SERIES HISTORY

- Notre Dame and BYU are meeting for the ninth time and the first time since 2013.
- The Irish and BYU are meeting as FBS Independent teams, the first time the Irish are facing a fellow FBS Independent since a 44-6 Shamrock Series victory over Army in the Alamodome on November 12, 2016.
- Saturday evening in Las Vegas will mark the first time the Irish and Cougars are meeting at a natural site.
- The Irish have won three-consecutive games against BYU (2005, 2012, 2013) with the Cougars' last victory in the series occurring at Provo in 2004.

STORYLINES

- Notre Dame, coming off its first and only bye week of the season, faces its second ranked team of the season, No. 16/16 BYU, in a Shamrock Series game in Allegiant Stadium.
- The Irish are hosting their 11th Shamrock Series game, an event in which the Irish take a home game on the road to a unique venue across the country. Las Vegas marks the eighth different venue in which the Irish have played a Shamrock Series game, which includes Yankee Stadium, Fenway Park, AT&T Stadium, Lucas Oil Stadium and the Alamodome.
- Notre Dame is 10-0 all-time in Shamrock Series games and will be facing its third straight ranked opponent in the event and fourth overall. The Irish defeated No. 22 Arizona State at AT&T Stadium in 2013, No. 12 Syracuse in Yankee Stadium in 2018 and No. 18 Wisconsin last season in Soldier Field.
- Notre Dame hopes to build off the momentum of its first road victory of the season at previously undefeated North Carolina, 45-32, on September 24. The Irish put the game out of reach with 24 points in the second quarter.
- The North Carolina game was another memorable performance by All-American tight end Michael Mayer, who led the Irish with seven catches for 88 yards and was named the John Mackey Tight End of the Week for Week Four.
- Quarterback Drew Pyne logged his first-career start on the road and had an efficient performance, as Pyne went 24-34 with 289 yards and three touchdowns.
- A key battle to watch Saturday evening will be Notre Dame's emerging rushing attack – coming off a season-high 287 yards at North Carolina – against BYU's rush defense (ranked 93rd in the nation).

| 3.25 | Notre Dame is averaging 3.25 sacks per game this season, ranked 12th in the country entering this weekend's play. The Irish have 13 sacks in four games, with nine different players recording at least 0.5 sacks. Isaiah Foskey leads all Irish players with three sacks this season. |
| 6 | Audric Estimé is averaging six yards per carry over the past two games, during which he has carried the ball 35 times for 210 yards and three touchdowns. |
| 10 | Notre Dame is 10-0 all-time in Shamrock Series games. The event began in 2009 and has been held each year, save for 2017 and the 2019 Covid-19 affected campaign. |
| 16 | Notre Dame has played 16 times in its football history on October 8, compiling an 11-5 record on the date. BYU, ranked No. 16/16 this week, is the first ranked opponent Notre Dame has ever faced on October 8. |
| 22 | With 22 receptions this season, Michael Mayer is second among all FBS tight end in catches (Central Michigan's Joel Wilson has 25 catches in 5 games played). Mayer is 4th among FBS TEs in yards per game (58.3), seventh in total yards (233) and tied for ninth in touchdowns (3). |
| 28 | Michael Mayer has played 28 games in his Notre Dame career and has caught at least one pass in each of those 28 contests. |
| 35 | Notre Dame's offense was able to earn 35 first downs in its last outing at North Carolina. It is the most for the program since the Irish posted 36 first downs in a 49-0 victory over Army in 1974. |
| 54 | Career games played for senior linebacker Bo Bauer which is seven games away from matching Kurt Hinish (now in his rookie season with the Houston Texans) for the most games played in Notre Dame history. |
| 81 | Completion percentage for Drew Pyne in the final three quarters of his first two career starts. After starting the Cal and UNC games a combined 7-15 passing in the first quarter, Pyne is 34-42 (.809) combined over the final three quarters of both victories. |
| 214 | Since 1980, Notre Dame is 214-24 (.899) when it scores 30 or more points. |
| 253 | Notre Dame has rushed 56 times for 253 yards in the last two second halves (vs. Cal, at UNC), averaging 4.5 yards per carry. |
| 300 | Three Irish running backs each posted over 100 yards from scrimmage in the victory at North Carolina (Audric Estimé 134, Chris Tyree 111, Logan Diggs 115), the first time three Irish RBs accomplished that feat since 1987. Estimé and Tyree also posted over 100 yards from scrimmage against California. |

THE OFFENSE

QB - DREW PYNE | STEVE ANGELI

- Pyne started his first game at Notre Dame on the road and established career highs across the board with 24 completions, 34 attempts, 289 passing yards and three passing touchdowns.
- Pyne and Buchner competed for the starting job throughout August, Buchner earned the nod against Ohio State and Marshall, but suffered a season-ending shoulder injury in the fourth quarter of the Marshall game.
- Angeli is the Irish back up for the remainder of the season and made the game-winning play in the 2022 Blue-Gold Game with a 10-yard touchdown scramble as time expired.

RB - CHRIS TYREE | AUDRIC ESTIMÉ | LOGAN DIGGS

- Tyree has posted back-to-back games with over 100 total yards from scrimmage (108 vs. California, 104 at North Carolina) and had a season-high 80 yards rushing at UNC.
- Estimé posted his first career 100-yard rushing game at UNC leading the Irish with 134 yards and two touchdowns.
- Diggs missed the California game with an illness but returned in fine form at North Carolina, rushing for 50 yards and catching three passes for 65 yards and a touchdown.
- Tyree, Estimé and Diggs all combined for 100 total yards from scrimmage at North Carolina, the first time that has occurred by three Irish running backs since Tony Brooks (109), Mark Green (113) and Tim Brown (140) against Navy in 1987.

WR - BRADEN LENZY | LORENZO STYLES | MATT SALERNO | JAYDEN THOMAS

- Styles leads all the Irish wideouts with 16 catches for 221 yards (13.8 per reception) this season. He is coming off a five-catch, 69-yard effort with a 30-yard TD catch at UNC.
- Thomas started his first career game against California.
- Salerno nabbed a 31-yard reception in the season opener at Ohio State.

TE - MICHAEL MAYER | ELI RARIDON | HOLDEN STAES

- Mayer leads the team with 22 receptions and three touchdown receptions as he sets his sights on becoming the best statistical tight end in Notre Dame history (see page 9 for more).
- Mayer is second in the country – and first among power conference players – in tight end receptions with 22. Central Michigan’s Joel Wilson has 25 catches in five games.
- Mayer FBS TE statistical rankings -

 Yard Per Game - 4th - 58.3
 Yards - 233 - 7th
 Touchdowns - 3 - 9th
- Raridon and Staes are both talented true freshman that have seen action this season but have yet to catch a pass.
- Kevin Bauman was lost for the season with a knee injury suffered in practice before the North Carolina game.

OL - JOE ALT | JARRETT PATTERSON | ZEKE CORRELL | JOSH LUGG |

BLAKE FISHER | ANDREW KRISTOFIC

- The OL hopes to continue its momentum from the past two games. The run game keyed Notre Dame’s rally in the victory over California, eventually finishing with 41 carries for 162 yards. Against North Carolina, the Irish run game took over with 51 carries for 287 yards and three rushing touchdowns.
- The OL helped the Irish pile up an amazing 35 first downs in the victory over North Carolina – the most for the program since 36 against Army in 1974.
- Jarrett Patterson who started much of his career at center, missed the game at Ohio State but has started the last three games at left guard.
- The Irish have two talented but young tackles in sophomore Joe Alt and freshman Blake Fisher.
- Kristofic is the first offensive lineman off the bench at either guard spot for the Irish.

THE DEFENSE

DE - ISAIAH FOSKEY | RYLIE MILLS | JUSTIN ADEMILOLA | ALEXANDER EHRENSBERGER

- Foskey is one of the top pass rushers in the nation and is ninth on the all-time Notre Dame career sacks list with 18.5.
- Mills played the opposite DE position from Foskey and broke out in the victory at North Carolina with five tackles and two sacks. He earned the Notre Dame Defensive Player of the Game Award for the effort.
- Justin Ademilola started the Marshall game and delivered with four tackles, he also had a sack against California and recovered a fumble at North Carolina.

DT - JAYSON ADEMILOLA | JACOB LACEY | CHRIS SMITH

- Jayson Ademilola is one of the most experienced defensive lineman on the team and has eight tackles, two TFL and 1.5 sacks this season.
- Lacey posted his best game in an Irish uniform against Cal with a career-high five tackles and two sacks –he entered the game with 0.5 sacks total in his career.
- Smith graduate transferred from Harvard and has established himself as one of the strongest players on the team.

NG - HOWARD CROSS III | GABRIEL RUBIO

- Cross is second on the team in tackles with 23, including an 11-tackle performance against Marshall. It was the first 10-tackle game by an Irish defensive lineman since Kurt Hinich had 10 against Navy last season.
- Rubio provides another big defender in the middle of the Irish defense and sees action in short yardage and goal-to-go situations.

LB - JD BERTRAND | JACK KISER | MARIST LIUFAU | BO BAUER | JUNIOR TUIHALAMAKA | PRINCE KOLLIE

- The Irish linebacker group is experienced, talented and interchangeable.
- Bertrand led the Irish in tackles last season, but will miss the first half of the BYU game after a targeting penalty assessed against North Carolina. Bertrand forced a fumble on his first play at UNC after sitting out the first half for another targeting call against Cal.
- Bertrand has been named to the 2022 wAFCA Good Works Team.
- Kiser leads the team with 26 tackles, which includes a career-high nine against Marshall and at North Carolina, respectively.
- Liufau has 18 tackles so far this season and showed his across-the-field capability with six tackles against North Carolina.
- Bauer is a special teams all-star, has blocked a punt this season, and has played 54 games in his career (which ranks third all-time at Notre Dame).

CB - CAM HART | TARIQ BRACY | JADEN MICKEY | BENJAMIN MORRISON | CLARENCE LEWIS

- Bracy has been the most consistent and reliable defensive backs on the roster this season, with numerous key plays that include three tackles for loss this season.
- Morrison, a true freshman, has started two-consecutive games and owns seven tackles with one pass break up.
- Hart was one of three Irish players listed on *The Athletic’s* Freaks List this season and leads the team with three pass break ups.
- Lewis had a game-sealing interception against California called back for a personal foul-penalty while the pass was in the air.

S - BRANDON JOSEPH | DJ BROWN | RAMON HENDERSON | HOUSTON GRIFFITH

- Joseph has 15 tackles so far this season and is averaging 20 yards per game in punt returns. He was a two-time All-American at Northwestern before transferring to Notre Dame during the offseason.
- Brown leads all defensive backs with 20 tackles this season.
- Henderson contributed a career-best four tackles against California before missing the UNC game with an injury.
- Griffith is among the most experience players on the roster and is a key contributor on the Irish special teams.

SPECIALISTS

K - BLAKE GRUPE | ZAC YOAKAM

- A graduate transfer from Arkansas State, Grupe is 3-4 on field goals this season including a season-long 47 yards against California – his first field goal in Notre Dame Stadium.
- Yoakam has stepped in as the kick off specialist for Bryce McFerson, who injured his groin before the season opener at Ohio State. Yoakam and has responded with consistent depth and height on his kickoffs. He has 11 touchbacks on 19 kickoffs this season.

P - JON SOT

- A graduate transfer from Harvard, Sot boasts a solid 45.6 average so far this season with 10 punts downed inside the 20-yard line. He enters the weekend 14th in the country in punting average at 45.6 and has helped the Irish rank 8th in net punting (43.6).
- Sot also serves as the holder for Irish place kicks.

MAYER MAKING HISTORY

- Tight end Michael Mayer already owns the school records for tight end receptions in a season (71) and tight end touchdowns in a campaign (7) and has his eyes set on more season and career records as one of the top weapons in the Irish offensive arsenal this season.
- Mayer has played 28 career games with the Irish and has logged at least one catch in all 28 of those contests.
- Last year Michael Mayer joined Virginia's Heath Miller (2003) and Rice's James Casey (2008) as the only FBS underclassman tight ends (freshman or sophomore) in the last 25 years to have at least 70 receptions for 700 yards in a season.
- Mayer collected his 120th career reception against Marshall on September 10 and is one of 11 Notre Dame players to reach that mark this century. The only other one to reach that mark in the last five years was Chase Claypool.

BERTRAND ON AFCA GOOD WORKS TEAM

Junior linebacker JD Bertrand was selected as one of 22 players across the country to the Allstate AFCA Good Works Team for outstanding contributions to their communities.

Bertrand and others were nominated by their schools for this prestigious award based on their work off the field. This current list of 22 was narrowed down after the initial announcement of 114 nominees were selected in July. This final 22-player roster was chosen by a selection panel, which includes former Good Works Team players, journalists and officials from Allstate and the AFCA. The panel looks for players that demonstrate exceptional leadership on and off the football field.

Bertrand works with Uplifting Athletes, providing experiences for children with rare diseases and their families. He currently serves as Notre Dame's chapter president for the organization. In an effort to support its mission, Bertrand has organized fundraising events at Notre Dame, including a Lift for Life event with his teammates and an Uplifting Bowling Experience. Led by Bertrand, Notre Dame raised \$80,385 over the past year. Bertrand, having previously served as the chapter's vice president, made his mark in more than just fundraising. He set out to directly connect with and build a relationship with a child with a rare disease. He made an instant connection with a young football fan and his family and the two are in constant communication. Bertrand sees up close and personal the impact all of his fundraising efforts can have on those who benefit from the work of Uplifting Athletes.

Prior to the start of the 2022 season, Bertrand was voted a team captain by his peers. He's started all three games this season at linebacker, recording 17 tackles and 1.5 tackles for loss (TFL).

As a sophomore in 2021, Bertrand played and started in all 13 games, leading the team in tackles and was the only Irish player to record over 100 tackles (101). He became the first Irish player with triple digit tackles in a season since 2018, and 63 of his 101 stops were solo, more than double the next best Irish defender. He added 7.0 TFLs, 1.5 sacks, forced a fumble, recovered another, added a pass breakup and four quarterback hurries while being named to the Phil Steel Magazine All-Independent First Team and was a 2022 preseason candidate for the LOTT Impact trophy. Off the field, Bertrand is a member of the Alpha Mu Alpha National Marketing Honor Society. He is the 2022 Paul D. Gilbert Award for Leadership winner, an award given at the discretion of the faculty to the marketing student who has excelled in various extracurricular activities. He also earned a spot on the Notre Dame Mendoza School of Business Dean's List in 2020. The final roster features 11 players from the NCAA Football Bowl Subdivision (FBS); 11 players from the NCAA Football Championship Subdivision (FCS), Divisions II, III and the National Association of Intercollegiate Athletics (NAIA); and one honorary head coach.

“That was a very special moment. We’ve been through a lot, this entire senior class. Not only on the team, but everybody here,” Rees said. “They could have chanted anyone’s name, it’s a whole senior class effort, but that was definitely a memory I’ll hold very closely for a long time.”

- In a partnership that began in 2014, the University of Notre Dame and the Atlantic Coast Conference agreed to schedule the Irish to play, on average, five ACC opponents each season. Originally scheduled through the 2025 season, the games have now been scheduled through the 2037 campaign.
- Notre Dame is 37-7 (.841) against ACC opponents since the scheduling agreement began during the 2014 season

- The Irish completed their fourth-straight undefeated regular season against the ACC in 2021 (5-0). They have won 25-straight games against the ACC in the regular season dating back to 2017.
- In 2020, the Irish went 9-0 in ACC play, with wins over Duke, Florida State, Louisville, Pitt, Georgia Tech, Clemson, Boston College, North Carolina and Syracuse.
- In 2019, the Irish went undefeated against the ACC, beating Louisville, Virginia, Virginia Tech, Duke and Boston College as part of the scheduling agreement.
- The Irish improved to 29-1 in regular-season games against Atlantic Coast Conference opponents over the last five seasons (2017-22) after the win at North Carolina.
- Notre Dame has won 12-straight ACC road games and 14-consecutive ACC home games.
- There have been, and in the future there will be, seasons when the Irish face just four ACC opponents but will eventually even out the agreement by facing six ACC teams in another year (this occurred in 2014 and 2015 and is set to occur in 2021-22 and 2022-23).

NOTRE DAME ROAD GAME ATTENDANCE NOTES

- Since Notre Dame began to establish its national brand in the 1920s, the Fighting Irish have been a sure-fire ticket selling game where ever their football schedule takes the team. Notre Dame owns attendance records at 10 opponent home venues across the country – by far the most of any FBS team (Florida State and Miami each have four such record games).
- The Irish also own eight attendance records at active neutral site venues, which includes Soldier Field, Hard Rock Stadium, Aviva Stadium in Dublin, Ireland and Sun Bowl Stadium.
- Notre Dame also owns several top-10 attendance numbers at stadiums across the country, which includes some of the top attendance marks at the Cotton Bowl, Fiesta Bowl, Sugar Bowl and other notable venues.
- On page 13 there is a complete list of Notre Dame’s appearances in NFL Stadiums. The Irish will knock another NFL venue off the list on October 8th when they play their first game in Allegiant Stadium (Las Vegas Raiders) – which is one of two NFL stadium appearances this season (also M&T Bank Stadium against Navy on Nov. 12).
- Allegiant Stadium will become the 15th active NFL Stadium the Irish have competed in and the program plans to visit Mercedes-Benz Stadium (vs. Georgia Tech, 2024) and Lambeau Field (vs. Wisconsin, 2026) in the future.
- Notre Dame is 21-15 in current NFL Stadiums and 70-30-3 all-time in a facility that was home to an NFL team the year the Irish competed in the stadium.

- Freeman oversaw then-sophomore Isaiah Foskey's breakout season as a starter on the defensive line. Foskey tallied 11.0 sacks in 2021, third-most in program history for a single season.
- The depth of the Irish defense was on full display in 2021 as 15 different players recorded a sack and 21 different players had a tackle-for-loss.
- The 15 interceptions were the most in a single season since 2014 when the Irish had 16.
- In November, the Irish had three-straight games without allowing a touchdown for the first time since 2012.
- Prior to coming to South Bend, Freeman spent the previous four seasons as the defensive coordinator at Cincinnati.
- 2020 247Sports.com Defensive Coordinator of the Year and 2020 Broyles Award Finalist; 2018 & 2019 Broyles Award nominee
- In 2020, the Bearcats (9-1) earned a bid to the Peach Bowl as the No. 8-ranked team in the nation and won the American Athletic Conference Championship, the program's first outright league title since 2009, when Cincinnati's head coach was Brian Kelly.
- Cincinnati's defense ranked in the Top 20 nationally in several categories for 2020-21, including being ranked 13th in total defense (324.6 yards per game) and eighth in scoring defense (16.8 points per game) among all FBS teams.
- In addition, the Bearcats were third in team passing efficiency defense (101.25), 14th in rushing defense (111.1 yards per game), 15th in red zone defense (0.735), 17th in fourth down defense (0.375 rate), 16th in team sacks (3.00 per game) and 10th in turnovers gained (21).
- Coached the Bearcats to back-to-back 11-win seasons in 2018 and 2019, the 2019 American Athletic Conference East Division Championship and consecutive bowl-game wins in the 2018 Military Bowl and 2019 TicketSmarter Birmingham Bowl.
- The Bearcats finished atop the 2019 AAC ranks in scoring defense for the second-straight season and ranked among the league's top three in rushing and total defense.
- Cincinnati led the American in 2018 in rushing defense, scoring defense and total defense and ranked among the Top-15 in the NCAA FBS in all three categories.
- Joined the Bearcats staff after a four-year stint at Purdue. He coached linebackers all four seasons and served as the Boilermakers co-defensive coordinator in 2015.
- Freeman coached linebackers at Kent State from 2011-12, helping develop all-conference selections Luke Batton and C.J. Malauulu.
- Freeman started his coaching career as a graduate assistant coach at his alma mater, Ohio State, in 2010 and the Buckeyes went 12-1 with a victory in the Sugar Bowl.
