	BY THE NUMBERS
.762	The Irish own a 32-10 record (.762) on the road under head coach Link Jarrett.
.767	The Irish are 66-20 (.767) since the start of the 2020 season. That winning percentage ranks third in the NCAA over the past three seasons, trailing only Tennessee and Arkansas.
.808	The Irish are 21-5 (.808) to start the 2022 season. It is the best start to a season since 2004, when the Irish began the year 23-3 (.885).
.988	Notre Dame is second in the NCAA in fielding percentage with a .988 mark this season. The Irish have committed 12 errors in 709 putout opportunities this season.
1	The Irish swept #5 Florida State on the road from April 1-3 (2-0 (12), 5-4, 9-7). It was the first time the Irish have swept a Top-5 team on the road in program history.
1.16	Notre Dame is sixth in the NCAA and leads the ACC with a 1.16 WHIP this season. They have surrendered 172 hits and 103 walks in 236.1 innings pitched.
3.08	The Irish rank sixth nationally and lead the ACC in team ERA with 3.08. They have given up 81 earned runs in 236.1 innings this season.
6.55	The Irish are third in the NCAA and lead the ACC with 6.55 hits allowed per nine innings. They have given up 172 hits in 236.1 innings pitched this season.
8	The Irish scored eight unanswered runs in the 8-4 comeback win over #17 NC State on March 11. It was the most unanswered runs in a game since Game 2 of the Super Regional when the Irish scored nine unanswered runs to beat #7 Mississippi State.
11.1	The Irish rank eighth in the NCAA and third in the ACC in strikeouts per nine innings with 11.1. The Irish pitching staff has struck out 292 batters in 236.1 innings this season.
12	John Michael Bertrand set a career high with 12 strikeouts against #5 Florida State on April 1. It was the most strikeouts in a game for an Irish pitcher since Cameron Brown struck out 12 against Florida State on March 23, 2019.
12.0	John Michael Bertrand (7.2 IP), Ryan McLinskey (1.2 IP), Aidan Tyrell (1.0) and Alex Rao (1.2 IP) combined to shutout #5 Florida State in 12.0 innings in the 2-0 Irish win on April 1. It was the first time in program history that the Seminoles had been shutout in an extra inning game.
16	Notre Dame is 16-2-1 all-time in regular-season series under Jarrett. The Irish are 9-1 in ACC series on the road and are 14-2-1 in ACC series over the past two-plus seasons.
16	The Irish allowed three runs or less for the 16th time this season in the 9-3 win over Clemson to sweep the series on April 10. They are 16-0 this season and 42-2 overall under Jarrett in games they allow three runs or less.
18	The Irish struck out 18 batters in the 2-0 win over #5 Florida State on April 1. It was the most strikeouts in a game for the Irish pitching staff since May 16, 2008, when they struck out 18 against South Florida.
58	Outfielder Spencer Myers has 58 steals in his Irish career and ranks eighth all-time in program history for most career steals. He trails AJ Pollock by two for seventh place in program history.

Irish Head South to Battle Duke

- Notre Dame hits the road for its second to last ACC road series of the regular season as they take on Duke this weekend in Durham.
- Duke leads the all-time series between the two teams 14-8 and have a 9-4 advantage in games played in Durham.
- Last season, the Irish took two-of-three games from Duke at Frank Eck Stadium in the first home series of the season.
- The home opener went into the 13th inning with the score tied at 4-4 before Ryan Cole hit his first career home run to give the Irish a 6-4 victory.
- In the second game of the series, Cole hit an inside-the-park home run to help the Irish clinch the series with a 6-2 win.
- John Michael Bertrand tossed his first complete game with the Irish in the series-clinching win. He struck out six and only allowed two runs.
- Niko Kavadas had a strong series at the plate against the Blue Devils, as he hit two home runs and had a team-high 6 RBI in the series.
- Duke heads into the series with a 13-20 overall record and are 3-12 in ACC play. They are coming off an 0-4 week after getting swept in a road series against Wake Forest and lost the midweek matchup against Campbell at home.
- The Irish are in the middle of their second long winning streak of the season. They have won their last nine games heading into the series and are coming off a home series sweep of Clemson and a midweek win over Michigan.
- Notre Dame continues to hold strong in a number of national categories this season. They currently rank in the Top-10 in fielding percentage (2nd - .988), hits allowed per nine innings (3rd - 6.55), WHIP (6th - 1.16), ERA (6th - 3.08) and strikeouts per nine innings (7th - 11.1).

Myers Slam Carries Irish over Michigan, 14-5

- Notre Dame finished the five-game homestand in style with a 14-5 win over rival Michigan on April 10.
- The win extended the Irish win streak to nine games and they improved to 5-0 in midweek games this season.
- The Irish broke out for five runs in the second and did not look back to improve to 7-1 at home this year.
- Spencer Myers hit his first career grand slam in the second to give the Irish an early lead they would not relinquish. He finished with a career high four RBI to lead the team.
- Zack Prajzner and Brooks Coetzee III both added three RBI each at the plate in the win.

ACC Dominance

- Since Link Jarrett arrived in South Bend, the Irish have been the class of the conference over the past two-plus seasons.
- Notre Dame is 36-14 (.720) in ACC games since 2020, the best record of any school in the conference.
- The Irish are 14-2-1 in ACC series over that time and seven of the 14 series wins have been sweeps.
- The seven ACC sweeps matches the total the Irish accumulated in the six years prior to Jarrett since they joined the conference in 2014.
- In 2022, the Irish are 3-1 in ACC series with all three series wins coming via a sweep. They swept the Wolfpack in an abbreviated two-game series on the road, swept the fifth-ranked Seminoles in Tallahassee and are coming off a home sweep over

Clemson.

Road Warriors

- The Irish have been known to be a tough out on the road under head coach Link Jarrett.
- Notre Dame is a combined 32-10 on the road and have won 11 of 12 regular season road series since Jarrett came to South Bend in 2020.
- The Irish swept #5 Florida State on the road this season for their first road series sweep over a Top-5 team in program history.
- The Irish also earned their first series win in Tallahassee in program history with the sweep.
- In Jarrett's tenure, the Irish have won nine ACC road series, while also winning non-conference road series against UAB and Presbyterian in the 2020 season.
- Earlier this season, the Irish won their eighthstraight ACC road series to set a program record for most consecutive conference road series wins.
- It broke the previous record set by the 1991-93 squads that won seven-consecutive conference series while in the Mid-Western Collegiate Conference.

Irish Sweep Tigers with 9-3 Win

- Notre Dame finished off its second-straight ACC sweep with a convincing 9-3 win over Clemson on April 10.
- They outscored the Tigers 21-5 in the series and limited Clemson to three runs or fewer in all three games.
- The Irish also never trailed against the Tigers at any point during the series and the score was tied for only two full innings the entire weekend.
- It was the 16th time this season the Irish have limited their opponent to three runs or fewer and they are 16-0 in those games this year.
- Carter Putz continued his torrid stretch at the plate, going 2-for-3 with three RBI. He finished the weekend series with eight RBI against the Tigers.
- Danny Neri tied a career high with three hits and tied a career-high with two runs.
- Jared Miller and Ryan Cole both hit home runs in the win, giving the Irish six long balls over the course of the series.
- On the mound the trio of Will Mercer, Roman Kimball and Alex Rao closed out the series sweep

- Kimball earned his third win of the season while Rao picked up his first save of the year.
- The sweep is Notre Dame's third ACC sweep this season and the seventh overall in the two-plus seasons under Jarrett.

Blasts Push Irish Past Tigers

- The Irish picked up another ACC series win with the 8-1 win over Clemson on April 9.
- Notre Dame blasted four home runs in the win, the most in a game since the South Bend Regional final when they hit five in the 1-2 win over Central Michigan.
- Nick Juaire and Danny Neri both hit their first career home runs in the win, while Brooks Coetzee III hit his team-leading seventh home run and Carter Putz hit his fifth of the year.
- Putz led the way at the plate for the Irish with a team-high three hits and he tied a career high with five RBI.
- Danny Neri also tallied three hits in a win, setting a new career high.
- Austin Temple earned his third win of the season following 5.1 scoreless innings of work. He tied a career high with nine strikeouts.
- Ryan McLinskey, Jackson Dennies and Radek Birkholz closed out the final 3.2 innings and did not allow an earned run.
- It was the second straight game of the series that the Irish did not allow an earned run.
- With the win, the Irish won their 16th series under Jarret and the 14th ACC series during his two plus seasons.

Bertrand Lifts Irish Over Clemson

- The Irish got another strong start from John Michael Bertrand to kick start another series in their 4-1 win over Clemson on April 8.
- Coming off his career high 12 strikeouts against Florida State, Bertrand went a season-high 8.1 innings against Tigers and did not allow an earned run.
- It was the longest start by an Irish pitcher over the weekend and he leads the ACC in innings pitched with 53.0.
- It was also the second-straight start for Bertrand without allowing an earned run, which covers a span of 16.0 innings.
- He struck out eight in his outing against the Tigers, the fourth start this season he has had eight more K's.
- At the plate, Spencer Myers, Jack Brannigan and Brooks Coetzee III all had multi-hit games in the win.
- Ryan McLinskey came on for the final two outs to earn his team-high third save of the year.

• Bertrand was named ACC Pitcher of the Week for the second-straight week following his performance against the Tigers.

Irish Grind Out Midweek Win Over Butler

- The Irish got their five-game homestand starting with a 5-2 win over in-state foe Butler.
- The Irish trailed 2-0 after the top of the first but scored once in the first and second inning to tie the game at 2-2.
- Jack Brannigan hit his fourth home run of the season, a solo shot, in the first to get the Irish on the board.
- In the second, Nick Juaire laced an RBI single to left that scored Ryan Cole and tied the game.
- The game stayed level until the sixth when Notre Dame scored three runs in the inning.
- Ryan Cole beat out the throw to home on Zack Prajzner's chopper to third and a throwing error allowed Juaire to score from second. Later in the inning, Prajzner scored on a suicide squeeze from Spencer Myers.
- The bullpen carried the Irish in the win as they tossed 8.1 innings of one hit ball to secure the win.
- The Irish did not allow the Bulldogs to get a hit from the second inning all the way to the eighth when there were already two outs in the frame.
- Jack Findlay earned his third win of the season with 3.0 innings of hitless relief.
- Austin Temple got his second save of the year after setting the Bulldogs down in order in the ninth.
- The win was the 13th time this season that the Irish gave up three runs or less and they are 13-0 in those games.
- The Irish won their 13th consecutive game against Butler and improved to 9-0 in mid-week matchups under head coach Link Jarrett.

Irish Earn Sweep with 9-7 Win over #5 Seminoles

- The bats came alive for the Irish in the 9-7 win over the Seminoles to sweep the series.
- Notre Dame scored multiple runs in four of the nine innings on Sunday, including a game-high three runs in the first inning.
- Ryan Cole hit his second home run of the weekend, a three-run shot off the scoreboard, in the first inning to put the lrish up early.
- Carter Putz also hit his second home run of the weekend, a two-run shot, in the fourth inning to regain the lead for the Irish.
- Cole finished the game 3-for-3 from the plate with two RBI and three runs. He also reached base in all five of his at bats (three hits, walk and hit-by-pitch).
- Putz was 2-for-3 at the plate and also had two RBI and three runs.

- On the mound, the bullpen tossed over eight innings of relief to help seal the win for the lrish.
- Aidan Tyrell pitched a game-high 4.2 innings to earn his fourth win of the season and Jack Brannigan got the final five outs for his first save of the year.
- With the win, the Irish completed the sweep over the fifth-ranked Seminoles. It is the first time in program history they have swept a Top-5 team on the road.

Irish Clinch Series with Comeback Win Over Seminoles

- After trailing heading into the ninth, the Irish battled back to defeat Florida State, 5-4, to clinch the series.
- The Irish broke a 1-1 tie in the fourth inning with a solo home run from Carter Putz.
- The lead held until the seventh inning when the Seminoles took their first lead of the series after scoring three runs in the innings.
- Notre Dame got a run back in eighth with a RBI double from Putz that scored Jack Brannigan to pull within one heading into the ninth.
- In the ninth, the Irish had two runners in scoring position and were down to their final out.
- Jared Miller hit a high chopper up the middle that the second baseman corralled in the shallow outfield. Brooks Coetzee III scored on the play and Jack Penney kept going for home and beat the throw to regain a 5-4 lead.
- Roman Kimball came back out for the ninth and set the Seminoles down in order to seal the win.
- The win clinched the Irish their first ever series win in Tallahassee in program history.

Irish Outlast Florida State in Extras, 2-0

- The pitcher's duel lived up to the hype as two of the best pitchers in the ACC faced off in the series opener.
- John Michael Bertrand and Parker Messick dueled for eight innings without allowing a run to either team.
- Bertrand had one of the best starts of his Irish career after tossing 7.2 innings of scoreless ball with a career-high 12 strikeouts.
- The 12 strikeouts were the most in a game by an Irish pitcher since 2019.
- The scoreless game carried into extras as neither team scored over the first 11 innings of the game and a runner did not make it past second base.
- In the 12th, Carter Putz doubled with two outs and then advanced to third on a wild pitch.
- Ryan Cole faced a 2-2 count and took the fastball clear over the wall in left for the game's first runs.
- Alex Rao came back out and set the Seminoles down in order to close out the 2-0 win.

- It was the first time in program history that the Seminoles were shut out in an extra inning game.
- The Irish strcuk out 18 batters in the game, the most in a game since 2008 when they struck out 18 against South Florida.
- Bertrand was named ACC Pitcher of the Week following his performance against the Seminoles.

Irish Run Past Northern Illinois

- The Irish were hot on the base paths and at the plate in the 11-2 win over Northern Illinois.
- They scored double-figure runs for the eighth time this season and had a season-best seven steals.
- The seven steals were the most in a game since 2020, when the Irish tallied seven in a win over Presbyterian.
- Zack Prajzner led the way at the plate with a team-high three hits and three runs. Ryan Cole set a career-high with three steals for the game and Jared Miller hit his first home run of the season.
- The Irish broke the game open after scoring five runs in the sixth inning. It was the 10th time this season the Irish have scored five or more runs in a single inning.
- On the mound, five different pitchers saw action against the Huskies.
- Freshman Roman Kimball earned the win after 2.1 innings of scoreless relief. He allowed just one hit while setting a career high with four strikeouts.
- Fellow freshman Jack Findlay tossed 2.1 innings of work without allowing a runner to reach base. He tied a career high with three strikeouts.
- The staff limited Northern Illinois to two runs, the ninth time this season they have allowed two runs or fewer.

Top-Ranked Irish Defeat Valparaiso in Home Opener

- After over 5,000 plus miles and 72 hours of travel over the first four weeks of the season, the Irish opened the home slate with a 12-1 win over Valpo on March 15.
- The bats started early as the Irish scored two runs in each of the first three innings to jump out to a 6-0 lead.
- Brooks Coetzee III highlighted the scoring with his team-leading fifth home run of the season in the third inning.
- The Irish deployed a staff day on the mound as six pitchers saw action against the Beacons.
- Jack Findlay, Alex Rao, Caden Aoki, Roman Kimball, Liam Simon and Radek Birkholz all pitched at least an inning for the Irish and allowed just one run and five hits on the afternoon.
- The offense exploded for six runs in the eighth to put the game out of reach.
- Jack Zyska hit his third home run of the season in

the eighth and Brady Gumpf added his first career hit, a two-run double, down the left field line.

- The Irish scored in double-figures for the secondstraight game and the sixth time this season.
- They also tallied 16 hits, the fifth time this season they have had 15 or more hits.
- On the mound, it was the fifth game this season the Irish have allowed one or fewer runs.

Irish Sweep #17 NC State with 11-4 Win

- The Irish brought the brooms out when they took down #17 NC State 11-4 on March 13 to sweep the weekend series (two games).
- Notre Dame took advantage of a number of Wolfpack miscues as six of the 11 runs for the Irish were scored on errors or wild pitches.
- The Irish plated 11 runs in the game, the fifth time this season they have scored 10 or more runs.
- Carter Putz led the Irish at the plate with a season-high three hits and Jared Miller added a season-high three runs.
- The Irish used big innings in the opening and closing sets of innings against the Wolfpack. They scored three runs in the first inning and scored seven runs over the final two innings.
- On the mound, the duo of John Michael Bertrand and Austin Temple never allowed the Wolfpack to take the lead on the afternoon.
- Bertrand tossed 5.0 innings as he earned his fourth win in as many starts this season.
- Temple pitched 4.0 of relief and tallied his first save with the Irish.
- The Irish allowed only four runs and they have allowed four runs or less in 11 of the 12 games this season.

Irish Score Eight-Unanswered in 8-4 Comeback Win Over #17 NC State

- The Irish faced their biggest deficit of the season when they opened ACC play against No. 17 NC State but battled back to win, 8-4, in 12 innings.
- The Irish trailed 4-0 heading into the seventh but scored three runs in the seventh and tied the game with a run in the eighth.
- Carter Putz got the scoring started with a solo home run, Jack Brannigan scored on a wild pitch and Zack Prajzner drove in Brooks Coetzee III to bring the Irish within one.
- In the eighth, Brannigan tied the game with a two-out RBI single that scored Jared Miller after his lead-off double.
- The bullpen kept the Irish in it as Alex Rao, Radek Birkholz, Ryan McLinskey and Brannigan tossed eight innings of scoreless relief as the Irish built the comeback.
- In the 12th, Zack Prajzner launched a solo home run to left to give the Irish their first lead of the



game. They added three more runs in the inning to build out the lead.

• Brannigan came on for the final two outs in the 11th and shut the door in the 12th as he picked up his first win of the season. Four of his five outs that he recorded came via the strikeout.

Coetzee III Powers Irish to Midweek Win

- Brooks Coetzee III has been off to a torrid start and it continued in Notre Dame's 11-3 win over Elon.
- The senior from Mahomet, Illinois led the Irish from the dish after going 2-for-3 with a home run, double and tallied five RBI.
- The home run was his team-leading fourth of the season and he tied a career-high with the five RBI.
- Coetzee's home run was in the middle of an eight-run third inning that broke the game open for the Irish.
- The eight runs in the third tied a season high for most runs in an inning. The Irish also scored eight runs in the first inning against Marist on February 25.
- It is the most runs in an inning since April 24, 2021 when the Irish scored 12 in the eighth against Boston College.
- On the mound, freshman left-hander Jack Findlay made his collegiate debut against the Phoenix.
- He earned the win after 3.0 innings of scoreless ball with three strikeouts.
- A number of Irish pitchers saw time in the win including Caden Aoki, Matt Lazzaro, Radek Birkholz, Jackson Dennies and Roman Kimball.
- The six pitchers held the Phoenix to three runs on the night. The Irish staff have limited opponents to three runs or fewer in each of the last seven games.

Irish Win Cambria College Classic With 3-1 Victory Over Minnesota

- The Irish clinched the Cambria College Classic with a 3-1 win over Minnesota after another complete team performance.
- The Irish scored in the top of the first after Carter Putz doubled to the gap in right center that scored Jared Miller.
- Danny Neri and Spencer Myers both added to the Irish lead with RBI in the sixth and seventh inning.
- On the mound, Austin Temple was masterful in his best start with the Irish.
- The graduate transfer from Jacksonville carried a no-hitter into the seventh inning until the Gophers got on the board with a solo home run.
- He finished the inning to give him a final line of 7.0 innings pitched, one hit allowed, one walk and tied a career high with nine strikeouts.
- Will Mercer came on in relief and shut the door as he got the final two outs of the game for his first

save this season.

- The Irish allowed just one hit in the game for the first time since April 18, 2007, when they gave up one hit in a 1-0 win over Purdue in 10 innings.
- After the game Temple, John Michael Bertrand, Ryan McLinskey and TJ Williams were named to the Cambria College Classic All-Tournament Team.
- Temple was named the tournament MVP and also was named ACC Pitcher of the Week.

Irish Outlast Michigan State

- Hits were hard to come by in Notre Dame's 2-1 win over Michigan State to improve to 2-1 in the Cambria College Classic.
- The Irish did not get their first hit until the 5th inning but made it count when TJ Williams doubled to left and advanced to third on an error.
- He scored on the next play after a sacrifice fly from Brooks Coetzee III.
- The Spartans tied it in the seventh but it lasted only one batter in the bottom of the seventh as the Irish regained the lead.
- Jack Brannigan launched a solo home run to lead off the inning to put the Irish back in front.
- On the mound, John Michael Bertrand pitched his third-straight quality start to begin the 2022 season.
- He went 7.0 innings and allowed just one run and one walk while striking out four.
- Ryan McLinskey came on for the final two innings and struck out four of the six batters he faced to close the game and earn his second save this year.
- The Irish only tallied two hits in the game but did not strike out at the plate the entire game.
- It is the first time since 2014 that the Irish did not strike out once in a game, a feat that they accomplished three times during the 2014 season.

Irish Cruise Past Illinois to Open Cambria College Classic

- The Irish began the Cambria College Classic with a win after the 6-1 result over the Illini.
- Brooks Coetzee III and TJ Williams both hit solo home runs and Jared Miller and Spencer Myers added 2-RBI singles to give the Irish their run support for the afternoon.
- It was Coetzee's team-leading third home run of the season and Williams' first career home run.
- On the mound, Aidan Tyrell had another strong start to begin the season. He went 5.0 innings to pick up his third win of the year and he allowed just one run and did not walk a batter.
- On the season, Tyrell has only allowed 1 earned run in 16.0 innings pitched.
- Alex Rao relieved Tyrell and tossed 3.0 innings without allowing a run and only one walk.
- Jack Brannigan got the final three outs of the

game without allowing a hit to seal the win.

Irish Shutout Monmouth to Sweep Doubleheader

- In their final game in Greenville, the Irish pitching staff put together their best performance of the season in the 9-0 win to sweep the double header.
- Graduate student Austin Temple got the Irish started with five scoreless innings and just two hits allowed. He struck out five after setting a career high last week against Delaware.
- Up next was fellow graduate student Ryan McLinskey, who pitched 1.2 innings with one hit allowed and four of his five outs came via the strikeout.
- Senior Alex Rao came in next for his first appearance of the season and he did not allow a walk or a hit in 1.1 innings pitched, striking out three of the four batters he faced.
- Moving over from third base, junior Jack Brannigan closed the deal in the ninth. He struck out the side to end the game and give the staff 15 total strikeouts, the highest in a game this season.
- At the plate, Zack Prajzner and Danny Neri led the way with 3 RBI each. Neri set a career high with the three runs batted in.
- The 4-5-6 spots in the lineup of Carter Putz, Brannigan and TJ Williams each had a team-high two runs scored.

Bats Stay Hot in 16-2 Victory over Monmouth

- The Irish continued the torrid stretch at the plate in the 16-2 win over Monmouth in the first game of the double header.
- Both teams were scoreless through the first three innings until the Irish scored in the fourth and then scored in each of the last four innings they were at bat.
- A day after going 3-for-3 against Marist, Cole one-upped himself and went 4-for-4 against the Hawks with four RBI and three runs.
- Cole broke the game open in the sixth with his first career grand slam to extend the Irish lead to 8-0 at the time.
- He was the first Notre Dame player to hit a grand slam since Alex Brait last season in the opening series of the season against Wake Forest.
- Carter Putz also went yard in the game, his first of the season, in the fifth inning.
- On the mound, John Michael Bertrand was superb for the second-straight start.
- He tossed seven innings and allowed just one earned run and one walk while striking out a career-high 11 batters.
- It was the most strikeouts in a single game by an Irish player since Cameron Junker tallied 11 against Canisius in 2019.
- Following Bertrand on the mound was freshman

Radek Birkholz, who made his collegiate debut against the Hawks.

• He pitched the final two innings without allowing a hit and struck out three batters to close the game.

Offense Explodes in 20-2 Win over Marist

- The Irish offense did not slow down in the second week of the season as they defeated Marist 20-2 on February 25 in Greenville.
- The Irish put up eight runs in the opening frame and never looked back as they scored the most runs in a regular season game since 2008.
- A number of Irish hitters got opportunities at the plate as 15 different players recorded a hit in the win.
- It was the most batters to get a hit in a game for the Irish over the last 16 seasons. The previous record was 13 against Georgetown in 2008.
- Ryan Cole led the Irish at the plate after going 3-for-3 with two runs and an RBI. DM Jefferson had a team-high 3 RBI in the win.
- On the mound, Aidan Tyrell improved to 2-0 after seven scoreless innings allowing just three hits, one walk and struck out five.
- Tyrell has not allowed a run in his 11.0 innings this season.
- Sammy Cooper made his collegiate debut out of the bullpen, tossing the final two innings, to close out the win.

Bats Power Irish to Season-Opening Win over Manhattan

- Notre Dame opened the 2022 season with a bang in the 17-2 win over Manhattan.
- It was the most runs scored in a season opener for the Irish since 2005 when they scored 18 against Florida A&M.
- The Irish tallied three triples in the game, including two in the first inning. It was the first time since April 3, 2016 against Wake Forest that the Irish had three triples in the same game.
- Brooks Coetzee III recorded his first multi-home run game in the win and set a career high with four hits.
- Coetzee III and Jack Brannigan both recorded 4 RBI in the win, the first time two players had 4 or more RBI in the same game since June 5, 2021 against UConn when Niko Kavadas tallied 8 and Ryan Cole had 6.
- The Irish totaled 19 hits in the win, the most since the UConn game when they had 21 during the South Bend Super Regional.
- LHP Aidan Tyrell got the win and tied a career high with six strikeouts. It was the second-straight start dating back to last season that Tyrell totaled six punchouts.

 Six different players made their Irish debuts in the win including DM Jefferson, Joey Spence, Jack Penney, Brady Gumpf, Nick DeMarco and Gerry Peacock.

Bertrand, McLinskey Too Much for Stetson

- In front of a sellout crowd in the second game of the Hatter Classic, the pitching duo of John Michael Bertrand and Ryan McLinskey shut down the hosts Stetson in the 5-3 Irish win.
- Bertrand picked up right where he left off in 2021 with a quality start to open the season.
- He pitched six innings without allowing an earned run and did not walk anybody.
- Bertrand struck out eight batters, one shy of his career high.
- David LaManna led the Irish at the plate with two hits and two RBI. His two-RBI single in the fourth inning extended the Irish lead.
- Following Bertrand on the mound, graduate transfer Ryan McLinskey made his Irish debut in the seventh inning.
- He pitched the final three innings without allowing an earned run or a walk and struckout six to earn the save.
- The Irish did not walk a batter in the win, the second-straight season the Irish had a game without allowing a walk.

2022 Team Captains

- Jared Miller, Carter Putz, David LaManna, Aidan Tyrell and John Michael Bertrand were voted captains by their teammates for the upcoming season.
- Miller is a graduate student and is a two-time team captain after being voted a captain ahead of the 2021 season. He played in 138 games heading into the season in his Irish career. Miller set career highs in 2021 in batting average (.257), home runs (4) and RBI (24).
- Putz is a senior that has played in 110 games in his career heading into the season. He played and started all 47 games last season and tied for the team lead with 57 hits and was second on the team in batting average (.305). He earned second team All-ACC accolades after the regular season and was one of six Irish named to the South Bend Regional All-Tournament Team.
- LaManna is a graduate student who has played in 149 games heading into the season. In 2021, he played in 44 games, made 39 starts and set careerbest marks with five home runs, 29 RBI and 21 runs scored. LaManna also finished with a career-best fielding percentage of .997 after committing just two errors in 329 chances.
- Tyrell is a senior who has played in 31 games and made nine starts heading into the season. He

finished the 2021 season with career-best numbers across the board in ERA (2.70), wins (5), innings pitched (60.0) and strikeouts (43). His two best starts came in the postseason when he set a career high with 8.0 innings pitched in the regionalclinching win over Central Michigan. Then, he tied a career high with six strikeouts to extend the Irish season in the 9-1 win over Mississippi State.

 Bertrand is a graduate student who has played in 50 career games and made 38 starts heading into the season. He set career-highs in innings pitched (92.2), strikeouts (68) and wins (8) during the 2021 campaign. He led the Irish in all three categories and was named first team All-ACC. Heading into this season, Bertrand was named a third team All-American by Perfect Game and NCBWA.

Lethal Lineup is Back for 2022

- Coming off the most successful season in almost 20 years, a strong portion of the 2021 starting lineup returns for the Irish.
- Notre Dame returned eight of the nine every day starters from the 2021 lineup.
- That group accounted for 358 games started (84.6%) out of 423 from 2021.
- Notre Dame also returned four players that started all 47 games last season (Spencer Myers, Zack Prajzner, Jack Brannigan and Carter Putz).
- The production returning from that group included 85.5% of runs scored (284/332), 86.9% of hits (392/451), 75.3% of runs batted in (232/308) and 65.2% of home runs hit (43/66) from the 2021 season.
- Each of the eight returning starters hit at least four home runs in 2021 and five of those eight had six or more.
- Ryan Cole led the returners with a career-high nine home runs from 2021. Heading into the 2021 season, Cole had not hit a home run in his career.
- Spencer Myers and Carter Putz both had a teamhigh 57 hits in 2021.
- Myers was the leading stolen base returner after swiping 15 bags last season.

Weekend Rotation Returns

- Much like the lineup, the Irish returned all three starting pitchers from the weekend rotation in 2021.
- LHP John Michael Bertrand, LHP Aidan Tyrell and LHP Will Mercer returned 209.1 innings pitched from last season, 17 combined wins and four saves.
- Bertrand led the way for the Irish in 2021 with a team-high 92.2 innings pitched, eight wins and 68 strikeouts to just 22 walks.
- He was named First Team All-ACC following the regular season after he threw the most innings by

an Irish pitcher since 2013.

- Bertrand threw a complete-game shutout in the postseason opener against Central Michigan, the first Irish complete game shutout in the postseason since the 2000 season. Bertrand had three complete games during the 2021 season.
- Heading into 2022, Bertrand was named a Third Team Preseason All-American by Perfect Game and the NCBWA.
- Tyrell tossed the best game of his Irish career in his final start of 2021. He threw 7.1 innings and allowed just one run to keep Notre Dame's season alive in the 9-1 win over Mississippi State in the Starkville Super Regional. He tied a career high with six strikeouts in the win.
- The week prior in the South Bend Regional, he set a career high with 8.0 innings pitched in the 14-2 regional-clinching win over Central Michigan.
- Mercer also had one his best starts of his Irish career in the postseason. He set a career high 7.0 innings pitched in the 26-3 win over UConn in the South Bend Regional.

Transfer Arms Add Wealth of Experience

- Similar to the 2021 season, the Irish bring in a strong stable of graduate transfer pitchers with a wealth of Division I experience.
- The trio of RHP Austin Temple, LHP Matt Lazzaro and RHP Ryan McLinskey combined threw 412.0 innings pitched in collegiate baseball before coming to the Irish.
- Temple began his career at Jacksonville. He threw 132.2 career innings with an 8-7 record with 124 strikeouts to 76 walks in four years with the Dolphins. He was named to the 2021 Preseason ASUN team before missing much of the season due to injury.
- Lazzaro played at Houston last season and beginning his collegiate career with John Michael Bertrand at Furman. He totaled 151.0 innings pitched prior to Notre Dame, four wins and a save to go with 114 strikeouts and 50 walks.
- McLinskey began his collegiate career at Seton Hall. He threw 128.1 career innings with a 7-5 record and one save with 142 strikeouts and 57 walks prior to Notre Dame. He was the Pirates Friday starter last season and ranked sixth in the BIG EAST with a 2.81 ERA.

Season to Remember in 2021

- In Link Jarrett's first full season at the helm of the Irish, they had their most successful season in almost 20 years.
- The Irish scored 19 runs in the series-sweeping win over North Carolina on May 2. It was the most runs they have scored in a conference game since joining the league in 2014.

- Notre Dame claimed its first ACC regular season title since joining the league and first regular season title since 2006.
- The Irish won 25 conference games in 2021 to tie the program record for most conference wins in a single season with the 1990 squad that won 25 games in the Mid-Western Collegiate Conference.
- They hosted a regional at Frank Eck Stadium for the first time since 2004 and won a regional for the first time since 2002.
- In the South Bend Regional, the Irish set a postseason record with 26 runs scored against UConn. It beat the previous postseason record of 25 runs against South Alabama in 2002.
- Niko Kavadas broke the program record for most home runs in a single season during the regional. He finished the season with 22 home runs, surpassing Frank Jacobs record of 20 from 1991.
- The Irish finished the season with a 34-13 (.723) record, their highest winning percentage in a single season since 2004 (.810).

2021 MLB Draft

- Two of the main cogs of the successful 2021 Irish baseball team heard their names called in the 2021 MLB Draft.
- RHP Tanner Kohlhepp was selected by the Detroit Tigers in the fifth round of the draft with the 135th overall pick.
- Kohlhepp was the highest drafted pitcher for the Irish since Peter Solomon was selected in the fourth round by the Astros in 2017.
- Kohlhepp led the Irish in appearances with 23 while finishing second in wins (7), innings pitched (61.1) and strikeouts (65).
- He earned third team All-American honors from D1Baseball following the season, the second year in a row an Irish pitcher earned All-American honors
- Slugger Niko Kavadas was selected by the Boston Red Sox in the 11th round with the 316th overall pick.
- Kavadas set the program record for most home runs in a single season with 22 in 2021.
- Kavadas finished the year with a .767 slugging percentage, which ranks second all-time in program history for a single season. Niko is also tied for second all-time for home runs in a career with 46.
- After the season, Kavadas was named a First Team All-American by D1Baseball, Baseball America and Perfect Game.
- He was the first Irish player to earn multiple first team honors in the same season since Steve Stanley in 2002.


