2021-22 FIGHTING IRISH - WHAT YOU NEED TO KNOW

The University of Notre Dame men's basketball team will look to bounce back from its first loss of the season in the second round of the 2021 Maui Jim Maui Invitational against Chaminade on Tuesday evening at 10:30 p.m. ET (ESPNU). Depending on the outcome of the games on Tuesday, Notre Dame will complete the tournament Wednesday against either Butler or Texas A&M.

PROJECTED STARTING LINEUP

#20 | PAUL ATKINSON JR. | Graduate Student | 6-9 | 230 | West Palm Beach, FL

Leads the Irish with 16.0 ppg, scored 11 of his 13 points vs. St. Mary's (CA) in the second half of the game • 2019–20 lvy League Player of the Year at Yale • did not participate in 2020–21, as the lvy League cancelled all intercollegiate athletics • ranked by ESPN+ as the fourth-best transfer prospect in 2020–21 • boasts a .661 career field goal percentage — top for any returning NCAA Division I player this year — and led lvy League in FG% all three seasons in which he competed.

#3 PRENTISS HUBB | Senior | 6-3 | 176 | Upper Marlboro, MD

Failed to record an assist for the first time in his Notre Dame career against St. Mary's (CA) • preseason All-ACC Second Team • leads all returning ACC players in career assists (451) • led the Irish in scoring (14.6) and three-point field goals made (65) last season • one of five major conference players to reach 100 assists in league play last season.

#5 CORMAC RYAN | Senior | 6-5 | 195 | New York, NY

Led the Irish with 16 points on 3-for-5 shooting from behind the arc against St. Mary's (CA) • started 16 of 25 games in his first year with the Irish last season • scored 21 points in the first half in the victory at Duke last year, eventually scoring career-best 28 points • shot .344 from 3FG range last season.

#23 DANE GOODWIN | Senior | 6-4 | 202 | Upper Arlington, OH

Has scored in double figures in all three games this season • averaging 13.3 ppg and 6.0 rpg • posted career highs of 11.8 ppg and 5.2 rpg in 2020–21 • one of the best free throw shooters on the team, boasting a .821 career average from the stripe.

#14 NATE LASZEWSKI | Senior | 6-10 | 235 | Jupiter, FL

Has pulled down 31 rebounds (including career-high 16 vs. High Point) in first three games of the year • improved FG% 19 percent, 3FG% 11% and RPG by 3.1 last season • scored over 20 points four times last season and has five 20-point games in his career.

OFF THE BENCH

#2 TREY WERTZ | Senior | 6-5 | 192 | Charlotte, NC

Led the Irish with five assists vs. St. Mary's (CA) and played a season-high 26 minutes • planned to sit out 2020-21 season after transferring from Santa Clara until all underclassmen transfers were given immediate eligibility in December of 2020 • appeared in 21 games making 14 starts, shooting .429 from three-point range • hit the game-winning 3FG at the buzzer vs. WF in 2021 ACC tournament.

#0 BLAKE WESLEY | Freshman | 6-5 | 185 | South Bend, IN

First Mike Brey freshman to score 20 points in a career debut (vs. CSUN) since Chris Thomas in 2001 • first South Bend, IN, public school MBB prospect to sign with Notre Dame since 1985 • consensus four-star prospect • athletic backcourt player expected to be an immediate key contributor.

#1 J.R. KONIECZNY | Freshman | 6-6 | 195 | South Bend, IN

(pronounced Ko-NEZZ-knee) Saw action in first career game vs. CSUN • all-time leading scorer in St. Joseph County history (1,996) • joins classmate Blake Wesley as the first Northern Indiana Conference players to sign with Notre Dame since 2012 (D. Jackson, A. Torres).

#22 ELIJAH TAYLOR | Sophomore | 6-8 | 242 | Philadelphia, PA

Missed CSUN game as a precaution due to minor lower leg injury, then the High Point game with the flu • missed 2020-21 while recovering from ankle surgery • athletic front court player will provide depth on the Irish front line.

| 66 | Or .661 to be precise – graduate student Paul Atkinson Jr.'s career field goal percentage — which leads all returning NCAA Division I players this year. The 2019–20 Ivy League Player of the Year graduate transferred to Notre Dame during the offseason. Atkinson is 13–19 (.684) so far this season. |
| 257 | Games won by Notre Dame with Mike Brey and Associate Head Coach Anthony Solomon on the coaching staff. Solomon returns for his third stint with the Irish this season and with him on the sidelines, Mike Brey has won .676 percent of the games he has coached at Notre Dame. |

NOTRE DAME - MAUI INVITATIONAL HISTORY

Notre Dame is making its fourth appearance in the Maui Invitational this season and boasts a 6-3 record in the event. The first trip to Maui occurred under John MacLeod in 1993, while Mike Brey led the Irish to the tournament championship game in 2008 and the Maui title in 2017. WESLEY POSTS NOTEWORTHY NOTRE DAME DEBUT

Freshman Blake Wesley led all scorers with 21 points in the season-opening victory over CSUN last Saturday.

- It marks just the second time in the Mike Brey era that a freshman has scored 20-or-more point in his debut (24, Chris Thomas, 2001–02).
- He is the sixth freshman to reach double digit points in his career debut under Mike Brey Chris Thomas, 2001-02, 24; Luke Harangody, 2006-07, 12; Nate Laszewski, 2018-19, 12; Robby Carmody, 2018-19, 11, Dane Goodwin, 2018-19, 10.

TRANSFER DEBUTS

Graduate student Paul Atkinson Jr. made his debut with the Irish on Saturday afternoon against CSUN. Of all the transfer players of the Mike Brey era, Atkinson's career parallels Dan Miller the most, who played three years at Maryland before transferring to Notre Dame for his senior season of eligibility in 2002-03. Atkinson played three years at Yale and was the 2019-20 lvy League Player of the Year.

IRISH WELCOME BACK MOST EXPERIENCED TEAM OF THE BREY ERA

Notre Dame is in an unusual position this season and welcomes back, by far, its most experienced group of players since the Mike Brey era began in 2000-01. With the additions of Trey Wertz (two seasons at Santa Clara) and Cormac Ryan (one season at Stanford) last season, then adding Paul Atkinson Jr. (three seasons at Yale) the Irish boast a veteran group of players who have seen a significant amount of college basketball action.

The three-member class is composed of forwards Dom Campbell and Ven-Allen Lubin, along with guard J.J. Starling. All three are consensus top-100 players and four-star prospects which provide the Irish the 15th-ranked recruiting class by 24/7 Sports (fifth-best in the ACC) and the 18th-rated (fourth-best in the ACC) group from Rivals.

LAPHONSO ELLIS TO ENTER PURCELL PAVILION RING OF HONOR

Glenn and Stacey Murphy Head Men's Basketball Coach Mike Brey has announced that LaPhonso Ellis will be the program's ninth individual inducted into the Purcell Pavilion Ring of Honor on Saturday, December 11, 2021.

"LaPhonso Ellis is one of the greatest athletes and gentlemen to ever suit up for Notre Dame basketball," Brey said.

"A dominant player on the court, 'Phonz' faced his share of challenges at Notre Dame, but overcame them all to become a great ambassador not only for our program, but our entire University. The Ring of Honor was meant to celebrate amazing individuals like LaPhonso and we can't wait to induct him in December."

Ellis dominated the front line, both offensively and defensively, during his career with the Irish from 1988 through 1992. He finished his career as the all-time leading shot blocker (200), third leading rebounder (1,075) and eighth on the all-time scoring list (1,505 — those rankings have changed over the years). Upon completion of his time at Notre Dame, Ellis was just the fourth Irish player to score 1,000 points and grab 1,000 rebounds in a career.

One of the elite athletes in college basketball during his time, Ellis exploded for 27 points in 27 minutes in his first college game and never let up through his 97 career contests. He saved his best performances for some of Notre Dame's best competition. During his senior season in 1991–92, Ellis averaged 20.6 points, 11.0 rebounds and shot .679 from the field against ranked opponents.

That final season for Ellis at Notre Dame is one of the finest for a front court player in program history. Recording 22 double-doubles (third best for a single season), Ellis played 1,194 minutes (36.2 per game, a school-record at the time), shot 63 percent from the field while scoring 17.7 points per game and pulling down 11.7 rebounds per contest. On February 29, 1992, Ellis connected on 16 of 16 free throws against Rutgers which earned him a share of the school record for free throw percentage in a game.

Ellis helped three Irish teams to postseason appearances, including a first-round NCAA tournament victory over Vanderbilt in 1989. He capped the 1992 season by leading the Irish to the NIT Championship game, earning all-tournament honors with 18 points and 12.8 rebounds per game. In keeping with Ellis' penchant for stepping up against the best competition, he averaged 17.0 points, 12.5 rebounds and shot 55 percent from the field in seven postseason performances.

While Ellis missed 20 games during his career when he fell behind academically, he graduated on time with a degree in accounting in 1992. He was the fifth overall pick of the 1992 NBA Draft by the Denver Nuggets, earning first-team all-rookie honors with the squad after the 1992-93 season. He helped the Nuggets make history in the 1994 postseason as they became the first No. 8 playoff seed to defeat at No. 1 seed (Seattle). Over his 11 year NBA career, Ellis played for the Nuggets, Atlanta Hawks, Minnesota Timberwolves and Miami Heat, scoring over 7,400 points (11.9 average) with over 4,000 rebounds (6.5 average).

Ellis joined the Notre Dame Basketball Radio network after his retirement from professional basketball as a color commentator, eventually working his way to ESPN in 2009 as a college basketball analyst. Ellis became a part of the popular College GameDay crew at ESPN starting in the 2019–20 season.

The Purcell Pavilion Ring of Honor was established in 2010 by the University of Notre Dame Athletics Department to honor former or current men's and women's basketball coaches and student-athletes who have made distinguished and noteworthy contributions during their careers at the University.

NOTRE DAME WILL MAKE TRIP TO HOWARD ON MARTIN LUTHER KING JR. DAY

The University of Notre Dame men's basketball team will travel to Washington, D.C., on Martin Luther King Jr. Day, Monday, January 17, 2022, to face Howard University. The trip will mark the first road game for Notre Dame men's basketball against one of the countries Historically Black Colleges and Universities.

The game was previously scheduled for January 18, 2021, but was postponed due to the health and safety regulations put in place for the coronavirus pandemic. The game will be played at Howard's Burr Gymnasium and nationally broadcast on Fox at 2:30 p.m. ET.

"I am as excited about this trip than any game we have scheduled for next season," Glenn and Stacey Murphy Head Men's Basketball Coach Mike Brey said.

"We were so disappointed that we had to cancel last season's game due to the pandemic, but the delay gives us an opportunity to really do it right. This game deserves the kind of atmosphere that only a full house at Burr Gymnasium can deliver. Our program's first trip to an HBCU on Martin Luther King Jr. Day is another step in our commitment to remaining active participants in the push for social change in this country. This event will provide an amazing educational experience for our student-athletes, coaches, support staff and University."

Since 2019, Howard has honored Dr. King's Celebration of Excellence by hosting non conference contests with iconic, historical institutions. In the past two seasons, HU has greeted Ivy League perennials Harvard (2019) and Yale (2020) to The Burr.

"Dr. King's impact on our world is remarkable, and his influence continues to be both felt and needed," Howard head coach Kenny Blakeney said.

"It gives me chills to think that only a few miles from where Dr. King shifted the country with his infamous speeches, marches and meetings, our basketball programs will have a historic first by hosting Notre Dame at Howard University. We are pressing forward toward the beloved community Dr. King sought to achieve and I am honored to lead this program and work with my lifelong friend, Coach Mike Brey, to deepen the call for social justice with our players."

The connections between Notre Dame men's basketball, the Howard coaching staff and the Washington, DC, area run deep. Mike Brey and associate head coach Rod Balanis have roots in the DMV area and both graduated from DeMatha High School. Kenny Blakeney also is a DeMatha graduate, played at Duke (1992–95) while Mike Brey was an assistant with the Blue Devils and was the head assistant coach under Brey at Delaware (2002–05).

The game also marks the return to the D.C. area for Irish senior Prentiss Hubb (Upper Marlboro), who graduated from Gonzaga High School. Hubb is the latest Notre Dame standout to call the Washington, D.C., area home, as the 'D.C. Pipeline' has included Austin Carr, Adrian Dantley, Jerian Grant, Bob Whitmore, Don Williams, Monty Williams, Collis Jones, Tracy Jackson, Tom Sluby, Sid Catlett and Notre Dame President Emeritus Rev. Edward A. Malloy, C.S.C.

Notre Dame has welcomed 10 different HBCUs to campus for 12 men's basketball games throughout the program's history. The trip to Howard will be the first road trip for the Irish to an HBCU and the first for an Atlantic Coast Conference team since Miami (Florida) played at Savannah State on December 19, 2013.

The contest marks the first against a Power Five Conference team for Howard at home since Oregon State visited Burr Gymnasium on November 27, 2010.

MIKE BREY, GLENN AND STACEY MURPHY HEAD MEN'S BASKETBALL COACH

22nd Season at ND | George Washington '82 | Career Record: 549-301 | ND Record: 450-249

In 22 seasons as the men's basketball coach at the University of Notre Dame, Mike Brey has guided the Fighting Irish to over 440 victories and is the all-time winningest men's basketball coach in school history.

The Irish are enjoying a recent stretch of success that ranks among the best in the 117-year history of basketball under the Golden Dome. Notre Dame was the only school in the nation to make back-to-back appearances in the NCAA Championship Elite Eight at the end of the 2015 and 2016 seasons, claimed an Atlantic Coast Conference title in 2015 and has made two ACC title game appearances in four years of ACC competition.

Brey was named head coach at Notre Dame on July 14, 2000. In his first season with the Irish, his team claimed the 2001 BIG EAST West Division championship and returned to the NCAA Championship for the first time in 12 seasons. Notre Dame soon became a regular in the NCAA tournament by making 12 appearances in 17 seasons with Brey on the sidelines.

In 2011, Brey was the recipient of both the Associated Press and the Henry Iba/USBWA National Coach of the Year award. He was named BIG EAST Coach of the Year in 2007, 2008 and 2011 and three of his players have been named BIG EAST Player of the Year.

Before arriving at Notre Dame, Brey was the head basketball coach at the University of Delaware, where he compiled a 99-52 mark from 1995-2000 and won America East Co-Coach of the Year honors in 1998. Prior to his time at Delaware, he was an assistant coach at Duke University. During his eight years at Duke, the Blue Devils advanced to the Final Four six times and won back-to-back national championships in 1991 and 1992.

Brey graduated from George Washington University in 1982. He played for and coached with legendary high school coach Morgan Wootten at DeMatha High School.
