

FINAL SCORE

No. 17/17 Notre Dame (8-3) 56, Stanford (3-8) 23

TEAM NOTES

- Notre Dame won the toss and deferred its choice to the second half. Stanford received the opening kick off and started the game defending the north end zone.
- Notre Dame improves to 23-14 all-time against Stanford and evens its record at 9-9 in Stanford Stadium.
- The victory gives Notre Dame three straight at Stanford (2019, 2021, tonight) which matches the program-best three-game win streak in Stanford Stadium in 2003, 2005 and 2007.
- Notre Dame's 382 rushing yards are the first 300-yard rushing game for the Irish since 2020 vs. Florida State and the first time on the road since 2017 at Boston College (515).

NOTABLE

- Audric Estimé wrote his name all over the Notre Dame record book tonight:
 - A career-high 238 rushing yards, the 17th 200-yard rushing game in school history and fourth-most in a single game all-time at Notre Dame
 - A career-high four rushing touchdowns, which moved his season total to a Notre Dame single-season record 18
 - A career-high 25 rushing attempts
 - Finished the regular season with 1,341 yards, which is fifth on the Notre Dame single-season list
 - Moved his career rushing total to 2,321, which is 11th on the all-time career list at Notre Dame and just 20 yards behind George Gipp (1917-20; 2,341).
- Sam Hartman threw two touchdown passes, moving his career total to 134 and matching Graham Harrell for fourth on the all-time FBS list.
- Hartman finished the season with a 159.5 passer rating, which is second on the single-season list at Notre Dame behind the 161.4 by Jimmy Clausen (2009) and Bob Williams (1949).
