## NCAA HISTORY

Notre Dame has competed in 26 NCAA Championships. Their streak of 24 straight appearances came to an end in March of 2021. It was the fourth longest active streak in the country and fifth best all-time.

The Irish are 67-24 all-time in the NCAA Tournament, as their 67 wins rank fourth all-time.

Notre Dame joins Louisiana Tech and USC with two NCAA titles behind UConn (11), Tennessee (8), Baylor (3) and Stanford (3).

Notre Dame is one of three schools (Tennessee \& UConn) to reach seven NCAA Title games. Their nine Final Four appearances are the fifth-most of any school behind UConn (19), Tennessee (18), Stanford (14) and La Tech (10).

The Irish have reached 10 Elite Eights. In fact, Notre Dame and UConn are the only teams to reach the Elite Eight eight times over the last 11 tournaments. Yet, the Irish have been more successful than any other regular-ly-appearing school at that stage, as their .900 winning percentage $(9-1)$ is the best of any program to play in at least five Elite Eights.

She's also leading the ACC in assist-to-turnover ratio at 2.23. However, Miles is more than just stylish assists and great vision, she's a dynamic playmaker.

Miles is averaging double-digit points (12.4), reeling in 6.4 boards/game (2nd best on team behind Dodson) and collecting a team best 2.0 steals/game.

Miles is the only player in the country averaging at least 12 points / 6 rebounds / 7 assists / 2 steals. She simply does it all.

And by the way, she's piling up double-doubles, already earning 6 on the year, which ranks 4th in the ACC and 2nd among all Division I freshmen. And of those 6, one of them is a triple-double, as Miles became just the 2nd Irish freshman in program history to do so.

## MORE ON MILES' ASSIST NUMBERS

The top passer in the country is putting up assist numbers the program has rarely seen. Miles' 7.8 apg would finish 3rd all-time, with the top-three spots currently belonging to:

The most total assists in a season belong to Lindsay Allen at 282 (2016-17).

The highest assist average for a freshman at ND was 4.5 by Mary Gavin in 1984-85.

Miles boasts 5 double-digit assist performances on the year. All other players in the ACC have combined for one.

## 4X ACC FRESHMAN OF THE WEEK

Guard Sonia Citron has claimed ACC Freshman of the Week 4 times in the first 6 weeks of play, making her a contender for Freshman of the Year. Citron looks to challenge 2019 alumna Brianna Turner who set the program record with six ACC FOTW honors. Going back into the program's Big East days, both Jacqueline Batteast (01-02) and Alicia Ratay (99-00) were each six-time winners as well.

Also important to note - the ACC has ruled fellow freshman Olivia Miles ineligible to win ACC Freshman of the Week/Year due to enrolling early last winter and playing six games.

## ACC FRESHMAN OF THE YEAR RACE

When it comes to Freshman-Only ACC rankings -- Citron ranks 2nd in scoring, 1st in rebounding and 3rd in assists. No other freshman in the league ranks in the top-3 in all 3 categories. In fact, Citron has the highest PTS+REB+AST/Game of any ACC freshman.

## ERESHMEN DUO SENSATION

Therefore, Notre Dame doesn't just have one, but two super freshmen in Citron and Miles who will be the building blocks for years to come.

ESPN Women's Hoops in fact put both Miles and Citron on their midseason top-10 freshman list. Miles was ranked No. 2, while Citron checked in at No. 6. Notre Dame was the only program with two freshmen on the list.

In fact, Notre Dame is the only Power-Five school with two freshmen averaging double figures.
Furthermore, there's only one other school in Division I with 2 freshmen averaging at least 11 ppg - Pacific Anaya James and Elizabeth Elliot.

A 6-1 versatile guard, Citron does it all for Coach Ivey and just has a nose for the ball. She's averaging an impressive 11.1 points off the bench while ranking 3rd on the team in rebounds (6.0), 3rd in assists (2.2) and 2nd in steals (1.5).

Rare numbers off the bench --> there are only 2 players in the entire country (of any class) who are putting up those numbers off the bench: Citron and NCState's

Diamond Johnson.
In addition, there are only 3 freshmen in the entire country averaging at least 10 points, 5 rebounds and 2 assists and 1 steal, and two belong to ND. The other is Arkansas State's Lauryn Pendleton.

Then there's Olivia Miles, who has already been detailed above. Ultimately, Miles ranks in the top- 15 in the ACC in 5 different stat categories: Rebounds, Assists, Steals, A/TO Ratio and Defensive Rebounds. Best of any Irish player.

Both freshmen are extremely active on the glass. In fac ,Miles' 5.6 defensive boards/game leads the team and ranks 5th in the ACC.

## HALFTIME ADJUSTMENTS

Kudos to Coach Ivey and her staff and their ability to stress certain halftime adjustments. The third quarter has been Notre Dame's best all year, outscoring its opposition by over 100 points! The gap currently sits at 386-273.

## WHO'S HOT

Let's start with the reigning ACC and Naismith Trophy Player of the Week, Dara Mabrey. The New Jersey native averaged 23.0 ppg and converted nine treys in the wins over Wake Forest and No. 21 North Carolina. Over the last three games, she's 11-for-24 (.458) from beyond
the arc, scoring a total of 56 points in that stretch.
Miles --> double-digit points in 7 of the last 8 games, including 2 20-point performances. 68 assists to 25 turnovers in last 8 games as well aka a $2.72 \mathrm{~A} / \mathrm{T} 0$ ratio.

Maya Dodson is currently enjoying the best stretch of her collegiate career - 5 straight games in double figures, including two 20-point performances. She's averaging 17.4 points in said stretch on 40-of-74 shooting. Thus she's shooting 54.1 percent compared to her season average of 44.2 percent.

From a wider lens perspective, Citron has scored in double figures in 7 of the last 10 games. The freshman also recently notched a double-double against North Carolina.

## DARA HEAT CHECK

Since Dara's unfortunate 0-for-9 showing from three at DePaul before the Christmas holiday, she's been on an absolute tear from deep upon her return. Over the last 4 games, she's 12 -for- 25 , converting 48.0 percent. Mabrey achieved a season high 6 made treys in the win over No. 21 UNC. The game prior at Wake, she started the game 3-for-3, which included a buzzer beater from the WF logo.

## INTHENET

In the updated NET rankings, ND currently sits at No. 17, which ranks as the 3rd best in the ACC behind №. 1 NC State and No. 4 Louisville. Against the NET top-25, the lrish are 1-2. Against the top-50, they are 2-4. Zero losses then outside the top- 50 . In fact, 3 of their 4 losses are against teams currently ranked in the top- 25 .

## DOUBLE-DOUBLE DELIGHTS

The notes have previously mentioned how Olivia's 6 double-doubles rank 4th in the ACC, but now we'll go a little more in depth. Her 6 also rank 2nd among all Division I freshmen, behind DePaul's Aneesah Morrow (11).

At Valpo on Dec. 8, Miles notched a triple-double (11p/13r/13a) - 9th ever in program history - 7th different Irish player to do so-2nd ever Irish freshman, joining Marina Mabrey.

Against Pitt on Dec. 19, Miles became the 4th Irish player ever to record a $20+$ point, $10+$ assist double-double - the other 3 were Skylar Diggins-Smith, Marina Mabrey and Jackie Young. Miles had 21 points, 11 assists, 6 rebounds and a career high 6 steals.

## BACKINTHE RANKINGS WITH 1ST RANKED WIN

After Notre Dame's 64-62 win over a ranked Oregon State squad, the Irish moved in to the AP top- 25 for the first time since a 2020-21 preseason ranking. It also marked Coach Ivey's first ranked win at the helm.

The Irish climbed for 4 straight weeks in the poll, reaching as high as No. 17 before the loss to Duke. Currently, the Irish land at No. 19 and have been in the AP Poll for 7 straight weeks.

## WESTBELD TIES PURCELL RECORD

When Westbeld reeled in her career high 18 rebounds against Western Illinois, it tied the Purcell Pavilion single-game rebounding record. Said record has been achieved six times prior, most previously from Dever-
eaux Peters vs USF on 2/25/12. Peters just so happened to be courtside for the Western game.

For those wondering, the all-time record is 22 set by Jane Politiski vs Goshen on 2/13/78.

## ERESHMAN STARTING AT POINT GUARD

Olivia Miles became the first freshman to start at point guard for the season opener since Lindsay Allen in 2013.

Back in 2013, it was the first time a Fighting Irish rookie point guard started the season opener since Nov. 26, 1994, when Mollie Peirick cracked the lineup and played 38 minutes (two points, five rebounds, three assists) in a $65-60$ overtime loss at No. 25 Seton Hall.

## A NEW SAM

When it comes to the Mabrey family, that's a whole lot of buckets. Queens of three some might say. Marina graduated in 2019 as the program's all-time career made three-pointer leader, draining a total of 274. Michaela converted a career total of 228, while Dara now boasts 228.

With Dara's third trey vs Ohio on Nov. 9, it was career three-pointer No. 700 for the Mabrey sisters. They currently sit at 738 .

Points wise, the trio have combined for over 3,000 points, currently sitting at 3,241.

KK BRANSFORD BECOMES IRISH
Coach Ivey landed her star shooting guard in the 2021 early signing day period, signing Cincinnati, Ohio native KK Bransford.

She's a two-time Ohio state champion, and could have been a third as Covid stopped her 28-0 squad in 2020. Mount Notre Dame is also a three-time Greater Girls Catholic League champion during Bransford's tenure. Speaking of records, Bransford has led the Cougars to a combined 85-2 mark, and will be riding a 72 -game win streak heading into the 2021-22 season.

Last year, Bransford averaged an impressive 21.4 points, 6.4 rebounds, 5.1 assists and 3.0 steals, which led her to be named not only the MaxPreps Ohio Player of the year, but also the Ohio Gatorade Player of the Year as well. Therefore, for those counting, that would make back-to-back Ohio Gatorade Player of the Years for the Irish, with current sophomore Maddy Westbeld earning the honor in 2020.
"I chose Notre Dame because I believe in Coach Ivey's vision, and I want to be a part of it," explained Bransford. "The education and degree from Notre Dame speaks for itself. One of the most important things was the family atmosphere that I felt when I was with the girls. It was amazing."

On Jan. 12, 2022, Bransford landed on the Naismith Girls Basketball Player of the Year Midseason Watch List.

## ALUMNI SUCCESS - WNBA AND OLYMPICS

The irish dominated the WNBA and Olympic scene this past summer. Arike Ogunbowale was the WNBA All-Star game MVP after scoring 26 points, including 5-of-10 from three, beating the USA Olympic team.

Skylar Diggins-Smith and Brianna Turner reached the WNBA Finals. Next, Ogunbowale earned Second Team All-WNBA honors while Diggins-Smith and Jewell Loyd earned First Team distinction.

Speaking of Diggins-Smith and Loyd, the Irish duo earned the gold medal with Team USA in the 2020 Tokyo Olympics. And speaking of the Olympics, Jackie Young earned gold with the USA $3 \times 3$ team. The Irish now boast 5 Olympians and 4 gold medalist in program history.

## CITRON EARNS GOLD AS WELL

Freshman Sonia Citron got some international experience before preseason began, earning gold with the U19 Team USA squad at the 2021 FIBA World Cup. Citron averaged USA second bests of 14.3 ppg and 7.7 rpg overall in Hungary. As a result, she was named to the World Cup All-Star Five Team.

## IVEY BIO

One of the finest point guards ever to wear the Notre Dame uniform, Niele Ivey (first name pronounced knee-L) was announced as the fourth Karen \& Kevin Keyes Family Head Women's Basketball Coach on April 22, 2020, just mere minutes after Muffet McGraw stepped down from her post after a Hall of Fame career.

Ivey is the common link to all nine of the program's Final Four appearances, two as a player and seven as an assistant coach, logging a combined 18 years on Notre Dame's campus ( 13 as a coach and five as a player).
"I am so honored to be able to follow in the legacy that Coach McGraw built here at Notre Dame," Ivey stated. "My love and appreciation for Coach McGraw is beyond anything I can express. She's more than a mentor, more than a friend, she's one of the most influential people in my life. I am full of gratitude for Coach McGraw and what she has done for me. She was the first to give me an opportunity to play for Notre Dame and coach here as well. I will forever be grateful for her love and support. I would also like to thank Jack Swarbrick and Father Jenkins for having the faith to move this program forward with me. I can never thank you enough for this incredible opportunity."

In her first year at the helm, Ivey not only had to balance settling into her new role with a young roster but also navigating the waters of both a national pandemic and a country battling systemic racism. In a shortened season due to Covid-19, Ivey's squad went 10-10 (8-7), all while using their platform to make their voices heard. Also, on her first week on the job, Coach lvey received verbals from freshmen Sonia Citron and Olivia Miles, who made up a top-five nationally ranked recruiting class.
$\qquad$
As an assistant, the Irish went $386-55(.875)$ during Ivey's time patrolling the sidelines. Notre Dame's recent decade of dominance (2010-19) had Ivey's handprints all over it - no other program had produced more trips to the national title game (six), and the lrish posted the third-most wins in that span as well (339).

That decade also consisted of 14 conference championships (eight regular-season plus six tournament titles split between the BIG EAST and ACC), seven Final Fours and a 2018 national championship.
$\qquad$
Ivey expanded her basketball prowess when she stepped away from Notre Dame to accept an assistant coaching position with the Memphis Grizzlies for the 2019-20 season. Ivey proved to be a true trailblazer, becoming the ninth active female coach in the NBA.

Over that year, Ivey helped develop a young team, with a new coaching staff, into a playoff contender. Ivey worked with several different position groups with the Grizzlies, but primarily with standout guards Jarien Jackson and Ja Morant, as the latter won 2020 NBA Rookie of the Year honors.

## ——

Ivey originally joined the Fighting lrish women's basketball coaching staff in May 2007 (she added the title of recruiting coordinator in 2012 and was promoted to associate head coach in the summer of 2015). Ivey went on to spend 12 seasons under Coach McGraw before departing for the Memphis Grizzlies.

Over her last eight years in particular as an assistant, Notre Dame ranked in the top-12 in field goal percentage (led the country in 2013-14 season), scoring offense and assists. In fact, Notre Dame's offense over its back-to-back title game runs in 2018 and 2019 was one for the record books. The 2018 championship squad ranked in the top five in all the aforementioned categories. Meanwhile, the 2019 Irish took home the statistical championship for top-scoring offense in the country, averaging a program-record 88.6 points per game. In addition, they broke the program record for assists (804) while finishing second in shooting percentage ( 50.8 percent). The stat that is the icing on the cake to all of this - the 2019 starting five of Ogunbowale, Mabrey, Shepard, Turner and Young went down as the most prolific scoring fivesome in the history of NCAA Division I basketball (men's or women's), amassing an astonishing 10,230 combined career points.

In addition to her achievements in player development with such proteges as All-Americans Skylar Diggins, Jewell Loyd, Lindsay Allen and Arike Ogunbowale, Ivey emerged as a rising star on the recruiting trail, with a sharp eye for young up-and-coming talent. In fact, she helped Notre Dame attract top-12 incoming classes in nine of her last 10 years. In her last class, Coach Ivey nabbed No. 6 Samantha Brunelle and №. 18 Anaya Peoples. Fast forward to now and Coach Ivey nabbed a top-five recruiting class in year one.

What's more, Ivey displayed brilliant prowess when it came to scouting and in-game strategy. In her last

six years as an assistant, she was directly responsible for creating the game plans that led to victories over Duke (12 times), Tennessee (8times), Florida State (7 times), Connecticut ( 5 times), Maryland (three times), Louisville (8 times), Syracuse (7 times), UCLA (three times), Baylor (twice), Texas A\&M (3 times) and South Carolina, among many others.

In fact, Notre Dame is 5-3 all-time against UConn in the NCAA Tournament, which more than doubles the next best team's win total. Overall, over her last 12 years, the lrish have knocked off the Huskies nine times, while all other Division I teams combined for 10 wins.

All things considered, it was no surprise when Ivey was chosen as the inaugural recipient of the Women's Basketball Coaches Association (WBCA) Division I National Assistant Coach of the Year award in 2016.

Most notable players under Ivey's tutelage: Arike Ogunbowale, Jewell Loyd and Skylar Diggins-Smith. Ogunbowale was a two-time All-American, two-time Ann Meyers Drysdale Award finalist and the 2018 Final Four MVP after her famous lce Twice. Ogunbowale graduated as the program's all-time leading scorer. Ivey helped mold Loyd into one of the country's top players from 2012-15. Loyd finished with 1,909 points and a 17.0 career points-per-game average. Loyd's best performances came against Top 25 teams, in which she averaged 22.8 points, 6.5 rebounds and 3.2 assists per game, including a school record-tying 41 at DePaul. Then there's Skylar Diggins-Smith. Under Ivey's guidance, Diggins-Smith made a seamless transition from shooting guard to point guard during her final three seasons, emerging as one of the nation's elite players to become one of just three two-time recipients of the Lieberman Award and a two-time consensus first-team All-America and BIG EAST Player of the Year selection. Diggins-Smith graduated in 2013 as the holder (or co-holder) of no fewer than 32 game, season or career records at Notre Dame, and ranks among the top five on an astounding 105 of the program's game, season or career charts.
--
Ivey sat out most of her freshman season at Notre Dame (1996-97 Final Four campaign) after suffering a season-ending knee injury five games in. However, she was awarded a fifth year of eligibility in 2000-01 and made the most of it, earning third-team AP All-America honors, the first Fighting lrish point guard to be so recognized. She also was the recipient of the 2001 Frances Pomeroy Naismith Award (nation's top senior player standing 5 -foot-8 or under) and was a finalist for the 2001 Lieberman Award. In addition, Ivey made the 2001 NCAA Women's Final Four All-Tournament Team after averaging 16.5 points and 5.5 steals per game as the Fighting Irish defeated Connecticut and Purdue to win their first national title.

All told, Notre Dame went 109-22 (.832) during Ivey's last four seasons, reaching the NCAA Sweet 16 three times $(1998,2000,2001)$ and rolling up a (then) school-record 34 wins in 2000-01. The Fighting Irish also won a share of their first BIG EAST regular-season championship in 2000-01 and were ranked in the top 10 of either or both the Associated Press and WBCA/USA Today polls for all but two weeks during her final three campaigns. While at Notre Dame, Ivey was a three-time all-BIG EAST selection (1999-2001), collecting first-team honors in 2001, and was tapped as the BIG EAST Player of the Week five times. She also led the Fighting lrish in steals in each of her final four seasons (1997-98 to 2000-01) and was the team's assist leader in her last three years, setting school records with 95 steals in 1999-2000 (since topped by Diggins) and 247 assists in 2000-01, along with a school-standard 2.67 assist/turnover ratio the latter season.

Ivey went on to play five seasons in the WNBA, beginning with her selection by the Indiana Fever in the second round (17th overall pick) of the 2001 WNBA Draft. She spent four seasons with the Fever, helping them to the first playoff berth in franchise history in 2002. Ivey signed with the Detroit Shock as a restricted free agent in 2005, and subsequently was acquired by the Phoenix Mercury later that season.

A native of St. Louis, Ivey graduated from Notre Dame's College of Arts and Letters in 2000 with a bachelor's degree in history.

## 2021-22 UPDATE

- Started all 17 games. Averaging the most minutes with 32.3 - which ranks 5th in the ACC. The team's leader and biggest talker on the floor.
- Dara produced back-to-back season highs in the wins over Wake and No. 21 UNC, which resulted in her first ACC Player of the Week honor. She was also named the Naismith Trophy's National Player of the Week. Dara dropped 22 points at Wake, then 24 points over UNC, converting a season high 6 made three-pointers against the latter. She ultimately hit 9 three's on the week, including one from the WF logo.
- Made her 100th collegiate start in the win over No. 21 UNC on Jan. 16

- Averages double-digit points (12.4), leads the NATION in assists (7.8), leads the team in steals (2.0) and just so happens to reel in 6.4 boards/game as a point guard (2nd best on the team behind Dodson)


## - Miles is the only player in the country averaging at least $12 \mathrm{p} / 6 \mathrm{r} / 7 \mathrm{a} / 2 \mathrm{~s}$.

- ESPN ranked Olivia as the 2nd best freshman and Sonia as the 6th. Notre Dame was the only program with 2 players on its top-10 freshman midseason list.
- 68 assists to 25 turnovers in last 8 games as aka a $2.72 \mathrm{~A} / \mathrm{TO}$ ratio.
- ND is the only P5 school with two freshmen averaging double-digit points. Out of all Division-I schools it's just ND and Pacific University.
- Collected 6 double-doubles $->2$ via points/rebounds +3 via points/assists +1 triple-double. Her 6 rank 4th in the ACC behind Kitley (10), Cubaj (7) and Ustby (7). Her 6 rank 42nd in the country and 2nd among all Division I freshmen, behind DePaul's Aneesah Morrow (12).
- Became the 4th lrish player ever to record a $20+$ point, $10+$ assist double-double. The other 3 were Skylar Diggins-Smith, Marina Mabrey and Jackie Young. Miles had 21 points, 11 assists, 6 rebounds and a career high 6 steals vs Pitt on Dec. 19.
- Triple-double at Valpo on Dec. 8 (11p/13r/13a) - 9th ever in program history - 7 th different lrish player to do so. 2nd ever Irish freshman, joining Marina Mabrey.
- How her 6 double-doubles stack up at ND: Most by a guard in a season - Jackie Young (2018-19) - 12
- If the season ended today, her 7.8 assists/game would rank 3rd all-time in program history. If she were to finish 7.7 or higher it would mark the highest average since 1988. Top-three spots belong to Lindsay Allen (7.6) and Mary Gavin (7.9 \& 8.6). The most total assists in a seaosn belong to Allen at 282 (2016-17). The highest assist average for a freshman at ND was 4.5 by Mary Gavin in 1984-85.
-Miles boasts 5 double-digit assist performances on the year. All other players in the ACC have combined for 1.
- Ranks in the top-15 in the ACC in 5 different stat categories: Rebounds, Assists, Steals, A/TO Ratio and Defensive Rebounds. Best of any lrish player.
- Active on the glass, as her 5.6 defensive boards/game lead the team and ranks 5th in the ACC.
- Defensive threat: leads the team with her 2.0 steals/game, which also ranks 6th in the ACC. She's notched 3 or more steals in 5 of the last 7 games.
- Went off in Georgia game on Nov. 26 with a career high 24 points.
- First freshman to start season opener at point guard since Lindsay Allen in 2013. Before Allen, it was Mollie Peirick who cracked the lineup on Nov. 26, 1994.
