FIRST-AND-10

» Boston College hits the road for its second straight game at a top-20 opponent when it visits Notre Dame Stadium to take on the No. 18/19 Fighting Irish Saturday at 2:30 p.m.
» The Eagles are 3-7 overall and 2-5 in the ACC after a 21-20, come-from-behind win at No. 16 North Carolina State.
» Saturday's game will air nationally on NBC. **Jac Collinsworth** (play-by-play) and **Jason Garrett** (analyst) are in the booth with **Zora Stephenson** (reporter) on the sideline.
» Coverage on the Boston College Sports Network begins 30 minutes prior to kickoff on WEEI 93.7 FM and 850 AM. **Jon Meterparel** (play-by-play) is joined on the call by former BC linebacker **Pete Cronan** in the booth and quarterback **Scott Mutryn** on the sideline.
» BC trails the all-time series with ND, 9-17, having lost eight in a row since 2009 after winning six in a row between 2001 and 2008.
» The first game in series history was a 17-3 Irish victory at Schaefer Stadium (later known as Foxboro Stadium) in 1975. The Eagles' first win was at No. 1 Notre Dame, 41-39, on a last-second David Gordon field goal.
» In the last meeting, No. 2 and temporary ACC-football member Notre Dame won, 45-31, at Alumni Stadium in 2020.
» BC last defeated ND in 2008, 17-0. Paul Anderson picked off Jimmy Clausen twice, including a pick-six, in the shutout victory.
» The Eagles' win at NC State ended a string of 25 consecutive losses to AP-ranked opponents; having last defeated No. 9 USC in 2014.
» BC last defeated back-to-back ranked opponents in 2008 (No. 17 VT, No. 20 FSU) and last defeated back-to-back ranked opponents on the road in 2007 with three consecutive wins (No. 17 GT, No. 8 VT, No. 15 Clemson).

WEEK TEN RECAP

Saturday, Nov. 12: Boston College 21, No. 16 NC State 20
Carter-Finley Stadium (Raleigh, N.C.)
» Boston College gave up two quick touchdowns as NC State average 14 yards per play on its first two drives. The Eagle defense allowed just 3.1 yards per play the rest of the way, including 61 total yards in the second half.
» The Eagles trailed 17-7 at the half and 20-14 after the third. **Emmett Morehead** led a 12-play, 69-yard drive, capped by a two-yard touchdown pass to **Joe Griffin** with 14 seconds left.
» Morehead totaled 330 yards and three touchdowns, including two to **Zay Flowers**, who finished with 130 yards on seven catches.
» The BC defense forced four turnovers, including three fumbles.
WHATTA YA SAY ABOUT ZAY?
» **Zay Flowers** became Boston College's all-time leader in receiving yards on a 15-yard catch in the first quarter at NC State (11/16). He stands at 2,900 career yards.
» Ranks third all-time with 189 career receptions, two behind the record, and second all-time with 27 career touchdown receptions, one behind the record.
» Flowers' 130-yard game at NC State marked the ninth 100-yard game of his career as he went for touchdowns of 17 and 35 yards.
» Flowers caught touchdown passes of 57 and 69 yards against Louisville (10/1) en route to a 151-yard game.
» Following the Louisville win, Flowers was named the Reese's Senior Bowl Offensive Player of the Week and the East-West Shrine Bowl Breakout Offensive Player.
» Flowers also claimed his fourth career ACC Offensive Receiver of the Week award after the Louisville game.

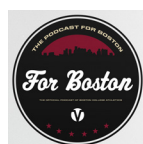

The Gregory P. Barber '69 and Family Head Football Coach

Jeff Hafley was introduced as The Gregory P. Barber '69 and Family Head Coach of the Boston College football program on Dec. 14, 2019.

Of the 24 coaches hired in the 2020 coaching cycle, Hafley enters the 2022 season tied for second among all Power Five head coaches with 12 victories. He has led the Eagles to bowl eligibility in each of his first two seasons at the helm.

On the recruiting trail, Hafley and his staff have signed two of the top recruiting classes in school history. The 2021 and 2022 signing classes earned ESPN's best ranking in program history since its rankings began in 2006. BC also earned its best showing in the 247 Sports rankings and was awarded its first Rivals top-30 class since 2004.

One of college football's top defensive minds, Hafley's defense ranked third nationally in passing yards allowed (173.5 per game) during the 2021 season. The Eagles were also top-30 nationally in six other defensive categories: total defense, red zone defense, first downs allowed, third down percentage, team passing efficiency, and defensive touchdowns. His disciplined squad led the ACC in fewest penalties and fewest penalty yards.

A total of 12 Eagles were All-ACC selections, led by First Team offensive linemen Zion Johnson and Alec Lindstrom. Johnson was named to seven different All-America teams and was selected 17th overall in the first round of the 2022 NFL Draft by the Los Angeles Chargers, becoming the 21st first round pick in school history.

In his first season on the Heights in 2020, Hafley finished with the most victories of any first-year head coach in college football. More impressive than the marked improvement on both sides of the ball from Boston College in 2020 was how the program handled playing in the COVID-19 pandemic. BC's team had just one positive COVID-19 result in over 9,000 administered tests since the team returned to campus in June of 2020.

Hafley helped improve BC's defense 52 spots in the national rankings in total defense as the Eagles allowed 62 fewer yards per game than the previous year, prior to his arrival. Isaiah McDuffie ranked fifth nationally in total tackles while Max Richardson ended the season 11th as Boston College was one of two schools in the entire country with two players finishing in the top 11 in tackles.

Nine Eagles were named All-ACC in 2020. Tight end Hunter Long was named a Second Team All-American by multiple outlets as he led all tight ends nationally in receptions and finished the year second in receptions.

Prior to taking over as head coach at Boston College, Hafley led a dramatic turnaround in leading the defense for Ohio State as the Buckeyes won the 2019 Big Ten Championship and qualified for the College Football Playoff.

A finalist for the Frank Broyles Award and the 247 Sports Defensive Coordinator of the Year, Hafley was one of the architects of a Buckeye defense that ranked first nationally in yards per play, second nationally in total defense, third nationally in scoring defense, third nationally in sacks, seventh nationally in rushing defense, second nationally in passing yards allowed and first nationally in red zone defense.

A standout defensive backs coach throughout his career in the NFL and collegiate ranks, Hafley's work as the defensive backs coach at Ohio State led to impressive results. The Buckeyes totaled 15 interceptions in 2019, tied for ninth nationally, while allowing just 25 pass plays of 20+ yards. Before arriving at Ohio State, Hafley spent the previous seven seasons in the NFL, the last three with the San Francisco 49ers as defensive backs coach.

Prior to his time with San Francisco, Hafley was the secondary coach for two seasons in Cleveland, the secondary/safeties coach with Tampa Bay in 2013 and a defensive backs assistant with the Buccaneers in 2012.

His coaching career includes 11 seasons in collegiate football before a move to the NFL in 2012, and then seven subsequent seasons there. After starting his career working as running backs coach for one season (2001) at Worcester (Mass.) Polytechnic Institute, Hafley moved on to the University of Albany for four seasons as defensive assistant and defensive backs coach (2002-05).

He then coached at the University of Pittsburgh for five seasons (2006-10) where he worked under the direction of Dave Wannstedt and helped mentor Darrelle Revis into a Jim Thorpe Award finalist in 2006. Hafley was a defensive assistant/cornerbacks coach in 2006-07 and was secondary coach from 2008-10.

One season as the defensive backs coach at Rutgers, working under Greg Schiano, followed his positions at Pittsburgh. The Scarlet Knights ranked ninth nationally in passing defense in his one season there, 2011. Hafley helped develop future NFL standout defensive backs Duron Harmon and Logan Ryan during his time in Piscataway.

Hafley moved on to the NFL following his year at Rutgers and coached two seasons with the Buccaneers, serving as assistant defensive backs coach in 2012 and secondary/safeties coach in 2013. Two seasons with the Cleveland Browns followed under coach Mike Pettine.

Three seasons as defensive backs coach with the San Francisco 49ers, 2016-2018, preceded Hafley's position with the Buckeyes. He worked under Chip Kelly in 2016 and Kyle Shanahan the final two seasons. In 2018, the 49ers ranked 11th in the league in passing defense. They were 14th in 2016 after ranking 27th in 2015, the year before Hafley arrived.

Hafley and his wife, Gina, have two daughters, Hope and Leah.

» Boston College wide receiver **Zay Flowers** was named to the Biletnikoff Award watch list for the second year in a row.
 » He is two receptions behind Alex Amidon for the career reception record at BC.
 » Alone in second with 27 receiving TDs and one behind Kelvin Martin for the record.

» On the season, Flowers has 67 receptions, 921 yards and 10 receiving touchdowns. His 70 catches are fifth most and 10 touchdowns tied for the most in a single season at BC with Kelvin Martin (1984). His 921 receiving yards are seventh most at BC as he aims to record just the fourth 1,000-yard season in program history.

» Flowers put together one of the best seasons by a BC wide receiver ever in 2020. An All-ACC first-team selection, Flowers was just the second BC wide receiver to be named first-team All-ACC in school history (Alex Amidon, 2012). He finished 18th nationally and second in the ACC with 892 yards receiving, ranked 26th nationally with 56 receptions and tied for 12th nationally with nine touchdown receptions.

» The speedster from Fort Lauderdale finished with his second 100-yard receiving game of the season in 2020 with six catches for 162 yards and a career-high three scores in the 31-30 victory in overtime over Pitt. Flowers became the first BC player with three receiving touchdowns in a game since Kelvin Martin at Holy Cross (11/22/86). He tied the school record with five other players with three touchdown receptions.

» He is second in BC career history with nine career 100-yard receiving games.

AGAINST THE RANKED

» Boston College is 32-121-1 all-time against opponents ranked in the top-25. The Eagles snapped a streak of 15 straight losses to ranked opponents and 25 straight to AP-ranked opponents with a 21-20 win at No. 16 NC State (11/12).

» The win over the Wolfpack also marked the program's first win over a CFP ranked opponent since the poll was started in 2014.

» The Eagles' last win over a top-five opponent was 2002 at Notre Dame, 14-7.

GOLD HELMET

» Quarterback **Emmett Morehead** was honored as a week-10 Gold Helmet Award recipient by the New England Football Writers following a 330-yard, four-touchdown performance vs. Duke (11/4).

» Morehead immediately followed up that effort with a 330-yard, three-touchdown performance at NC State (11/12) and earned his second NEFW Gold Helmet Award.

SPOT START

» **Emmett Morehead** made his first career start against Duke (11/4) and went for 330 yards and four touchdowns on 27-for-45 passing.

» Morehead became the only BC quarterback at BC since Doug

Flutie's 1981 debut to throw four touchdowns in his first career start. He is just the third QB in that era to record a 300-yard game and first since **Phil Jurkovec** (2020).

» In his first two starts, Morehead totaled 660 passing yards and seven touchdowns; both highs by an Eagle through the first two starts of a player's career. Previously, Jurkovec threw for 510 yards and three players tossed five touchdown passes; most recently Matt Ryan.

FRESHMAN SIGNAL CALLERS

» **Emmett Morehead** is one of just four true freshman or red-shirt freshman quarterbacks to throw for 325 yards and three touchdowns in a game this season. He has done so twice with 330 yards and four touchdowns vs. Duke (11/4) and 330 yards and three touchdowns at NC State (11/12).

» Morehead is one of just two freshman quarterbacks with multiple 325-yard, three-touchdown games.

» His first completion was a 44-yard pass to **Zay Flowers**. Morehead finished the day 6-of-15 passing for 87 yards.

JURKOVEC: BY THE NUMBERS

» **Phil Jurkovec** is one of just six quarterbacks to start 24 or more games since **Doug Flutie** first took over as the BC quarterback as a freshman in 1981. He ranks among the top-four in touchdowns (35), completions (404) and passing yards (5,183).

CHESTNUT PHIL

» **Phil Jurkovec** entered the season on the Maxwell, Unitas Golden Arm and Walter Camp Player of the Year watch lists.

» Missed six starts in 2021 after a first-quarter injury in week two at Massachusetts (9/11).

» Eight 300-yard games are fifth most in BC history. Matt Ryan and Doug Flutie hold the school record with 12.

» Started all 10 games played in 2020, missing the finale due to injury, and passed for 2,558 yards; the most by any BC quarterback in his first 10 starts in program history.

» Eight career rushing touchdowns four behind Jack Concannon for BC record by a quarterback.

» Currently seventh all-time at BC with 4,807 career passing yards and third fastest (19 games) at BC to 4,000 career yards.

JOE GO GET IT

» Freshman wide receiver **Joe Griffin** caught five passes for 103 yards, with a long of 36, against Duke (11/4).

» It marked the first 100-yard and two-touchdown game of his career.

» Griffin is the only true freshman wide receiver at BC to record a 100-yard game or two-touchdown game since 1996 and one of just five true freshmen in the country this season with a 100-yard, two-touchdown game as a receiver.

ROOKIE PERFORMERS

» Running back **Alex Broome** and wide receiver **Joe Griffin** each got their first taste of the end zone, both through the air, in a lopsided defeat at Florida State (9/24).

» A week later, they each scored again; contributing to a 34-33 win over Louisville (10/1).

» The 6-foot-4 Griffin scored the first BC touchdown of day to tie the game 7-7 on a jump ball thrown to the back of the end zone. Broome later put BC ahead 21-16 late in the second quarter on a 40-yard run.

» Broome and Griffin are the first true freshman duo with multiple TDs in a season since running back Jon Hilliman (13) and wide receiver Sherman Alston (4) in 2014.

CAREER DAY

» Tight end **George Takacs**, a graduate transfer from Notre Dame, made seven catches for 84 yards in his BC debut against Rutgers (9/3).

» His yard total for the game surpassed his career receiving yard total with the Irish (78), while his seven catches were one behind his career total at ND (8).

» Takacs and Phil Jurkovec were a part of the same signing class that entered Notre Dame in the fall of 2018.

» In week three, Takacs scored his first touchdown at BC and third of his career. He last scored in 2021 for ND vs. Stanford.

ACC LEADERS

» **Zay Flowers** leads the ACC in receiving yards (921) and is second in receiving touchdowns (10). Flowers is also second in the conference in receptions (67).

» On defense, cornerback **Elijah Jones** is second in the league

with pass-breakups. He has added two interceptions and his 1.40 passes defended per game are tied for second in the conference and sixth in the country.

GARWO CAN GO

» Running back **Pat Garwo** rushed for a then career-high 160 yards at UMass (9/11/21), becoming BC's first 100-yard rusher since David Bailey at Syracuse (Nov. 7, 2020). Garwo's previous career best was 36 yards vs. Pitt (10/10/20).
 » Garwo became the first BC rusher over 150 yards since AJ Dillon (242) and David Bailey (172) did so at Syracuse (11/2/19).
 » He started the remaining 10 games and rushed for 1,045 yards to become the 19th 1,000-yard rusher in BC history; recording the 24th 1,000-yard season by an Eagle.
 » Garwo ripped off a career-long 67-yard run for BC's first touchdown to cap off a 99-yard scoring drive in a 41-34 OT win against Missouri (9/25/21).
 » Garwo finished with his second 100-yard game of the year and second of his career with a career-high 175 vs. Mizzou.
 » Garwo registered four 100-yard rushing games in 2021.
 » Named to the Doak Walker Award watch list.
 » Became 19th player at BC to surpass 1,000 yards in a season with 1,045 in 2021; the 24th overall 1,000-yard season at BC.
 » Took over as the Eagles' starter in week three a year ago with a 160-yard performance at Temple (9/18/21).
 » Four 100-yard rushing games in 2021.
 » Second career two-touchdown game vs. Maine (9/17).

MOVEMENT UP FRONT

» BC did not use the same starting offensive line in more than one game this season until game 10 at NC State (11/12).
 » **Ozzy Trapilo** started the opener at left tackle, but then missed two games due to injury.
 » **Jack Conley** has started at four different positions; right guard, left tackle, right tackle plus two starts as an eligible sixth-lineman and is the only player to appear in the lineup for all 10 games.
 » **Kevin Cline** (right tackle) was injured in week two at Virginia Tech (9/10) and will miss the rest of the season.
 » **Dwayne Allick** spent his 2020 freshman season as a back-up center and moved to defensive line in the 2021 preseason due a lack of depth. He remained on defense through 2022 spring ball, but returned to the offense this preseason. He has now started the last nine games at guard.
 » Former preferred walk-on **Nick Thomas** was elevated to starting left tackle vs. Maine (9/17) and was re-inserted to the lineup at left guard at Wake Forest (10/22) before undergoing surgery following the UConn (10/29) game.
 » **Drew Kendall** (center) started the first six games before suffering a wrist injury vs. Clemson (10/8), but returned at UConn (10/29); playing with a club on his left hand.
 » **Finn Dirstine** (left guard) was injured at FSU (9/24) and was ruled out for the year during week seven for labrum surgery.
 » Former defensive lineman **Jackson Ness** began the season rotating into the interior, but then started at left guard in Dirstine's place before taking over at center at Wake (10/22).
 » True freshman **Jude Bowry** earned starts at Wake (10/22) and UConn (10/29), but was limited to one series at Connecticut due to an injury.

GETTING TO THE QUARTERBACK

» Sophomore defensive end **Donovan Ezeiruaku** leads Boston College with 11.5 tackles for loss, six sacks and three forced fumbles.
 » Ezeiruaku is the first Eagle with 10 or more TFLs since linebacker Max Richardson (14.5, 2019) and first with six or more sacks since Wyatt Ray (9.0, 2018) and Zach Allen (6.5, 2018).

DB DEPTH

» Prior to arriving at BC, head coach **Jeff Hafley** was best known as a defensive backs coach; holding DB coaching roles at Pitt and Rutgers before spending seven seasons as a DB coach in the NFL and ultimately a one-year stint as the DC/DB Coach at Ohio State.
 » Boston College has started in nickel in eight of 10 games with three players starting all 10 games; **Elijah Jones** (CB), **Jason Maitre** (FS) and **Jaiden Woodbey** (SS). **Josh DeBerry** has totaled nine starts at corner and nickel, while **CJ Burton** has started four games at nickel, but missed four games.
 » True freshman **Amari Jackson** has had his number called to start four games before an injury vs. Duke (11/4). He debuted with a tackle and a third-down PBU against No. 5 Clemson (10/8) and followed up with seven tackles at No. 13 Wake Forest (10/22).
 » With an injury to Jones at Wake, BC rotated DeBerry to corner, Maitre to nickel and inserted redshirt-freshman **Cole Batson** for his first significant snaps at free safety. He turned in eight tackles, tied for the team lead, and picked up an interception. Batson made his first career start at NC State (11/12) with a game-high nine tackles.

MY COUSIN VINNY

» **Vinny DePalma** missed all of 2020 with an Achilles injury. The New Jersey native returned in 2021 and finished third on the team in tackles at 54.
 » He started six games, including four of the final five at middle linebacker a season ago.
 » This year, DePalma is first on the team with 71 tackles, matching his career-high of 11 in twice this season.

BOOZEY IS BACK

» Nose tackle **Chibueze Onwuka** is back after missing 2021 due to a preseason Achilles injury. Onwuka started five of 10 games in 2020 with 19 tackles and two forced fumbles.
 » Onwuka spent his first three years at Buffalo, where he started 19 of 36 games. He made Buffalo as a walk-on after transferring from Niagara County C.C., where he competed on the wrestling team.
 » Onwuka earned ACC Defensive Lineman of the Week following the Louisville (10/1) win. He totaled a career-high nine tackles and blocked a point-after attempt in the second quarter that stood as the difference in a 34-33 victory.

HEY, ARNOLD

» Linebacker **Kam Arnold** played cornerback in high school, moved to safety as a freshman in 2020 and then transitioned to linebacker in 2021.
 » He has started 18 of the last 19 games at linebacker.
 » At Virginia Tech (9/10/22), Arnold made a career-high 12

tackles. He is second on BC with 58 tackles on the season.
 » Arnold leads the BC defense with two interceptions.

JUNGLELAND

» BC secondary, known as “The Jungle”, ranked third in the country in 2021 with 173.5 passing yards allowed per game.
 » In the season opener against Rutgers, the Eagles allowed just 110 passing yards. BC followed that performance with 140 passing yards allowed against Virginia Tech.
 » The two games marked the fifth and sixth games of fewer than 150 passing yards allowed to a Power 5 opponent in the last two seasons and sixth and seventh overall.
 » Cornerback **Elijah Jones** recorded the team’s first interceptions of the season against the Scarlet Knights.

COVER CORNER

» **Josh DeBerry** primarily played nickel back in 2021 and finished fourth on the team with 53 tackles, despite missing the final two games of the season. One of the top cover corners in the ACC, DeBerry tied for second on the team with two interceptions and added three pass breakups.
 » Not only an elite cover corner, DeBerry led BC with eight tackles for loss in 2021.

PUNTER PLATOON

» BC employed two punters in the season opener against Rutgers (9/3). **Danny Longman**, who has handled kickoffs since 2018, won the job in preseason camp, but it was freshman **Sam Candotti** that made the first appearance of the season.
 » Longman, who punted twice in 2019, averaged 43.4 yards per punt with five attempts in the season opener.
 » At Virginia Tech (9/10), Longman punted 10 times, averaging 44.3 yards per kick. He recorded a long of 76 yards; just the fourth punt of 76 yards or more in BC history, the first since Johnny Ayers in 2004 and one off the program record.
 » Longman successfully executed a fake punt on 4th-and-8 at Wake Forest (10/22) with a 24-yard run up the middle to keep an eventual touchdown drive alive.
 » Candotti, a 22-year old freshman from Australia, was called upon for a first-quarter punt in Rutgers’ territory and dropped a 33-yard kick out of bounds at the three-yard line.
 » Candotti played Australian football for Airport West FC and East Keilor FC before training as a punter at Prokick Australia.

2022 CAPTAINS

» A season ago, BC named captains on a weekly basis ahead of each game. For 2022, head coach Jeff Hafley and the Eagles have elected seven veterans to serve as captains: **Vinny DePalma, Zay Flowers, Pat Garwo, Phil Jurkovec, Marcus Valdez, Jaiden Woodbey** and honorary captain **Christian Mahogany**, who will miss the season due to injury.
 » Valdez is a two-time team captain after serving as a captain in Hafley’s first season of 2020. He is the first two-time captain since Jon Baker (2017, 2018) and the first two-time captain on defense since Mike McLaughlin (2008, 2009).
 » All seven players earned the honor of game captain during the 2021 season. Flowers, Garwo, Jurkovec, Valdez and Woodbey each served as game captains twice, while DePalma and Mahogany were each a game captain once.

NFL EXPERIENCED STAFF

» BC’s coaching staff, including head coach **Jeff Hafley**, features 46 combined years of experience on a NFL staff as a position coach, assistant position coach or quality control coach.
 » The Eagles’ 46 combined years in the NFL are the most in the ACC and more than double the next closest team.

MOMENTS THAT MATTERED

» *Sept. 15, 1975 - Notre Dame 17, Boston College 3*

Boston College and Notre Dame took the field for the first edition of the Holy War at Foxboro Stadium in 1975; a game won by the No. 9 Fighting Irish, 17-3, on the first day of the season.

» *Dec. 29, 1983 - Notre Dame 19, Boston College 18*

The next meeting occurred at the 1983 Liberty Bowl in Memphis. The Eagles and quarterback Doug Flutie drove down for an opening-score on a Brian Brennan touchdown reception, but the missed point after was costly in a one-point defeat.

» *Nov. 20, 1993 - Boston College 41, Notre Dame 39*

David Gordon drilled a 41-yard field goal as time expired to give the No. 17 Eagles a 41-39 win over the No. 1 Fighting Irish and end Notre Dame and head coach Lou Holtz's hopes of a national championship in 1993.

BC built a 38-17 lead heading into the fourth quarter.

» *Nov. 2, 2002 - Boston College 14, Notre Dame 7*

An infamous "Green Jersey" game, Boston College stunned the No. 4 Irish in South Bend, 14-7.

Linebacker Josh Ott recovered an early ND fumble and BC took advantage with a three-yard touchdown run by Derrick Knight. Ott later added a 71-yard interception return for a touchdown to make it 14-0.

» *Oct. 24, 2009 - Notre Dame 20, Boston College 16*

The Eagles' six-game win-streak against the Fighting Irish was snapped in South Bend.

A Montel Harris touchdown gave BC the lead early in the third quarter, but Notre Dame got the game-winning score midway through the fourth, following a goal-line stand by the Eagles, on a 36-yard hook-up between QB Jimmy Clausen and wide receiver Golden Tate.

Clausen and BC wide receiver Rich Gunnell, who caught 10 passes for 179 yards, exchanged words on the field post-game after a day full of trash talk from both sides beginning during warm-ups.
