COUNTDOWN TO PUCK DROP

541	Head coach Jeff Jackson has 541 career wins, which ranks second among active NCAA Division I head coaches, spanning six seasons at Lake Superior State and 16+ seasons at Notre Dame. Jackson's win total ranks 11th all-time (John MacInnes ranks 10th with 555 career wins).
21	Graduate student Matthew Galajda has 21 career shutouts, which ranks tied for third in NCAA Div I men's hockey history.
16	Sixteen sets of brothers have now suited up for the Irish, including current players Cam Burke (brother Cal graduated in 2020), Graham and Landon Slaggert , Trevor and Justin Janicke and Brady Bjork (brother Anders played 2014-17).
12	With Alex Steeves making his NHL debut on Dec. 7, 12 former Fighting Irish players have played in the NHL this season: Anders Bjork (Buffalo Sabres), Ian Cole (Carolina Hurricanes), Jake Evans (Montreal Canadiens), Vinnie Hinostroza (Buffalo Sabre), Anders Lee (New York Islanders), Kyle Palmieri (New York Islanders), Andrew Peeke (Columbus), Cal Petersen (Los Angeles Kings), Bryan Rust (Pittsburgh Penguins), Riley Sheahan (Seattle Kraken), Alex Steeves (Toronto Maple Leafs) and TJ Tynan (Los Angeles Kings).
8	With the most recent being the 2019 Big Ten tournament title, Notre Dame has won eight conference championships in program history - each under Jeff Jackson (three regular-season).
5	Notre Dame has an active five-straight NCAA tournament appearances streak, including Frozen Four appearances in 2017 and 2018, which is the longest streak in program history and is the second-longest active streak in the NCAA. The Irish have also appeared in eight of the last 11 NCAA Tournaments (due to the COVID-19 pandemic, the 2020 NCAA tournament did not take place and all appearance streaks remained intact).
4	Notre Dame forward Justin Janicke is the fourth-youngest player in NCAA Div. I men's hockey this season, with only Northeastern's Jack Hughes, Denver's Jack Devine and Michigan's Luke Hughes younger than the Irish freshman.
3.62	Through 15 games, the Fighting Irish are averaging 3.62 goals per game, which ranks ninth nationally and second among Big Ten teams.
2	Notre Dame's penalty kill is 54-for-59 on the season, which ranks second in the country at 91.53%.

NOTES

SETTING THE STAGE

- The Irish close out the first semester with a weekend home series against Michigan State at the Compton Family Ice Arena (Dec. 10-11).
- Notre Dame is coming off a weekend split with Ohio State, including a 5-1 game two win (Dec. 4), while the Spartans split a road series at Penn State including a 4-3 game two win (Dec. 4).
- Notre Dame is fourth in the Big Ten standings (5-3-0-2-0-0/13 points in 8 GP), while Michigan State is fifth (4-4-0-0-0-0/12 points in 8 GP).
- Ryder Rolston had a goal and an assist in each game versus the Buckeyes en route to being named the Big Ten's Second Star of the Week (Dec. 8).
- In the game two victory, Rolston netted his team-leading third game-winning goal of the season (his three game winners rank tied for sixth in the NCAA).
- The Irish have won seven of their last games dating back to the beginning of November.
- Max Ellis has an active career-long, nine-game point streak (8-5-13) and he has at least one point in 13 of Notre Dame's 15 games this season.
- Rolston has an active career-long, seven-game point streak (5-6-11).
- Nick Leivermann has an active career-long, six-game point streak (2-7-9).
- In addition, Graham Slaggert has a three-game point streak (1-2-3), while Landon Slaggert has a two-game point streak (1-1-2).
- In 15 games, Ellis leads the team with 11 goals and 20 points and is tied for second on the team lead with nine assists.
- Ellis' 11 goals rank tied for sixth in the NCAA, while his 20 points are tied for 17th (15th in points per game at 1.333) and he is tied for the NCAA lead with two shorthanded goals this season.
- Rolston ranks second on the team with six goals, followed by Trevor Janicke (5) and Graham Slaggert (5).
- Rolston leads the Irish with 10 assists, followed by Ellis (9) Adam Karashik (9) and Nick Leivermann (9).
- All told, 13 Notre Dame players have scored so far this season, while 18 have at least one point.
- The Irish are 8-1-0 when scoring first this season.
- Notre Dame's penalty kill is 54-for-59 on the season (.9153), which ranks second in the NCAA.
- The Irish are averaging 3.62 goals per game, which ranks ninth in the NCAA (second in the Big Ten) and are also holding opponents to 1.97 goals-against per game, which ranks sixth nationally (first in the Big Ten).
- Notre Dame has made each of the last five NCAA Tournaments, the longest streak in program history, and eight of the last 11 NCAA Tournaments overall.

ALEX STEEVES MAKES NHL DEBUT

- Former Irish forward Alex Steeves (2018-21) made his NHL debut for the Toronto Maple Leafs on Tuesday, Dec. 7 against Columbus (and former Notre Dame teammate Andrew Peeke) in a 5-4 Toronto win.
- Peeke and Steeves played together during the 2018-19 season.
- Steeves, who earned Second Team All-Big Ten honors in 2020-21, had 12 points in 12 games with the Marlies this season – his first as a professional.
- Steeves became the 25th former Irish player under head coach Jeff Jackson to reach the NHL and the Notre Dame program's 39th NHL player overall.
- The most recent Notre Dame players to make their NHL debuts were Jordan Gross, Peeke, Jake Evans and Thomas DiPauli during the 2019-20 season.

SENIORS WITH CLASS

- Forward Graham Slaggert and defenseman Spencer Stastney have been named two of the 20 candidates for the 2021-22 Senior CLASS Award®.
- The Senior CLASS Award focuses on the total student-athlete, who must have notable achievements in four areas of excellence: community, classroom, character and competition. The Notre Dame hockey program consistently produces finalists for the national award, including past winners David Brown (2007) and Jake Evans (2018).
- The 20 candidates will be narrowed to ten finalists later in the season. Those ten names will then be placed on the official ballot. Ballots will be distributed through a nationwide voting system to media, coaches and fans, who will select one candidate who best exemplifies excellence in the four Cs of community, classroom, character, and competition.
- The Senior CLASS Award winner will be announced during the 2022 NCAA Men's Frozen Four® in April.

THE BIG TEN STANDINGS

- This season, teams are awarded three points in the conference standings for a win in regulation.
- If the game is tied following regulation, both teams will receive one point, with a second point being awarded to the team that wins in either the 3-on-3 overtime period or the shootout.
- The conference standings now match a national standard: W-L-T-OTW-OTL-SOW.

SLAGGERT ON USA'S PRELIM ROSTER

- Sophomore forward Landon Slaggert has been named to the 2022 U.S. National Junior Team Preliminary Roster (Team USA's training camp at USA Hockey Arena in Plymouth, Michigan will start on December 12).
- The 2022 International Ice Hockey Federation World Junior Championship will take place in Edmonton and Red Deer, Alberta from Dec. 26, 2021- January 5, 2022.
- Slaggert will be looking to make Team USA for the second consecutive season as he was part of last season's gold medal winning Team USA.
- At last season's World Junior Tournament, Slaggert skated in all seven games for Team USA and became the first Fighting Irish player to medal at the event since 2018 – when current Columbus Blue Jackets defenseman Andrew Peeke helped the U.S. secure the bronze in Buffalo.
- Slaggert's gold marked the eighth medal by a Notre Dame player at the event as he also joined Anders Bjork (bronze in 2016), Mario Lucia (gold in 2013), Kyle Palmieri (gold in 2010 and bronze in 2011), Kyle Lawson (bronze in 2007) and Ben Simon (silver in 1997).
- Slaggert was the 23rd Notre Dame player to take part in the World Junior Championship and the South Bend, Indiana native will look to join Palmieri (2010/11), Ian Cole (2008/09), Rob Globke (2001/02), Connor Dunlop (2000/01), Simon (1997/98) and Jack Brownschidle (1977/79) as two-time Irish participants.

THE NOTRE DAME - MSU SERIES

- Former CCHA rivals, the Irish and Spartans have met 131 times dating back to their first meeting in 1926, which was played at the University Rink in East Lansing, Michigan (Notre Dame won the first game, 3-1).
- All-time, the Spartans lead the series 69-47-15.
- The first meetings as a Notre Dame varsity sport were in the 1970-71 season when the Spartans came to South Bend and split a weekend series: Michigan State took the first game 10-5, before the Irish bounced back for a 4-3 victory the second night.
- Since the turn of the century (2000-01 season), the Irish hold the advantage as Notre Dame is 24-21-10 against Michigan State since 2000.
- Of those 55 games, 12 have gone to overtime and 17 have been decided by a single goal.
- Since joining the Big Ten, Notre Dame is 10-4-4 against Michigan State.
- The teams most recently met on Feb. 26-27, 2021 at Michigan State with the Irish posting back-to-back 2-0 shutout victories to sweep that road series.
- In game one, Landon Slaggert and Alex Steeves score, while Dylan St. Cyr made 27 saves.
- Then in game two, Landon Slaggert scored again as well as Colin Theisen, and St. Cyr stopped all 29 shots he faced.
- Irish head coach Jeff Jackson is 33-19-12 all-time against his alma mater Michigan State (including his time at Lake Superior State).
- Jackson graduated from Michigan State in 1978 with a degree in communications, followed by an education degree in 1979.
- Jackson coached current Michigan State head coach Danton Cole and current Spartan assistant Chris Luongo during their junior hockey days with the Detroit Falcons and then Jackson also coached Cole during the 1983-84 season with the Fraser Flags of the Great Lakes Junior Hockey League (GLJHL).
- The current Notre Dame roster features Michigan natives: Max Ellis (Canton, Michigan) and Ryder Rolston (Birmingham, Michigan).
- Notre Dame's career offensive leaders against the Spartans include Graham Slaggert (14 GP, 3-5-8), Spencer Stastney (14 GP, 0-4-4) and Nick Leivermann (13 GP, 1-3-4).
- In net, Ryan Bischel is 0-1-1 with a 2.37 goals against average and a .896 save percentage against the Spartans.

GALAJDA SHUTOUT RANKS

- Graduate student Matthew Galajda made 22 saves to help lead the Irish to a 3-0 win over Wisconsin on Oct. 13, marking his second shutout for Notre Dame and the 21st of his career.
- A 2018 First Team All-American, his 21 career shutouts rank tied for third in NCAA Men's Division I history:

STEPPING UP

- Several Fighting Irish skaters have increased their point totals already this season over the past few years.
- After a freshman season with one goal in eight games and a sophomore season with 16 points in 24 games (5-11-16), Max Ellis has 11 goals and nine assists for a career-best 20 points in 15 games.
- Ellis posted the first hat trick of his career, capped by scoring the overtime game-winning goal, at Michigan on Nov. 20 marking the first visiting player to record a hat trick at Yost Ice Arena in 15 years (2006).
- Solag Bakich has a career-high 11 points (3-8-11) in 13 games this season after scoring once in 10 games as a freshman and then notching seven points (4-3-7) in 28 games as a sophomore.
- Ryder Rolston had six points on a goal and five assists last season as a freshman and now has six goals and 10 assists for 16 points in 15 games as a sophomore.
- Defenseman Jake Boltmann joined the Irish for the second semester last season, skating in 19 games (0 points).
- This season, Boltmann has a goal and seven assists for eight points.

2021-22 QUICK HITS

- The 2021-22 season marks Notre Dame's 17th under head coach Jeff Jackson and its fifth season in the Big Ten.
- Overall, it is the 53rd season of NCAA Division I hockey for Notre Dame.
- Notre Dame returned four of its top-five point scorers from 2020-21, including Graham Slaggert (7-18-25), Landon Slaggert (8-14-22), Nick Leivermann (5-12-17) and Max Ellis (5-11-16).
- Key losses from 2020-21 included the graduation of Dylan St. Cyr, Pierce Crawford, Matt Hellickson and Colin Theisen; Nate Clurman and Alex Steeves signing professional contracts and Michael Graham being forced to medically retire (he has since joined the Irish coaching staff as an undergraduate assistant coach).
- The Irish welcomed four graduate transfers into the fold for the 2021-22 campaign, including forward Jack Adams, defenseman Chase Blackmun, goaltender Matthew Galajda, and defenseman Adam Karashik.
- Five freshmen also joined the Irish this season in forward Tyler Carpenter, defenseman Ryan Helliwell, forward Justin Janicke, forward Hunter Strand and defenseman Hunter Weiss.
- Goaltender Josh Graziano also transferred into the program as a sophomore, having last played collegiately at Union.

FAMILY TIES

- The 2021-22 Notre Dame roster features quite a few family connections to the program and hockey world.
- Two sets of brothers are currently on the roster, including Justin and Trevor Janicke and Graham and Landon Slaggert.
- Cam Burke played his first two seasons in an Irish uniform alongside his older brother, Cal Burke, who signed with the Colorado organization for the second consecutive season for 2021-22.
- Freshman forward Brady Bjork is the younger brother of former Irish All-American and current Buffalo Sabre Anders Bjork.
- The Janickes represent the 16th set of brothers to play for Notre Dame.
- The Slaggerts also are part of the fifth set of father-son combinations to suit up for

the Irish, joining their father and associate head coach Andy Slaggert.

- Justin and Trevor Janicke are the sons of Curtis Janicke, who played for the Irish from 1989-93, appearing in 125 games while scoring 46 goals and adding 98 assists for 144 points.
- Justin, Trevor and Curtis represent the sixth father-son duo to play for the Irish.
- Senior forward Jake Pivonka is the son of Czech Republic native and former NHL player Michael Pivonka, who played over 800 games with the Washington Capitals (1986-99).
- Junior forward Solag Bakich is the son of Huntley Bakich, who was a linebacker for the Fighting Irish football team during the Lou Holtz era.
- Sophomore forward Ryder Rolston is the son of former NHLer and Stanley Cup Champion Brian Rolston.

100% GRADUATION SUCCESS RATE

- The University of Notre Dame claimed the 2020 national championship for graduating student-athletes in all sports—in the process posting the top NCAA Graduation Success Rate (GSR) figure (98) for the 14th-straight year (released on Nov. 17, 2020 by the NCAA).

CAPTAINS NAMED

- Graduate student Adam Karashik and seniors Jake Pivonka and Graham Slaggert will serve as team captains for the Irish this season.
- Additionally, seniors Nick Leivermann and Spencer Stastney will be alternate captains.
- Leivermann, Pivonka, Slaggert and Stastney will wear letters for the first time in their Notre Dame careers while Karashik served as UConn's captain in 2020-21 before joining the Irish.

PRESEASON B1G: SLAGGERT & STASTNEY

- Senior forward Graham Slaggert was named a Preseason Second Team All-Big Ten selection and senior defenseman Spencer Stastney earned Honorable Mention honors (Sept. 24)
- Notre Dame was also tabbed fourth in the Big Ten Preseason Coaches Poll.
- Slaggert, a South Bend, Indiana native, played 27 games last season and was the team's second-leading scorer with 25 points on seven goals and a team-best 18 assists.
- Slaggert's 25 points as a junior marked a season-best total and he enters his senior season with 15 goals and 29 assists for 44 points in 104 games played.
- Stastney skated in all 29 games for the Irish last season, scoring a career-high five goals and adding seven assists for 12 points.
- A fifth round selection (131st overall) by the Nashville Predators in the 2018 NHL Entry Draft, Stastney's five goals were tied with teammate Nick Leivermann and Michigan's Nick Blankenburg for the most by a Big Ten defenseman a season ago.
- Stastney has now played in 104 career games while scoring nine goals and adding 27 assists for 36 points. He was an Academic All-Big Ten selection each of the past two seasons and earned Second Team All-Big Ten honors last season.
- The Fighting Irish hockey program posted a perfect 100 GSR in the latest rankings, tying for first among NCAA DI men's hockey teams.
- Notre Dame hockey also posted a 95% Federal Graduation Rate (t-5th).
- Former players Cal Petersen, Andrew Oglevie and Dennis Gilbert, who all left following their respective junior seasons, were working towards completing their degrees this past semester.

JANICKE SELECTED IN 2021 NHL DRAFT

- Freshman forward Justin Janicke was selected in the seventh round (195th overall) by the Seattle Kraken in the 2021 National Hockey League Draft.
- The Irish have seen at least one player selected in the National Hockey League Entry Draft every year since 2004, and in 22 of the last 23 years.

**HEAD COACH
JEFF JACKSON**



- The 2021-22 season marks University of Notre Dame hockey coach Jeff Jackson's 17th season behind the Irish bench. During his first 16 seasons, the program has enjoyed a great deal of success, including four trips to the Frozen Four and eight conference championships.
- Jackson has over 30 years of coaching experience and led Notre Dame to back-to-back Big Ten tournament championship seasons in 2018 and 2019 while also guiding the Irish to the 2018 national title game en route to being named the Spencer Penrose Award winner as the National Coach of the Year.
- Jackson was also named the Spencer Penrose award winner in 2007 and he is one of just 15 coaches to have earned the honor multiple times (dating back to 1951).
- Additionally, Jackson is one of only two coaches to have earned the honor multiple times in the last 17 seasons.
- Jackson's Notre Dame teams have made 11 trips to the NCAA Championship (2007-09, 2011, 2013-14, 2016-19 and 2021), advancing to the Frozen Four four times and playing in the 2008 and 2018 national title games.
- During his 16-year run, Notre Dame has become one of the nation's top teams while playing in the Central Collegiate Hockey Association, Hockey East and now Big Ten.
- Under Jackson, the Irish won the CCHA regular-season title twice (2006-07 and 2008-09) while earning three Mason Cup championships (2007, 2009 and the final one in 2013).
- Then, in the team's first season in the Big Ten (2017-18), Notre Dame captured both the regular season and conference championships and followed up by once again winning the conference tournament in year two (2018-19).
- Jackson's success on the ice also has had a major impact off the ice for the Irish. With the wins came a commitment from the University that led to the new home of Irish hockey — The Compton Family Ice Arena — one of the finest college hockey facilities in the nation. The venue opened for business on Oct. 21, 2011.
- Since Jackson's arrival, the Irish have had 43 players selected in the National Hockey League Entry Draft, including three first round selections. In that same span, 33 players from USA Hockey's National Team Developmental Program have matriculated to Notre Dame.

- During Jackson's tenure, the Irish have had eight players garner All-America honors — Bobby Nardella in 2019, Cale Morris in 2018, Anders Bjork in 2017, Robbie Russo in 2015, Anders Lee in 2013, Ian Cole and Erik Condra in 2009 and David Brown in 2007. In addition, 24 of Jackson's Notre Dame players have gone on to play in the NHL.
- Jackson entered the 2021-22 season with a 21-year collegiate record of 530-271-91 for a .645 winning percentage, the third-highest winning percentage among all active coaches with five years or more in Division I (entering 2021-22).
- Jackson's 530 career wins rank 11th all-time in Division I and second among active coaches (entering 2021-22).
