

Can parents stay and watch the training session, lectures and games?

YES. All spectators must have a mask on at all times, remain socially distant from others and remain in designated spectator areas.

Will campers be required to play in a mask?

NO. Campers will be required to wear a mask, but are allowed to take the mask off once they engage in the workout. Campers will be required to wear a mask during all lectures.

Will there be an athletic trainer present?

YES. We will have an athletic trainer onsite. Please note, our athletic training staff is not allowed to give out any pain medication (Advil, Ibuprofen, Tylenol).

Will water be provided at the fields?

YES. Extra water will be available at the fields, but all campers are encouraged to come with their own full water bottle.

Will there be a camp ball we can purchase?

NO. Each camper will be required to bring their own ball and we will NOT have any to purchase on site.

Is any food provided?

NO.

Can we bring lunch and eat it in the indoor facility between sessions?

NO. No food or drink (besides water) are allowed in the indoor facility at any time.

Do we have to go on the Campus Tour?

The campus tour is scheduled at the end of camp to ensure rest between sessions. We understand some travel arrangements may require some campers to miss the tour.

Will there be a refund if camper is sick or tests positive for Covid prior to camp and can't attend?

YES. If a camper must cancel due to Covid prior to camp starting, a full refund will be issued.
