#### THE GAME

- Saturday's game will mark the fourth time that NC State and Notre Dame have met on the gridiron and the third regular season meeting between the two teams.
- The teams faced off following the 2002 campaign in the Toyota Gator Bowl, when the Wolfpack capped off the winningest season in school history (11-3) with a 28-6 victory over the 11th-ranked Irish. That was the only time NC State has won a game involving two teams that had 10 wins entering the game.
- On the day that NC State celebrated the 50th anniversary of the first game in Carter-Finley Stadium, the two teams slugged it out in the torrential rain caused by the outer bands of Hurricane Matthew. A blocked punt return by FS Dexter Wright early in the fourth quarter was the game's lone touchdown and gave the Pack a 10-3 victory.
- The No. 14 Pack traveled to South Bend to take on the ninth-ranked Irish on Oct. 28, 2017. Notre Dame won that contest handily: 35-14.
- Wolfpack quarterback Brennan Armstrong has never faced Notre Dame. When his former team, Virginia, played the Irish in 2021, he was sitting out with broken ribs.
- NC State has faced Notre Dame quarterback Sam Hartman three times at his previous school: Wake Forest. Hartman was 1-2 vs. the Pack, losing both games in Carter-Finley. He put up big numbers, though - throwing for 823 yards on 72-131 passing. Although he threw six touchdowns in those three games, he also threw six interceptions and was sacked 13 times.
- This will mark the first time since 2005 that the Wolfpack faces a ranked opponent in its home opener. NC State dropped that contest, 16-20, to No. 8 Virginia Tech.
- The Wolfpack has blocked a punt that for a touchdown in each of the past two games against the Fighting Irish. In 2016, Pharoah McKeever blocked a punt that was returned by Dexter Wright for the game's only TD by either team, while in 2017, James Smith-Williams (Washington Commanders) blocked a punt that was recovered by Germaine Pratt (Cincinnati Bengals) in the endzone.

#### DIAMOND TIME

NC State's players will wear a sticker on the back of their helmets this week that feature the old diamond logo and the initials "DS" in honor of former Wolfpack head coach Dick Sheridan, who passed away in July.

Sheridan coached the Wolfpack from 1986-92, compiling a .637 winning percentage with a 52-29-3 overall record. During his tenure, his teams finished second or tied for second three times in the ACC and third twice. He was the 1986 Bobby Dodd College Football Coach of the Year and a 2020 inductee into the College Football Hall of Fame inductee.

Sheridan introduced the diamond logo in 1986, his first year as

head coach. The Wolfpack wore that helmet for the next 14 seasons. During his tenure, Sheridan posted the top winning percentage in school history at .637 (52-29-3).

Ironically, the last time Notre Dame came to Raleigh (10/8/2016), the Wolfpack wore throw-back uniforms featuring the diamond logo on the 50th anniversary of Carter-Finley Stadium.

## THE WOLFPACK

### HOME FIELD ADVANTAGE

The Wolfpack enters the 2023 season having won 16 of its last 17 home games.

In 2022, NC State tied the school record for the longest home winning streak at 16 before falling in the last home game of the season. That streak, which tied the mark set under head coach Lou Holtz from 1972-75, was the sixth-best active home winning streak in the FBS at the time.

Since the beginning of the 2017 season, the Wolfpack has posted a 33-7 mark in games played at Carter-Finley Stadium.

### HOME vs. NON-CON

NC State has won its last 24 home games against non-conference opponents, dating back to a 2013 loss to East Carolina. In other words, Dave Doeren (now in his 11th year as head coach of the Wolfpack), has not lost a home game to a non-con opponent since year 1.

The Wolfpack has won 23 straight home games vs. non-ACC teams, with the last loss coming on Nov. 23, 2013 to ECU (28-42).

### SEPTEMBER SUCCESS

The Wolfpack hasn't lost a home game in the month of September since 2014. Since that 41-56 loss to No. 1 Florida State on 9/27/14 has won 19 straight home games in the month of September plus one late August win.

### PACK-ED HOUSE

Before the Wolfpack even kicked off in the Duke's Mayo Bowl on Dec. 30, 2022, NC State had sold more than 31,000 season tickets for 2023. Wolfpack Nation has continued to show its anticipation with 35,000 season tickets sold (and that number doesn't include the sold out suites and club level in TowneBank Center).

It marks just the fourth time in school history the Pack has surpassed the 35k mark and marks the most season ticket revenue in program history.

Last season, the Wolfpack sold out six of its seven home games. That was the highest number of sold out games for NC State Football since 2003, when then-QB Philip Rivers had just one kid (his 10th is on the way!).

As of Aug. 15, 2023, the Pack has already repeated the feat for 2023 with six games completely sold out and as of Sept. 4 had just 350 tickets remaining to the VMI game.

### SIZE MATTERS

NC State's home field advantage will get even more advantageous in 2023 with the addition of the new videoboard on the north end of Carter-Finley Stadium.

The 7,121 square foot board, which is the 11th largest single-display board in college football, boasts 6.6+ million pixels. The concert-grade sound system will be one of the loudest and clearest in the country, with 75 Audio Speakers covering the entire stadium.

For perspective, the board is 50' wider than the height of the Memorial Belltower.

**DOEREN FINE**

Dave Doeren is just four wins from tying as the winningest coach in the 132 years of NC State football.

The Leader of the Pack boasts a 73-54 mark in his 10+ years as head coach, trailing only Earle Edwards, who tallied 77 wins.

Doeren has guided NC State to at least eight wins in five of the last six seasons and the Pack ranks third in the ACC in conference wins since 2018. Eight of his 10 Wolfpack squads have qualified for bowl games - the most of any coach in school history.

**DOEREN TIME**

NC State head coach Dave Doeren is now in his 11th season at the helm of the Wolfpack. That marks the second-longest tenure in the school history and ranks eighth among current FBS coaches.

**STARTING EARLY**

On the day before the season opener, freshman receiver KC Concepcion was named to the preseason watch list for the Shaun Alexander Freshman of the Year Award.

The following night, he was the only true freshman to start the win at UConn. In fact, he was the first true freshman wide receiver to start a game for NC State since 2016, when Kelvin Harmon got the start in Game 7.

To find the last time a true freshman started game 1 of a season, you've got to go all the way back to 2014. That year, Bo Hines got the nod in Game 1 vs. Georgia Southern.

Concepcion was the leading receiver against the Huskies with four grabs for 36 yards. He was the first true freshman since Hines to lead the Pack in receiving as well.

**BRENNAN ARM ... LEGSTRONG**

It was no secret when Brennan Armstrong came to NC State that he was a quarterback who could run. During his five years at UVa he amassed 1,267 rushing yards - more than any QB in NC State history.

In the season opener win over UConn, he showed off his running skill, scoring both of the team's touchdowns and leading the Wolfpack with 96 rushing yards.

That was the most rushing yards for an NC State quarterback since Jacoby Brissett (Washington Commanders) had 128 yards (and 2 TDs) rushing in a 2014 win over UNC.

**SPREADING THE WEALTH**

Although the Wolfpack rushed for more yards (209) than it passed for (155) in the season opener, the passing game was well distributed.

Nine different players caught passes for NC State in the win at Connecticut, led by rookie KC Concepcion with 4-36.

**DOMINANT DEFENSE**

The Wolfpack ranked among the top 20 nationally in seven different defensive categories last season, leading the ACC in scoring defense and passing efficiency defense. Tony Gibson's unit was the only Power 5 team to hold every opponent to 30 points or less in 2022 - marking the first time since 1980 an NC State squad had done so.

In the 2021 and 2022 seasons, the Wolfpack D allowed less than 1.5 points per drive. That mark held in the season opener, as the Huskies averaged 1.55 points per drive.

In fact, after a 75 yard touchdown drive on their first possession, the Huskies gained just 198 yards for the rest of the contest.

**ALL ABOARD!**

New Wolfpack offensive line coach Garret Tujague has not only brought a new energy to that position group, he's also brought a new stat.

In addition to charting knockdowns and pancakes for the o-line, Tujague also keeps track of "Raleigh Railroads."

A RR is an extended, sustained block - basically when the lineman pushes the defender back like a freight train.

In the season opener, LT Anthony Belton led the way with two Raleigh Railroads, while RT Tim McKay and LG Anthony Carter had one apiece.

**PAYTON'S PLACE**

Fifth-year Wolfpack linebacker Payton Wilson decided to come back for one more season, and Wolfpack Nation is happy he did.

The hard-hitting linebacker came out hot in the season opener, leading the Pack in tackles with 10 (including eight solo stops) and sealing the victory with an interception (the fourth of his career) late in the fourth quarter. That marked the 15th double-figure tackle tally of his career.

Wilson has been plagued by injuries throughout his career, but that hasn't slowed him down. One of 15 semifinalists for the 2022 Comeback Player of the Year Award, he ranked second on the team with 7.2 tackles per game and second with 9.5 tackles for loss last season despite missing two complete games.

While he wasn't the winner of the award, Wilson was certainly a contender. Prior to the 2021 season, Wilson underwent two shoulder surgeries to repair the labrum on his shoulder. Then in game two of 2021, he suffered a left shoulder dislocation with a bony Bankart lesion requiring him to undergo another surgery and miss the remainder of the season.

The surgery required a nine-month rehab as Wilson focused on regaining his range of motion and strength. He was back in the lineup in game one of 2022, but left that game early with an injury as well and missed the next contest.

### THE WHITE STUFF

Junior corner Aydan White has followed the momentum of his All-ACC performance in 2022 by being named to three preseason watch lists: Bednarik, Nagurski and Thorpe.

White played the most coverage snaps in the nation without allowing a touchdown in 2022 (482) according to PFF. He ranked second in the ACC in interceptions with four for the season - the No. 33 mark in the FBS. Those four picks were the most for a Wolfpack CB since 2012 (David Amerson).

He had three tackles and a PBU in the season opener.

### 8 for 80

The Wolfpack needed a veteran in its wideout corps, and boy did they get it!

Receiver Bradley Rozner is entering his eighth season of college football after transferring just before fall camp from Rice. The Needville, Texas, native missed four seasons during his career due to injuries (including the 2020 COVID season).

As far as we know, Rozner is just the third eight-year player in FBS history (Kyle Pugh, Northern Illinois and Cam McCormick, Oregon in 2022).

### SNAP DECISION

Never heard of Joe Shimko?

That's because he's so stinking good at his job!

NC State long snapper Joe Shimko has NEVER had a bad snap. And he's had plenty of opportunities! The graduate student has snapped for every placekick since the beginning of the 2019 season. He's handled every long snap in 50 straight games.

For his career, he boasts 239 long snaps and 244 short snaps (that's 483 total snaps for his career with ZERO bad snaps!).

Shimko was named a 2022 Patrick Mannely Award semifinalist - the award given to the nation's best player at his position - and is on the preseason watch list for 2023 as well.



But Shimko's contributions don't end when he hangs up his helmet. In the past two years, he's helped raised more than \$400,000 for charities, including \$50,000 for GiGi's Playhouse in Raleigh. For those efforts, he's on the preseason watch lists for the Wuerffel Trophy and the AFCA Good Works Team.

**SAME FACES, NEW PLACE**

There are a few new faces on the sideline for the Wolfpack in 2023, but although those faces might not be familiar to Wolfpack Nation, they're at least familiar to each other.

Offensive coordinator Robert Anae and offensive line coach Garret Tujague joined the staff in January, with Anae coming from Syracuse and Tujague coming from Virginia. However, with the exception of the '22 season, that duo had coached for nine years together (at BYU from 2013-15 and at UVA from 2016-21).

One of the Virginia offense's most prolific seasons during their tenure was the 2021 campaign. That unit ranked third in the FBS in total offense, averaging 515.8 yards per game for a program record.

The quarterback from that team is now wearing red and white as well. Brennan Armstrong reunited with his former OC (Anae) and the coach who recruited him (Tujague) at NC State in January. In 2021, Armstrong broke school single-season marks for touchdown passes (31), passing yards (4,449) and total offense (4,700).

**NEW FACES**

Five true freshmen saw action in the season opener: LB Kamal Bonner, CB Brandon Cisse, WR KC Concepcion, RB Kendrick Raphael, and TE Juice Vereen. All five of those players enrolled in January and went through spring practice.

Bonner and Cisse saw action on special teams only, while the three offensive players saw action from scrimmage: Concepcion (41 snaps), Vereen (7 snaps) and Raphael (5 snaps).

**WELCOME BACK**

Two talented players on defensive will return in 2023 after missing significant time.

DE/DT Savion Jackson missed the last six games of the 2022 season after suffering an injury in game seven at Syracuse. Jackson started the first seven games of the season before the injury - his second season-ending injury in as many years (In 2021, he suffered a torn ACL and missed the last three games).

After sitting out this spring, Jackson returned for fall camp. Although he did not play in the opener, he hopes to return to action vs. Notre Dame.

Back in action after missing two entire seasons is corner Cecil Powell. Powell started five of the 11 games he played in 2020, but then missed the 2021 and 2022 campaigns with a back injury.

Powell did not see action from scrimmage, but did play seven special teams snaps in the opener.

**LINING UP**

Returnees on NC State 2023 offensive line had combined to start 60 career games heading into the 2023 season. More than half of those starts (55%) had been from the versatile Dylan McMahon.

The graduate student (who is a redshirt junior in terms of eligibility) had started 33 games over the past three seasons: eight at left guard, 22 at right guard and three at center. Ironically, after just those three previous starts at center, he is on the preseason watch list for the Rimington Trophy.

**ONEPACK EMPOWERED**

A generous gift from Dave and Sara Doeren will establish a new initiative at NC State to support students with executive functioning challenges and those who are neurodivergent. Their \$1.25 million commitment is among the largest made by a college football coach to his NCAA-member institution.

The new program being launched through the Doeren Family Fund will be called OnePack Empowered and will benefit NC State students who face challenges with executive function skills critical to academic success, such as organization, planning, setting priorities, task completion and decision making.

Autism and attention deficit hyperactivity disorder are just two of the diagnoses that could be linked to challenges in this realm, but students with these challenges also might have no formal diagnosis; no particular diagnosis will be prioritized or required in the program's application process.

With a focus on one-on-one mentoring, individual support plans, career readiness and additional specialized assistance, the program is being designed to bolster academic and personal success and ensure students can complete their degrees.

The Doerens' commitment will pilot the program for five years, serving up to 50 students at a time. They hope to inspire other donors to join them in contributing to OnePack Empowered as a sustainable source of support and guidance for an expanding number of participants over the next several years.

**ANAE TO REMEMBER**

Offensive coordinator Robert Anae has earned a reputation as one of the top offensive minds in college football during his career. In his 16 previous years as an OC, his offenses have finished in the top 25 of 10 different NCAA offensive statistical categories a total of 56 times.

NC State is his third ACC stop in as many years. Here's how his offenses fared at the last two stops:

**OFFENSIVE (RE)ASSIGNMENTS**

With the additions of Robert Anae and Garret Tujague to the offensive staff, returning coaches have new assignments for 2023. Anae will coach the inside receivers, while Joker Phillips returns for his third season and will continue to coach the outside receivers.

Kurt Roper, who coached the Wolfpack running backs in 2020, '21 & '22, is now coaching the QBs - the position he also led in 2019. Tobb Goebbel, who has led the tight ends and fullbacks for the past four seasons, is now coaching the running backs.

**VETERAN STAFF**

NC State's coaching staff - including head coach Dave Doeren and the 10 full-time assistants - combines for 329 years of coaching experience. That's almost three and a half centuries!

Leading the way in terms of experience is defensive line coach Charley Wiles, followed by three coaches (OC Robert Anae, Safeties coach Joe DeForest and WR coach Joker Phillips) in their 36th season.

**GIVE A DAWG A BONE**

Defensive coordinator Tony Gibson says he wants 'dawgs' on his defense, aka tenacious, relentless, aggressive players. To commemorate those who play with those characteristics, the defensive staff introduced the TAKEAWAY BONE in 2020.

When a Wolfpack defender recovers a fumble or intercepts a pass, the BONE comes out on the sideline. The player who got the take-

away signs it and at the end of the season, whoever has signed it the most times gets to keep the bone.

Now in its fourth season, the TAKEAWAY BONE has come out 52 times.

**WATCH OUT FOR THE WOLFPACK**

NC State was well represented on the preseason watch lists for national awards in 2023. Led by returning All-ACC corner Aydan White - who was named to three different preseason lists - nine different players were named to 13 different watch lists.

**REPLACING THE LEADER**

In the 2,071 days between the final game of 2017 (12/29 at the Hyundai Sun Bowl) and the season opener of 2023, the Wolfpack had kicked the ball 318 times. Of those 318 kicks (which included 299 makes), 315 were by NC State's all-time leading scorer Christopher Dunn.

The 2022 Lou Groza Award winner finished his five-year career with an ACC-record 491 career points. Which means, there are some pretty big shoes to fill!

Transfer Braydan Narveson hopes to step up where Dunn left off. The grad transfer from Western Kentucky is on the preseason watch list for the Groza Award after connecting on 51-64 FGs and all 158 PATs in the last three years.

In the opener, Narveson missed a 50-yarder, but was good from 44 yards.

**CLOSE CALLS**

Half of the Wolfpack's 2022 games ended up being one-score finishes, with five contests decided by three points or less. Over the past three seasons, NC State has played in 16 contests decided by one score.

The Wolfpack posted a 4-2 record in one-score games last season.

off (CFP) and will continue to serve in that role for the 2023 season.

Corrigan, who will complete his three-year term as a member of the CFP selection committee, spent the second half of the 2022 season commuting back and forth between Raleigh and Texas as the committee compiled its weekly rankings. He also served as the spokesperson for the CFP committee following each week's picks.

**BROTHERLY LOVE**

There are three sets of brothers on the 2023 Wolfpack squad.  
*Crowell:* RB Micah and Nickel Isaiah.

*Seabrough:* These two brothers are identical twins who both play tight end: Cedd and Fred.

Vann: Davin is a returner on the offensive line, while Rylan is a back-up center.

**THE JUICE SQUAD**

One of the key factors behind the Wolfpack's success in recent games has been the contributions of the players on the bench - otherwise known as the JUICE SQUAD.

Head coach Dave Doeren challenged the players who are redshirting, injured or otherwise not playing on the sidelines to become a factor in the Wolfpack's home games by helping get the crowd into the game and loudly supporting the players on the field.

You can see that group on the sidelines at Carter-Finley waving towels, jumping up and down ... basically bringing the juice!

**ROAD OPENERS**

Prior to opening the season at ECU last season, NC State had not kicked off a season on its opponent's home field since 2008. Now the Pack will do it twice in two years.

Since 1970, the Wolfpack posts a 5-2 record in season openers on the road.

- In his 11th season at NC State, his 13th season as a head coach overall. Boasts the second-longest tenure in the ACC and the eighth in the FBS.
- Named to the preseason list to for the Dodd Trophy.
- Ranks second in Wolfpack history in coaching victories (73).
- Has more nine-win campaigns than any coach in school history (three) and has now led six of his 10 NC State squads to seasons with eight or more victories.
- Between 2017-22, 20 of his players have been drafted by the NFL - including an ACC-best seven in 2017 - the sixth-highest total nationally. Three of his players have gone on to be first-round picks, including OT Ikem Ekwonu (No. 6 to the Panthers) in 2022.
- The Wolfpack ranks third in the ACC in conference wins since 2018.
- In 2022, the Pack qualified for the eighth bowl game during his tenure, the most under any coach in program history.
- The Wolfpack has boasted 56 Academic All-ACC performers under his guidance - including a program-high 13 in 2022 - and in 2018 had a player named to the prestigious NFF National Scholar-Athlete Team.
- Three of his players have won four national awards: Bradley Chubb (2017 Nagurski Trophy, 2017 Hendricks Award), Garrett Bradbury (2018 Rimington Trophy) and Christopher Dunn (2022 Lou Groza Award).
- Over the 2021 and 2022 seasons, the Pack won 16 straight games, tying the longest home winning streak in school history (1972-74).
- 2022 NC State squad was the first since 1980 not to give up more than 30 points in a single game all season.
- Has coached bowl eligible teams in 17 of his 21 years in Division I.
- He and his wife Sara have donated \$1.25 million to establish a new initiative at NC State to support students with executive functioning challenges and those who are neurodivergent. Their commitment is among the largest made by a college football coach to his NCAA-member institution.
- Led Northern Illinois to the most successful two years in program history.
- His first Husky squad won the school's first MAC Championship since 1983 and tied the school record with 11 wins.
- His 2012 NIU team repeated as league champ and set a new school mark with 12 victories, earning a trip to the Orange Bowl - the first BCS berth ever for a MAC school.
- Was a finalist for several national coach of the year awards in 2012.
- NIU boasted the nation's longest conference winning streak (17) and never lost a home game during his tenure.
- Spend five seasons in the Big Ten, serving as defensive coordinator and linebackers coach at Wisconsin.
- Spent four seasons at Kansas and was on staff when the Jayhawks ended a seven-year bowl drought.
- In 2000 and 2001, coached the secondary at NCAA Division I-AA powerhouse Montana. The Grizzlies advanced to the national title game in 2000, losing by two points, but returned in 2001 to win the championship.
- Montana posted a 28-3 record and won two Big Sky titles during his tenure.
- Planned to go to medical school following college and become an orthopedic surgeon. He took the MCAT but after helping coach high school between his junior and senior years, fell in love with coaching.
- Lettered at tight end at Drake and was an Academic All-American.
- Earned his undergraduate degree in pre-medical biology. Earned his master's from Drake in educational leadership and began work on a Ph.D. while serving as a graduate assistant at the University of Southern California.
