TEAM

- Notre Dame won the coin toss and elected to defer to the second half. The Irish will kick off and defend the end zone to the west.
- Attendance: 72,613
- Notre Dame and Southern Cal met for the 93rd time this evening. The series now stands at 50-38-5.

INDIVIDUAL

SUPERLATIVES

- Consecutive games with at least one reception - Michael Mayer 36 (all 36 games of his career).
- Drew Pyne finished the first half of the game 8-8 for 106 yards and a touchdown, he eventually completed his first 15 attempts.
- Pyne finished the game 23-26 passing, which is second on the Notre Dame single-game completions percentage list (.884) behind Steve Buerlein's .909 (10-11) against Colorado in 1984.

FIRSTS

- Career start for freshman defensive back Jaden Mickey.
- Touchdown reception for Deion Colzie - a 23-yard reception in the third quarter.

CAREER HIGHS

- 9 - tackles for Xavier Watts.
- 15 - consecutive completions for Drew Pyne.
- 318 - passing yards for Drew Pyne.
- 75 receiving yards, 1 receiving touchdown and a career-high matching 3 receptions for Deion Colzie.

ISAIAH FOSKEY

- Isaiah Foskey finished the game with 1.5 sacks, moving into third on the Notre Dame single-season list (11) and extending his Irish career record to 26.5.
- Foskey also tacked on a tackle for loss and a forced fumble in the game.

MICHAEL MAYER

- Michael Mayer scored Notre Dame's first touchdown on a 22-yard reception in the second quarter, then followed up with a 24-yard scoring reception on the fourth quarter. It creates a new single-season tight end touchdown record with nine this season (surpassing Mayer's seven from last year) and extends his career TE touchdown mark to 18.
- Mayer nabbed eight receptions in the game to push his career total to 180, moving ahead of Jeff Samardzija (179) for third on Notre Dame's all-time reception list.
