### COUNTDOWN TO PUCK DROP

<b>534</b>	Head coach <b>Jeff Jackson</b> has 534 career wins, which ranks second among active NCAA Division I head coaches, spanning six seasons at Lake Superior State and 16+ seasons at Notre Dame. Jackson's win total ranks 11th all-time (John MacInnes ranks 10th with 555 career wins).
<b>20</b>	Graduate student <b>Matthew Galajda</b> has 20 career shutouts, which ranks second among active goaltenders behind only Dryden McKay of Minnesota State (26). Galajda notched his first shutout with the Irish last Friday night against RIT as he stopped all 22 shots he faced (Oct. 22).
<b>17</b>	Notre Dame begins its 17th season under the direction of Head Coach <b>Jeff Jackson</b> and Associate Head Coaches <b>Paul Pooley</b> and <b>Andy Slaggert</b> .
<b>16</b>	Sixteen sets of brothers have now suited up for the Irish, including current players <b>Cam Burke</b> (brother <b>Cal</b> graduated in 2020), <b>Graham</b> and <b>Landon Slaggert</b> , <b>Trevor</b> and <b>Justin Janicke</b> and <b>Brady Bjork</b> (brother <b>Anders</b> played 2014-17).
<b>10</b>	Ten former Fighting Irish players appeared on opening-night NHL rosters ahead of the 2021-22 season: <b>Anders Bjork</b> (Buffalo Sabres), <b>Ian Cole</b> (Carolina Hurricanes), <b>Jake Evans</b> (Montreal Canadiens), <b>Vinnie Hinostroza</b> (Buffalo Sabres), <b>Anders Lee</b> (New York Islanders), <b>Kyle Palmieri</b> (New York Islanders), <b>Andrew Peeke</b> (Columbus), <b>Cal Petersen</b> (Los Angeles Kings), <b>Bryan Rust</b> (Pittsburgh Penguins) and <b>Riley Sheahan</b> (Seattle Kraken).
<b>8</b>	With the most recent being the 2019 Big Ten tournament title, Notre Dame has won eight conference championships in program history - each under <b>Jeff Jackson</b> (three regular-season).
<b>5</b>	Notre Dame has an active five-straight NCAA tournament appearances streak, including Frozen Four appearances in 2017 and 2018, which is the longest streak in program history and is the second-longest active streak in the NCAA. The Irish have also appeared in eight of the last 11 NCAA Tournaments (due to the COVID-19 pandemic, the 2020 NCAA tournament did not take place and all appearance streaks remained intact).
<b>4</b>	Notre Dame forward <b>Justin Janicke</b> is the fourth-youngest player in NCAA Div. I men's hockey this season, with only Northeastern's Jack Hughes, Denver's Jack Devine and Michigan's Luke Hughes younger than the Irish freshman.

## NOTES

### SETTING THE STAGE

- The Fighting Irish hit the road to open Big Ten play at seventh-ranked Minnesota this weekend, marking the start of Notre Dame's fifth season as an affiliate member of the Big Ten.
- Last weekend, the Irish split a home series with RIT, falling 3-2 in overtime of game one (Oct. 21) before rebounding with a resounding 6-0 game two win (Oct. 22).
- Trevor Janicke (two goals), Max Ellis (two goals) and Solag Bakich (three assists) led the Irish offense, while Matthew Galajda posted 22 saves to earn his first shutout with the Irish and the 20th of his career.
- Bakich notched his first career three-point game and his second career multi-point game (had a goal and an assist versus LIU on Oct. 9).
- Janicke posted his third career two-goal game (second of the season) and his seventh multi-point game.
- For Ellis, it marked his second career two-goal game and his seventh career multi-point game.
- Notre Dame is 2-0-0 on the road this season after going 9-2-1 on the road last season.
- The Fighting Irish are averaging 3.93 goals per game, which ranks eighth nationally and fourth in the Big Ten.
- Notre Dame's penalty kill has started the season with a perfect 23-for-23 showing over the five games, joining Michigan Tech and St. Lawrence with perfect penalty kills in the early going.
- The Irish are also holding opponents to 1.57 goals-against average, which ranks fourth nationally.
- Adam Karashik (0-3-3) and Graham Slaggert (1-1-2) each have two-game point streaks heading to Minnesota.
- Ellis leads the Irish with seven points followed by Janicke (4-2-6) and Solag Bakich (1-4-5).
- All told, nine Notre Dame players have scored so far this season, while 17 have at least one point.
- The 2021-22 season marks Notre Dame's 17th under head coach Jeff Jackson and its fifth season in the Big Ten.
- Overall, it is the 53rd season of NCAA Division I hockey for Notre Dame.
- Notre Dame returns four of its top-five point scorers from 2020-21, including Graham Slaggert (7-18-25), Landon Slaggert (8-14-22), Nick Leivermann (5-12-17) and Max Ellis (5-11-16).
- The Irish welcome four graduate transfers into the fold for the 2021-22 campaign, including forward Jack Adams, defenseman Chase Blackmun, goaltender Matthew Galajda, and defenseman Adam Karashik.
- Five freshmen also join the Irish this season in forward Tyler Carpenter, defenseman

- Goaltender Josh Graziano also transferred into the program as a sophomore, having last played collegiately at Union.
- Notre Dame has made each of the last five NCAA Tournaments, the longest streak in program history, and eight of the last 11 NCAA Tournaments overall.

### THE BIG TEN STANDINGS

- This season, teams will be awarded three points in the conference standings for a win in regulation.
- If the game is tied following regulation, both teams will receive one point, with a second point being awarded to the team that wins in either the 3-on-3 overtime period or the shootout.

### GALAJDA NAMED THIRD STAR

- Graduate student Matthew Galajda was named Big Ten Hockey's Third Star of the Week, the conference announced on Tuesday (Oct. 26).
- Galajda made 22 saves to help lead the Irish to a 6-0 win over RIT on Friday night (Oct. 22), marking his first shutout for Notre Dame and the 20th of his career. A 2018 First Team All-American, his 20 career shutouts rank second in NCAA Men's Division I.
- Galajda is now 3-0-0 on the season with a 1.33 goals-against average and a .943 save percentage. For his career, the Aurora, Ontario native is 63-15-9 with an 1.63 goals-against average and a .931 save percentage.

### THE NOTRE DAME - MINNESOTA SERIES

- Minnesota leads the all-time series 35-24-5 dating back to 1924-25 when the Irish lost 2-1 in overtime in the first meeting.
- Notre Dame recognizes its first win over Minnesota in 1926-27 when the Irish shutout their opponent, 2-0, in Minneapolis.
- Twenty-nine contests between the two teams have been decided by a single goal, with the Irish narrowly leading that category 16-13.
- The teams will be playing for a 10th consecutive season.
- Before the Irish joined the Big Ten, those meetings largely overlapped with Mario Lucia's time at Notre Dame from 2012-16 (Mario is the son of former Minnesota head coach Don Lucia - a 1981 Notre Dame graduate/former defenseman).
- Last season, the Irish swept then top-ranked Minnesota at 3M Arena by scores of 3-2 and 2-1 on Jan. 15-16 and then the Gophers swept a series at Notre Dame on Feb. 12-13 in a pair of 3-0 wins.
- During the 2019-20 regular season, the Irish went 1-1-2 against Minnesota, including a 1-0-1 mark in Minneapolis (Nov. 1-2).
- That road series at Minnesota included a 2-2 game one tie (Minnesota won the 3-on-3 ot) and a 5-3 game two victory.
- Then in the 2020 playoffs, the Gophers eliminated the Irish, two games to one on March 6-8.
- The teams eliminated each other from the postseason in 2019 and 2020 with the Irish posting a 2-1 Big Ten Tournament semifinal win in overtime on March 16, 2019 en route to ultimately claiming a second consecutive Big Ten Tournament Championship.
- Notre Dame leads the series 11-9-2 since joining the Big Ten and 14 of the last 17 meetings have been decided by a goal or ended in a tie (two ties in that span, 12 one-goal games).
- Notre Dame's active career leaders against the Gophers include Nick Leivermann (15 GP; 5-1-6), Graham Slaggert (16 GP; 1-4-5), Spencer Stastney (16 GP; 1-4-5) and Trevor Janicke (11 GP; 3-2-5).
- Five of Nick Leivermann's 13 career goals have come against the Gophers.
- Ryan Bischel is 1-1-0 with a 2.50 goals against average and an .894 save percentage against the Gophers.

**CAPTAINS NAMED**

- Graduate student Adam Karashik and seniors Jake Pivonka and Graham Slaggert will serve as team captains for the Irish this season.
- Additionally, seniors Nick Leivermann and Spencer Stastney will be alternate captains.
- Leivermann, Pivonka, Slaggert and Stastney will wear letters for the first time in their Notre Dame careers while Karashik served as UConn's captain in 2020-21 before joining the Irish.

**PRESEASON B1G: SLAGGERT & STASTNEY**

- Senior forward Graham Slaggert was named a Preseason Second Team All-Big Ten selection and senior defenseman Spencer Stastney earned Honorable Mention honors (Sept. 24)
- Notre Dame was also tabbed fourth in the Big Ten Preseason Coaches Poll.
- Slaggert, a South Bend, Indiana native, played 27 games last season and was the team's second-leading scorer with 25 points on seven goals and a team-best 18 assists.
- Slaggert's 25 points as a junior marked a season-best total and he enters his senior season with 15 goals and 29 assists for 44 points in 104 games played.
- Stastney skated in all 29 games for the Irish last season, scoring a career-high five goals and adding seven assists for 12 points.
- A fifth round selection (131st overall) by the Nashville Predators in the 2018 NHL Entry Draft, Stastney's five goals were tied with teammate Nick Leivermann and Michigan's Nick Blankenburg for the most by a Big Ten defenseman a season ago.
- Stastney has now played in 104 career games while scoring nine goals and adding 27 assists for 36 points. He was an Academic All-Big Ten selection each of the past two seasons and earned Second Team All-Big Ten honors last season.

**FAMILY TIES**

- The 2021-22 Notre Dame roster features quite a few family connections to the program and hockey world.
- Two sets of brothers are currently on the roster, including Justin and Trevor Janicke and Graham and Landon Slaggert.
- Cam Burke played his first two seasons in an Irish uniform alongside his older brother, Cal Burke, who signed with the Colorado organization for the second consecutive season for 2021-22.
- Freshman forward Brady Bjork is the younger brother of former Irish All-American and current Buffalo Sabre Anders Bjork.
- The Janickes represent the 16th set of brothers to play for Notre Dame.
- The Slaggerts also are part of the fifth set of father-son combinations to suit up for the Irish, joining their father and associate head coach Andy Slaggert.
- Justin and Trevor Janicke are the sons of Curtis Janicke, who played for the Irish from 1989-93, appearing in 125 games while scoring 46 goals and adding 98 assists for 144 points.
- Justin, Trevor and Curtis represent the sixth father-son duo to play for the Irish.
- Senior forward Jake Pivonka is the son of Czech Republic native and former NHL player Michael Pivonka, who played over 800 games with the Washington Capitals (1986-99).
- Junior forward Solag Bakich is the son of Huntley Bakich, who was a linebacker for the Fighting Irish football team during the Lou Holtz era.

**JEFF JACKSON**



- The 2021-22 season marks University of Notre Dame hockey coach Jeff Jackson's 17th season behind the Irish bench. During his first 16 seasons, the program has enjoyed a great deal of success, including four trips to the Frozen Four and eight conference championships.
- Jackson has over 30 years of coaching experience and led Notre Dame to back-to-back Big Ten tournament championship seasons in 2018 and 2019 while also guiding the Irish to the 2018 national title game en route to being named the Spencer Penrose Award winner as the National Coach of the Year.
- Jackson was also named the Spencer Penrose award winner in 2007 and he is one of just 15 coaches to have earned the honor multiple times (dating back to 1951).
- Additionally, Jackson is one of only two coaches to have earned the honor multiple times in the last 17 seasons.
- Jackson's Notre Dame teams have made 11 trips to the NCAA Championship (2007-09, 2011, 2013-14, 2016-19 and 2021), advancing to the Frozen Four four times and playing in the 2008 and 2018 national title games.
- During his 16-year run, Notre Dame has become one of the nation's top teams while playing in the Central Collegiate Hockey Association, Hockey East and now Big Ten.
- Under Jackson, the Irish won the CCHA regular-season title twice (2006-07 and 2008-09) while earning three Mason Cup championships (2007, 2009 and the final one in 2013).
- Then, in the team's first season in the Big Ten (2017-18), Notre Dame captured both the regular season and conference championships and followed up by once again winning the conference tournament in year two (2018-19).
- Jackson's success on the ice also has had a major impact off the ice for the Irish. With the wins came a commitment from the University that led to the new home of Irish hockey — The Compton Family Ice Arena — one of the finest college hockey facilities in the nation. The venue opened for business on Oct. 21, 2011.
- Since Jackson's arrival, the Irish have had 43 players selected in the National Hockey League Entry Draft, including three first round selections. In that same span, 33 players from USA Hockey's National Team Developmental Program have matriculated to Notre Dame.
