THE SHOOTAROUND

- This will be the 27th meeting between Western Michigan and Notre Dame
- WMU trails the all-time series, 19-7
- The Broncos have dropped the last eight meetings to the Fighting Irish
- It's the first meeting between WMU and Notre Dame since 1992
- Of the 27 meetings, 16 have been decided by single digits
- WMU last win over Notre Dame came back on Feb. 28, 1966, the Broncos defeated Notre Dame, 82-76
- It's the Broncos first game against the ACC since playing Syracuse back in 2014 at the NCAA Tournament
- The Broncos last win over the ACC came in 2006 with a 71-68 victory over Virginia Tech
- Western Michigan has 13 wins over the ACC
- WMU is coming off a 66-62 loss against Butler on Wednesday, Nov. 25
- Against Butler, WMU shot 46 percent from the field, 50 percent from three and 70 percent from the free-throw line
- WMU was led by sophomore guard B. Artis White with 17 points, 7 rebounds and 5 assists
- White's 7 rebounds was a career-high
- Off the bench, senior Rafael Cruz Jr. and junior Patrick Emilien score in double figures
- Cruz Jr., had 14 points off the bench while Emilien had 11 points
- Emilien connected on three three-pointers, matching a career-high
- WMU leads the MAC in three-point field goal percentage at 50%
- WMU ranks second in the MAC with 5.0 blocks per game
- The Broncos are led by first-year head coach Clayton Bates, who seeks his first win as head coach
- Western Michigan was picked to finish 12th in the Preseason MAC Coaches' Poll.

THE TIP-OFF

This will be the 27th meeting between Western Michigan and Notre Dame. WMU trails the all-time series 19-7 and has dropped the last eight meetings against the Fighting Irish.

PARTY LIKE IT'S 1992

This will be the first meeting between WMU and Notre Dame since 1992 when the Fighting Irish defeated the Broncos, 63-56.

CLOSER THAN YOU THINK

Of the 27 meetings between Western Michigan and Notre Dame, 16 have been decided by single digits including the last three meetings in 1975, 1976 and 1992.

IT CAN BE DONE AGAIN

Western Michigan's last win over the Fighting Irish came in Kalamazoo back on Feb. 28, 1966. The Broncos defeated Notre Dame, 82-76.

ACC SUCCESS

Against the current Atlantic Coast Conference schools, the Broncos have registered 13 wins against the ACC.

This will be the first time the Broncos have challenged an ACC team since squaring off with Syracuse in the First Round of the NCAA Tournament back in 2014. A 77-53 loss for the Broncos.

LAST WIN OVER THE ACC

The last victory WMU had over an ACC opponent was back in 2006 when the Broncos defeated Virginia Tech, 71-68.

PREVIOUS GAME REWIND

To open up the season the Broncos went on the road and challenged Big East opponent Butler, falling to the Bulldogs in a back and forth battle, 66-62. The Broncos held a two point lead with 10 minutes left in the second half and only trailed by three with 30 seconds remaining.

NEAR TRIPLE-DOUBLE

Backing up his stellar freshman campaign, sophomore B. Artis White led the Broncos against Butler with 17 points, 7 rebounds and 5 assists.

TRIO OF SCORING

Western Michigan had three players score in double figures against Butler with B. Artis White (17 pts), Rafael Cruz Jr. (14 pts) and Patrick Emilien (11 pts).

BENCH PRODUCTION

WMU got plenty of production off the bench against Butler with 28 points, having two players score in double figures. Rafael Cruz Jr., led the way with 14 points off the bench followed by Patrick Emilien with 11 points.

QUITE A DEBUT

Senior forward Greg Lee had quite a debut for the Broncos against Butler with 6 points and 7 rebounds.

SCOUTING THE BRONCOS

The Broncos return 10 from last years squad that went 13-19 and 6-12 in Mid-American Conference play. WMU welcomes five newcomers to the 2020-21 roster while also returning four of its top six scorers from a year ago.

SHOOTING THE LIGHTS OUT

Western Michigan shot the lights out at Hinkle Fieldhouse against Butler, shooting 46 percent from the field, 50 percent from three and 70 percent from the free-throw line.

BLOCK PARTY

WMU ranks second in the MAC with five blocked shots per game. WMU had five blocks at Butler, led by Patrick Emilien with two blocks.

NEW MAN IN CHARGE

For the first time in 17 years, Western Michigan men's basketball has a new head coach. Back in March of 2020, Clayton Bates was named the program's 14th men's basketball head coach.

Bates has been an assistant coach at WMU the last eight seasons. It's Bates' first head coaching job. Bates is one of 28 new coaches at the collegiate level.

A YEAR UNDER HIS BELT

Returning to the Broncos for the 2020-21 campaign is All-MAC Freshman team member Titus Wright. Wright played in all 32 games last season, making 31 starts and averaging 6.2 points per game.

Wright's 197 total points was the 10th most by a freshman in a single-season in school history.

Sophomore B. Artis White looks to lead the Broncos after averaging 7.3 points per game during his freshman campaign. White 226 points a year ago was the 8th most by a freshman in a single-season at WMU.

"CRUZ"-ING TOWARD THE BASKET

Senior Rafael Cruz Jr. will look to make an impact once again, ranking fourth on the team last season at 7.1 points per game off the bench.

OH CAPTAIN, OUR CAPTAINS

As voted on by their teammates, senior Greg Lee, junior William Boyer-Richard and red-shirt junior Jason Whitens have been named captains for the 2020-21 season.

UPPER PENINSULA POWER

Redshirt junior Jason Whitens returned from injury last season and played in all 32 games, marking 29 starts and ranked second on the team with 4.3 rebounds per game. Whitens also ranked third on the team last season with 42 offensive rebounds.

MAC PRESEASON POLL

Western Michigan was picked to finish 12th in the MAC Men's Basketball Preseason Coaches' poll with 13 points. Bowling Green was picked to win the conference with 132 points and eight first-place votes.

ROAD WOES

Dating back to last season, WMU has lost six straight road games. Since 2010, the Broncos have recorded 14 non-conference road victories.

NON-CONFERENCE SUCCESS

Since 2002, Western Michigan has compiled 123 non-conference victories.

A NON-CONFERENCE TO REMEMBER

The Broncos will have five non-conference games in 2020-21 with two being played at home. After it's contest with Butler, WMU makes road trips to Notre Dame (Dec. 2) and Michigan State (Dec. 6).

NEW TO THE SIDELINES

Jacob Bullock and Kristof Kendrick will make their debuts as Assistant Coaches on the bench for the Broncos this season. Bullock has been a part of the Bronco basketball program the last four seasons, two of which were as Director of Basketball Operations. Kendrick comes to WMU from Bradley University

where he was the coordinator of player development and video operations for the men's basketball program.

HOUSTON WE HAVE A BALLER

Freshman Daylan Hamilton from Houston, Texas looks to make an immediate impact for the Broncos this season. Hamilton averaged 26 points per game during his final prep season and was named HABCA First Team All-Greater Houston.

PLAY "FREEMAN"

Freshman Josiah "JoJo" Freeman was ranked the No.17 recruit in Virginia and No.74 shootin guard in the country by 247Sports.com. During his senior season at Paul VI Catholic, averaged 14.9 points per game and shot 47 percent from the field.

"HOLMES" IS WHERE YOU MAKE IT

Redshirt sophomore Jaylon Holmes transfered to WMU from Lincoln Trail College where last season he averaged 17.5 points and 5.5 rebounds per game prior to an injury.

THREE'S A PLENTY

Western Michigan's 676 three-point attempts last season was the third most in a single-season in school history. Of those 676 attempts, WMU made 228 three's.

IT'S A LOCK WITH THE HALFTIME LEAD

When having the lead at the half the past three seasons, the Broncos have been dominant with a 40-11 record.

HOME SWEET HOME

Last season WMU clinched 10 wins at home for the first time since the 2017-18 season. WMU has now registered at least 10 wins at home in 17 of the last 19 seasons.

307 AND COUNTING

WMU has made at least 1 three-pointer in 307 consecutive games. 2011 was the last time WMU went without a three.

THAT 70'S SHOW

In the past three seasons, the Broncos have been successful when scoring over 70 points, registering a 55-35 record.

THE MAN IN CHARGE

Clayton Bates was named the 14th head coach of the Western Michigan men's basketball program back in March of 2020. In his third tour of duty with the Broncos, Bates has been a key cog in the program's successes since the turn of the century.

Bates has played a direct part in seven 20-win seasons, two Mid-American Conference Tournament victories and subsequent NCAA Tournament appearances, and four other trips to the postseason for the Broncos.

THIRD TIME'S A CHARM

Bates has spent a considerable portion of his coaching career as an assistant with the Broncos. His first stint at Western Michigan lasted nearly a decade, with Bates serving as an assistant coach for the last two WMU Men's basketball head coaches Rob McCullum and Steve Hawkins.

Bates left for a brief period and returned to be an assistant on the 2009-10 staff before heading off to become an assistant at Wright State. Bates returned two years later as an assistant for WMU before being promoted to head coach.

PREVIOUS EXPERIENCE

Bates has played an important role in the success at WMU while establishing himself as one of the best coaches and top recruiters in the MAC. During his first stint at WMU, from 2000-2008, the Broncos posted four 20-win seasons while advancing to the 2004 NCAA Tournament.

Bates also served as an assistant coach at Wright State, 2010-2012, helping the Raiders to a 19-14 record in his first season. While at Wright State, Bates recruited the 2012 Horizon League Newcomer of the Year Julius Mays as well as coached three players to All-Horizon League honors.

In 1997 Bates served as an administrative assistant at the University of Illinois where the Fighting Illini advanced to the second round of the NCAA Tournament. After one year at Illinois, Bates spent the next three seasons as an assistant coach at Jacksonville University.

THE PLAYING DAYS

Bates played at the University of Florida under Lon Kruger and played for Gator teams that made four post-season appearances, most notably the 1994 Final Four. During his playing career, Bates was awarded the 1993 Most Inspirational Player and the 1996 Most Outstanding Academic Player.

Bates was also named the 1996 Fred Koss Memorial Award winner, which is given to the player who displays the highest levels of sportsmanship, dedication and commitment to the team and community during his career.

PERSONAL

Bates is married to the former Annemarie Mernagh, an All-Big East volleyball player at the University of Pittsburgh and former assistant volleyball coach at WMU.

The couple has two daughters, Annelyse and Sydney.

THE KELLEY-GO-ROUND

Thomas Kelley heads into his third season as an assistant coach with the Bronco program. Kelley comes to the Broncos from Michigan State University where he spent two seasons as a graduate assistant under legendary head coach Tom Izzo.

Kelley had an illustrious playing career, playing at Michigan State from 1995-99 and was an integral part of Izzo's first Final Four team as a fifth-year senior in 1998-99. At MSU, Kelley played in 115 games and averaged 5.3 points and 2.0 assists per game and was Izzo's first signed recruit.

After his collegiate career, Kelley played 15 seasons overseas in Amsterdam, Israel, Turkey, Austria, Hungary and Finland. Kelley will work primarily with the Bronco guards.

WORKED HIS WAY UP

Jacob Bullock enters his fourth season with the Broncos and first season as an assistant coach. Bullock spent the past two seasons as Director of Basketball Operations after spending one season as a graduate assistant before being promoted to DOBO.

Bullock, a native of Lansing, Mich., enjoyed a successful playing career at Aquinas College. Bullock scored 1,843 career points, ranking sixth all-time at Aquinas. Bullock was a two-time NAIA All-American, averaging 14.3 points per game for his career.

Bullock earned his bachelor's degree in sports management and business administration from Aquinas in 2016. Bullock received his Master's Degree from Western Michigan in Sports Management in 2018. He played prep ball at Lansing Catholic High School.

FORMER BRONCO BACK ON THE BENCH

Kristof Kendrick enters his first season as an assistant coach with the Broncos. Prior to WMU, Kendrick spent one season as the coordinator of player development and video operations for Bradley Men's Basketball.

Kendrick is an experienced coach from the Indianapolis area, spending 10 seasons as a head and assistant coach with a number of Indianapolis high schools. Most recently, Kendrick spent two seasons as the head coach at T.C. Howe High School. In 2018 Kendrick was named the 2019 GIAC Conference Coach of the Year. In two seasons Kendrick led T.C. Howe to a 35-15 record with appearances in two sectional championships and the 2018 Indianapolis City Tournament title game.

Kendrick earned his bachelor's degree at Western Michigan, where he also earned two letters with the Bronco men's basketball program, helping the team win the 2005 Mid-American Conference west division title.

BEHIND THE SCENES

Jacob Kramers enters his first season as Director of Basketball Operations for the WMU Men's Basketball program. During the 2019-20 season, Kramers was an assistant coach at Highland Community College. In his first season at Highland, Kramers helped the Scotties to a 28-3 record and a KJCCC DII championship and Region VI runner-ups.

Prior to Highland, Kramers spent four seasons as a student manager for the Iowa State Men's Basketball program. Kramers earned his bachelor's degree from Iowa State in 2018 in Business Management.
