COUNTDOWN TO PUCK DROP

545	Head coach Jeff Jackson has 545 career wins, which ranks second among active NCAA Division I head coaches, spanning six seasons at Lake Superior State and 16+ seasons at Notre Dame. Jackson's win total ranks 11th all-time (John MacInnes ranks 10th with 555 career wins).
21	Graduate student Matthew Galajda has 21 career shutouts, which ranks tied for third in NCAA Div I men's hockey history.
16	Sixteen sets of brothers have now suited up for the Irish, including current players Cam Burke (brother Cal graduated in 2020), Graham and Landon Slaggert , Trevor and Justin Janicke and Brady Bjork (brother Anders played 2014-17).
13	With Alex Steeves making his NHL debut on Dec. 7, 13 former Fighting Irish players have played in the NHL this season: Anders Bjork (Buffalo Sabres), Ian Cole (Carolina Hurricanes), Jake Evans (Montreal Canadiens), Jordan Gross (Colorado Avalanche), Vinnie Hinostroza (Buffalo Sabres), Anders Lee (New York Islanders), Kyle Palmieri (New York Islanders), Andrew Peeke (Columbus), Cal Petersen (Los Angeles Kings), Bryan Rust (Pittsburgh Penguins), Riley Sheahan (Seattle Kraken), Alex Steeves (Toronto Maple Leafs) and TJ Tynan (Los Angeles Kings).
8	With the most recent being the 2019 Big Ten tournament title, Notre Dame has won eight conference championships in program history - each under Jeff Jackson (three regular-season).
5	Notre Dame has an active five-straight NCAA tournament appearances streak, including Frozen Four appearances in 2017 and 2018, which is the longest streak in program history and is the second-longest active streak in the NCAA. The Irish have also appeared in eight of the last 11 NCAA Tournaments (due to the COVID-19 pandemic, the 2020 NCAA tournament did not take place and all appearance streaks remained intact).
4	Notre Dame forward Justin Janicke is the fourth-youngest player in NCAA Div. I men's hockey this season, with only Northeastern's Jack Hughes, Denver's Jack Devine and Michigan's Luke Hughes younger than the Irish freshman.
2	Notre Dame's penalty kill is 75-for-81 on the season, which ranks second in the country at 92.59% (Quinnipiac is first at 92.86).
1.97	The Fighting Irish rank fifth in the country and first in the Big Ten with a 1.97 goals against average.

NOTES

SETTING THE STAGE

- Notre Dame continues with Big Ten road play, heading to #15/16 Ohio State for a weekend series versus the Buckeyes on Friday, Jan. 14 (7 p.m. ET) and Saturday, Jan. 15 (8 p.m. ET).
- The teams are separated by one point in the Big Ten standings, with the Fighting Irish fourth with 22 points (8-4-0-3-1-0), while Ohio State is tied for second with 23 points (7-4-1-0-0-1).
- Notre Dame is in the midst of playing seven games in the first 19 games of January, culminating in next Wednesday's makeup game against Boston College (Jan. 19).
- After taking five of six points at Penn State last weekend, including a 4-2 game one win (Jan. 7) and a 5-4 overtime comeback win in game two (Jan. 8), the Fighting Irish are 6-2-0 on the road this season.
- Max Ellis had two goals in the game one win versus the Nittany Lions and then scored the overtime winner in game two with 0.2 seconds remaining, with assists from Spencer Stastney and Jake Pivonka.
- Nick Leivermann had a career-high three points in that overtime win, scoring his sixth goal of the season and adding a pair of assists.
- Ellis leads the Irish with a career-best 24 points on a team-high 14 goals and 10 assists.
- Ellis' 14 goals rank tied for fifth in the country (tied for first in the Big Ten).
- Ellis is averaging 0.667 goals per game, which ranks ninth in the NCAA.
- Ellis is also tied for the NCAA lead with two shorthanded goals this season.
- Senior defenseman Nick Leivermann is tied for second on the team with 17 points (6-11-17).
- With the 17 points, Leivermann ranks tied for ninth in the NCAA in points by a defenseman.
- Cam Burke and Ryder Rolston lead the Irish with three game-winning goal apiece, which also ranks tied for seventh in the NCAA.
- All told, 15 Notre Dame players have scored so far this season, while 11 players have at least 10 points on the season.
- The Irish are 11-1-0 when scoring first this season.
- Notre Dame's penalty kill is 75-for-81 on the season (.9259), which ranks second in the NCAA.
- The Irish also have four shorthanded goals this season (Ellis 2, Cam Burke, Spencer Stastney), which ranks fifth-most in the country (first in the Big Ten).
- Notre Dame has made each of the last five NCAA Tournaments, the longest streak in program history, and eight of the last 11 NCAA Tournaments overall
- The five consecutive NCAA Tournament appearances is the second-longest active streak in the NCAA, trailing only Minnesota Duluth (6), with Minnesota State (3) and St. Cloud State (3) tied for third.

THE NOTRE DAME - OHIO STATE SERIES

- Notre Dame owns a 41-40-11 edge in the all-time series after splitting a series last semester at Compton Family Ice Arena (Dec. 3-4).
- Ohio State took game one of that series, 4-2, after building a 2-1 lead in the first period; Ryder Rolston and Max Ellis scored for the Notre Dame goals.
- In game two, Nick Leivermann had a goal and an assist to lead the Irish to a 5-1 win and the senior defenseman finished that two-game series with four points on a goal and three assists.
- Rolston, Landon Slaggert, Cam Burke and Jesse Lansdell also scored for Notre Dame in the game two win, while Ryan Bischel totaled 24 saves to earn the victory.
- Since joining the Big Ten, Notre Dame leads the series with the Buckeyes 10-6-1.
- In their last visit to Columbus, the Irish posted wins of 6-1 and 8-1 to sweep the road series against Ohio State last year (Feb. 5-6, 2021), led by Alex Steeves who had a goal and three assists in game one and added three more assists in game two for a seven point weekend and Big Ten Second Star of the Week honors.
- Nick Leivermann had three goals and an assist in that series, while Cam Burke posted a career-best three points on a goal and two assists in the game two victory and Spencer Stastney had a goal in each game.
- Earlier in the 2020-21 season, the teams split a series at the Compton Family Ice Arena (Dec. 12-13).
- Notre Dame went 2-1-1 against the Buckeyes during the 2019-20 season, including a home sweep of Ohio State on Nov. 8-9, 2019 inside Compton Family Ice Arena.
- In that home sweep over then #8 Ohio State, the Irish took game one in overtime, 3-2, before earning a 2-1 victory in game two.
- Pierce Crawford provided the OT game winner in game one while then-freshman Solag Bakich scored his first career goal in that contest.
- In their inaugural season in the Big Ten (2017-18), the Irish and Buckeyes met five times, with Notre Dame skating away with a 4-1-0 record including a 3-2 overtime victory in the 2018 Big Ten Championship game courtesy of a Cam Morrison game winner.
- Notre Dame's first Big Ten conference games included a weekend sweep of the Buckeyes in Columbus by scores of 4-1 and 3-2 on Nov. 3-4.
- Notre Dame Associate Head Coach Paul Pooley is a 1984 graduate of Ohio State where he earned All-American honors and graduated as the program's all-time leader in goals (114), assists (156) and points (270).
- Pooley, who wore No. 22, became the first Ohio State hockey player to have his number retired on November 4, 2006 during a game between Notre Dame and Ohio State.
- Pooley's nephew, Austin Pooley, played for the Buckeyes from 2017-21.
- Current Ohio State graduate student/forward Eric Cooley is the nephew of former Notre Dame forward Tom Mooney (1984-88).
- Notre Dame's career offensive leaders against Ohio State include Graham Slaggert (14 GP; 3-9-12), Nick Leivermann (9 GP; 4-6-10), Jesse Lansdell (10 GP; 2-5-7), Spencer Stastney (14 GP; 2-4-6), Landon Slaggert (4 GP; 2-4-6) and Cam Burke (13 GP; 3-2-5).

GOALTENDING TANDEM

- Fighting Irish goaltenders Ryan Bischel and Matthew Galajda are one of the top tandems in college hockey, with two of the nation's top-10 save percentages.
- Galajda, who is 9-3-0, ranks 10th in the NCAA with a .926 mark, while Bischel, who is 6-3-0, ranks seventh with a .932 save percentage.
- In goals against average, the duo also ranks seventh and eighth in the NCAA, with Bischel at 1.85 and Galajda at 1.92.
- Galajda (2) and Bischel (1) have also combined for three shutouts.

STEPPING UP

- Several Fighting Irish skaters have increased their point totals this season over the past few years.
- After a freshman season with one goal in eight games and a sophomore season with

16 points in 24 games (5-11-16), Max Ellis has 14 goals and 10 assists for a career-best 24 points in 21 games.

- Ellis posted the first hat trick of his career, capped by scoring the overtime game-winning goal, at Michigan on Nov. 20 marking the first visiting player to record a hat trick at Yost Ice Arena in 15 years (2006).
- In 21 games this season, Cam Burke has seven goals and seven assists for 14 points, all of which represent career-high totals for the senior.
- Solag Bakich has a career-high 13 points (4-9-13) in 17 games this season after scoring once in 10 games as a freshman and then notching seven points (4-3-7) in 28 games as a sophomore.
- Ryder Rolston had six points on a goal and five assists last season as a freshman and now has six goals and 11 assists for 17 points in 20 games as a sophomore.
- Defenseman Jake Boltmann joined the Irish for the second semester last season, skating in 19 games (0 points).
- This season, Boltmann has a goal and eight assists for nine points in 21 games.

HOBEY HOPEFULS

- Forward Max Ellis and goaltender Matthew Galajda have been named to the Hobey Baker Award's Phase One Fan Ballot (Jan. 12).
- Given annually to college hockey's top player, the Hobey Baker Award includes candidates exhibiting the exceptional character traits of the award's namesake, Hobey Baker, with consideration given to scholastic achievement and sportsmanship.
- To vote, visit the website www.hobeybaker.com/vote.
- Phase two of fan balloting will come from the list of Top Ten Hobey Baker finalists beginning March 17 and closing March 27. The fans' vote accounts for a full one percent of the total ballot in each phase in selecting this year's award recipient.
- The 2022 Hobey Baker Award winner will be announced from a field of three Hobey Hat Trick finalists on Friday, April 8, 2022 during the NCAA Frozen Four Championship in Boston.

THE BIG TEN STANDINGS

- This season, teams are awarded three points in the conference standings for a win in regulation.
- If the game is tied following regulation, both teams will receive one point, with a second point being awarded to the team that wins in either the 3-on-3 overtime period or the shootout.
- The conference standings now match a national standard: W-L-T-OTW-OTL-SOW

SLAGGERT: TEAM USA X2

- Sophomore forward Landon Slaggert was named to the U.S. National Junior Team, USA Hockey announced on Dec. 16.
- The South Bend, Indiana native was named an alternate captain for Team USA and scored the game winner in Team USA's tournament-opening 3-2 win over Slovakia (Dec. 26).
- The International Ice Hockey Federation then canceled the 2022 World Junior Championship in Edmonton and Red Deer, Alberta due to COVID-19 protocols.
- Slaggert was one of six players from the 2021 U.S. National Junior Team that won a gold medal in Edmonton.
- Slaggert became the seventh Notre Dame player to take part in two World Junior Championships.
- At last season's World Junior Tournament, Slaggert skated in all seven games for Team USA and became the first Fighting Irish player to medal at the event since 2018 – when current Columbus Blue Jackets defenseman Andrew Peeke helped the U.S. secure the bronze in Buffalo.
- Slaggert's gold marked the eighth medal by a Notre Dame player at the event as he also joined Anders Bjork (bronze in 2016), Mario Lucia (gold in 2013), Kyle Palmieri (gold in 2010 and bronze in 2011), Kyle Lawson (bronze in 2007) and Ben Simon (silver in 1997).
- Slaggert was the 23rd Notre Dame player to take part in the World Junior Championship and joined Palmieri (2010/11), Ian Cole (2008/09), Rob Globke (2001/02), Connor Dunlop (2000/01), Simon (1997/98) and Jack Brownschidle (1977/79) as two-time Irish participants.

ALEX STEEVES MAKES NHL DEBUT

- Former Irish forward Alex Steeves (2018-21) made his NHL debut for the Toronto Maple Leafs on Dec. 7 against Columbus (and former Notre Dame teammate Andrew Peeke) in a 5-4 Toronto win.
- Steeves, who earned Second Team All-Big Ten honors in 2020-21, became the 25th former Irish player under head coach Jeff Jackson to reach the NHL and the Notre Dame program's 39th NHL player overall.
- Prior to Steeves, the most recent Notre Dame players to make their NHL debuts were Jordan Gross, Peeke, Jake Evans and Thomas DiPauli during the 2019-20 season.

BURKE & MORRIS INK NHL DEALS

- Former Fighting Irish All-American goaltender Cale Morris (Chicago) and former captain Cal Burke (Colorado) recently inked NHL deals and were recalled to their teams' respective taxi squads.
- Morris, who played from 2016-20 and led the Irish to the 2018 NCAA Championship game, signed a one-year entry-level deal on Dec. 31.
- Burke, who also played from 2016-20 with the Irish, signed a one-year contract with Colorado on Dec. 16 and later was recalled to the taxi squad.

SENIORS WITH CLASS

- Forward Graham Slaggert and defenseman Spencer Stastney have been named two of the 20 candidates for the 2021-22 Senior CLASS Award®.
- The Senior CLASS Award focuses on the total student-athlete, who must have notable achievements in four areas of excellence: community, classroom, character and competition. The Notre Dame hockey program consistently produces finalists for the national award, including past winners David Brown (2007) and Jake Evans (2018).
- The 20 candidates will be narrowed to ten finalists later in the season. Those ten names will then be placed on the official ballot. Ballots will be distributed through a nationwide voting system to media, coaches and fans, who will select one

candidate who best exemplifies excellence in the four Cs of community, classroom, character, and competition.

- The Senior CLASS Award winner will be announced during the 2022 NCAA Men's Frozen Four® in April.

GALAJDA SHUTOUT RANKS

- Graduate student Matthew Galajda made 22 saves to help lead the Irish to a 3-0 win over Wisconsin on Oct. 13, marking his second shutout for Notre Dame and the 21st of his career.

- The 2021-22 Notre Dame roster features quite a few family connections to the program and hockey world.
- Two sets of brothers are currently on the roster, including Justin and Trevor Janicke and Graham and Landon Slaggert.
- Cam Burke played his first two seasons in an Irish uniform alongside his older brother, Cal Burke, who signed with the Colorado organization for the second consecutive season for 2021-22.
- Freshman forward Brady Bjork is the younger brother of former Irish All-American and current Buffalo Sabre Anders Bjork.
- The Janickes represent the 16th set of brothers to play for Notre Dame.
- The Slaggerts also are part of the fifth set of father-son combinations to suit up for the Irish, joining their father and associate head coach Andy Slaggert.
- Justin and Trevor Janicke are the sons of Curtis Janicke, who played for the Irish from 1989-93, appearing in 125 games while scoring 46 goals and adding 98 assists for 144 points.
- Justin, Trevor and Curtis represent the sixth father-son duo to play for the Irish.
- Senior forward Jake Pivonka is the son of Czech Republic native and former NHL player Michael Pivonka, who played over 800 games with the Washington Capitals (1986-99).
- Junior forward Solag Bakich is the son of Huntley Bakich, who was a linebacker for the Fighting Irish football team during the Lou Holtz era.
- Sophomore forward Ryder Rolston is the son of former NHLer and Stanley Cup Champion Brian Rolston.

2021-22 QUICK HITS

- The 2021-22 season marks Notre Dame's 17th under head coach Jeff Jackson and its fifth season in the Big Ten.
- Overall, it is the 53rd season of NCAA Division I hockey for Notre Dame.
- Notre Dame returned four of its top-five point scorers from 2020-21, including Graham Slaggert (7-18-25), Landon Slaggert (8-14-22), Nick Leivermann (5-12-17) and Max Ellis (5-11-16).
- Key losses from 2020-21 included the graduation of Dylan St. Cyr, Pierce Crawford, Matt Hellickson and Colin Theisen; Nate Clurman and Alex Steeves signing professional contracts and Michael Graham being forced to medically retire (he has since joined the Irish coaching staff as an undergraduate assistant coach).

- The Irish welcomed four graduate transfers into the fold for the 2021-22 campaign, including forward Jack Adams, defenseman Chase Blackmun, goaltender Matthew Galajda, and defenseman Adam Karashik while goaltender Josh Graziano transferred into the program as a sophomore, having last played collegiately at Union.
- Five freshmen also joined the Irish this season in forward Tyler Carpenter, defenseman Ryan Helliwell, forward Justin Janicke, forward Hunter Strand and defenseman Hunter Weiss.

100% GRADUATION SUCCESS RATE

- The University of Notre Dame claimed the 2020 national championship for graduating student-athletes in all sports—in the process posting the top NCAA Graduation Success Rate (GSR) figure (98) for the 14th-straight year (released on Nov. 17, 2020 by the NCAA).

CAPTAINS NAMED

- Graduate student Adam Karashik and seniors Jake Pivonka and Graham Slaggert will serve as team captains for the Irish this season.
- Additionally, seniors Nick Leivermann and Spencer Stastney will be alternate captains.
- Leivermann, Pivonka, Slaggert and Stastney will wear letters for the first time in their Notre Dame careers while Karashik served as UConn's captain in 2020-21 before joining the Irish.

JANICKE SELECTED IN 2021 NHL DRAFT

- Freshman forward Justin Janicke was selected in the seventh round (195th overall) by the Seattle Kraken in the 2021 National Hockey League Draft.
- The Irish have seen at least one player selected in the National Hockey League Entry Draft every year since 2004, and in 22 of the last 23 years.

JEFF JACKSON



- The 2021-22 season marks University of Notre Dame hockey coach Jeff Jackson's 17th season behind the Irish bench. During his first 16 seasons, the program has enjoyed a great deal of success, including four trips to the Frozen Four and eight conference championships.
- Jackson has over 30 years of coaching experience and led Notre Dame to back-to-back Big Ten tournament championship seasons in 2018 and 2019 while also guiding the Irish to the 2018 national title game en route to being named the Spencer Penrose Award winner as the National Coach of the Year.
- Jackson was also named the Spencer Penrose award winner in 2007 and he is one of just 15 coaches to have earned the honor multiple times (dating back to 1951).
- Additionally, Jackson is one of only two coaches to have earned the honor multiple times in the last 17 seasons.
- Jackson's Notre Dame teams have made 11 trips to the NCAA Championship (2007-09, 2011, 2013-14, 2016-19 and 2021), advancing to the Frozen Four four times and playing in the 2008 and 2018 national title games.
- During his 16-year run, Notre Dame has become one of the nation's top teams while playing in the Central Collegiate Hockey Association, Hockey East and now Big Ten.
- Under Jackson, the Irish won the CCHA regular-season title twice (2006-07 and 2008-09) while earning three Mason Cup championships (2007, 2009 and the final one in 2013).
- Then, in the team's first season in the Big Ten (2017-18), Notre Dame captured both the regular season and conference championships and followed up by once again winning the conference tournament in year two (2018-19).
- Jackson's success on the ice also has had a major impact off the ice for the Irish. With the wins came a commitment from the University that led to the new home of Irish hockey — The Compton Family Ice Arena — one of the finest college hockey facilities in the nation. The venue opened for business on Oct. 21, 2011.
- Since Jackson's arrival, the Irish have had 43 players selected in the National Hockey League Entry Draft, including three first round selections.
- In that same span, 33 players from USA Hockey's National Team

- During Jackson's tenure, the Irish have had eight players garner All-America honors — Bobby Nardella in 2019, Cale Morris in 2018, Anders Bjork in 2017, Robbie Russo in 2015, Anders Lee in 2013, Ian Cole and Erik Condra in 2009 and David Brown in 2007.
- In addition, 25 of Jackson's Notre Dame players have gone on to play in the NHL.
- Jackson entered the 2021-22 season with a 21-year collegiate record of 530-271-91 for a .645 winning percentage, the third-highest winning percentage among all active coaches with five years or more in Division I (entering 2021-22).
- Entering the 2021-22 season, Jackson's 530 career wins rank 11th all-time in Division I and second among active coaches (entering 2021-22).
