princeton job, she and her brother were finalists to appear on "The Amazing Race."
- A four-time soccer state champion in high school, she planned to play that sport at Dartmouth until a coaching change made her rethink her path and talk the women's basketball coach into giving her a spot. (She also won two high school state titles in basketball and three in tennis.)

## Young Added to Roster

On Jan. 7, coach Courtney Banghart announced that Ariel Young, a wing from Tallahassee, Fla., has joined the UNC women's basketball team. Young transferred to Carolina from the University of Michigan, where she played for the Wolverines during the 2018-19 season.
She began practicing with the Tar Heels on Jan. 8 , the first day of spring semester classes. She will become eligible during the 2020-21 season.
"We are thrilled to have Ariel join our program," Banghart said. "She brings length, athleticism, and a hard-work mentality to our wing position. She can defend at a high level and she'll help us play fast. She has an overall game that we feel will translate really well to the ACC. She is eager to be a Tar Heel and to help build upon what we've started here. In addition, Ariel is a high-quality student-athlete and will contribute to this University both on and off the court."
As a freshman in 2018-19, Young appeared in 20 games for the Wolverines. She was part of the UM team that participated in the 2019 USA Basketball $3 \times 3$ National Championship in May. (Tar Heel junior Janelle Bailey represented the U.S. team there.)

Young's mother, Carolyn, played in the WNBA and as a member of the 1992 U.S. Olympic Team after twice earning All-America honors at Auburn, where she was the 1991 Southeastern Conference Player of the Year. Her father, C.Y., is an assistant coach for the Florida State men's basketball team. He was a standout player at Georgia Southern, where he is a member of the school's Athletics Hall of Fame, and played professionally in France.

## Three At 1,000

With Taylor Koenen scoring her 1,000th career point on Jan. 12 at Florida State, three members of the UNC starting lineup have reached that scoring milestone. Junior Janelle Bailey got there in the final game of her sophomore season, in the 2019 NCAA Tournament first round. Senior Madinah Muhammad reached 1,000
points during her junior year at Mississippi and came to UNC with 1,079 career points. With 348 this season as a Tar Heel she now has 1,427 , the team's highest career scoring total.

## Bailey on the Boards

Junior Janelle Bailey starts the Notre Dame game six points away from reaching 1,400 for her career. She'll become the 25th Tar Heel to score that many.
She recently passed 800 rebounds and will be the 13th player in school history with 1400 points and 800 rebounds.

- Bailey passed 1,000 career points in the team's final game of last season, the NCAA first-round matchup with California. With 15 points in that game, she finished her first two years with 1,007. She was honored for that feat on Dec. 28 before the game against Yale.
- Only one player in program history - Dawn Royster - reached 1,000 points and 600 rebounds quicker than Bailey. Royster passed 600 rebounds as a sophomore and started her junior year just seven points shy of 1,000 .
Thirty for 30: Bailey, wearing jersey No. 30 this year in honor of sidelined teammate Jaelynn Murray, registered her 30th career double-double on Dec. 5 against Illinois with 13 points and 11 boards.
With 23 points and 17 rebounds against Virginia on Jan. 30, she recorded her 11th double-double this season and 37th of her Tar Heel career.


## Stellar Start

Freshman forward Malu Tshitenge has gotten off to an outstanding start at UNC. A starter in all 27 games, she's averaging 10.7 points and 7.4 rebounds. She leads the team in field goal percentage (59.7) and ranks second in rebounding.

- Tshitenge leads the ACC in offensive rebounding with 4.15 per game.
- After averaging 13.0 points and 12.5 rebounds in wins over Navy (Nov. 11) and Charleston Southern (Nov. 15), she was named the Atlantic Coast Conference Freshman of the Week on Nov. 18. It was her first honor as a Tar Heel and UNC's first weekly honor of the season.


## MVP Muhammad

Senior guard Madinah Muhammad (known to her teammates as "Dino") sat out all of last season after transferring to UNC from Mississippi, and she announced her return loudly during the Cancun Challenge. In two games there over the Thanksgiving break, Muhammad averaged 22 points, leading the Tar Heels in wins over Temple and Missouri. Over the two games she was 10-for-16 ( 62.5 percent) from threepoint range and also averaged 6.0 rebounds. With her mother, Rasheda, in from Chicago to watch her daughter play for the first time in a Tar Heel uniform, Muhammad was named MVP of the six-team Riviera Division.
For the season, she's averaging 12.9 points, third on the team. She led the Tar Heels with 20 points in the ACC opener against Pitt and scored a team-high 21 in the loss at Wake Forest

- Muhammad scored 17 points in the win at Georgia Tech, including seven of the Tar Heels' 13 points in OT.


## Welcome to the Family

After her arrival at UNC last spring, women's basketball coach Courtney Banghart put special emphasis on recruiting the first group of players who would join the Tar Heel program under her watch. Seven months later, she was ready to present that

Banghart announced on Nov. 19 that five outstanding high school studentathletes have signed National Letters of Intent to join the North Carolina program. Deja Kelly, Anya Poole, Kennedy Todd-Williams, Alyssa Ustby and Ali Zelaya will join the Tar Heel roster in 2020, and Banghart isn't the only one touting their merits: as a group, the Carolina class was ranked 11th nationally and fourth in the Atlantic Coast Conference by ESPNW.
"My staff, team, and our entire Carolina Family are all so glad that this day is finally here," Banghart said. "The class of 2020 will always be extra special to us, as it's the first class we signed together here at North Carolina. We targeted these five very early on and we're beyond excited that they are now officially Tar Heels. All are eager to help us bring this program back to an elite level and all look forward to writing the first pages of our future.
"As a group, they bring a lot of everything to our roster. They bring versatility, length, talent, scoring ability, defensive toughness, speed, athleticism, a winning mentality, and an ability to play all five positions on the floor. They are winners, leaders, and proven teammates, and they will represent the North Carolina brand of broad-based excellence perfectly. We have high expectations for this class and they are eager to get started."

- UNC signee Deja Kelly was one of 24 high school players named to the 2020 McDonald's All-American Game roster. She's the first Tar Heel picked for the prestigious event since Janelle Bailey in 2017. Kelly has also been selected for the Jordan Brand Classic game.


## Accolades for Bailey.

- Junior Janelle Bailey was one of 20 top collegiate centers named to the 2020 Lisa Leslie Award Watch List. It's the second year in a row that Bailey has been part of the watch list. In February she was announced as a Top 10 Finalist, also for the second year in a row.
- Bailey was one of 30 players from across the nation and one of just four from the ACC named to the Preseason "Wade Watch" List, announced Nov. 6 by the Women's Basketball Coaches Association (WBCA).
- Bailey was named to the Preseason All-ACC Team for the second year in a row.


## Lineup Notes

- Although there are three seniors in the starting lineup, Taylor Koenen is the only one who is in her fourth year in the program. Madinah Mohammad is in her first year playing for UNC after sitting out last season as a transfer. Shayla Bennett is in her second year with the Tar Heels after playing two years in junior college.
- Four players - Jaelynn Murray, Emily Sullivan, Naomi Van Nes and Olivia Smith - are sidelined while rehabilitating injuries.
- UNC reached the NCAA Tournament in 2019, ending a three-year drought, but the Tar Heels fell to California in a first-round game. No player on the current roster has won an NCAA Tournament game. (In program history, Carolina is 47-26 in NCAA postseason play.)


## Captain Koenen

On Sept. 25, just before UNC's first official practice of the fall, Banghart gathered her players in the office conference room and announced that senior Taylor Koenen would serve as the team captain for 2019-20. As Banghart met with her players and talked to them about goals for the season, she also asked each one who should lead the team and Koenen was the common thread, mentioned by each player.
Koenen comes into the role with some experience: She represents her team on UNC's Student-Athlete Advisory Council and in 2018 she was one of three studentathletes selected to serve on the ACC Autonomy Committee. In that role, she attended the 2019 NCAA Convention in Orlando last January.
A business administration major, Koenen has been named to the All-ACC Academic Team in each of the last three years. After starting 12 of 31 games as a freshman, she started all 31 her sophomore year and all 33 last year. The Temple game on Nov. 28 was her 100th in a Tar Heel uniform.

## A Number with Meaning

Junior Janelle Bailey announced the week the season started that she'll wear jersey No. 30 this year in honor of teammate Jaelynn Murray, who tore her ACL in the team's exhibition game and will miss the season. Murray will be listed as No. 44 this season and the two plan to switch back when Murray returns to the court.
The two came on their recruiting visit together and have been roommates since arriving on campus in the fall of 2017. Bailey got the idea to honor her friend shortly after the injury. "I just wanted to do something for her," Bailey said. "She's passionate about the team and really into the game. She makes everyone feel better. I wanted to do that for her."
"I was flabbergasted when I heard," Murray said. "Janelle and I have been close

for a couple years now - the bond has just gotten stronger and stronger over the years. To know that she'll honor me this way is very meaningful."
Bailey has worn jersey No. 44 since she was a freshman at Providence Day School in Charlotte. She started wearing it in honor of her older sister, Gigi, who also wore the number before she stopped playing basketball.

Murray played in 30 games last year and started two. She was expected to be a valuable piece of the Tar Heels' puzzle this season, and after her injury, that remains true.
"Jaelynn is the heart of the team," UNC coach Courtney Banghart said.
"The consistency with which she brings positive energy is remarkable.

She's one of those players who can help you almost as much off the court as she can on. I feel horrible for her, but I'm grateful that her impact is so other-centered that she'll still be able to help us and be a part of the team."

## Player Notes

- A video of junior guard Leah Church hitting three long-range shots in her driveway with her back to the basket went viral in August. Church's tweet made the Today show, among many other outlets, and the video, shot by her mom, has been viewed more than 1 million times.
- Senior guard Liz Roberts was awarded a scholarship during the preseason. The exercise and sport science major from Chapel Hill (Durham Academy) received another big honor in November when she was one of 162 UNC students inducted into Phi Beta Kappa honorary society. There ceremony took place on the afternoon of Nov. 6, and practice wrapped up early enough for both Roberts and coach Courtney Banghart to attend.
- Freshman forward Malu Tshitenge has made an immediate impact for the Tar Heels, but perhaps that's to be expected, as impact runs in the family: her uncle is Hall of Fame center Dikembe Mutombo.
- In May, junior Janelle Bailey played at the USA Basketball Women's $3 \times 3$ National Championship in Las Vegas, where her team finished as the runner-up.
Bailey won a gold medal at the 2017 FIBA $3 \times 3$ U18 World Cup and later was named USA Basketball's 2017 Female Athlete of the Year.
- Shayla Bennett is playing in jersey No. 22 this year after wearing No. 0 as a junior and No. 24 when she was in junior college. The switch is a return to the number she wore in high school and considers her favorite.
"It's something that symbolizes family for me," she said. "I don't feel like myself without this number."
No. 22 has deep roots for Bennett. Her brother, Carrio Bennett, wore the number at South Carolina State and her father, John Bennett, wore it at Berea High School.

## Honors

- Recipient of an ACC Weaver-James-Corrigan Postgraduate Award, announced on Feb. 21. Of the 50 total honorees, Koenen is one of eight who are planning on professional careers and received honorary awards instead of postgraduate scholarships. She was the only women's basketball player on this year's list.
- Selected as the team captain, an honor announced on Sept. 25 just before the team's first practice of the season, as the Tar Heels were gathered in the office conference room.
- Named to the All-ACC Academic Team in her freshman, sophomore and junior years.


## Bio Updates

- Has started 100 consecutive games: the last nine games of her freshman year, all 31 as a sophomore, all 33 as a junior, and 27 so far as a senior.
- Has played in every game since coming to UNC, a total that stands at 122 after the Wake game.
- Scored her 1,000th career point in the loss at FSU and was honored for that feat prior to the following game, against Miami on Jan. 16
- Is the 38th player in school history to reach 1,000 points but just the fifth player with 1,000 points, 700 rebounds and 300 assists
