MISCELLANEOUS:

- Coin Toss: Jarret Patterson, Myron Tagovailoa-Amosa, Avery Davis and Kurt Hinish represented the Irish for the coin toss. Virginia Tech won the toss and elected to defer. The Irish elected to receive and they defended the north endzone.
- Brian Kelly awarded the game ball to quarterback Jack Coan and kicker Jonathan Doerer. Coan led the Irish in the fourth quarter to 11 unanswered points to clinch the win. Doerer hit the 48-yard game-winning field goal with 17 seconds left.

TEAM NOTES:

- The Irish have won 36 straight-games against unranked opponents. It is the longest active streak in the FBS.
- Notre Dame extended its ACC regular season winning streak to 21 games with the win.
- Since 2017, Notre Dame is 25-1 against ACC opponents in the regular season.
- The Irish have won eight-straight road games dating back to the 2019 season.
- Notre Dame has won 37 consecutive-games when they have scored 30 or more points.

OFFENSIVE NOTES:

- Freshman offensive lineman Joe Alt is the second true freshman to start on the offensive line for the Irish this season after Blake Fisher started against Florida State.
- Running back Logan Diggs tallied his first career carry with a three-yard rush in the first
- Quarterback Tyler Buchner connected with Kevin Austin Jr. for a 46-yard pass in the second quarter. It marked a career-long pass for **Buchner** and career-long reception for **Austin Jr.**
- **Buchner** recorded his first career rushing touchdown with a three-yard run in the second miarter.
- **Buchner** is the first true-freshman quarterback to record a rushing touchdown since Brandon Wimbush had a 57-yard rushing touchdown against UMass in 2015.
- Later in the second quarter, Buchner connected with Kyren Williams for an eight-yard touchdown pass. Buchner is the first true-freshman quarterback to have a passing and rushing touchdown in the same game in Notre Dame history.

 Williams tallied a 10-yard rushing touchdown in the third quarter. It is the third time in his
- career that he has had a rushing and receiving touchdown in the same game. **Williams** finished with 107 all-purpose yards (81 rushing, 26 receiving), his fourth game this season with 100 all-purpose yards or more.

DEFENSIVE NOTES:

- Defensive lineman Isaiah Foskey tallied a sack in the second quarter. He leads the team with 6.0 on the season and it is his fifth game this year with a sack.
- Cornerback TaRiq Bracy recorded his first career interception in the third quarter. He is the seventh different player with an interception this season for the Irish.
- Linebacker Drew White tied a career high with 2.0 tackles-for-loss against the Hokies.
- Linebacker JD Bertrand tallied a team-high 10 tackles. It is the fourth game this season he has had 10 or more tackles.
- Defensive lineman Jayson Ademilola set a career high with six tackles.
- Defensive lineman **Kurt Hinish** set a career high with five tackles.
