


2022 Notre Dame Football Home Game Credentialed Media Information

- All media parking will be located in the IP (Innovation Park) lot. See the following maps (red square) for the IP lot location.

- The entrance to the IP Parking lot can only be accessed via Angela Boulevard.






- Credentialed media will receive their parking passes for each game via email. There are no physical parking passes for any credentialed media all parking passes are digital for 2022.
- All parking passes should be downloaded and added to your digital wallet before Saturday. We cannot guarantee that we can help with sending out additional parking passes or transfer requests on game day.



MEDIA WILL CALL:

• Media Will Call is located in the Joyce Center, just inside Gate 1.



- Will Call will open 4 ½ hours prior to the scheduled kickoff time (10 a.m. for 2:30 p.m kickoffs, 3 p.m. for 7:30 p.m. kickoffs).
- Media will be required to show identification to pick up credentials.
- Photographers and videographers credentialed for field access will be required to wear a photo vest, which can be picked up at Will Call inside Gate 1, then returned after the game at the press box entrance of Notre Dame Stadium (Door 4).

PRESS BOX ENTRANCE/HOURS OF ACCESS:

• The Notre Dame Stadium press box will open three hours prior to the scheduled kickoff time (11:30 a.m. for 2:30 p.m. kickoffs, 4:30 p.m. for 7:30 p.m. kickoffs).



- The press box will close one hour after the completion of the post game press conferences.
- The press box entrance is located at Door 4 of Notre Dame Stadium, directly across from Gate 1 of the Joyce Center (see map above).

WIFI ACCESS:

• Credentialed media can access the Notre Dame Stadium WiFi network via ND-guest or NDStadium17 networks. There is no login information required.

PHOTOGRAPHERS/VIDEOGRAPHERS:

- Credentialed photographers and videographers will be required to wear a photo vest at all times while on the playing field. The vest can be checked out at Gate 1 of the Joyce Center when credentials are picked up.
- Photographers and videographers are limited to gathering content on the field behind the dashed line outside the perimeter of the field and from the 18-yard line to the end zone and around the back of the end zone only. There is no access to the playing surface, past the dashed line before, during or after the game.
- The walkway behind each bench is for relocating to either end of the field. At no time should any photos or video be captured behind the bench areas.
- The photo work room is located just inside and to the left of Door 4 of Notre Dame Stadium (the press box entrance) Academic Commons 102. You will be able to return your photo vest in this area after the game is over.
- Photographers are not allowed to access the tunnel or the north tunnel gate area at any time after arrival to the Stadium through the end of the game until the teams exit the field.
- Photographers can access the field between section 7 and 8 and also between sections 12 and 13 on the east side of the Stadium.



- There are no on field interviews, live shots or video on demand stand ups at any time before, during or after the game in Notre Dame Stadium.
- You have three options for post game wrap up on-demand on-camera content - outside Gate B of Notre Dame Stadium (the Ara Parseghian Gate), at the main circle at the north end of Notre Dame Avenue, or on Level 9 of Corbett Hall (the press box) on the southernmost patio after completion of the post game press conferences.
- Live shots can be conducted outside Gate B or the main circle, we ask that all content gathered on Level 9 on the patio be live to tape only.

PRINT MEDIA:

- Press box access inside Door 4 of Notre Dame Stadium there are two elevator banks that can take you up to the press box (level 9), as well as an additional elevator around the corner to your right.
- Print media are assigned seats in the press box, please refer to a press box seating chart when you arrive in the press box.
- Flip cards will be available at each media members seat, game notes will not be printed but are available at **und.com/ndfbmedia**
- Live stats are available at und.com/mediastats
- Media members can access the field with five minutes remaining in the game between section 7 and 8. There is a designated space for media to stand while the game concludes between the Notre Dame team tunnel and the visiting team tunnel. No members of the media are allowed up the tunnel until both teams have cleared the field. There are no on field interviews allowed at any time, nor post game wrap ups allowed on the field after the conclusion of the game.
- Media members, including photographers, are not allowed to access the tunnel or the north tunnel gate area at any time until the completion of the game and the teams exit the tunnel.
- The media meal will begin one hour before kickoff, with full meal service wrapping up after halftime. Snacks will be available after halftime and pizza will be provided at the end of the game.



• The press box will close one hour after the post game press conferences end.




THE VICTORY MARCH:

- The Notre Dame football team will walk from The Basilica of the Sacred Heart, after finishing pregame mass, to Notre Dame Stadium before every game.
- Dubbed 'The Victory March,' the team will pause briefly in front of the Word of Life Mural (Touchdown Jesus) where Dick Corbett Head Football Coach Marcus Freeman will say a few words.
- There will be a roped off section for media members wishing to cover The Victory March at the basilica and in front of the small stage on the library quad.
- Media members will need to show their game credentials for access to the roped off areas.
- Credentialed media are limited to the two areas to capture content of the Victory March. At no time is any member of the credentialed media allowed to join in the walk or walk alongside the team, as part of the security group, along the route.
- No media member will be allowed to exit the field through the tunnel to capture The Victory March. You must exit through Door 4 of Notre Dame Stadium (the press box entrance) and walk around to the designated areas. See the map below, with the roped off areas indicated in blue boxes and the team route indicated by the red arrows.
- The Victory March will begin approximately 2 ¹/₂ hours before kickoff.
