BY THE NUMBERS

.714	Notre Dame is 50-20 (.714) away from Frank Eck Stadium under head coach Link Jarrett. In 2022, the Irish are 10-8 in true road games and 11-3 in neutral site games.
.741	The Irish are 83-29 (.741) since the start of the 2020 season. That winning percentage ranks second in the NCAA over the past three seasons, trailing only Tennessee.
.980	Notre Dame is 14th in the NCAA and first in the ACC in fielding percentage with a .980 mark this season. The Irish have committed 39 errors in 1,394 putout opportunities this season.
1	The Irish swept #5 Florida State on the road from April 1-3 (2-0 (12), 5-4, 9-7). It was the first time the Irish have swept a Top-5 team on the road in program history.
1.27	Notre Dame is 10th in the NCAA and first in the ACC with a 1.27 WHIP this season. They have surrendered 393 hits and 197 walks in 464.2 innings pitched.
3	Notre Dame is one of three teams (Tennessee and Texas) to go undefeated in the Regional Round in each of the last two seasons.
3.82	The Irish rank seventh nationally and are first in the ACC in team ERA with 3.82. They have given up 197 earned runs in 464.2 innings this season.
6	The Irish are one of six teams nationally to be ranked in every D1 Baseball poll this season. They are the only ACC team that has been ranked in every poll this year.
7	The Irish allowed seven runs in the three games of the Statesboro Regional. It is the second-fewest runs allowed by a team in the Regional Round this season (Texas, 6).
7.61	The Irish are seventh in the NCAA and first in the ACC with 7.61 hits allowed per nine innings. They have given up 393 hits in 464.2 innings pitched this season.
11.0	The Irish rank fourth in the NCAA and first in the ACC in strikeouts per nine innings with 11.0. The Irish pitching staff has struck out 569 batters in 464.2 innings this season.
11	The Irish scored 11 runs in the sixth inning against Boston College, the most in a single inning this season. It was the most runs in an inning since April 24, 2021, when the Irish scored 12 runs in the eighth inning against Boston College.
12	John Michael Bertrand set a career high with 12 strikeouts against #5 Florida State on April 1. It was the most strikeouts in a game for an Irish pitcher since Cameron Brown struck out 12 against Florida State on March 23, 2019.
12.0	John Michael Bertrand (7.2 IP), Ryan McLinskey (1.2 IP), Aidan Tyrell (1.0) and Alex Rao (1.2 IP) combined to shutout #5 Florida State in 12.0 innings in the 2-0 Irish win on April 1. It was the first time in program history that the Seminoles had been shutout in an extra inning game.
19	The Irish tied the program record for most strikeouts in a game with 19 in the win over #24 Texas Tech on June 3. They tied the record that was set back on April 16, 1958 in a walk-off 12-10 win over Indiana.
27	The Irish allowed three runs or less for the 27th time this season in the 2-1 win over #24 Texas Tech on June 5. They are 27-0 this season and 53-2 overall under Jarrett in games they allow three runs or less.
63	Outfielder Spencer Myers has 63 steals in his Irish career and ranks seventh all-time in program history for career steals. He trails Dan Bautch by five for sixth place in program history.
569	The Irish set a program record for the strikeouts as they are at 569 heading into the Knoxville Super Regional. They surpassed the previous record of 504 in the ACC Championship win over Florida State.

Irish Battle Top-Ranked Volunteers in Super Regional

- Notre Dame is off to the third Super Regional in program history as they travel to Knoxville to take on No. 1 Tennessee.
- The Irish have made the super-regional round for the second-straight season for the first time in program history.
- They are one of seven teams this year that have made the supers in back-to-back seasons.
- Notre Dame is just one of three teams (Tennessee and Texas) that have gone undefeated in the Regional Round in each of the past two seasons.
- The Irish allowed just seven runs in the three games at the Statesboro Regional. It was the second fewest runs scored in the Regional Round behind Texas (6).
- All three of Notre Dame's wins in the regional came against ranked teams (#24 Texas Tech (2x) and #21 Georgia Southern).
- The Knoxville Super Regional is matching up two of the most successful teams over the past three seasons. Tennessee ranks first (.818) and the Irish are second (.741) in total winning percentage since the start of the 2020 season.
- The top-ranked Volunteers come into the matchup 56-7 on the season and they went 25-5 in SEC play. They won the regular season and SEC Tournament championship this year.
- In the Knoxville Regional, they defeated Alabama State 10-0, Campbell 12-7 and Georgia Tech 9-6.
- Tennessee is 37-3 in games at home this season and the Irish are 10-8 in true road games and 21-11 in games away from Frank Eck Stadium.
- The Volunteers bring one of the top offenses in the country into the weekend as the lead the NCAA in home runs (150), runs (592) and slugging percentage (.607). Tennessee also leads the nation in ERA (2.38), hits allowed per nine innings (6.34) and WHIP (0.980).
- The Irish also have one of the best pitching staffs in the country heading into the weekend. They rank fourth in strikeouts per nine innings (11.0), seventh in ERA (3.72) and hits allowed per nine innings (7.61) and 10th in WHIP (1.27).
- This will be the second time in program history that the Irish will face the No. 1 overall seed in the Super Regionals. Back in 2002, Notre Dame traveled to Tallahassee to face the top-ranked Seminoles in the supers. The Irish won the first and third game to advance to the College World Series for the second time in program history.

Irish Advance to Second Straight Super Regional after 2-1 Win Over #24 Texas Tech

- The Irish finished off the Statesboro Regional in dramatic fashion with the 2-1 win over #24 Texas Tech in the Regional Final.

- The Red Raiders loaded the bases in the eighth and ninth inning but Jack Findlay got out of both jams to secure the win for the Irish.
- In the ninth with two outs, he got Jace Jung to ground out to Carter Putz to end the game and advance the Irish to the Super Regional.
- John Michael Bertrand got the start and went 7.2 innings and allowed just one run against the potent Red Raider lineup.
- He pitched a total of 8.2 innings over the weekend and allowed just one run and was named the Statesboro Regional Most Outstanding Player.
- Bertrand eclipsed the 100 strikeout mark in the win, the first Irish pitcher since David Phelps in 2007 to have more than 100 strikeouts in a single season.
- Bertrand has 103 strikeouts on the season, the sixth-most in program history for a single season.
- Ryan Cole drove in both runs for the Irish. His RBI single in the third scored Spencer Myers and he beat out an infield single in the fourth to score Zack Prajzner.

Irish Take Down Hosts No. 16 Georgia Southern, 6-4

- The Irish overcame two separate deficits to defeat Georgia Southern, 6-4, and advance to the Regional Final.
- Trailing 1-0 in the fourth, the Irish hit solo home runs to take their first lead of the game.
- Jack Zyska tied the game with his 11th home run of the season and Jack Brannigan gave the Irish the lead with his 10th of the year.
- Georgia Southern scored three in the sixth to regain the lead but it did not last long.
- The Irish tied the game in the bottom of the sixth after a two-run home run from Zack Prajzner.
- The score stayed tied until the seventh as Notre Dame scored two runs on hit-by-pitches with the bases loaded.
- Georgia Southern brought the go-ahead run to the plate in the eighth but Jack Findlay got three-straight outs to get the Irish out of the jam.
- He set the Eagles down in order in the ninth to earn his first career save and advance the Irish to the Regional Final.

Irish Outlast #24 Red Raiders in Regional Opener

- The Irish battled the elements and the Red Raiders as they opened the Statesboro Regional with a 3-2 win over Texas Tech.
- David LaManna got the Irish started in the bottom of the first with a ground rule double that scored two on the play.
- Right after his hit, the game went into a weather delay that lasted nearly six hours.
- As play resumed, Liam Simon and Alex Rao anchored the Irish over the middle portion of the game.

- The duo tossed 6.0 innings and combined for 15 strikeouts and just one run allowed.
- After the Red Raiders tied the game in the top of the eighth, Notre Dame got the lead back in the bottom of the inning.
- Pinch-runner Jared Miller stole third and then came home on a wild pitch to regain the lead.
- Will Mercer, Jackson Dennies and Aidan Tyrell all got a single out in the ninth to close the door and advance the Irish to the winner's bracket.

Jack Findlay Named Freshman All-American

- Left-handed pitcher Jack Findlay was named a Freshman All-American by Collegiate Baseball heading into the Super Regionals.
- In his first collegiate season, he has a 5-2 record with two saves and a 2.11 ERA over 38.1 innings. He has made 16 appearances and eight starts with 44 strikeouts and just 12 walks.
- Two of his most important appearances this season have come in the postseason at the Statesboro Regional.
- He collected his first career save against No. 21 Georgia Southern after 2.0 innings of work and entered the game with the winning run at the plate.
- In the Regional Final, he earned his second-straight save after getting the final four outs of the game. The Red Raiders had the bases loaded in the eighth and the ninth but Findlay protected the one-run lead to advance the Irish to the Super Regionals.
- Findlay is the first Irish player to be named a Freshman All-American since Jack Brannigan in 2020.

Among the Nation's Best

- Since the start of the 2020 season, the Irish have been one of the most consistent teams over the past three seasons.
- Notre Dame is 83-29, good for a .741 winning percentage over that period.
- That ranks second overall in the NCAA, trailing only Tennessee.

Irish Finish Pool Play Undeclared with 3-0 Shutout of #15 Virginia

- The Irish closed out pool play with one of its best pitching performances of the season in the 3-0 win over #15 Virginia.
- It was the third time the Irish have shut out an ACC opponent this season and the first time Virginia has been shut out since March 5, 2021.
- Liam Simon had a career day with 5.0 innings pitched and he tied a career high with eight strikeouts.
- 4 different Irish relievers combined for the final four innings with Aidan Tyrell earning the save in the final inning.
- The Irish scored runs in the second, fourth and sixth to secure the win.
- It was the 25th time the Irish have limited their opponent to three or less runs this season and they are 25-0 in those games.

Irish Advance to Semifinals with 5-3 win over Florida State

- The Irish advanced to the ACC semifinals for the first time in program history after the 5-3 win over Florida State to begin pool play.
- John Michael Bertrand stymied the Seminoles for the second time this season as he tossed 8.0 innings of work and allowed just one unearned run and struck out seven.
- Over the two starts this season against the Seminoles, he has pitched 15.2 innings and has not allowed an earned run. He has struck out 20 batters over the two appearances.
- The Irish bats got the long ball working against first team All-ACC pitcher Parker Messick.
- The Irish hit three home runs against Messick, tied for the most Messick has allowed in a start in his career.
- Zack Prajzner hit a solo shot in the third, Jack Zyska hit a two-run blast in the fourth and Brooks Coetzee III also hit a two-run shot in the fifth.
- The Seminoles attempted to rally in the ninth with the go-ahead run at the plate but Alex Rao recorded the final out for the save.

- The Irish had two players selected to the All-Conference teams as John Michael Bertrand was named to the first team and Ryan Cole was named to the third team.
- It is the second-straight season Bertrand has earned first team All-ACC honors.
- He is the first Irish pitcher to earn first team all-conference honors in back-to-back seasons since 1999-01 when Aaron Heilman did it in three-straight seasons back in the BIG EAST.
- Heading into the conference tournament, Bertrand leads the Irish in wins (7), innings pitched (82.1), strikeouts (86) and ERA among starters (2.68).
- He finished the regular season third in the ACC in ERA, fifth in innings pitched, sixth in wins and batting average against (.218) and seventh in strikeouts.
- His strikeout and wins total for the season are already career-best marks for Bertrand.
- Cole leads the team in steals (18) and ranks second in home runs (9) and hits (53).
- His 18 steals ranks fourth in the ACC and is already a career-best mark for him.
- Cole is the first Irish outfielder to earn all-conference honors since 2018 when Eric Gilgenbach and Matt Vierling were named to the all-conference teams.

Irish Shut Out #9 Miami

- The Irish had another stellar pitching performance in the 5-0 win over #9 Miami to even the series on May 20.
- Austin Temple logged his longest start against an ACC opponent after pitching 6.0 innings of scoreless work and he allowed just one hit and five strikeouts.
- The one hit ties a season-best for Temple in a start. He allowed just one hit against Minnesota back in March.
- Matt Bedford, Will Mercer and Alex Rao took care of the final nine outs to secure the win for the Irish. It was the first time Miami had been shut out this season.
- At the plate, Notre Dame hit three home runs for the sixth time this season to supply the offense.
- Jack Zyska launched his ninth home run of the season in the second, Jack Brannigan hit his seventh home run in the fifth and Jack Penney launched his second home run of the season in the eighth.
- It was the third time this season the Irish have shut out an opponent and the 23rd time they have allowed three runs or less.

ACC Dominance

- Since Link Jarrett arrived in South Bend, the Irish have been the class of the conference over the past two-plus seasons.

Bertrand and Cole Earn All-ACC Honors

AT A GLANCE

- Notre Dame is 44-21 (.694) in ACC games since 2020, the best winning percentage of any school in the conference.
- The 44 conference wins over the last three seasons are the most by any school in the league.
- The Irish are 17-4-1 in ACC series over that time and eight of the 17 series wins have been sweeps.
- The eight ACC sweeps eclipses the seven sweeps the Irish had over the six seasons prior to Jarrett when they joined the conference in 2014.
- In 2022, the Irish went 6-3 in ACC series with four of the series wins coming via a sweep. They swept No. 17 Wolfpack in an abbreviated two-game series on the road, swept the fifth-ranked Seminoles in Tallahassee and swept Clemson and Wake Forest at home.

Offensive Outburst Leads Irish Past Northwestern, 14-4

- The Irish offense started the last road trip of the regular season with a bang as they took down Northwestern 14-4.
- The Irish finished off their non-conference slate against the Wildcats and went 17-2 in non-conference games this season.
- It was also the seventh time the Irish faced a Big 10 opponent this year and they were 6-1 in those games.
- The Irish scored in double-figures for the 16th time this season and it was the 10th time they did it against a non-conference opponent.
- The Irish put the game away early with crooked numbers in four-straight innings starting in the second.
- They scored four runs in the second, three in the third, four in the fourth and two in the fifth.
- All nine starters recorded a hit and David LaManna and Ryan Cole led the way with a team-high three hits each.
- A trio of Irish led the way with team-high three runs in LaManna, Jack Zyska and Jack Brannigan.
- Brannigan stole home for the third time in his career. He has stolen home in each of his first three collegiate seasons.
- Zack Prajzner hit the lone long ball of the game as he tied a career high with 4 RBI.
- Radek Birkholz picked up his first collegiate victory after pitching 1.1 innings of scoreless relief.
- The Irish amassed 16 hits in just seven innings as the game ended via run rule after the seventh

inning.

- It was the 23rd game this season the Irish have had 10 hits or more and the seventh time it has occurred in the last eight games.

Irish Clinch Another ACC Series in 8-1 Win Over Pitt

- The Irish had another strong performance on the mound and at the plate in the 8-1 win over Pitt to clinch the series.
- With the win, the Irish secured their sixth ACC series win of the season and improved to 7-1-1 under head coach Link Jarrett in home ACC series over the past two seasons.
- The Irish had a balanced approach at the plate as nine different players recorded a hit and they scored in five of the eight innings.
- Jack Penney tied a career-high with two hits and he led the team on the day with David LaManna and Zack Prajzner also having multi-hit games.
- On the mound, Austin Temple set a career high with 10 strikeouts over the first four innings of the game.
- Temple had two strikeouts in the first and second inning while he had three strikeouts in the third and the fourth.
- Will Mercer earned the win after tossing 3.1 innings of scoreless relief. He allowed only two hits and no walks in his outing.
- It was the 22nd time the Irish have limited their opponents to three runs or less this season and the Irish are 22-0 in those games.

Coetzee III, Bertrand Push Irish Past Panthers

- Brooks Coetzee III and John Michael Bertrand led the Irish to an 8-3 win in the series opener against Pitt.
- Coetzee III got hits in his first three at-bats at the plate, including his team-high 10th home run in the fourth inning.
- It was the second-straight game with a home run for Coetzee III and he finished 3-for-4 from the plate with two runs and two RBI.
- Bertrand picked up his seventh win of the season after 7.0 innings of work and he allowed just two runs, now walks and tallied nine strikeouts.
- It was the fifth time this season Bertrand has gone 7.0 innings or longer and the eighth start this year he has given up two earned runs or less.
- It was also the fifth time this season Bertrand has struck out eight or more batters and the third time he has done it against an ACC opponent.

Home Sweet Home

- After not being able to play a home game in his first season due to the pandemic, the Irish have been dominant at Frank Eck Stadium over the past two seasons.
- The Irish hold a 33-10 (.767) record at home under Link Jarrett and are 17-3 (.850) in home games

during the 2022 season.

- The 17 wins at home this season are the most in a single season since 2017 when the Irish won 18 games at Frank Eck Stadium.
- Notre Dame is 8-1-1 in home ACC series since Jarrett took over and three of those eight series wins have been sweeps.
- They are undefeated in home midweek matchups over the past two seasons. They won all three home midweeks in 2020 and went 8-0 this season in midweek matchups. The Irish also swept all three games of the 2021 South Bend Regional at Frank Eck Stadium.
- Earlier in the season, the Irish had an 11-game winning streak at home. It was the longest home-winning streak in a single season since 2006 when the Irish won 20-straight games at home.

Big Innings Lead Irish Past Spartans

- The Irish claimed the season series over Michigan State with the 15-6 win at Frank Eck Stadium on May 10. The Irish defeated the Spartans in two of the three matchups across the year.
- It was the third-straight game and 14th time this season the Irish scored in double-digits.
- Two big innings propelled the Irish to the midweek victory and it started with six runs in the third.
- Ryan Cole blasted his seventh home run of the season to open the scoring in the third.
- Back-to-back doubles from Carter Putz and Jack Zyska scored three runs and Spencer Myers plated the final run on his bases-loaded walk.
- A five-run inning in the seventh put the game out of reach. The Irish had RBI doubles by Putz and Zyska and RBI singles by Coetzee and LaManna.
- On the mound, Jack Findlay had the best start of his young career. He set careers highs with 4.0 innings pitched and eight strikeouts.
- He improved to 5-0 this season and is the second Irish pitcher to start the season 5-0 this year (John Michael Bertrand began the year 6-0).
- Matt Bedford made his first career appearance in the win. He tossed 2.0 innings of work with two strikeouts.
- After the third and seventh inning, the Irish have had 18 separate innings this year in which they have scored five or more runs.
- This was the third game this season that they had two innings of five runs or more in the same game.

11-Run Inning Propels Irish to Series Win Over Boston College

- In their first rubber game of the season, the Irish jumped out to an early lead on Boston College with a 5-2 advantage heading into the sixth inning.
- Boston College took their first lead of the game

after plating six runs in the frame and held an 8-5 lead.

- The Irish responded in a big way, scoring 11 runs in the bottom half of the inning to take control of the game and eventually led to the 16-10 victory to clinch the series.
- After trailing for the first time in the game, the first four batters in the bottom of the sixth reached base and three of them scored to tie the game at 8-8.
- The Eagles got an out in the inning but the next two runners reached to load the bases for Jared Miller.
- He smashed his first career grand slam, the second slam for the Irish in as many games, to put the Irish back in front for good at 12-8.
- Notre Dame was not done in the inning as they hit two more home runs, an inside-the-park home run from Ryan Cole and a two-run shot by Jack Zyska, to grow the lead to 16-8.
- The 11 runs in the inning were the most for the Irish this season and the most since April 24, 2021, when they scored 12 runs in the eighth against Boston College.
- The Irish hit three home runs in the sixth inning, the most in a single inning since June 4, 2021 when the Irish hit three home runs in the sixth inning against Central Michigan in the South Bend Regional.
- With the win, the Irish clinched their fifth ACC series win of the season.
- They scored in double-figures for the second-straight game and 14th time this season. It was also the sixth time they have scored in double-digits against an ACC opponent.

Big Opening Inning Leads Irish Past Eagles

- After dropping the first game of the series, the Irish responded with a dominant 11-5 win to even the series.
- The Irish got off to a fast start and scored eight runs in the first inning on Saturday.
- The Irish had three straight hits to start the game and followed with four-straight singles to load the bases.
- Zack Prajzner unloaded for his first career grand slam to put the cap on the eight run-first inning.
- The eight runs ties for the most runs in a single inning for the Irish this season. They scored eight runs in the third inning against Elon.
- Jack Brannigan hit the second home run of the afternoon and his sixth of the season in the fifth inning to extend the Irish lead.
- Brannigan led the way at the plate with a 4-for-4 showing and he tied a career high in hits and runs with three.
- Eight of the nine starters got hits on the afternoon and all nine starters reached base.
- It was the 13th time this season the Irish have

scored in double-digits and the fifth time they have done it against an ACC opponent.

Irish Complete Comeback to Sweep Wake Forest

- The Irish overcame a six-run deficit in the fifth and four-run deficit in the seventh to walk-off Wake Forest 13-12 on April 24 to sweep the series.
- The Irish never led the entire game until the bottom of the ninth when Carter Putz singled up the middle and Brooks Coetzee III scored the game-winning run from second.
- The run capped the fourth ACC sweep of the season for the Irish, the most in a single season since joining the conference in 2014.
- It is the most conference sweeps in a single season since 2006 when the Irish swept five series in the BIG EAST.
- The Irish totaled 42 runs in the series against Wake Forest, setting the program record for most runs in an ACC series. The previous record was 36 last season against North Carolina.
- It was the most runs in a three-game conference series since 1993 when the Irish scored 48 runs in a sweep of Dayton when they were members of the Midwestern Collegiate Conference.
- Jack Zyska had the best game of his career in the win as he was one of the main catalysts in the comeback.
- He hit two home runs in the game for the first time in his career and tied a career high with four RBI.
- His second home run of the game was a three-run shot in the seventh that tied the game up at 12-12, the first time the game was tied since the first inning.
- Eight of the nine starters got hits in the game, all nine starters reached base and six had multi-hit games in the comeback win.
- Zack Prajzner tied a career high with three runs for the second-straight game and Brooks Coetzee III also tied a career high with three runs.

Irish Set Program Record in Series-Clinching Win over Wake Forest

- The Irish set a program record as they clinched another ACC series in the 21-3 win over Wake Forest.
- The 21 runs were the most in program history in an ACC game since joining the conference in 2014. The previous high was 19 last season against North Carolina.
- It was the most runs in a conference game since 2008 when the Irish scored 25 against Georgetown back in the BIG EAST.
- The Irish scored in seven of the eight innings at the plate in the win and scored multiple runs in five of those innings.
- The Irish hit four home runs on the afternoon, the most home runs in a game since they hit four in

the 8-1 win over Clemson on April 9.

- David LaManna hit his first home run of the season and Brady Gumpf tallied his first career home run in the win. Zack Prajzner and Jack Brannigan also hit home runs in the game.
- 11 different players recorded a hit in the win and six players had multi-hit games.
- Carter Putz tied a career high with four hits and LaManna set a career high with four RBI. Prajzner tied a career high with three runs.
- It was the third-straight game and the 20th time this season the Irish limited their opponents to three runs or fewer.
- The win clinched the fourth ACC series this season for the Irish and the 17th overall series victory under head coach Link Jarrett.
- The Irish are 17-3-1 all-time in regular season series the past two-plus seasons under Jarrett.

Irish Blow By Demon Deacons in Series-Opening Win

- The Irish battled the conditions in the 8-3 series-opening win over Wake Forest.
- They survived a 1:10 rain delay and got out of a bases-loaded jam when play resumed after the delay.
- In the final two innings at the plate, the Irish scored four runs to put the game out of reach.
- John Michael Bertrand had another strong outing on the mound for the Irish. He went 6.0 innings and allowed just one earned run.
- It was the eighth start this season he has pitched 6.0 innings or more and seventh start this year he has given up one earned run or less.
- Jack Zyska tied a career high with a team-high three hits at the plate and David LaManna added two runs and two hits.
- It was the third-straight game and the 19th time this season the Irish limited their opponents to three runs or fewer.

Blasts Lift Irish Past Purdue Fort Wayne

- Home runs and strong pitching were key in Notre Dame's 12-2 win over Purdue Fort Wayne on April 20.
- Liam Simon tossed a career-best 4.0 innings pitched and tied a career high with eight strikeouts and no walks to start the game.
- Jack Findlay followed with a career high four strikeouts and tied a career high with 3.0 innings pitched.
- Radek Birkholz and Matt Lazzaro combined for the final two innings and allowed just two hits.
- It was the second-straight game and 18th time this season the Irish have held their opponents to three runs or fewer.
- The Irish improved to 7-0 in midweek games with the win and they are 12-0 all-time in midweek contests under head coach Link Jarrett.
- At the plate, the Irish scored in each of the last

- At the plate, Carter Putz and Ryan Cole put together multi-hit games and Jack Penney tallied his first career home run.

Myers Slam Carries Irish over Michigan, 14-5

- Notre Dame finished the five-game homestand in style with a 14-5 win over rival Michigan on April 10.
- The win extended the Irish win streak to nine games and they improved to 5-0 in midweek games this season.
- The Irish broke out for five runs in the second and did not look back to improve to 7-1 at home this year.
- Spencer Myers hit his first career grand slam in the second to give the Irish an early lead they would not relinquish. He finished with a career high four RBI to lead the team.
- Zack Prajzner and Brooks Coetzee III both added three RBI each at the plate in the win.
- The offensive outburst was the ninth time this season the Irish have scored 10 or more runs in a game.
- On the mound, sophomore Jackson Dennies picked up his first career win after 1.2 innings of relief.

Road Warriors

- The Irish have been known to be a tough out on the road under head coach Link Jarrett.
- Notre Dame is a combined 32-13 on the road and have won 11 of 13 regular season road series since

Jarrett came to South Bend in 2020.

- The Irish swept #5 Florida State on the road this season for their first road series sweep over a Top-5 team in program history.
- The Irish also earned their first series win in Tallahassee in program history with the sweep.
- In Jarrett's tenure, the Irish have won nine ACC road series, while also winning non-conference road series against UAB and Presbyterian in the 2020 season.
- Earlier this season, the Irish won their eighth-straight ACC road series to set a program record for most consecutive conference road series wins.
- It broke the previous record set by the 1991-93 squads that won seven-consecutive conference series while in the Mid-Western Collegiate Conference.

Irish Sweep Tigers with 9-3 Win

- Notre Dame finished off its second-straight ACC sweep with a convincing 9-3 win over Clemson on April 10.
- They outscored the Tigers 21-5 in the series and limited Clemson to three runs or fewer in all three games.
- The Irish also never trailed against the Tigers at any point during the series and the score was tied for only two full innings the entire weekend.
- It was the 16th time this season the Irish have limited their opponent to three runs or fewer and they are 16-0 in those games this year.
- Carter Putz continued his torrid stretch at the plate, going 2-for-3 with three RBI. He finished the weekend series with eight RBI against the Tigers.
- Danny Neri tied a career high with three hits and tied a career-high with two runs.

- Nick Juaire and Danny Neri both hit their first career home runs in the win, while Brooks Coetzee III hit his team-leading seventh home run and Carter Putz hit his fifth of the year.

- Putz led the way at the plate for the Irish with a team-high three hits and he tied a career high with five RBI.
- Danny Neri also tallied three hits in a win, setting a new career high.
- Austin Temple earned his third win of the season following 5.1 scoreless innings of work. He tied a career high with nine strikeouts.

- The Spartans tied it in the seventh but it lasted only one batter in the bottom of the seventh as the Irish regained the lead.

- The Irish put up eight runs in the opening frame and never looked back as they scored the most runs in a regular season game since 2008.
- A number of Irish hitters got opportunities at the plate as 15 different players recorded a hit in the win.
- It was the most batters to get a hit in a game for the Irish over the last 16 seasons. The previous record was 13 against Georgetown in 2008.
- Ryan Cole led the Irish at the plate after going 3-for-3 with two runs and an RBI. DM Jefferson had a team-high 3 RBI in the win.
- On the mound, Aidan Tyrell improved to 2-0 after seven scoreless innings allowing just three hits, one walk and struck out five.
- Tyrell has not allowed a run in his 11.0 innings this season.
- Sammy Cooper made his collegiate debut out of the bullpen, tossing the final two innings, to close out the win.

Bats Power Irish to Season-Opening Win over Manhattan

- Notre Dame opened the 2022 season with a bang in the 17-2 win over Manhattan.
- It was the most runs scored in a season opener for the Irish since 2005 when they scored 18 against Florida A&M.
- The Irish tallied three triples in the game, including two in the first inning. It was the first time since April 3, 2016 against Wake Forest that the Irish had three triples in the same game.

- Brooks Coetzee III recorded his first multi-home run game in the win and set a career high with four hits.
- Coetzee III and Jack Brannigan both recorded 4 RBI in the win, the first time two players had 4 or more RBI in the same game since June 5, 2021 against UConn when Niko Kavadas tallied 8 and Ryan Cole had 6.
- The Irish totaled 19 hits in the win, the most since the UConn game when they had 21 during the South Bend Super Regional.
- LHP Aidan Tyrell got the win and tied a career high with six strikeouts. It was the second-straight start dating back to last season that Tyrell totaled six punchouts.
- Six different players made their Irish debuts in the win including DM Jefferson, Joey Spence, Jack Penney, Brady Gumpf, Nick DeMarco and Gerry Peacock.

Bertrand, McLinskey Too Much for Stetson

- In front of a sellout crowd in the second game of the Hatter Classic, the pitching duo of John Michael Bertrand and Ryan McLinskey shut down the hosts Stetson in the 5-3 Irish win.
- Bertrand picked up right where he left off in 2021 with a quality start to open the season.
- He pitched six innings without allowing an earned run and did not walk anybody.
- Bertrand struck out eight batters, one shy of his career high.
- David LaManna led the Irish at the plate with two hits and two RBI. His two-RBI single in the fourth inning extended the Irish lead.
- Following Bertrand on the mound, graduate transfer Ryan McLinskey made his Irish debut in the seventh inning.
- He pitched the final three innings without allowing an earned run or a walk and struckout six to earn the save.
- The Irish did not walk a batter in the win, the second-straight season the Irish had a game without allowing a walk.

2022 Team Captains

- Jared Miller, Carter Putz, David LaManna, Aidan Tyrell and John Michael Bertrand were voted captains by their teammates for the upcoming season.
- Miller is a graduate student and is a two-time team captain after being voted a captain ahead of the 2021 season. He played in 138 games heading into the season in his Irish career. Miller set career highs in 2021 in batting average (.257), home runs (4) and RBI (24).
- Putz is a senior that has played in 110 games in his career heading into the season. He played and started all 47 games last season and tied for the team lead with 57 hits and was second on the team in batting average (.305). He earned second team

All-ACC accolades after the regular season and was one of six Irish named to the South Bend Regional All-Tournament Team.

- LaManna is a graduate student who has played in 149 games heading into the season. In 2021, he played in 44 games, made 39 starts and set career-best marks with five home runs, 29 RBI and 21 runs scored. LaManna also finished with a career-best fielding percentage of .997 after committing just two errors in 329 chances.
- Tyrell is a senior who has played in 31 games and made nine starts heading into the season. He finished the 2021 season with career-best numbers across the board in ERA (2.70), wins (5), innings pitched (60.0) and strikeouts (43). His two best starts came in the postseason when he set a career high with 8.0 innings pitched in the regional-clinching win over Central Michigan. Then, he tied a career high with six strikeouts to extend the Irish season in the 9-1 win over Mississippi State.
- Bertrand is a graduate student who has played in 50 career games and made 38 starts heading into the season. He set career-highs in innings pitched (92.2), strikeouts (68) and wins (8) during the 2021 campaign. He led the Irish in all three categories and was named first team All-ACC. Heading into this season, Bertrand was named a third team All-American by Perfect Game and NCBWA.

Lethal Lineup is Back for 2022

- Coming off the most successful season in almost 20 years, a strong portion of the 2021 starting lineup returns for the Irish.
- Notre Dame returned eight of the nine every day starters from the 2021 lineup.
- That group accounted for 358 games started (84.6%) out of 423 from 2021.
- Notre Dame also returned four players that started all 47 games last season (Spencer Myers, Zack Prajzner, Jack Brannigan and Carter Putz).
- The production returning from that group included 85.5% of runs scored (284/332), 86.9% of hits (392/451), 75.3% of runs batted in (232/308) and 65.2% of home runs hit (43/66) from the 2021 season.
- Each of the eight returning starters hit at least four home runs in 2021 and five of those eight had six or more.
- Ryan Cole led the returners with a career-high nine home runs from 2021. Heading into the 2021 season, Cole had not hit a home run in his career.
- Spencer Myers and Carter Putz both had a team-high 57 hits in 2021.
- Myers was the leading stolen base returner after swiping 15 bags last season.

Transfer Arms Add Wealth of Experience

- Similar to the 2021 season, the Irish bring in a strong stable of graduate transfer pitchers with a wealth of Division I experience.

AT A GLANCE

- The trio of RHP Austin Temple, LHP Matt Lazzaro and RHP Ryan McLinskey combined threw 412.0 innings pitched in collegiate baseball before coming to the Irish.
- Temple began his career at Jacksonville. He threw 132.2 career innings with an 8-7 record with 124 strikeouts to 76 walks in four years with the Dolphins. He was named to the 2021 Preseason ASUN team before missing much of the season due to injury.
- Lazzaro played at Houston last season and beginning his collegiate career with John Michael Bertrand at Furman. He totaled 151.0 innings pitched prior to Notre Dame, four wins and a save to go with 114 strikeouts and 50 walks.
- McLinskey began his collegiate career at Seton Hall. He threw 128.1 career innings with a 7-5 record and one save with 142 strikeouts and 57 walks prior to Notre Dame. He was the Pirates Friday starter last season and ranked sixth in the BIG EAST with a 2.81 ERA.

Season to Remember in 2021

- In Link Jarrett's first full season at the helm of the Irish, they had their most successful season in almost 20 years.
- The Irish scored 19 runs in the series-sweeping win over North Carolina on May 2. It was the most runs they have scored in a conference game since joining the league in 2014.
- Notre Dame claimed its first ACC regular season title since joining the league and first regular season title since 2006.
- The Irish won 25 conference games in 2021 to tie the program record for most conference wins in a single season with the 1990 squad that won 25 games in the Mid-Western Collegiate Conference.
- They hosted a regional at Frank Eck Stadium for the first time since 2004 and won a regional for the first time since 2002.
- In the South Bend Regional, the Irish set a postseason record with 26 runs scored against UConn. It beat the previous postseason record of 25 runs against South Alabama in 2002.
- Niko Kavadas broke the program record for most home runs in a single season during the regional. He finished the season with 22 home runs, surpassing Frank Jacobs record of 20 from 1991.
- The Irish finished the season with a 34-13 (.723) record, their highest winning percentage in a single season since 2004 (.810).

2021 MLB Draft

- Two of the main cogs of the successful 2021 Irish baseball team heard their names called in the 2021 MLB Draft.
- RHP Tanner Kohlhepp was selected by the Detroit Tigers in the fifth round of the draft with the 135th overall pick.
- Kohlhepp was the highest drafted pitcher for

the Irish since Peter Solomon was selected in the fourth round by the Astros in 2017.

- Kohlhepp led the Irish in appearances with 23 while finishing second in wins (7), innings pitched (61.1) and strikeouts (65).
- He earned third team All-American honors from D1Baseball following the season, the second year in a row an Irish pitcher earned All-American honors
- Slugger Niko Kavadas was selected by the Boston Red Sox in the 11th round with the 316th overall pick.
- Kavadas set the program record for most home runs in a single season with 22 in 2021.
- Kavadas finished the year with a .767 slugging percentage, which ranks second all-time in program history for a single season. Niko is also tied for second all-time for home runs in a career with 46.
- After the season, Kavadas was named a First Team All-American by D1Baseball, Baseball America and Perfect Game.
- He was the first Irish player to earn multiple first team honors in the same season since Steve Stanley in 2002.

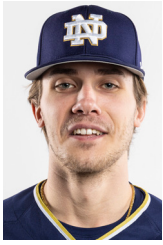

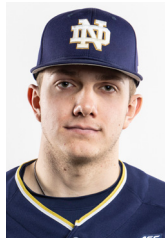
