### COUNTDOWN TO PUCK DROP

<b>555</b>	Head coach <b>Jeff Jackson</b> has 555 career wins, which ranks second among active NCAA Division I head coaches, spanning six seasons at Lake Superior State and 16+ seasons at Notre Dame. Jackson's win total ranks tied for 10th all-time with John MacInnes.
<b>77</b>	Graduate student <b>Adam Karashik</b> has 77 shot blocks this season, which ranks fifth in the country and first in the Big Ten.
<b>25</b>	Notre Dame (25-9-0) enters the weekend tied for third in the country with 25 wins this season, trailing only Minnesota State (31) and Quinnipiac (28) and tied with Michigan (25). It will mark the first time since the 1989-90 season the Irish will finish without a tie (played as a Div. I independent that season).
<b>16</b>	Sixteen sets of brothers have now suited up for the Irish, including current players <b>Cam Burke</b> (brother <b>Cal</b> graduated in 2020), <b>Graham</b> and <b>Landon Slaggert</b> , <b>Trevor</b> and <b>Justin Janicke</b> and <b>Brady Bjork</b> (brother <b>Anders</b> played 2014-17).
<b>16</b>	With a career-high 16 goals on the season, junior forward <b>Max Ellis</b> is tied for 13th nationally in goals (tied for third in the Big Ten).
<b>14</b>	Fourteen former Fighting Irish players have played in the NHL this season: <b>Anders Bjork</b> (Buffalo Sabres), <b>Ian Cole</b> (Carolina Hurricanes), <b>Jake Evans</b> (Montreal Canadiens), <b>Steven Fogarty</b> (Boston Bruins), <b>Jordan Gross</b> (Colorado Avalanche) <b>Vinnie Hinostroza</b> (Buffalo Sabres), <b>Anders Lee</b> (New York Islanders), <b>Kyle Palmieri</b> (New York Islanders), <b>Andrew Peeke</b> (Columbus), <b>Cal Petersen</b> (Los Angeles Kings), <b>Bryan Rust</b> (Pittsburgh Penguins), <b>Riley Sheahan</b> (Seattle Kraken), <b>Alex Steeves</b> (Toronto Maple Leafs) and <b>TJ Tynan</b> (Los Angeles Kings).
<b>9</b>	The Irish are averaging 3.41 goals per game, which ranks ninth in the country. Notre Dame is 21-1-0 this season when scoring at least three goals.
<b>8</b>	With the most recent being the 2019 Big Ten tournament title, Notre Dame has won eight conference championships in program history - each under <b>Jeff Jackson</b> (three regular-season).
<b>5</b>	Notre Dame has an active five-straight NCAA tournament appearances streak, including Frozen Four appearances in 2017 and 2018, which is the longest streak in program history and is the second-longest active streak in the NCAA. The Irish have also appeared in eight of the last 11 NCAA Tournaments (due to the COVID-19 pandemic, the 2020 NCAA tournament did not take place and all appearance streaks remained intact).
<b>5</b>	Notre Dame carries a five -game winning streak into the postseason and is 7-1-0 dating back to the start of February. <b>Matthew Galajda</b> has started each of the past five games, posting a .956 save percentage to go along with a 1.40 goals-against average.

## NOTES

### SETTING THE STAGE

- No. 3 seeded Notre Dame will play host to sixth-seeded Wisconsin in a best-of-three 2022 Big Ten Tournament quarterfinal series at Compton Family Ice Arena (March 4-6).
- The Fighting Irish earned the No. 3 seed by sweeping then second-ranked Michigan last weekend, winning game one 4-1 (Feb. 26) and game two 2-1 (Feb. 26).
- Notre Dame handed the Wolverines their first regulation loss since Dec. 11 and became the only team to sweep Michigan this season, which they did twice (home and away).
- In the sweep of Michigan, graduate student goaltender Matthew Galajda stopped 59 of the 61 shots he faced over the weekend for a .967 save percentage and a 1.00 goals against average en route to being named the Big Ten's Second Star of the Week for the second consecutive week.
- Notre Dame carries a five-game winning streak into the playoffs, with Galajda starting each of those five games (5-0-0, 1.40 goals-against average, .956 save percentage).
- Notre Dame is tied for third in the country with 25 wins (25-9-0), trailing only Minnesota State (31-5-0) and Quinnipiac (28-5-3) and tied with Michigan (25-9-1).
- It will mark the first time since going 18-15-0 in 1989-90 as a Div. I Independent that the Irish will finish a season without a tie.
- The Fighting Irish are 15-5-0 at home this season and 17-1-0 when scoring first.
- Spencer Stastney (2-2-4) and Jack Adams (2-2-4) each have three-game point streaks, while Nick Leivermann has a two-game point streak (0-3-3).
- Notre Dame is 6-2-0 in overtime this season, with the OT game-winning goals coming from Cam Burke (at Michigan Tech), Ryder Rolston (at Michigan), Max Ellis (at Michigan and at Penn State), Spencer Stastney (at Ohio State) and Landon Slaggert (vs. Minnesota).

### STASTNEY'S STARRING ROLE

- Since the Irish returned from break on Jan. 1, senior defenseman Spencer Stastney has five goals and 12 assists for 17 points in 17 games and he has notched at least one point in 13 of the 17 games.
- Stastney is now Notre Dame's second leading scorer with a career-high 26 points on seven goals and 19 assists.
- Stastney's previous career highs were five goals (2020-21), 17 assists (2019-20) and 20 points (2019-20).
- Stastney is the only defenseman in the country with multiple shorthanded goals this season (2).
- Stastney is averaging 0.58 assists per game, which ranks ninth in the Big Ten.
- Stastney has also blocked 53 shots, which ranks fourth in the Big Ten.

## IRISH/BADGERS SERIES HISTORY

- Former opponents in the WCHA, Notre Dame and Wisconsin have met 84 times in program history with Wisconsin leading the all-time series 47-28-9.
- The first meeting between the two teams came during the 1921-22 season when the Irish skated away with a 3-0 victory at Badin Rink (outdoors at Notre Dame).
- The teams met once more, in 1925-26, before taking a 40 year hiatus and returning to competition when Notre Dame earned varsity status.
- As a head coach, Jeff Jackson is 11-9-2 all-time against the Badgers (1-1-0 at Lake Superior State).
- The one win Jackson had over the Badgers at Lake Superior State came on April 4, 1992, in Albany, New York, as the Lakers defeated Wisconsin 5-3 to win the NCAA Championship (the first of Jackson's two NCAA Championships at Lake State).
- Since the Irish joined the Big Ten, Notre Dame leads the series 10-8-2.
- Last season, the teams opened the shortened 2020-21 season on Nov. 13-14 at the Compton Family Ice Arena, with the Badgers posting a 2-0 win and a 5-3 victory (Colin Theisen had a hat trick in that game two loss).
- Then at Wisconsin on Feb. 19-20 2021, the Badgers took game one 4-2 before the teams skated to a back-and-forth 5-5 tie in game two.
- In the game two shootout, Max Ellis scored and Dylan St. Cyr denied Cole Caufield, Dylan Holloway and Ty Pelton-Byce to seal the extra point.
- The teams split the 2019-20 series 2-2-0, including a split at the Kohl Center on Nov. 15-16.
- Wisconsin took game one, 3-0, and Notre Dame took a back-and-forth game two, 5-4 in overtime.
- Later in the season at home (Jan. 24-25), Notre Dame dropped game one, 6-4, before bouncing back to take game two, 5-2.

## NOTRE DAME V. WISCONSIN IN 2021-22

- Notre Dame went 3-1-0 against the Badgers during the 2021-22 regular season.
- The teams first met on Nov. 12-13 at the Compton Family Ice Arena with Notre Dame posting a series sweep, taking game one 5-1 and then following up with a 3-0 win in game two.
- Matthew Galajda played both games in that series, stopping 24 shots in game one and posting a 22-save shutout in game two.
- Max Ellis had a pair of goals in game one with Spencer Stastney chipping in three assists, while game two featured Irish goals by Grant Silianoff, Nick Leivermann and Hunter Strand.
- The teams then played in Madison on Feb. 12-13, with the Irish dropping game one 5-3 before rebounding to take game two 3-2.
- Notre Dame outshot the Badgers 41-15 in that game one loss, but could not overcome a 3-1 first period deficit despite goals from Solag Bakich and Grant Silianoff to make it a 4-3 game late in the third.
- In game two, Galajda made 30 saves and Jesse Lansdell, Hunter Strand and Trevor Janicke scored to secure the win.
- Galajda started three of the four games against Wisconsin but was the goalie of record in all four contests (3-1-0) while posting a .955 save percentage to go along with a 1.10 goals against average and one shutout.
- Offensively, Ryder Rolston (1-3-4) and Spencer Stastney (0-4-4) each had four points against the Badgers this season, while seven other skaters had three points.

## BIG TEN TOURNAMENT

- Notre Dame enters the 2022 Big Ten Tournament as the No. 3 seed after placing third in the standings with 47 points, trailing only Minnesota (55 points) and Michigan (51 points).
- The Irish will host a quarterfinal series for the second time since joining the league,

- having swept Michigan State in 2019 en route to winning the championship.
- It will be Notre Dame's third quarterfinal series overall, as the Irish dropped a quarterfinal series at Minnesota, two games to one, in 2020 before the season was halted due to the Covid-19 pandemic.
  - Last season's single-elimination tournament was also played at the Compton Family Ice Arena, with the Irish falling in their first game to Penn State.
  - All told, Notre Dame is 7-3-0 in Big Ten Tournament games (7-2-0 in games played under the current format and 3-2-0 in quarterfinal games under the current format).
  - Notre Dame captured Big Ten Tournament Championships in 2018 and 2019.
  - As the top seed, Minnesota has a bye this weekend, while No. 2 Michigan hosts Michigan State, the Irish host Wisconsin and No. 4 seed Ohio State hosts Penn State in best-of-three quarterfinal series March 4-6.
  - The top seed and highest remaining seed will then host one game semifinals on March 12, while the championship will be played on March 18 or 19 depending on the site (highest remaining seed).

## ND IN THE PLAYOFFS UNDER JACKSON

**BALANCED ATTACK**

- The Fighting Irish have seen several players step up and contribute to the offense throughout the 2021-22 season, with Notre Dame averaging 3.41 goals per game which ranks ninth in the country (fourth in the Big Ten).
- An impressive 16 players have double-digit point totals, including six players with at least 20 points on the season.
- Nineteen Notre Dame players have scored this season, while 23 have at least one point.
- With Notre Dame facing several injuries in the Feb. 4-5 sweep of the Nittany Lions, freshmen forwards Justin Janicke and Tyler Carpenter each scored their first career goals, while graduate transfer defensemen Adam Karashik and Chase Blackmun each netted their first goals with Notre Dame (10 players accounted for the 10 goals that series).
- Freshman defenseman Ryan Helliwell was the most recent player to post a point, notching his first career point with an assist at Michigan State (Feb. 19).

**JACK AND THE KIDS**

- Notre Dame's line of Justin Janicke (LW), Hunter Strand (C) and Jack Adams (RW) has provided a timely scoring punch of late, accounting for at least one goal in each of the past five games.
- During the current five-game winning streak, Janicke (1-3-4), Strand (3-2-5) and Adams (2-3-5) have combined for six goals and eight assists for 14 points.
- Adams, a fifth-year graduate student is 25 years old, Janicke is one of the youngest players in college hockey (18) and Strand turned 19 in November.

**NCAA TOURNEY TALK**

- Notre Dame has made each of the last five NCAA Tournaments, the longest streak in program history, and eight of the last 11 NCAA Tournaments overall.
- The five consecutive NCAA Tournament appearances is the second-longest active streak in the NCAA, trailing only Minnesota Duluth (6), with Minnesota State (3) and St Cloud State (3) tied for third.

**STEPPING UP**

- Several Fighting Irish skaters have increased their point totals this season over the past few years.
- Spencer Stastney is the team's second-leading scorer with seven goals and 19 assists for 26 points, all career-best totals for the senior defenseman.
- After a freshman season with one goal in eight games and a sophomore season with 16 points in 24 games (5-11-16), Max Ellis has 16 goals and 12 assists for a career-best 28 points in 33 games.
- Ellis posted the first hat trick of his career, capped by scoring the overtime game-winning goal, at Michigan on Nov. 20 marking the first visiting player to record a hat trick at Yost Ice Arena in 15 years (2006).
- Junior Trevor Janicke has a career-high 13 goals in 34 games this season, besting his previous career-high of eight goals scored as a freshman and as a junior.
- Janicke's 21 points are also a career-best total (he had 13 points in 37 games as a freshman and in 24 games as a sophomore).
- In 32 games this season, Cam Burke has eight goals and 11 assists for 19 points, all of which represent career-high totals for the senior.
- Ryder Rolston had six points on a goal and five assists last season as a freshman and now has 10 goals and 15 assists for 25 points in 32 games as a sophomore.
- Solag Bakich has a career-high 17 points (5-12-17) in 29 games this season after

scoring once in 10 games as a freshman and then notching seven points (4-3-7) in 28 games as a sophomore.

- Defenseman Jake Boltmann joined the Irish for the second semester last season, skating in 19 games (0 points).
- This season, Boltmann has a goal and 12 assists for 13 points in 34 games.

## HOCKEY HUMANITARIAN NOMINEE

- The Hockey Humanitarian Award Foundation announced Fighting Irish senior captain Graham Slaggert as one of 11 nominees for the 2022 Hockey Humanitarian award (Jan. 25).
- The award, celebrating its 27th season, is presented annually to college hockey's finest citizen — a student-athlete who makes significant contributions not only to his or her team but also to the community-at-large through leadership in volunteerism.
- Off the ice, Slaggert serves on Notre Dame's Student-Athlete Advisory Council and is pursuing a management consulting degree.
- He earned Big Ten All-Academic Team honors each of the past two seasons.
- Slaggert also spearheaded Notre Dame's involvement with the 525 Foundation, which helps raise funds and awareness about the dangers of both alcohol and prescription drug misuse and abuse.
- Slaggert also helped the Irish support alum Stephen Johns' #MentalMiles initiative.

## HOBEBY HOPEFULS

- Forward Max Ellis and goaltender Matthew Galajda have been named to the Hobey Baker Award's Phase One Fan Ballot (Jan. 12).
- Given annually to college hockey's top player, the Hobey Baker Award includes candidates exhibiting the exceptional character traits of the award's namesake, Hobey Baker, with consideration given to scholastic achievement and sportsmanship.

- Phase two of fan balloting will come from the list of Top Ten Hobey Baker finalists beginning March 17 and closing March 27. The fans' vote accounts for a full one percent of the total ballot in each phase in selecting this year's award recipient.
- The 2022 Hobey Baker Award winner will be announced from a field of three Hobey Hat Trick finalists on Friday, April 8, 2022 during the NCAA Frozen Four Championship in Boston.

## SLAGGERT: TEAM USA X2

- Sophomore forward Landon Slaggert was named to the U.S. National Junior Team, USA Hockey announced on Dec. 16.
- The South Bend, Indiana native was named an alternate captain for Team USA and scored the game winner in Team USA's tournament-opening 3-2 win over Slovakia (Dec. 26).
- The International Ice Hockey Federation then canceled the 2022 World Junior Championship in Edmonton and Red Deer, Alberta due to COVID-19 protocols.
- Slaggert was one of six players from the 2021 U.S. National Junior Team that won a gold medal in Edmonton.
- Slaggert became the seventh Notre Dame player to take part in two World Junior Championships.
- At last season's World Junior Tournament, Slaggert skated in all seven games for Team USA and became the first Fighting Irish player to medal at the event since 2018 — when current Columbus Blue Jackets defenseman Andrew Peeke helped the U.S. secure the bronze in Buffalo.
- Slaggert's gold marked the eighth medal by a Notre Dame player at the event as he also joined Anders Bjork (bronze in 2016), Mario Lucia (gold in 2013), Kyle Palmieri (gold in 2010 and bronze in 2011), Kyle Lawson (bronze in 2007) and Ben Simon (silver in 1997).

- Slaggert was the 23rd Notre Dame player to take part in the World Junior Championship and joined Palmieri (2010/11), Ian Cole (2008/09), Rob Globke (2001/02), Connor Dunlop (2000/01), Simon (1997/98) and Jack Brownschilde (1977/79) as two-time Irish participants.

## NHL NOTES

- Former Irish forward Alex Steeves (2018-21) made his NHL debut for the Toronto Maple Leafs on Dec. 7 against Columbus (and former Notre Dame teammate Andrew Peeke) in a 5-4 Toronto win.
- Steeves, who earned Second Team All-Big Ten honors in 2020-21, became the 25th former Irish player under head coach Jeff Jackson to reach the NHL and the Notre Dame program's 39th NHL player overall.
- Prior to Steeves, the most recent Notre Dame players to make their NHL debuts were Jordan Gross, Peeke, Jake Evans and Thomas DiPauli during the 2019-20 season.
- Former Fighting Irish All-American goaltender Cale Morris (Chicago) and former captain Cal Burke (Colorado) recently inked NHL deals and were recalled to their teams' respective taxi squads.
- Morris, who played from 2016-20 and led the Irish to the 2018 NCAA Championship game, signed a one-year entry-level deal on Dec. 31.
- Burke, who also played from 2016-20 with the Irish, signed a one-year contract with Colorado on Dec. 16 and later was recalled to the taxi squad.
- Former Irish captain Steven Fogarty made his Boston debut late in January to become the 14th former Fighting Irish player to appear in the NHL this season.
- The program's 14 alums in the NHL ranked seventh nationally, trailing only North Dakota (23), Minnesota (23), Boston University (19), Boston College (19), Michigan (19) and Wisconsin (16) [totals as of Feb. 1, 2022].

## SENIORS WITH CLASS

- Forward Graham Slaggert and defenseman Spencer Stastney have been named two of the 20 candidates for the 2021-22 Senior CLASS Award®.
- The Senior CLASS Award focuses on the total student-athlete, who must have notable achievements in four areas of excellence: community, classroom, character and competition. The Notre Dame hockey program consistently produces finalists for the national award, including past winners David Brown (2007) and Jake Evans (2018).
- The 20 candidates will be narrowed to ten finalists later in the season. Those ten names will then be placed on the official ballot. Ballots will be distributed through a nationwide voting system to media, coaches and fans, who will select one candidate who best exemplifies excellence in the four Cs of community, classroom, character, and competition.
- The Senior CLASS Award winner will be announced during the 2022 NCAA Men's Frozen Four® in April.

- Two sets of brothers are currently on the roster, including Justin and Trevor Janicke and Graham and Landon Slaggert.
- Cam Burke played his first two seasons in an Irish uniform alongside his older brother, Cal Burke, who signed with the Colorado organization for the second consecutive season for 2021-22.
- Freshman forward Brady Bjork is the younger brother of former Irish All-American and current Buffalo Sabre Anders Bjork.
- The Janickes represent the 16th set of brothers to play for Notre Dame.
- The Slaggerts also are part of the fifth set of father-son combinations to suit up for the Irish, joining their father and associate head coach Andy Slaggert.

**HEAD COACH**  
**JEFF JACKSON**



- The 2021-22 season marks University of Notre Dame hockey coach Jeff Jackson's 17th season behind the Irish bench. During his first 16 seasons, the program has enjoyed a great deal of success, including four trips to the Frozen Four and eight conference championships.
- Jackson has over 30 years of coaching experience and led Notre Dame to back-to-back Big Ten tournament championship seasons in 2018 and 2019 while also guiding the Irish to the 2018 national title game en route to being named the Spencer Penrose Award winner as the National Coach of the Year.
- Jackson was also named the Spencer Penrose award winner in 2007 and he is one of just 15 coaches to have earned the honor multiple times (dating back to 1951).
- Additionally, Jackson is one of only two coaches to have earned the honor multiple times in the last 17 seasons.
- Jackson's Notre Dame teams have made 11 trips to the NCAA Championship (2007-09, 2011, 2013-14, 2016-19 and 2021), advancing to the Frozen Four four times and playing in the 2008 and 2018 national title games.
- During his 16-year run, Notre Dame has become one of the nation's top teams while playing in the Central Collegiate Hockey Association, Hockey East and now Big Ten.
- Under Jackson, the Irish won the CCHA regular-season title twice (2006-07 and 2008-09) while earning three Mason Cup championships (2007, 2009 and the final one in 2013).
- Then, in the team's first season in the Big Ten (2017-18), Notre Dame captured both the regular season and conference championships and followed up by once again winning the conference tournament in year two (2018-19).
- Jackson's success on the ice also has had a major impact off the ice for the Irish. With the wins came a commitment from the University that led to the new home of Irish hockey — The Compton Family Ice Arena — one of the finest college hockey facilities in the nation. The venue opened for business on Oct. 21, 2011.
- Since Jackson's arrival, the Irish have had 43 players selected in the National Hockey League Entry Draft, including three first round selections.
- In that same span, 33 players from USA Hockey's National Team

- In addition, 25 of Jackson's Notre Dame players have gone on to play in the NHL.
- Jackson entered the 2021-22 season with a 21-year collegiate record of 530-271-91 for a .645 winning percentage, the third-highest winning percentage among all active coaches with five years or more in Division I (entering 2021-22).
- Entering the 2021-22 season, Jackson's 530 career wins rank 11th all-time in Division I and second among active coaches (entering 2021-22).
