DEBUTS

• Notre Dame debuts - Freshman tight end Eli Raridon, freshman tight end Holden Stayes

TYLER BUCHNER

- Tyler Buchner achieved new career highs for passing attempts (18), completions (32) passing yards (201) and rushing touchdowns (two) in today's game.
- The two-point conversion run by Buchner in the fourth guarter was the first for the Irish since a passing conversion (Jack Coan to Braden Lenzy) last season vs. Navy (November 6, 2021).

HOWARD CROSS III

- Howard Cross III far surpassed his previous career high in tackles (five) with a team-leading 11 this afternoon.
- It marks the first time an Irish defensive lineman had put up 10 or more tackles since Kurt Hinish against Navy last season (Nov. 6, 2020).

ISAIAH FOSKEY

• Isaiah Foskey's sack in the third quarter moved his career total to 16.5 and he is up to 11th all-time on the career sack chart behind Anthony Weaver (17, 1998-01).

BRANDON JOSEPH

- Brandon Joseph, with eight tackles in the game, made two big plays for the Irish this afternoon. His fourth down stop at 5:07 in the first quarter ended a Marshall drive, then he combined with JD Bertrand for a tackle on third down to force a punt at 10:40 of the second quarter.
- Joseph logged his first punt return in an Irish uniform, a 15-yard effort in the second half.

MICHAEL MAYER

- Tight end Michael Mayer collected his 120th career reception this afternoon, one of 11 Notre Dame players to reach that mark this century. The only other one to reach that mark in the last five years was Chase Claypool.
- Mayer's touchdown reception in the fourth quarter was the 10th of his career and he becomes just the third Irish tight end to reach double digit touchdown receptions in a career. He trails Ken MacAfee (15) and Tyler Eifert (11) on the career list for Notre Dame tight end touchdown receptions.
- Mayer logged his third career 100-yard receiving game with eight catches for 103 yards and one touchdown.

• Jon Sot's 61-yard punt in the second guarter is the best of his two-game Notre Dame career and the best for an Irish punter since Jay Bramblett has a 72-yard punt against Wisconsin last season.
