COUNTDOWN TO PUCK DROP

536	Head coach Jeff Jackson has 536 career wins, which ranks second among active NCAA Division I head coaches, spanning six seasons at Lake Superior State and 16+ seasons at Notre Dame. Jackson's win total ranks 11th all-time (John MacInnes ranks 10th with 555 career wins).
20	Graduate student Matthew Galajda has 20 career shutouts, which ranks tied for fourth in men's NCAA Div I history.
16	Sixteen sets of brothers have now suited up for the Irish, including current players Cam Burke (brother Cal graduated in 2020), Graham and Landon Slaggert , Trevor and Justin Janicke and Brady Bjork (brother Anders played 2014-17).
10	Ten former Fighting Irish players appeared on opening-night NHL rosters ahead of the 2021-22 season: Anders Bjork (Buffalo Sabres), Ian Cole (Carolina Hurricanes), Jake Evans (Montreal Canadiens), Vinnie Hinostroza (Buffalo Sabre), Anders Lee (New York Islanders), Kyle Palmieri (New York Islanders), Andrew Peeke (Columbus), Cal Petersen (Los Angeles Kings), Bryan Rust (Pittsburgh Penguins) and Riley Sheahan (Seattle Kraken).
8	With the most recent being the 2019 Big Ten tournament title, Notre Dame has won eight conference championships in program history - each under Jeff Jackson (three regular-season).
5	Notre Dame has an active five-straight NCAA tournament appearances streak, including Frozen Four appearances in 2017 and 2018, which is the longest streak in program history and is the second-longest active streak in the NCAA. The Irish have also appeared in eight of the last 11 NCAA Tournaments (due to the COVID-19 pandemic, the 2020 NCAA tournament did not take place and all appearance streaks remained intact).
4	Notre Dame forward Justin Janicke is the fourth-youngest player in NCAA Div. I men's hockey this season, with only Northeastern's Jack Hughes, Denver's Jack Devine and Michigan's Luke Hughes younger than the Irish freshman.
3.52	Through nine games, the Fighting Irish are averaging 3.52 goals per game, which ranks 13th nationally and fourth among Big Ten teams.

NOTES

SETTING THE STAGE

- Coming off a home non-conference sweep of Holy Cross, the Fighting Irish return to Big Ten play by hosting Wisconsin this weekend at the Compton Family Ice Arena (Nov. 12-13).
- It will mark Notre Dame's first home conference games of the season.
- Notre Dame is 4-1-0 at home this season.
- Max Ellis (2-1-3), Jake Boltmann (1-2-3) and Solag Bakich (1-2-3) helped lead the Irish to the sweep over Holy Cross by scores of 5-2 (Nov. 4) and 4-1 (Nov. 5).
- In net, graduate student Matthew Galajda made both starts, stopping 45 of the 48 shots he faced for a .938 save percentage to go along with a 1.50 goals against average.
- Ellis leads the Irish with 11 points on a team-high five goals and six assists, followed by Bakich (3-6-9) and Trevor Janicke (4-3-7).
- Janicke and Graham Slaggert rank tied for second on the team with four goals each.
- Notre Dame's penalty kill is 33-for-34 on the season (.970), which ranks second in the NCAA.
- All told, 13 Notre Dame players have scored so far this season, while 18 have at least one point.
- The Irish are averaging 3.52 goals per game, which ranks 13th in the NCAA (fourth in the Big Ten) and are also holding opponents to 1.98 goals-against per game, which ranks 11th nationally (second in the Big Ten).
- Notre Dame has made each of the last five NCAA Tournaments, the longest streak in program history, and eight of the last 11 NCAA Tournaments overall.

THE BIG TEN STANDINGS

- This season, teams will be awarded three points in the conference standings for a win in regulation.
- If the game is tied following regulation, both teams will receive one point, with a second point being awarded to the team that wins in either the 3-on-3 overtime period or the shootout.
- The conference standings now match a national standard: W-L-T-OTW-OTL-SOW.

GALAJDA SHUTOUT RANKS

- Graduate student Matthew Galajda made 22 saves to help lead the Irish to a 6-0 win over RIT on Oct. 22, marking his first shutout for Notre Dame and the 20th of his career.

THE NOTRE DAME - WISCONSIN SERIES

- Former opponents in the WCHA, Notre Dame and Wisconsin have met 80 times in program history with Wisconsin leading the all-time series 46-25-9.
- The first meeting between the two teams came during the 1921-22 season when the Irish skated away with a 3-0 victory at Badin Rink (outdoors at Notre Dame).
- The teams met once more, in 1925-26, before taking a 40 year hiatus and returning to competition when Notre Dame earned varsity status.
- As a head coach, Jeff Jackson is 8-8-2 all-time against the Badgers (1-1-0 at Lake Superior State).
- The one win Jackson had over the Badgers at Lake Superior State came on April 4, 1992, in Albany, New York, as the Lakers defeated Wisconsin 5-3 to win the NCAA Championship (the first of Jackson's two NCAA Championships at Lake State).
- Since joining the Big Ten, the series is tied at 7-7-2.
- The teams opened the shortened 2020-21 season on Nov. 13-14 at the Compton Family Ice Arena, with the Badgers posting a 2-0 win and a 5-3 victory (Colin Theisen had a hat trick in that game two loss).
- Then at Wisconsin on Feb. 19-20 2021, the Badgers took game one 4-2 before the teams skated to a back-and-forth 5-5 tie in game two.
- In the game two shootout, Max Ellis scored and Dylan St. Cyr denied Cole Caufield, Dylan Holloway and Ty Pelton-Byce to seal the extra point.
- The teams split the 2019-20 series 2-2-0, including a split at the Kohl Center on Nov. 15-16.
- Wisconsin took game one, 3-0, and Notre Dame took a back-and-forth game two, 5-4 in overtime.
- Alex Steeves had the OT game winner (just moments after Nate Clurman cleared a puck off the Notre Dame goal line) and Trevor Janicke, Cam Burke and Colin Theisen also scored for the Irish.
- Later in the season at home (Jan. 24-25), Notre Dame dropped game one, 6-4, before bouncing back to take game two, 5-2.
- With a career-high four points on a goal and three assists, Alex Steeves helped the Irish to that 5-2 win.
- Notre Dame's active career offensive leaders against the Badgers include Graham Slaggert (10 GP, 2-3-5), Spencer Stastney (12 GP, 0-5-5), Landon Slaggert (4 GP, 0-4-4), Trevor Janicke (8 GP, 2-1-3), Jesse Lansdell (8 GP, 1-2-3) and Jake Pivonka (12 GP, 1-2-3).

2020-21 QUICK HITS

- The 2021-22 season marks Notre Dame's 17th under head coach Jeff Jackson and its fifth season in the Big Ten.
- Overall, it is the 53rd season of NCAA Division I hockey for Notre Dame.
- Notre Dame returned four of its top-five point scorers from 2020-21, including Graham Slaggert (7-18-25), Landon Slaggert (8-14-22), Nick Leivermann (5-12-17) and Max Ellis (5-11-16).

- Key losses from 2020–21 included the graduation of Dylan St. Cyr, Pierce Crawford, Matt Helleickson and Colin Theisen; Nate Clurman and Alex Steeves signing professional contracts and Michael Graham being forced to medically retire (he has since joined the Irish coaching staff as an undergraduate assistant coach).
- The Irish welcomed four graduate transfers into the fold for the 2021–22 campaign, including forward Jack Adams, defenseman Chase Blackmun, goaltender Matthew Galajda, and defenseman Adam Karashik.
- Five freshmen also joined the Irish this season in forward Tyler Carpenter, defenseman Ryan Helliwell, forward Justin Janicke, forward Hunter Strand and defenseman Hunter Weiss.
- Goaltender Josh Graziano also transferred into the program as a sophomore, having last played collegiately at Union.

CAPTAINS NAMED

- Graduate student Adam Karashik and seniors Jake Pivonka and Graham Slaggert will serve as team captains for the Irish this season.
- Additionally, seniors Nick Leivermann and Spencer Stastney will be alternate captains.
- Leivermann, Pivonka, Slaggert and Stastney will wear letters for the first time in their Notre Dame careers while Karashik served as UConn’s captain in 2020–21 before joining the Irish.

PRESEASON B1G: SLAGGERT & STASTNEY

- Senior forward Graham Slaggert was named a Preseason Second Team All-Big Ten selection and senior defenseman Spencer Stastney earned Honorable Mention honors (Sept. 24)
- Notre Dame was also tabbed fourth in the Big Ten Preseason Coaches Poll.
- Slaggert, a South Bend, Indiana native, played 27 games last season and was the team’s second-leading scorer with 25 points on seven goals and a team-best 18 assists.
- Slaggert’s 25 points as a junior marked a season-best total and he enters his senior season with 15 goals and 29 assists for 44 points in 104 games played.
- Stastney skated in all 29 games for the Irish last season, scoring a career-high five goals and adding seven assists for 12 points.
- A fifth round selection (131st overall) by the Nashville Predators in the 2018 NHL Entry Draft, Stastney’s five goals were tied with teammate Nick Leivermann and Michigan’s Nick Blankenburg for the most by a Big Ten defenseman a season ago.
- Stastney has now played in 104 career games while scoring nine goals and adding 27 assists for 36 points. He was an Academic All-Big Ten selection each of the past two seasons and earned Second Team All-Big Ten honors last season.

FAMILY TIES

- The 2021–22 Notre Dame roster features quite a few family connections to the program and hockey world.
- Two sets of brothers are currently on the roster, including Justin and Trevor Janicke and Graham and Landon Slaggert.
- Cam Burke played his first two seasons in an Irish uniform alongside his older brother, Cal Burke, who signed with the Colorado organization for the second consecutive season for 2021–22.

**HEAD COACH
JEFF JACKSON**



- The 2021-22 season marks University of Notre Dame hockey coach Jeff Jackson's 17th season behind the Irish bench. During his first 16 seasons, the program has enjoyed a great deal of success, including four trips to the Frozen Four and eight conference championships.
- Jackson has over 30 years of coaching experience and led Notre Dame to back-to-back Big Ten tournament championship seasons in 2018 and 2019 while also guiding the Irish to the 2018 national title game en route to being named the Spencer Penrose Award winner as the National Coach of the Year.
- Jackson was also named the Spencer Penrose award winner in 2007 and he is one of just 15 coaches to have earned the honor multiple times (dating back to 1951).
- Additionally, Jackson is one of only two coaches to have earned the honor multiple times in the last 17 seasons.
- Jackson's Notre Dame teams have made 11 trips to the NCAA Championship (2007-09, 2011, 2013-14, 2016-19 and 2021), advancing to the Frozen Four four times and playing in the 2008 and 2018 national title games.
- During his 16-year run, Notre Dame has become one of the nation's top teams while playing in the Central Collegiate Hockey Association, Hockey East and now Big Ten.
- Under Jackson, the Irish won the CCHA regular-season title twice (2006-07 and 2008-09) while earning three Mason Cup championships (2007, 2009 and the final one in 2013).
- Then, in the team's first season in the Big Ten (2017-18), Notre Dame captured both the regular season and conference championships and followed up by once again winning the conference tournament in year two (2018-19).
- Jackson's success on the ice also has had a major impact off the ice for the Irish. With the wins came a commitment from the University that led to the new home of Irish hockey — The Compton Family Ice Arena — one of the finest college hockey facilities in the nation. The venue opened for business on Oct. 21, 2011.
- Since Jackson's arrival, the Irish have had 43 players selected in the National Hockey League Entry Draft, including three first round selections. In that same span, 33 players from USA Hockey's National Team Developmental Program have matriculated to Notre Dame.

In addition, 24 of Jackson's Notre Dame players have gone on to play in the NHL.
- Jackson entered the 2021-22 season with a 21-year collegiate record of 530-271-91 for a .645 winning percentage, the third-highest winning percentage among all active coaches with five years or more in Division I (entering 2021-22).
- Jackson's 530 career wins rank 11th all-time in Division I and second among active coaches (entering 2021-22).
