#### **STORYLINES**

**REPLACING DICKERSON AND KLUESNER:** As the 2020-21 season gets underway the RedHawks will need to find a way to replacing its top two scorers from a year ago. Lauren Dickerson averaged 17.4 points, while Savannah Kluesner averaged 16.1 points and 8.9 rebounds per game. Dickerson finished her Miami career with 2,143 points, the most in school history.

**HENDRIX BEGINS YEAR TWO:** Head Coach DeUnna Hendrix begins her second year at the helm of the Miami women's basketball team.

**TAKE TWO:** Miami's season opener at Wisconsin was postponed due to COVID-19 concerns. Both teams are looking at rescheduling the event.

**ON TAP:** Miami travels to Notre Dame following the postponement of its season opener at Wisconsin. Tip-off is scheduled for 4 p.m. Fans can listen to the game on The Miami Sports Network from Van Wagner and watch on the ACC Network.

**LAST YEAR'S REDHAWKS:** Miami is coming off of an 11-20 season, which included a 4-14 conference record under then first year head coach De'Unna Hendrix. Miami returns three starters from last season's squad that averaged 72.2 points per game and made 6.77 three pointers per game in 2019-20.

**ABOUT NOTRE DAME:** Notre Dame went 13-18 in 2019-20 and 8-10 in ACC play. They averaged 64.8 points per game and are led by senior Destinee Walker, who averaged 14.5 points and 4.4 rebounds per game in 2019-20. The Fighting Irish lost 86-85 in overtime on Friday at Ohio to begin the year. Dara Mabrey had 34 points in the loss.

ROSTER UPDATES: Miami will play this season with just 12 student-athletes. Freshmen Tajah Foster-Walker and Jordan Tuff opted out of the 2020-21 season and Sydney Watkins will miss the year with an injury.

**SERIES WITH NOTRE DAME:** Miami is 4-2 all-time versus the Fighting Irish but these two teams have not competed since 2007-08, a contest Notre Dame won 98-50.

**GREAT SCOTT:** Peyton Scott had a banner year for the RedHawks in 2019-20, averaging 12.5 points and 4.7 rebounds per game, earning All-MAC Freshman honors. Scott started and played in 30 game last season.

**LOOKING AHEAD:** The RedHawks return to action on Dec. 3 with a trip to Purdue.

## **DeUnna Hendrix** Head Coach

Years at Miami: Second Season Record at Miami: 11-20 (4-14 MAC) Years as Head Coach: Ninth Season

Overall Record: 136-113 (93-57 conference)

DeUnna Hendrix completed her first season as the ninth head coach in Miami women's basketball history in 2019-20 after being hired on April 23, 2019.

In 2019-20, the RedHawks finished with an 11-20 overall record and a 4-14 conference record as they were fifth in the MAC East. The Red and White picked up a power-five win with an 80-71 decision at Pittsburgh on Dec. 17.

Three Miami players received all-conference honors following the conclusion of the regular season as Lauren Dickerson was named All-MAC Second Team, Savannah Kluesner was named All-MAC Third Team and Peyton Scott was named MAC All-Freshman Team. Dickerson became Miami's all-time leading scorer in addition to breaking five other Miami career records and one single-season record. Kluesner broke the program record for single-season double-doubles (14) and Miami's single-game block record (7).

Hendrix came to Oxford from High Point University, where she was the head coach for seven seasons. She ranks third among Panther women's basketball coaches with 125 wins and amassed an 89-43 mark in the Big South. The 67.4 conference winning percentage is the best in program history.

In 2018-19, Hendrix led High Point to a 22-9 record and a 15-3 record in Big South competition, earning an invite to the WNIT for the second time during her tenure.

During Hendrix's time with the Panthers, the Kokomo, Indiana-native has coached three Big South Players of the Year, five All-Big South First Team members, 15 all-conference players and five players that earned all-freshman accolades, including one Big South Freshman of the Year honoree. She also has won one regular season championship (2013-14), earning Big South Coach of the Year that same season.

Hendrix served as an assistant coach for one year with HPU before earning the top job in May of 2012.

Hendrix joined High Point in 2011 after four years as an assistant coach at Jacksonville University. The Dolphins advanced to the Atlantic Sun championship game in three of her four seasons, including 2011. The team went 23-9 in 2007-08, the best overall record in program history.

Prior to Jacksonville, Hendrix played at the University of Richmond from 2003-07. Hendrix was a two-time team captain her junior and senior year. She also helped the Spiders to an NCAA Tournament appearance (2004-05) as well as the WNIT semifinals in 2003-04.

Hendrix was a three-sport athlete during her prep career at Kokomo High School. She was a First-Team All-State selection as a senior, leading the Lady Kats to an undefeated season, a state championship and a No. 14 national ranking.

Hendrix went on to play professionally for the Jacksonville Cougars of the Women's Blue Chip Basketball League in the summer of 2008. It was the league's inaugural season and Hendrix was elected team captain.

Hendrix earned her bachelor's degree in rhetoric and communications from Richmond in 2007.
