TEAM NOTES

- Louisville won the toss and deferred its choice to the second half. Notre Dame received and started the game defending the south end zone.
- Attendance: 59,081 - A L&N Stadium record
- Notre Dame falls to 2-2 all-time against Louisville and 1-1 in L&N Stadium.
- Notre Dame's 30-game regular-season win streak over ACC teams ended tonight, as did their 15-game road win streak against ACC teams.

SUPERLATIVES

- Spencer Shrader kicked his third and fourth 50-yard (or more) field goals this season in the third quarter, connecting from 53 yards and matching his school-record with a 54-yard kick. He joins Kyle Brindza (2011-14) and Jonathan Doerer (2017-21) for the school record for career 50-yard field goals with four each.

FIRSTS

- Freshman wide receiver Jordan Faison had a number of firsts this evening, first appearance, first career reception (a third-down conversion) then his first touchdown reception – a 36-yard catch in the second quarter.
- Joshua Burnham - first career start
- Eli Raridon - first game played of the season and first action since the BYU game last season on October 15, 2022 - 357 days ago.
- Clarence Lewis - first start of the season, 22nd of his career and first since the Marshall game in 2022.
