COUNTDOWN TO PUCK DROP

550	Head coach Jeff Jackson has 550 career wins, which ranks second among active NCAA Division I head coaches, spanning six seasons at Lake Superior State and 16+ seasons at Notre Dame. Jackson's win total ranks 11th all-time (John MacInnes ranks 10th with 555 career wins).
61	Graduate student Adam Karashik has 61 shot blocks this season, which ranks tied for fifth in the country and first in the Big Ten.
21	Graduate student Matthew Galajda has 21 career shutouts, which ranks tied for third in NCAA Div I men's hockey history.
16	Sixteen sets of brothers have now suited up for the Irish, including current players Cam Burke (brother Cal graduated in 2020), Graham and Landon Slaggert , Trevor and Justin Janicke and Brady Bjork (brother Anders played 2014-17).
16	With a career-high 16 goals on the season, junior forward Max Ellis is tied for 11th nationally in goals (tied for third in the Big Ten).
14	Fourteen former Fighting Irish players have played in the NHL this season: Anders Bjork (Buffalo Sabres), Ian Cole (Carolina Hurricanes), Jake Evans (Montreal Canadiens), Steven Fogarty (Boston Bruins), Jordan Gross (Colorado Avalanche) Vinnie Hinostroza (Buffalo Sabres), Anders Lee (New York Islanders), Kyle Palmieri (New York Islanders), Andrew Peeke (Columbus), Cal Petersen (Los Angeles Kings), Bryan Rust (Pittsburgh Penguins), Riley Sheahan (Seattle Kraken), Alex Steeves (Toronto Maple Leafs) and TJ Tynan (Los Angeles Kings).
8	With the most recent being the 2019 Big Ten tournament title, Notre Dame has won eight conference championships in program history - each under Jeff Jackson (three regular-season).
5	Notre Dame has an active five-straight NCAA tournament appearances streak, including Frozen Four appearances in 2017 and 2018, which is the longest streak in program history and is the second-longest active streak in the NCAA. The Irish have also appeared in eight of the last 11 NCAA Tournaments (due to the COVID-19 pandemic, the 2020 NCAA tournament did not take place and all appearance streaks remained intact).
1	Notre Dame's penalty kill is 97-for-104 on the season, which ranks first in the country at 93.27%. Quinnipiac (91.78) and Northeastern (91.46) rank second and third.

NOTES

SETTING THE STAGE

- Notre Dame heads out on the road for a Saturday-Sunday series (Feb. 12-13) at Wisconsin after the series was postponed from Feb. 10-11 due to COVID-19 protocols within the Wisconsin program.
- The Fighting Irish are 7-3-0 on the road this season.
- Notre Dame is coming off a series sweep of Penn State, taking game one 7-2 (Feb. 4) and then blanking the Nittany Lions 3-0 in game two (Feb. 5).
- Ryan Bischel stopped 67 of the 69 shots he faced in the series for a .971 save percentage en route to being named the Big Ten's First Star of the Week (Feb. 8).
- In game two, Bischel made 35 saves to earn his second shutout of the season and of his career.
- Notre Dame's 10 goals against Penn State were scored by 10 different players, including freshmen Tyler Carpenter and Justin Janicke scoring their first career goals and graduate students Adam Karashik and Chase Blackmun scoring their first goals with Notre Dame.
- The Fighting Irish head into the weekend fourth in the Big Ten standings with 32 points, while Wisconsin is tied for fifth with 17 points.
- On Nov. 12-13, Notre Dame swept Wisconsin at home, winning game one 5-1 and then posting a 3-0 win in game two.
- Max Ellis has a three-game point streak (2-1-3), while Adam Karashik (1-2-3), Hunter Strand (1-1-2), Ryder Rolston (0-3-3) and Jesse Lansdell (1-1-2) each have two-game point streaks.
- Ellis leads the Irish with a career-best 27 points on a team-high 16 goals and 11 assists.
- Ellis' 16 goals rank tied for 11th in the country (tied for third in the Big Ten).
- Since returning from break on Jan. 1, Spencer Stastney has three goals and nine assists for 12 points in 11 games and he has at least one point in nine of the 11 games.
- Trevor Janicke ranks second on the team with a career-high 11 goals and he has scored a goal in four of Notre Dame's last five games.
- The Irish are 14-1-0 when scoring first this season and 18-0-0 when scoring at least three goals.
- The Fighting Irish boast the nation's top penalty kill at 93.27% (97-for-104) on the season and also have scored six shorthanded goals this season (Ellis 2, Cam Burke 2, Spencer Stastney, Graham Slaggert), which ranks tied for second in the country (first in the Big Ten).
- Notre Dame is 6-2-0 in overtime this season, with the OT game-winning goals coming from Cam Burke (at Michigan Tech), Ryder Rolston (at Michigan), Max Ellis (at Michigan and at Penn State), Spencer Stastney (at Ohio State) and Landon Slaggert (vs. Minnesota).
- Notre Dame has made each of the last five NCAA Tournaments, the longest streak in

program history, and eight of the last 11 NCAA Tournaments overall.

- The five consecutive NCAA Tournament appearances is the second-longest active streak in the NCAA, trailing only Minnesota Duluth (6), with Minnesota State (3) and St Cloud State (3) tied for third.

THE NOTRE DAME - WISCONSIN SERIES

- Former opponents in the WCHA, Notre Dame and Wisconsin have met 82 times in program history with Wisconsin leading the all-time series 46-27-9.
- The first meeting between the two teams came during the 1921-22 season when the Irish skated away with a 3-0 victory at Badin Rink (outdoors at Notre Dame).
- The teams met once more, in 1925-26, before taking a 40 year hiatus and returning to competition when Notre Dame earned varsity status.
- As a head coach, Jeff Jackson is 10-8-2 all-time against the Badgers (1-1-0 at Lake Superior State).
- The one win Jackson had over the Badgers at Lake Superior State came on April 4, 1992, in Albany, New York, as the Lakers defeated Wisconsin 5-3 to win the NCAA Championship (the first of Jackson's two NCAA Championships at Lake State).
- Since the Irish joined the Big Ten, Notre Dame leads the series 9-7-2.
- With last season's series at Wisconsin taking place at LaBahn, Notre Dame is 4-1-0 at the Kohl Center since joining the Big Ten for the 2017-18 season.
- Earlier this season the teams met on Nov. 12-13 at the Compton Family Ice Arena with Notre Dame posting a series sweep, taking game one 5-1 and then following up with a 3-0 win in game two.
- Matthew Galajda played both games in that series, stopping 24 shots in game one and posting a 22-save shutout in game two.
- Max Ellis had a pair of goals in game one with Spencer Stastney chipping in three assists, while game two featured Irish goals by Grant Silianoff, Nick Leivermann and Hunter Strand.
- Last season, the teams opened the shortened 2020-21 season on Nov. 13-14 at the Compton Family Ice Arena, with the Badgers posting a 2-0 win and a 5-3 victory (Colin Theisen had a hat trick in that game two loss).
- Then at Wisconsin on Feb. 19-20 2021, the Badgers took game one 4-2 before the teams skated to a back-and-forth 5-5 tie in game two.
- In the game two shootout, Max Ellis scored and Dylan St. Cyr denied Cole Caufield, Dylan Holloway and Ty Pelton-Byce to seal the extra point.
- The teams split the 2019-20 series 2-2-0, including a split at the Kohl Center on Nov. 15-16.
- Wisconsin took game one, 3-0, and Notre Dame took a back-and-forth game two, 5-4 in overtime.
- Later in the season at home (Jan. 24-25), Notre Dame dropped game one, 6-4, before bouncing back to take game two, 5-2.
- With a career-high four points on a goal and three assists, Alex Steeves helped the Irish to that 5-2 win.
- Notre Dame's active career offensive leaders against the Badgers include Graham Slaggert (12 GP, 2-3-5), Spencer Stastney (14 GP, 0-8-8), Landon Slaggert (6 GP, 1-6-7), Trevor Janicke (10 GP, 3-1-4), Jesse Lansdell (10 GP, 2-2-4).

BALANCED ATTACK

- The Fighting Irish have seen several players step up and contribute to the offense throughout the 2021-22 season, with Notre Dame averaging 3.50 goals per game which ranks seventh in the country (third in the Big Ten).
- An impressive 14 players have double-digit point totals, including nine players with at least 16 points on the season.
- Nineteen Notre Dame players have scored this season, while 21 have at least one point.
- In Notre Dame's sweep of Penn State on Feb. 4-5, 10 Irish skaters accounted for the 10 Fighting Irish goals as Notre Dame took game one 7-2 and followed with a 3-0 win in

game two.

- With Notre Dame facing several injuries in that series against the Nittany Lions, freshmen forwards Justin Janicke and Tyler Carpenter each scored their first career goals, while graduate transfer defensemen Adam Karashik and Chase Blackmun each netted their first goals with Notre Dame.

STEPPING UP

- Several Fighting Irish skaters have increased their point totals this season over the past few years.
- After a freshman season with one goal in eight games and a sophomore season with 16 points in 24 games (5-11-16), Max Ellis has 16 goals and 11 assists for a career-best 27 points in 27 games.
- Ellis posted the first hat trick of his career, capped by scoring the overtime game-winning goal, at Michigan on Nov. 20 marking the first visiting player to record a hat trick at Yost Ice Arena in 15 years (2006).
- In 26 games this season, Cam Burke has eight goals and nine assists for 17 points, all of which represent career-high totals for the senior.
- Junior Trevor Janicke has a career-high 11 goals in 28 games this season, besting his previous career-high of eight goals scored as a freshman and junior.
- Janicke's 17 points are also a career-best total (he had 13 points in 37 games as a freshman and in 24 games as a sophomore).
- Solag Bakich has a career-high 14 points (4-10-14) in 23 games this season after scoring once in 10 games as a freshman and then notching seven points (4-3-7) in 28 games as a sophomore.
- Ryder Rolston had six points on a goal and five assists last season as a freshman and now has nine goals and 15 assists for 24 points in 27 games as a sophomore.
- Defenseman Jake Boltmann joined the Irish for the second semester last season, skating in 19 games (0 points).
- This season, Boltmann has a goal and 11 assists for 12 points in 28 games.

HOCKEY HUMANITARIAN NOMINEE

- The Hockey Humanitarian Award Foundation announced Fighting Irish senior captain Graham Slaggert has been named one of 11 nominees for the 2022 Hockey Humanitarian award (Jan. 25).

- Off the ice, Slaggert serves on Notre Dame's Student-Athlete Advisory Council. He is pursuing a management consulting degree, earned Big Ten All-Academic Team honors

- Forward Max Ellis and goaltender Matthew Galajda have been named to the Hobey Baker Award's Phase One Fan Ballot (Jan. 12).
- Given annually to college hockey's top player, the Hobey Baker Award includes candidates exhibiting the exceptional character traits of the award's namesake, Hobey Baker, with consideration given to scholastic achievement and sportsmanship.

- Phase two of fan balloting will come from the list of Top Ten Hobey Baker finalists beginning March 17 and closing March 27. The fans' vote accounts for a full one percent of the total ballot in each phase in selecting this year's award recipient.

SLAGGERT: TEAM USA X2

- Sophomore forward Landon Slaggert was named to the U.S. National Junior Team, USA Hockey announced on Dec. 16.
- The South Bend, Indiana native was named an alternate captain for Team USA and scored the game winner in Team USA's tournament-opening 3-2 win over Slovakia (Dec. 26).
- The International Ice Hockey Federation then canceled the 2022 World Junior Championship in Edmonton and Red Deer, Alberta due to COVID-19 protocols.
- Slaggert was one of six players from the 2021 U.S. National Junior Team that won a gold medal in Edmonton.
- Slaggert became the seventh Notre Dame player to take part in two World Junior Championships.
- At last season's World Junior Tournament, Slaggert skated in all seven games for Team USA and became the first Fighting Irish player to medal at the event since 2018 — when current Columbus Blue Jackets defenseman Andrew Peeke helped the U.S. secure the bronze in Buffalo.
- Slaggert's gold marked the eighth medal by a Notre Dame player at the event as he also joined Anders Bjork (bronze in 2016), Mario Lucia (gold in 2013), Kyle Palmieri (gold in 2010 and bronze in 2011), Kyle Lawson (bronze in 2007) and Ben Simon (silver in 1997).
- Slaggert was the 23rd Notre Dame player to take part in the World Junior Championship and joined Palmieri (2010/11), Ian Cole (2008/09), Rob Globke (2001/02), Connor Dunlop (2000/01), Simon (1997/98) and Jack Brownschidle (1977/79) as two-time Irish participants.

NHL NOTES

- Former Irish forward Alex Steeves (2018-21) made his NHL debut for the Toronto Maple Leafs on Dec. 7 against Columbus (and former Notre Dame teammate Andrew Peeke) in a 5-4 Toronto win.
- Steeves, who earned Second Team All-Big Ten honors in 2020-21, became the 25th former Irish player under head coach Jeff Jackson to reach the NHL and the Notre Dame program's 39th NHL player overall.
- Prior to Steeves, the most recent Notre Dame players to make their NHL debuts were Jordan Gross, Peeke, Jake Evans and Thomas DiPauli during the 2019-20 season.
- Former Fighting Irish All-American goaltender Cale Morris (Chicago) and former captain Cal Burke (Colorado) recently inked NHL deals and were recalled to their teams' respective taxi squads.
- Morris, who played from 2016-20 and led the Irish to the 2018 NCAA Championship game, signed a one-year entry-level deal on Dec. 31.
- Burke, who also played from 2016-20 with the Irish, signed a one-year contract with Colorado on Dec. 16 and later was recalled to the taxi squad.
- Former Irish captain Steven Fogarty made his Boston debut late in January to become the 14th former Fighting Irish player to appear in the NHL this season.
- The program's 14 alums in the NHL ranked seventh nationally, trailing only North Dakota (23), Minnesota (23), Boston University (19), Boston College (19), Michigan (19) and Wisconsin (16) [totals as of Feb. 1, 2022].

SENIORS WITH CLASS

- Forward Graham Slaggert and defenseman Spencer Stastney have been named two of the 20 candidates for the 2021-22 Senior CLASS Award®.
- The Senior CLASS Award focuses on the total student-athlete, who must have notable achievements in four areas of excellence: community, classroom, character and competition. The Notre Dame hockey program consistently produces finalists for the national award, including past winners David Brown (2007) and Jake Evans (2018).
- The 20 candidates will be narrowed to ten finalists later in the season. Those ten names will then be placed on the official ballot. Ballots will be distributed through a nationwide voting system to media, coaches and fans, who will select one candidate who best exemplifies excellence in the four Cs of community, classroom, character, and competition.
- The Senior CLASS Award winner will be announced during the 2022 NCAA Men's Frozen Four® in April.

- The 2021-22 Notre Dame roster features quite a few family connections to the program

and hockey world.

- Two sets of brothers are currently on the roster, including Justin and Trevor Janicke and Graham and Landon Slaggert.
- Cam Burke played his first two seasons in an Irish uniform alongside his older brother, Cal Burke, who signed with the Colorado organization for the second consecutive season for 2021-22.
- Freshman forward Brady Bjork is the younger brother of former Irish All-American and current Buffalo Sabre Anders Bjork.
- The Janickes represent the 16th set of brothers to play for Notre Dame.
- The Slaggerts also are part of the fifth set of father-son combinations to suit up for the Irish, joining their father and associate head coach Andy Slaggert.
- Justin and Trevor Janicke are the sons of Curtis Janicke, who played for the Irish from 1989-93, appearing in 125 games while scoring 46 goals and adding 98 assists for 144 points.
- Justin, Trevor and Curtis represent the sixth father-son duo to play for the Irish.
- Senior forward Jake Pivonka is the son of Czech Republic native and former NHL player Michael Pivonka, who played over 800 games with the Washington Capitals (1986-99).
- Junior forward Solag Bakich is the son of Huntley Bakich, who was a linebacker for the Fighting Irish football team during the Lou Holtz era.
- Sophomore forward Ryder Rolston is the son of former NHLer and Stanley Cup Champion Brian Rolston.

2021-22 QUICK HITS

- The 2021-22 season marks Notre Dame's 17th under head coach Jeff Jackson and its fifth season in the Big Ten.
- Overall, it is the 53rd season of NCAA Division I hockey for Notre Dame.
- Notre Dame returned four of its top-five point scorers from 2020-21, including Graham Slaggert (7-18-25), Landon Slaggert (8-14-22), Nick Leivermann (5-12-17) and Max Ellis (5-11-16).
- Key losses from 2020-21 included the graduation of Dylan St. Cyr, Pierce Crawford, Matt Hellekson and Colin Theisen; Nate Clurman and Alex Steeves signing professional contracts and Michael Graham being forced to medically retire (he has since joined the Irish coaching staff as an undergraduate assistant coach).
- The Irish welcomed four graduate transfers into the fold for the 2021-22 campaign, including forward Jack Adams, defenseman Chase Blackmun, goaltender Matthew Galajda, and defenseman Adam Karashik while goaltender Josh Graziano transferred into the program as a sophomore, having last played collegiately at Union.
- Five freshmen also joined the Irish this season in forward Tyler Carpenter, defenseman Ryan Helliwell, forward Justin Janicke, forward Hunter Strand and defenseman Hunter Weiss.
- Justin Janicke is the fourth-youngest player in NCAA Div. I men's hockey this season, with only Northeastern's Jack Hughes, Denver's Jack Devine and Michigan's Luke Hughes younger than the Irish freshman.

100% GRADUATION SUCCESS RATE

- The University of Notre Dame claimed the 2020 national championship for graduating student-athletes in all sports—in the process posting the top NCAA Graduation Success Rate (GSR) figure (98) for the 14th-straight year (released on Nov. 17, 2020 by the NCAA).

JANICKE SELECTED IN 2021 NHL DRAFT

- Freshman forward Justin Janicke was selected in the seventh round (195th overall) by the Seattle Kraken in the 2021 National Hockey League Draft.
- The Irish have seen at least one player selected in the National Hockey League Entry Draft every year since 2004, and in 22 of the last 23 years.

HEAD COACH
JEFF JACKSON



- The 2021-22 season marks University of Notre Dame hockey coach Jeff Jackson's 17th season behind the Irish bench. During his first 16 seasons, the program has enjoyed a great deal of success, including four trips to the Frozen Four and eight conference championships.
- Jackson has over 30 years of coaching experience and led Notre Dame to back-to-back Big Ten tournament championship seasons in 2018 and 2019 while also guiding the Irish to the 2018 national title game en route to being named the Spencer Penrose Award winner as the National Coach of the Year.
- Jackson was also named the Spencer Penrose award winner in 2007 and he is one of just 15 coaches to have earned the honor multiple times (dating back to 1951).
- Additionally, Jackson is one of only two coaches to have earned the honor multiple times in the last 17 seasons.
- Jackson's Notre Dame teams have made 11 trips to the NCAA Championship (2007-09, 2011, 2013-14, 2016-19 and 2021), advancing to the Frozen Four four times and playing in the 2008 and 2018 national title games.
- During his 16-year run, Notre Dame has become one of the nation's top teams while playing in the Central Collegiate Hockey Association, Hockey East and now Big Ten.
- Under Jackson, the Irish won the CCHA regular-season title twice (2006-07 and 2008-09) while earning three Mason Cup championships (2007, 2009 and the final one in 2013).
- Then, in the team's first season in the Big Ten (2017-18), Notre Dame captured both the regular season and conference championships and followed up by once again winning the conference tournament in year two (2018-19).
- Jackson's success on the ice also has had a major impact off the ice for the Irish. With the wins came a commitment from the University that led to the new home of Irish hockey — The Compton Family Ice Arena — one of the finest college hockey facilities in the nation. The venue opened for business on Oct. 21, 2011.
- Since Jackson's arrival, the Irish have had 43 players selected in the National Hockey League Entry Draft, including three first round selections.
- In that same span, 33 players from USA Hockey's National Team

- During Jackson's tenure, the Irish have had eight players garner All-America honors — Bobby Nardella in 2019, Cale Morris in 2018, Anders Bjork in 2017, Robbie Russo in 2015, Anders Lee in 2013, Ian Cole and Erik Condra in 2009 and David Brown in 2007.
- In addition, 25 of Jackson's Notre Dame players have gone on to play in the NHL.
- Jackson entered the 2021-22 season with a 21-year collegiate record of 530-271-91 for a .645 winning percentage, the third-highest winning percentage among all active coaches with five years or more in Division I (entering 2021-22).
- Entering the 2021-22 season, Jackson's 530 career wins rank 11th all-time in Division I and second among active coaches (entering 2021-22).
