OPENING TIP: The 'Cats hit the road for the first time in the 2023-24 season on Wednesday, heading to South Bend to take on the No. 16 Fighting Irish. It will be the first ranked matchup of Northwestern's season and their first against a Power Five opponent.

- Notre Dame leads the all-time series 4-2 after beating the 'Cats 92-58 at Welsh-Ryan Arena last fall. Northwestern will visit South Bend for the fourth time in program history and the first time since 1987. They hold a 1-2 road record against the Irish.
- The last time the Wildcats won their road opener was 2020-21, when they beat Purdue 70-54 in December of the pandemic-shortened season.
- Northwestern last beat a ranked opponent on Feb. 13, 2022, taking down No. 4 Michigan 71-69 in overtime at Welsh-Ryan.

THE DALEY NEWS: After missing the majority of last season, **Melannie Daley** has opened her junior year with back-to-back 20-point games, the second and third of her career. Daley backed up her career-high 25 points in Thursday's opener with 21 more on Sunday against Omaha, giving her a top-30 scoring average nationally through the first few games. The performance made her one of just four Big Ten players to score 20+ points in each of her first two games this season and her 22 made field goals are second only to Caitlin Clark's 30.

GET LAU'D: With 11 points and 12 assists against Omaha, **Caroline Lau** has now posted back-to-back double-doubles to begin the season. She opened with a near-program record 15 assists in the opener and has racked up 27 total through her first two games - good for an NCAA-best 13.5-per-game average. That's more than three assists per game ahead of second-place Sharonica Hartsfield (Troy, 10.0). Last Thursday, Lau became the second Wildcat in program history to record a 15+ assist game (Nancy Kennelly) and the first to do so since 1993. The sophomore currently owns two of the NCAA's top five spots in single-game assists this year, including the number-one slot, and is one of just two Big Ten players to post 15 or more assists in a game in the last three seasons (Caitlin Clark, Iowa).

A PAIGE IN THE RECORD BOOK: Paige Mott grabbed 20 rebounds in the season opener, by far a career high, en route to the second double-double of her career. That total tied for third in single-game program history and made Mott the fifth Wildcat all-time to log a 20+ rebound game in purple. She's the first Northwestern player to do so since Pallas Kunaiki-Akpanah in 2018 and one of three players in the NCAA to do so this season so far. On Sunday, she followed it up with a second consecutive double-double that included 13 more rebounds. Mott's 16.5 rebounds per game so far are tied for first in the nation and lead the Big Ten by more than a four-rebound margin. In addition to the boards, Mott is averaging 13.5 points and 4.0 assists per game after dealing out a career-high five dimes against Omaha.

FIRST FIVE: Both of Northwestern's games this season have ended with all five of their starters in double figures - the first games with five NU players in double digits since February of 2022. Last season, the 'Cats topped out at four double-digit scorers, a mark they hit three times. Through the first week of regular season play, Northwestern is one of just two Big Ten teams to have five players averaging double digit scoring (Michigan State).

FAST FACTS:

- Sunday's win was **Head Coach Joe McKeown's** 252nd, making him the winningest coach in Northwestern basketball history.
- **Crystal Wang** recorded two points and a rebound in her collegiate debut on Sunday.
- The 'Cats are averaging 28.5 assists per game so far, good for first in the Big Ten and third in the NCAA.
- Junior **Melannie Daley** hit the second three-point field goal of her career as part of her 21-point performance against Omaha.

MORE NOTES...

NO FLY ZONE: Northwestern finished play last season second in the Big Ten and 26th in the NCAA in blocks, at 4.7 per game. It was the second straight season to see the 'Cats near the top of the ranks after they finished first in the conference and 15th nationally in 2021-22. Sydney Wood led all Wildcats with 38, but **Caileigh Walsh** was close behind, with 35. After logging 40 blocks as a first year in 2021-22, Walsh was one of just two Big Ten Players to block 35 or more shots in both of the last two seasons (Mackenzie Holmes, Indiana). The 'Cats are off to a strong start in that category again this season and enter Wednesday's matchup averaging 5.0 blocks per game. Walsh has blocked three shots so far, and **Paige Mott** has stepped up defensively as well, leading the team with four blocks through two games. Northwestern is currently the only Big Ten team with more than one player averaging more than 1.0 block per game.

HAILEY THIEVER: Junior **Hailey Weaver** emerged as a defensive weapon in the second half of last season for Northwestern, racking up 33 steals in under 300 total minutes on the floor. Despite ranking ninth on last year's team in minutes, she ranked third in steals, picking them up at a team-best clip of 4.5-per-40 minutes. That rate was not only first among Northwestern players, it was also near the top of the conference, ranking fourth among Big Ten players with at least two games played and second among Big Ten players with at least 40 minutes on the season. Weaver collected a team-high three steals in 20 minutes of playing time in the exhibition against Lewis, then started her official season off with a steal against UIC and three more against Omaha.

TRIPLE DOUBLE-DOUBLE: **Caroline Lau, Paige Mott** and **Caileigh Walsh** all recorded double-doubles last Thursday - the first trio of Wildcats teammates to do so in the same game since February 7, 2016. That game also reached overtime and that trio also consisted of two point/rebound double-doubles and one point/assist double-double. Though the 'Cats eventually fell to Minnesota 112-106, Maggie Lyon notched 31 points and 12 rebounds, Nia Coffey had 28 and 12 and Ashley Deary scored 22 and dealt out 11 assists.

POWER WALSH: **Caileigh Walsh** came three assists shy of a triple-double in the season opener after recording 19 points and 12 rebounds in the contest. That rebound total was a career high for Walsh, good for the fifth double-digit rebound game of her career and her third career double-double. As a sophomore, Walsh scored in double digits in 15 of 30 games last year, including three 20+ point performances - the only Northwestern player to reach that total more than once.

MOTT STREAK: **Paige Mott** made a major impact in her junior season as she transitioned from a bench to a starting role, and she'll look to continue that leadership as a second-year captain in 2023. Mott appeared in all 30 of Northwestern's games last season, starting 25, and more than doubled her output from 2021-22. She finished with 267 points and 132 rebounds, both of which put her second on the team, and shot a team-best 52.7 percent from the floor. Of the 25 games she started, she reached either double-digit points or rebounds in 15 of them. Her production only increased throughout the year; she scored in double digits in ten of her final 13 games of the year, making her the leading scorer in seven of those matchups. Along with Courtney Shaw and Abbie Wolf, Mott is one of just three Wildcats in the past five seasons to finish a year with a shooting percentage of at least 52 percent.

PINA POWER: For the first time in Head Coach Joe McKeown's Northwestern tenure, he welcomed a graduate transfer to his roster this offseason. **Maggie Pina**, a guard from Boston University, suited up against UIC for her first game with the 'Cats on Thursday and scored her first points of the bench on Sunday. Pina brings a long resume to Evanston, including five Rookie of the Week selections in 2019-20, 2020 Patriot League Rookie of the Year honors, and Third-Team All-Conference selection. Pina's strength is from deep, as she hit 29 or more three-pointers each of her four seasons in Boston, including a team-best 51 last year. All that added up to 186 made threes in her BU career, good for third in program history. She's already made an impact beyond the arch for the 'Cats, too, going 2-3 from deep for six points against Omaha.

WELCOME TO WELSH-RYAN: In addition to graduate transfer **Maggie Pina**, the 'Cats welcomed three first years to their roster this offseason. Guard **Casey Harter** and forward **Crystal Fuqu Wang** saw action last week and forward **Rachel Mutombo** will look to make her debut in purple soon. Wang graduated from Sierra Canyon High School in California, which ranks among the top girls basketball schools in the nation. The 6'2" forward has also spent time with the Chinese National Team. Mutombo comes to the 'Cats out of Good Counsel High School in Silver Spring, Md. - the same high school as Wildcat great Lindsey Pulliam. A 6'3" forward, Mutombo comes from a long basketball lineage, including NBA Hall-of-Famer Dikembe Mutombo, Rachel's uncle. Harter, a 5'11" guard, scored over 1,000 points in her high school career.

THE CAPTAINS: Seniors **Jasmine McWilliams** and **Paige Mott** and sophomore **Caroline Lau** were tabbed as the team's 2023-24 captains earlier this fall. Mott begins her second year in the role after stepping up as a leader both on and off the court during her junior season. McWilliams, the only other senior on the roster, started 20 games last year for the Wildcats and averaged 2.7 points and 2.0 rebounds per game. The final captain, Lau, is the first sophomore to earn the role since Veronica Burton in 2019-20.

COACH MCKEOWN: Head coach Joe McKeown is in his 16th year at the helm of Northwestern's women's basketball program, making him the longest tenured women's basketball coach in school history.

- McKeown has now outlasted Don Perrelli, who headed the team for 15 seasons from 1984 to 1999 and is the only head coach besides McKeown to lead the program to a conference title.
- McKeown currently ranks second among active Big Ten coaches in total wins with 252, which is the most wins by a Northwestern head coach.
- The Wildcats have enjoyed ten winning seasons, five trips to the WNIT and two NCAA tournament bids during McKeown's time at the helm.

JOE MCKEOWN

HEAD WOMEN'S BASKETBALL COACH



Joe McKeown enters his 16th season with Northwestern as the longest tenured women's basketball coach in school history. He was hired on June 9, 2008, and has led the program to a record 252 wins since.

During his time in Evanston, McKeown has transformed the culture of the women's basketball program while cementing his name as one of the winningest coaches in NCAA Division I Women's Basketball. He currently ranks second among active Big Ten coaches in total wins and is first in Northwestern history after guiding the Wildcats to ten winning seasons.

During his tenure, the Wildcats have established a number of program firsts. Nia Coffey became the first freshman in program history to be named First Team All-Big Ten during the 2013-14 campaign. Maggie Lyon became the first Wildcat to be crowned Big Ten Freshman of the Year in 2013 and Amy Jaeschke became the first Northwestern player to be selected in the WNBA Draft in 2011. Most recently, Veronica Burton was named Northwestern's first AP All-American in women's basketball after the 2021-22 campaign.

McKeown has also led the Wildcats to plenty of postseason success; they've qualified for postseason play in six of the last ten seasons. That span has included two trips to the NCAA tournament and three to the WNIT, including the 2018-19 season where they finished as runners up. McKeown was named the Big Ten Coach of the Year following NU's tremendous run in 2019-20, when the Wildcats' record-breaking 26 wins overall and 16 in conference play also led to him being named one of five semifinalists for the Naismith Trophy Women's College Coach of the Year.

McKeown joined the Wildcats from George Washington University, where he coached the Colonials for 19 seasons. He led the program to 14 regular season or postseason Atlantic 10 Conference crowns as well as 15 NCAA Tournaments and departed as the winningest coach in school and conference history.

Before starting at George Washington in 1989, McKeown spent three seasons as the head coach at New Mexico State. Prior to that, he served as an assistant coach at the University of Oklahoma from 1983-86, and at his alma mater, Kent State University, from 1979-83.

As a player, McKeown earned Junior College National Small Player of the Year honors at Mercer College in Trenton, N.J., before transferring to Kent State the following season. There, he co-captained the Golden Flashes as a senior and earned honorable mention All-Mid-American Conference honors. His school-record 15 assists in a game still stands.
