COUNTDOWN TO PUCK DROP

561	Head coach Jeff Jackson has 561 career wins, which ranks third among active NCAA Division I head coaches, spanning six seasons at Lake Superior State and now 18 seasons at Notre Dame. Jackson's win total ranks 10th all-time for most wins at the NCAA Division I level.
24	Twenty-four former Irish icers participated in NHL training camps ahead of the 2022-23 season, representing nearly half of the NHL franchises. The Toronto Maple Leafs saw a team-high four former ND players lace up their skates at their camp including Max Ellis, Matt Hellickson, Graham Slaggert and Alex Steeves.
19	The Irish return 19 letterwinners from the 2021-22 roster this season, including three graduate students in Nick Leivermann, Chase Blackmun and Jack Adams.
18	Head coach Jeff Jackson has guided his teams at Lake Superior State and Notre Dame to 18 NCAA Tournament appearances, including winning NCAA Championships with the Lakers in 1992 and 1994, while guiding the Irish to their only four Frozen Four appearances in program history: 2008, 2011, 2017 and 2018.
16	Sixteen sets of brothers have now suited up for the Irish, including current players, Landon Slaggert (brother Graham graduated in 2022), Trevor and Justin Janicke and Brady Bjork (brother Anders played 2014-17).
14	Fourteen former Fighting Irish players dressed in an NHL game last season: Anders Bjork (Buffalo Sabres), Ian Cole (Carolina Hurricanes), Jake Evans (Montreal Canadiens), Steven Fogarty (Boston Bruins), Jordan Gross (Colorado Avalanche) Vinnie Hinostroza (Buffalo Sabres), Anders Lee (New York Islanders), Kyle Palmieri (New York Islanders), Andrew Peeke (Columbus), Cal Petersen (Los Angeles Kings), Bryan Rust (Pittsburgh Penguins), Riley Sheahan (Seattle Kraken), Alex Steeves (Toronto Maple Leafs) and TJ Tyman (Los Angeles Kings).
10	Veteran leadership: Notre Dame's roster features 10 seniors and graduate students in 2022-23.
8	With the most recent being the 2019 Big Ten tournament title, Notre Dame has won eight conference championships in program history - each under Jeff Jackson (three regular-season).
7	Notre Dame advanced to a NCAA Regional Final for the seventh time in program history last season. The Irish are 4-2-0 in NCAA Regional Final games
6	Notre Dame has an active six-straight NCAA tournament appearances streak, including Frozen Four appearances in 2017 and 2018, which is the longest streak in program history and is the second-longest active streak in the NCAA.

NOTES

QUICK HITS

- The No. 12 Irish are coming off a weekend split with Western Michigan. Notre Dame picked up the victory at home Friday night with Ryan Bischel's first shutout of the season (2-0, 30 saves), before being shutout on the road at Lawson Ice Arena.
- In his first game of the season, captain Nick Leivermann tallied the game-winning goal Friday with a laser of a shot from the blueline. His first of the year was followed up by Justin Janicke netting an even strength goal at 18:13 of the second period to give ND the 2-0 final.
- Chayse Primeau registered an assist on both goals Friday night for his second-consecutive multi-point night. The grad student now has five points in his last four games played (1-4-5).
- The Irish picked up their first sweep of the season last weekend with a pair of home victories over Northern Michigan. Seven individuals found twine in the weekend series with the Wildcats, including Ryan Helliwell who scored his first collegiate goal. Drew Bavaro also scored for the first time with the Blue and Gold, breaking a 3-3 tie late in the third period Sunday to lift his team to victory.
- Solag Bakich net the first shorthanded goal of the season with Notre Dame's second goal Oct. 16. Landon Slaggert intercepted the puck at the blueline and sent it to Bakich on the breakaway to make it a 2-1 game late in the opening period.
- Primeau lit the lamp for his first goal of the season, and with the Irish, when he scored a powerplay goal Oct. 14 to open scoring against the Wildcats.
- Primeau, Lansdell and Rolston each boasted three points on the weekend, tallying a goal and two assists each.
- Drew Bavaro was named Big Ten Second Star of the Week following his performance in the NMU series.
- Everything College Hockey named Jake Boltmann defenseman of the week for his defensive efforts in the home opening series. Boltmann combined for 14 blocked shots over the weekend, including eight in the Irish's one-goal victory Oct. 16.

NOTRE DAME VS. MICHIGAN STATE

- The Irish and Spartans have met 135 times in program history with MSU leading the all-time series, 70-50-15. At home, Notre Dame holds a narrow margin over the Spartans, boasting 30 wins and 10 ties in 66 games played in South Bend.
- Most recently, the Irish defeated the Spartans at Munn Ice Arena to finish the 2021-22 season with a 3-1-0 record against their foe.
- In game one of the series last year, the Irish bounced back from an early 2-0 deficit to defeat the Spartans 3-2. Less than two minutes into play MSU led by two but a pair of second period goals from former defenseman Spencer Statsney knotted things up. Nick

Leivermann scored the game-winner halfway through the third period. Current Irish icers Jesse Lansdell, Hunter Strand, Jack Adams and Chase Blackmun also had points in the contest.

- In four games played against the Spartans last season, Strand led the team with four points (1-3-4). His two points at Michigan State off a goal and an assist was a career-best for the sophomore.
- Justin Janicke recorded a goal and an assist to close out the season series with the Spartans last year for a career-high two point night.

TEAM LEADERS

- Ryder Rolston’s three goals and three assists leads the Irish in points (six).
- Rolston’s three goals is also a team-best.
- Drew Bavaro and Chayse Primeau’s four assists are tied for the team lead.
- Trevor Janicke’s powerplay goal in game one against the Wildcats turned into the game-winner and was his second on the man-advantage this season. Jesse Lansdell and Nick Leivermann also hold game-winners.
- Always willing to jump in front of a shot, Jake Boltmann’s 18 blocks leads the team and is third nationally.

NATIONAL RECOGNITION

- Drew Bavaro was named Big Ten Second Star of the Week, Oct. 18, by the conference for his performance on both sides of the puck last weekend. The offensive defenseman had an assist on the game-winning-goal Friday night before scoring his first goal as a member of the Irish on Sunday. His late powerplay goal Sunday broke the tie and sparked an offensive push to secure the Notre Dame victory, 5-4. The junior extended his point-streak to four games to start the season, a career-best.
- For his play on the defensive side of the puck, Jake Boltmann was recognised by Everything College Hockey as “Sponge” of the Week. The sophomore blueliner blocked a nation’s best 14 pucks over the weekend series with NMU, including eight Sunday night.

ON THE RETURNERS

- With 19 returners in 2022-23, the Irish return 83 goals from last season and 65 percent of their total scoring.
- Three of last season’s top-five scorers will suit up for the blue and gold again this season, including top-scoring defenseman Nick Leivermann. The graduate student returns for his fifth season at Notre Dame and has appeared in 118 games in his collegiate career.
- The current roster includes 10 seniors and graduate students for a strong veteran core.

- Notre Dame is 49-35-0 all-time in the playoffs under head coach Jeff Jackson, including a 14-10-0 mark in NCAA play.

**HEAD COACH
JEFF JACKSON**



- The 2022–23 season marks University of Notre Dame hockey coach Jeff Jackson’s 18th season behind the Irish bench. During his first 17 seasons, the program has enjoyed a great deal of success, including four trips to the Frozen Four and eight conference championships.
- Jackson has over 30 years of coaching experience and led Notre Dame to back-to-back Big Ten tournament championship seasons in 2018 and 2019 while also guiding the Irish to the 2018 national title game en route to being named the Spencer Penrose Award winner as the National Coach of the Year.
- Jackson was also named the Spencer Penrose award winner in 2007 and he is one of just 15 coaches to have earned the honor multiple times (dating back to 1951).
- Additionally, Jackson is one of only two coaches to have earned the honor multiple times in the last 17 seasons.
- Jackson’s Notre Dame teams have made 12 trips to the NCAA Championship (2007–09, 2011, 2013–14, 2016–19 and 2021), advancing to the Frozen Four four times and playing in the 2008 and 2018 national title games.
- During his 17-year run, Notre Dame has become one of the nation’s top teams while playing in the Central Collegiate Hockey Association, Hockey East and now Big Ten.
- Under Jackson, the Irish won the CCHA regular-season title twice (2006–07 and 2008–09) while earning three Mason Cup championships (2007, 2009 and the final one in 2013).
- Then, in the team’s first season in the Big Ten (2017–18), Notre Dame captured both the regular season and conference championships and followed up by once again winning the conference tournament in year two (2018–19).
- Jackson’s success on the ice also has had a major impact off the ice for the Irish. With the wins came a commitment from the University that led to the new home of Irish hockey — The Compton Family Ice Arena — one of the finest college hockey facilities in the nation. The venue opened for business on Oct. 21, 2011.
- Since Jackson’s arrival, the Irish have had 43 players selected in the National Hockey League Entry Draft, including three first round selections.
- In that same span, 33 players from USA Hockey’s National Team

- During Jackson’s tenure, the Irish have had eight players garner All-America honors — Bobby Nardella in 2019, Cale Morris in 2018, Anders Bjork in 2017, Robbie Russo in 2015, Anders Lee in 2013, Ian Cole and Erik Condra in 2009 and David Brown in 2007.
- In addition, 25 of Jackson’s Notre Dame players have gone on to play in the NHL.
- Jackson entered the 2021-22 season with a 21-year collegiate record of 530–271–91 for a .645 winning percentage, the third-highest winning percentage among all active coaches with five years or more in Division I (entering 2021–22).
- Entering the 2022–23 season, Jackson’s 558 career wins rank 11th all-time in Division I and leads all active NCAA Division I coaches).
