## #13 MICHIGAN WOLVERINES vs NOTRE DAME FIGHTING IRISH GAMES #17-18

### THE SERIES

- This weekend, a pair of long-standing institutional rivals reignite an intra-conference series for the first time in the 2023/24 season. The other half of this year's rivalry will take place in Ann Arbor to close out February for the penultimate series of the regular season.
- Last season on the road, U-M won the first meeting by four goals before falling to the Irish in OT. In the second half, the teams tied before Notre Dame escaped with a second OT win.
- No. 20 Notre Dame enters with a 7-5-2 record. They've gone 3-1-2 through six in the Big Ten.

### WOLVERINE BITES

- Michigan enters the final weekend of the first half with a 7-6-3 record after beating and tying St. Cloud State last week on the road. Inconsistency has led to a number of splits, but the non-conference record sits at 5-2-1 with two games against Stonehill remaining.
- Head Coach Brandon Naurato is in his second season behind the bench. Naurato, a 2009 graduate of U-M, posted the most wins (26) of any first-year Michigan HC last season.
- Despite facing a rash of injuries, the team's forward corps features a highly-skilled group of returners. Center TJ Hughes (8G, 12A) has 20 points while junior Dylan Duke (7G, 11A) has 18 points. Gavin Brindley (10G, 7A) leads the team in goal-scoring while Frank Nazar III (7G, 10A) also has 17 points. Freshmen Garrett Schifsky (8G, 8A) and Nick Moldenhauer (3G, 6A) have made an impact in the nightly lineup from the jump.
- On the back end, Seamus Casey (4G, 18A) has dazzled through 16 games to be the nation's highest-scoring D with 22 points. Captain Jacob Truscott (2G, 7A), Marshall Warren (1G, 8A) and Tyler Duke (1G, 6A) have contributed in both ends on a nightly basis.
- Jake Barczewski has gone 6-5-3 as a Wolverine while surpassing a pair of milestones with his 100th collegiate start and 3,000th career save. The goaltender has 401 saves so far this season to post a .913 save percentage and 2.69 goals against average. Last week, he backstopped Michigan to the team's first shutout victory since March 2022 at SCSU.
- Michigan's second-ranked power-play unit is operating at 32.8%. Against Lindenwood, the team scored six PPG for the first time since Dec. 31, 1996 when U-M went 6-for-10 at the GLI against Ferris State. Meanwhile, the penalty kill (72.6%) has had growing pains.

### SCOUTING THE IRISH

- On the day after Thanksgiving, Notre Dame hosted the now top-ranked Boston College Eagles, and BC's offense was merciless en route to a 6-1 win at Compton Family Ice Arena.
- The forward group is led by the team's top goal-scorer, Landon Slaggert (10G, 4A), at 14 points, and assist leader, freshman Danny Nelson (2G, 10A) with 12. A pair of freshmen

## BY THE NUMBERS

Sophomore Seamus Casey is second in the country with 18 assists. He's had at least one in 15 of 16 games thus far along with three two-assist games.

Casey is the nation's third-highest scorer as well as the highest-scoring defenseman. With 22 points off four goals and his 18 helpers, he's four points clear of second-most.

 • On the blue line, Harvard transfer Ryan Siedem (1G, 9A) and Drew Bavaro (4G, 5A) are third and fourth on the team in scoring, respectively. Zach Plucinski leads UND with 31 blocked shots while Siedem isn't far behind with 26.  
 • In net, Ryan Bischel has been a multi-year stalwart for the Irish and is currently the league's reigning Goaltender of the Year. Playing in every game, the veteran has posted a .928 save percentage and 2.37 goals against average in addition to three shutouts.  
 • Head Coach Jeff Jackson is no stranger to the Wolverines; the bench boss is in his 25th season as a collegiate head coach, and 21 of those campaigns have featured his teams sharing a conference with U-M. In 19 years with the Irish, Jackson has gone 399-247-71. Overall, he sits at 581 career wins in Division 1 hockey.

### LOOK AROUND THE LEAGUE

• #8 Michigan State traveled to #7 Minnesota and took three of six points with a shootout win on Friday before forcing OT with a late goal Saturday to split the weekend. This weekend, MSU is on a bye while Minnesota heads to #18 Penn State.  
 • In non-conference action, PSU swept Lindenwood, Ohio State swept Princeton, and #5 Wisconsin split with Alaska-Anchorage after being upset 1-0 in the first game.  
 • OSU travels to Madison this weekend for a pair of games against the Badgers.

### RED LIGHT STAYS LIT

The Wolverines are scoring an average of 4.31 goals per game, ranking third nationally in scoring offense behind Denver and Quinnipiac. The Maize and Blue have 69 goals in 16 games; the record for most goals in a season is from 1976-77 when the team tallied 260.

### B1G SECOND STAR, VOL. II

Goaltender Jake Barczewski was named Second Star of the Week by the Big Ten for the second time this season after an outstanding two-game performance in non-conference action. Barzo notched his first shutout in Maize & Blue on Friday at St. Cloud State with a 30-save performance. On Saturday, he was at the top of his game once again as he turned aside 36 of 39 shots to earn a tie for the Wolverines.

### EVEN-STRENGTH MAN

Garrett Schifsky enters as the national leader in even-strength goals (8). The freshman from Andover, Minn. has been a point-per-game player through 16 games with eight goals and eight assists while leading the team and sitting ninth nationwide with a +12 rating.

### SHOTPUTTERS

Michigan has the third-most shots on goal (572) in all of college hockey, trailing only conference foes Penn State (631) and Michigan State (579). U-M has outshot the opposition in 10 of 16 games in addition to tying in shots in one other contest. The Wolverines are scoring on 12.1% of the team's shots on goal, seventh-best in the country.

### IT'S BEEN AWHILE

Gavin Brindley scored on a penalty shot two weeks ago against Penn State. Brindley's goal, his team-leading 10th marker of the season, was the first successful penalty shot for a Wolverine since Alex Guptill netted one against Boston University on Oct. 25, 2013.

### CASEY'S CRUISING

• Seamus Casey continues to excel while embracing the role of the next great in a long line of stalwart, two-way defensemen at the University of Michigan. Casey (4G, 18A) is the nation's highest-scoring D with 22 points (2nd has 18) and a +11 rating in 16 games.  
 • In 53 career games, Casey has 12 goals and 39 assists for 51 points (.96 pt/gm). In an exhibition game last season, the shorthanded Wolverines slotted Casey in at center and the dynamic skater proceeded to put up four points against the US NTDP U-18 team.  
 • With 22 points already in his sophomore campaign, the blueliner is just seven away from matching his 37-game freshman year total of 29 points.

### SKILLS COMPETITION

Michigan won a shootout against Minnesota on Veteran's Day after the teams tied 2-2 at Yost Ice Arena. Seamus Casey netted the shootout winner to clinch the extra point for U-M in the team's first shootout win in over three years. Before Casey sent the people

home happy, Michigan's last 50 win had come on Feb. 28, 2020, also against Minnesota.

### HEY, SHORTIE

- Michigan notched its first two shorthanded goals of the season in the nine-goal win over Lindenwood when Gavin Brindley and Jackson Hallum lit the lamp twice in a 62-second span. The last time Michigan scored two shorties in a game was Feb. 12, 2022 vs. MSU when Jimmy Lambert and Thomas Bordeleau each scored to win the Duel in the D.
- Last season, the team scored three SHG in 41 games; Garrett Schifsky added an empty-net goal while shorthanded two weeks ago for U-M's third of the year to match that total.

### DOMINANCE IN THE DOT

- Michigan's staff has placed an emphasis on faceoffs, and the effort is paying off through 16 games. U-M leads the nation with 582 faceoff wins while the team's 55.5% win rate leads all of men's Division 1 hockey. Through 16 games, U-M has won the faceoff battle 12 times.
- Frank Nazar III has won a team-high 170 draws in 285 chances (59.6%) while his classmate TJ Hughes is winning them at a 61.3% (166 of 271) clip. Before his injury, the team's leader in the dot was junior Mark Estapa at 63% (68 of 108).

### EXTRA SPECIAL

- Michigan leads all of college hockey with 22 power-play goals, and the team's 32.8% success rate has U-M's power-play unit ranked second in the country.
- Michigan buried six power-play goals on nine chances in the second contest to sweep Lindenwood. The six-spot was the team's first since Dec. 31, 1996 when the Wolverines went 6-for-10 against Ferris State in a big win at the Great Lakes Invitational.
- The most successful PP in program history was the 1979-80 team that finished the year at a 35.8% clip (power-play tracking began in 1970-71).

### GRIZZLED GOALTENDER

Netminder Jake Barczewski joined the Wolverines as the NCAA's active career leader in saves (2,719) following a four-year run at Canisius. After making his 100th career start against OSU, he's now added 401 saves in 14 games as a Wolverine to build upon his lead. Barczewski, a graduate student at U-M, eclipsed the 3,000th career save mark against Penn State before notching his 50th career win last week at St. Cloud State.

### OUT THE GATES

Michigan has scored first in 13 of 16 games. Last week, the team opened the scoring in both contests on the road at St. Cloud, but just barely failed to cash in a sweep, tying on Saturday.

### STEADY SCORING

The Wolverines have scored in 35 of 48 periods thus far, with 22 multi-goal periods through 16 games. The high-water mark thus far was a seven-goal stanza against Lindenwood.

### NOT TOP 10

U-M is ranked No. 13 in the latest national poll; this stint out of the top-10 marks the first time that Michigan has fallen out of that select company in the rankings since Nov. 15, 2020.

### BACK-TO-BACK NINE-SPOTS

The offensive outpouring against Lindenwood saw the Wolverines score 9+ goals in back-to-back games for the first time since January 1996. That dominant stretch from nearly 28 years ago saw U-M score nine or more goals in four-straight contests: wins over Ferris State (10-3), Miami (13-0), and the now-defunct Illinois-Chicago Flames (9-3, 9-1).

### MAN OF THE MONTH

Rutger McGroarty was named the Hockey Commissioner's Association co-Player of the Month for the opening month of the 2023-24 season. McGroarty led the nation in scoring during October, finishing with 15 points in eight games, scoring five goals and 10 assists. He had at least one point in seven games, including the first five of the season, that extended his point-scoring streak to a career-high 13 games. McGroarty's best game was a four-point outing against Providence on Oct. 8. In the eight games he played, he had multiple points in five. He netted two game-winning goals and two power-play goals and led the team in shots with 33.

TJ Hughes had a career weekend against Lindenwood, and was rewarded for his impressive effort by receiving recognition as the Big Ten's Second Star of the Week. The sophomore pivot turned in three points on Friday before re-writing his personal record book with a five-point performance off two goals and a trio of assists on Saturday.

**SECOND STARZO FOR BARZO**

Goaltender Jake Barczewski earned the Big Ten's Second Star of the Week for his performance in his first career Big Ten series. In a win and a tie against Ohio State, Barczewski made 67 saves in 125 minutes of work while allowing three goals against.

**NHL FACTORY**

- With the return of the National Hockey League for the 2023-24 season, a new U-M hockey record has been set with 25 Michigan alumni making opening night rosters. Despite two (Josh Norris & Max Pacioretty) of the ex-Wolverines beginning the year on the injured reserve, 18 of 32 teams claim at least one representative of the Maize and Blue family.
- Will Lockwood's recent call-up by Florida makes it 26 Wolverines that have been featured on rosters in the NHL this season, the most of any NCAA program.
- Of the six captains in the NHL that played college hockey, half of them went to Michigan. With Dylan Larkin (DET), Quinn Hughes (VAN) and Jacob Trouba (NYR) wearing the "C"
- Johnny Beecher (BOS), Mackie Samoskevich (FLA), and Adam Fantilli (CBJ) made their National Hockey League debuts last month to bring U-M's total count of NHLers to 113.
- On Oct. 24, all 32 NHL teams participated in the league's first-ever "Frozen Frenzy." #ProBlue alumni featured in 13 of 16 games; 11 Wolverines accrued a total of 15 points. Dylan Larkin (1G, 2A), Adam Fantilli (1G, 1A), and Matty Beniers (2A) led the way.
- Kyle Connor was named the NHL Second Star of the Week on Nov. 13. He recorded his fifth career hat trick. He has the second-most goals in the NHL with 14.
- Quinn Hughes was named the NHL First Star of the Week last week. He currently sits in second among all NHL players with 33 points off eight goals and 25 assists this season.

**FIRST "FIRST STAR" HONORS**

Rutger McGroarty was honored as the Big Ten's First Star of the Week following the first weekend. Rut turned in his first collegiate four-point effort with one goal and three assists to lead U-M to a win on Sunday after tallying a single assist in Saturday's loss.

**EARLY APTITUDE**

By salvaging a split against Providence, the Wolverines have now gone nine seasons without beginning 0-2. The last group to drop their first two games was the 2014-15 team captained by Andrew Copp (C), Zach Hyman (A), and JT Compher (A).

**FIVE EXTRA LETTERS**

The captaincy will reside on Michigan's blue line after a year in the forward corps. Over the summer, senior defenseman Jacob Truscott was named the 105th captain in Michigan hockey history. Before the first game, graduate transfer Marshall Warren, senior Philippe Lapointe, and juniors Dylan Duke/Ethan Edwards were named alternate captains.

**WE PUT THE "BLUE" IN BLUE JACKETS**

At the 2023 NHL Draft in June, the Columbus Blue Jackets added to their well-established ties to the University of Michigan by drafting Adam Fantilli (#3) and Gavin Brindley (#34). Fantilli signed an entry-level contract to join a trio of recent Wolverines (Zach Werenski, Nick Blankenburg, and Kent Johnson) in the CBJ lineup while Brindley returns for his sophomore campaign as the team's third-highest drafted skater (McGroarty/Nazar).

**MICHIGAN'S OWN HOBEBY HAT TRICK**

- Following a record-breaking freshman campaign, forward Adam Fantilli was awarded the Hobey Baker Memorial Award in Tampa. Fantilli joined Kevin Porter (2008) and Brendan Morrison (1997) in rarified air by winning NCAA hockey's most prestigious honor.
- Fantilli's designation as a Hobey Baker finalist was the 25th such nod for a Michigan skater. In total, 21 separate Wolverines have been named finalists for the prestigious award since it was first established and handed out in 1981.

## NOTES

### SMALL BUT MIGHTY

• This year's class of four freshmen is Michigan's smallest since 2004-05 when a class of two (Kevin Porter and Chad Kolarik) reached campus to be impact players from the jump. The quartet is the fourth-smallest group in the nation this year; only St. Thomas, Miami, and Omaha brought in fewer first-year skaters.

• Despite a limited quantity of freshmen, U-M is tied with Minnesota and Notre Dame as the ninth-youngest team in the country. As of Oct. 1, U-M's average age was 21.5 years.

### BIG PRESEASON PICKS

In the Big Ten's Preseason Coaches Poll, Michigan was selected to finish in second place behind Minnesota. Last season, U-M was slated to finish third before locking up the second-seed in the regular season to win its second-consecutive Big Ten tournament.

### ALL-BIG PREDICTIONS

Five Wolverines were among the 18 skaters selected by the league's coaches to the Big Ten's preseason all-conference teams: Gavin Brindley & Seamus Casey (1st Team), Rutger McGroarty & Frank Nazar III (2nd Team), and Dylan Duke (Honorable Mention).

### PRESEASON ALL-CHN

Doubling last year's number, U-M had a pair of skaters named to College Hockey News' preseason All-CHN teams. Sophomore D Seamus Casey made the first team while recent NHL pick and longtime friend of Casey, Gavin Brindley, was named to the second team.

### GENUINE DRAFT

Michigan has a pair of first-round draft picks on this year's team (McGroarty/Nazar), two of just 14 in all of college hockey. In total, 11 of Michigan's 26 rostered players have been selected in the NHL Draft and 10 NHL organizations have prospects on the team. U-M's 11 total draft picks are tied for the seventh-most in the NCAA.

### BACK-TO-BACK BIG BOSSES

• After finishing in second-place in the regular season for the second-straight year, the Wolverines repeated as Big Ten Tournament Champions by beating Minnesota on their home ice. It was déjà vu, as a second-seeded Michigan team clad in navy skated into a jam-packed Mariucci Arena to knock off the top-seeded Gophers in a fantastic 4-3 game.

• Following the tournament, Adam Fantilli was named Most Outstanding Player in addition to headlining the All-Tournament team. The other Wolverines on the All-Tournament team were the trio of Rutger McGroarty, Seamus Casey, and Luke Hughes.

• Michigan now leads the Big Ten with three tournament titles (2016, 2022, 2023).

### NAURATO NAMED NUMBER 10

• Head Coach Brandon Naurato had the "interim" tag removed last year when he was named the University of Michigan ice hockey program's 10th all-time head coach. As the interim bench boss, Naurato led U-M through a campaign of adversity on the team's way to a Big Ten tournament championship, a #1 seed in the NCAA tournament, a Frozen Four bid, and a 26-12-3 (.671) record.

• The team's 26 wins were the most under a first-year head coach in program history. In total, Coach Naurato's record behind the bench is 33-18-6 (.632) through 57 games.

• The first-year head coach led Michigan to a 3-0 start after getting the top job in the offseason. Naurato is the first U-M head coach to start with three straight wins since Joseph Barss and the inaugural 1922-23 team debuted with three wins in their first three games vs. Wisconsin.

• Through the first eight games of the Naurato era, the team went 7-1. That mark is the best-ever start to a Michigan hockey coach's career (through eight games), comfortably besting the previous recordholder, Dan Farrell, whose team started 5-2-1 in 1973-74.



NOTES

NEW STAFF, WHO DIS?

Head Coach Brandon Naurato and Associate Coach Rob Rassey return for their second season at the helm in Ann Arbor. Over the summer, a pair of assistant coaches were added to the staff:

- Matt Deschamps is an '05 UMaine alum who played 111 games on defense for the Black Bears, with four-straight NCAA tournament appearances and a pair of Frozen Fours. For the past three years, Deschamps has excelled as an assistant with the USHL's Chicago Steel, where he coached 30 players who were selected in the NHL Draft. A noted defensive specialist, Coach Deschamps will mainly focus on the team defense & penalty kill.
- Kevin Reiter played goalie for the University of Alaska-Anchorage, graduating in 2004. After a seven-year run in professional hockey, he began his coaching career overseas, serving in various roles across the junior, professional, and national ranks. Reiter has been with the US National Team Development Program in Plymouth since 2013, acting as the NTDP's goaltending coach before being promoted to Director of Player Personnel in 2017. In total, Coach Reiter won seven gold medals with Team USA in addition to a number of other medals.

DOUBLE DUKE

- Tyler Duke's transfer from Ohio State to Michigan has reunited the Duke brothers. Like the elder Duke, Dylan, Tyler played his final two years of junior hockey with the US National Team Development Program, where he played alongside defense partner Seamus Casey as well as forwards Rutger McGroarty/Frank Nazar III.
- U-M has a history of brothers playing together, including Luca & Adam Fantilli, Nick & Michael Pastujov, and many more going all the way back to Gib & Eldon James in the 30s.

THE CATHEDRAL OF COLLEGE HOCKEY

Yost is tied with Hobey Baker Rink (Princeton) as the 2nd-oldest arena in college hockey, trailing only Northeastern's Matthews Arena. \*Yost did not serve as a rink until 1973

TRAINING CAMP TIME

Thirty-six Wolverines appeared in NHL training camps this year, with Columbus leading the way at four Michigan alums (Nick Blankenburg, Adam Fantilli, Kent Johnson, and Zach Werenski) in camp. In total, 23 of 32 teams had Wolverines attending training camp.

SIX STRAIGHT DDDDDDUELS

Every year, Michigan and MSU circle the "Duel in the D" when schedules are released. U-M has won six-consecutive Iron "D" trophies in the annual Motor City showdown after MSU won the inaugural battle in 2017 in OT. Last year, with time winding down in 3x3 OT, Luke Hughes netted the GWG with 0.6 seconds left to send LCA into a frenzy as the Wolverines poured off the bench and onto the ice to celebrate Michigan's trophy game victory. This year's Duel is scheduled for Saturday, February 10.

WEST JERSEY

New Jersey is the only NHL organization with multiple draft picks on the roster this season; their two defensive prospects (Ethan Edwards/ Seamus Casey) will look to uphold the pipeline that was recently traveled by All-American defenseman Luke Hughes.

BIG TOURNEY TIME

- Through 24 games in the modern Big Ten conference tournament, Michigan is 17-7 and has claimed a trio of championships (2016, 2022, 2023). In addition to owning the record for most overall Big Ten Tournament wins, U-M is 10-0 all-time when seeded second.
- Michigan's most common opponent in Big Ten tournament history is

Minnesota, with last year's Championship being the seventh overall meeting between the two schools.

U-M HOCKEY TURNED 100

- Last season, Michigan hockey celebrated the 100th anniversary of its first game (Jan. 12, 1923 vs. Wisconsin) under inaugural Head Coach Joseph Barss. Over the past century of intercollegiate competition, the program has gone 1784-1139-174 (.604) in 3,097 all-time games.
- Michigan is tied for the most national championships (9) in college hockey as well as the most NCAA tournament appearances (40). The Wolverines stand along with the most Frozen Four appearances (27) of any program in college hockey, including the past two seasons.
- U-M made 22 consecutive NCAA tournaments under Red Berenson from 1991-2012, a record that looks to last, as no other program has reached more than 15 consecutive tournaments.
- As a WIHL, MCHL, WCHA, CCHA, and B1G conference member, U-M has won 19 regular-season championships and 12 tournament titles for 31 overall conference crowns.
