BIG EAST TOUR ROLLS ON

After completing the home-and-home with Marquette on Dec. 9, the Irish will start a new home-and-home on Dec. 16 with Georgetown. The Hoyas lead the series 16-13, but the Irish lead in Purcell at 8-6. The two sides haven't met since Jan. 21, 2013. The series began back in 1948.

Georgetown enters the contest with a 6-4 record on the year, but 0-1 in true road contests. The Hoyas best statistical category is free throw attempts per game where they rank 39th in the nation and 1st in the Big East at 24.1 per game. Next best category -65th in three pointers per game with 8.9.

HITTING THE MARK(US)

Everyone is starting to take notice of freshman point guard Markus Burton. To help you get more acquainted, read up on the following stats:

- His 15.7 ppg leads all ACC freshmen and ranks 6th nationally amongst DI freshmen.
- Burton started his career with five straight games in double figures before the streak ended with 8 points at South Carolina. He now leads the team with seven games.
- Burton picked up his third game of 20 or more points at #8 Marquette on Dec. 9.

The following is a list of the most 20-point games by an Irish freshman: Adrian Dantley (13 in '73-74), Troy Murphy (10 in '98-99) and David Rivers (10 in '84-85).

- Only 3 freshmen in the country are averaging over 15 points and 3.5 assists per game: Burton, Harvard's Malik Mack and
- USC's Isaiah Collier.
- Ranks 9th in the ACC in Assists (3.7) and 9th in FT% (.857)

#TRENDING

Burton is coming off a stellar individual week in which he totaled 17 points againt Western Michigan and 20 points at #8 Marquette. Burton has also upped his assist numbers as of late. He's dished out 24 over the last five games (4.8 apg in that span).

J.R. Konieczny is emerging as an early season standout for the Irish. He has recorded double-digit points in four of the last seven games. In fact, if you take out ND's first two games and look at that sixgame stretch, Konieczny has since averaged 11.0 points.

ARE YOU REA-TAE FOR IT

Speaking of trending, Tae Davis's trajectory is shooting up. He had back-to-back games with double-doubles and three straight games in double figures before he ran into a Marquette buzzsaw on Dec. 9.

Coach Shrews has talked often about these guys making the most of their opportunities, whether its freshmen in their first year or transfers who haven't had a chance. Take Davis for example - in the 10th game of the season this Saturday against Georgetown, Davis could already amass more season points this year than what he did his freshman year total at Seton Hall.

With that said, he now averages the second most points (9.4) and the most rebounds (5.8) on the team.

D-UP!

If you are looking for an early Coach Shrewsberry stamp on the program, look no further the defensive effort by this young Irish squad. The Marquette game brought an end to a five-game streak in which the defense had only allowed 65 points or fewer. Most notably, limiting the Hurricanes to a season low in points – 24 points fewer than their season average of 86 points per game.

Notre Dame's scoring defense of 67.3 now ranks 5th in the ACC

"We can guard, even for a group of freshmen and sophomores," Coach Shrewsberry said. "They're believing in what we're talking about. We're sitting in a stance and guarding. It's all positive."

"We've emphasized the defensive end so much," Shrewsberry said. "We're guarding people. We're getting people into the right shots that we want them to take. That part there is what we've hung our hat on. It's given us a chance to be in every game. For a team that doesn't see the game or understand it defensively yet, we're really guarding. That's purely effort right now. Wait until we start understanding what's going on and seeing it and talking to each other. Holy smokes. We might be OK."

GREAT OPPORTUNITY AT HOME

Saturday vs. Georgetown marks the 10th game of the season and the Irish have had to compete in a lot of tough matches on the road: Auburn, South Carolina, Marquette and Miami. Now a great opportuniy awaits - six straight at home. The last time the Irish had six straight inside Purcell Pavilion -> games 2-7 at the start of the 2019-20 season.

At home, the Irish are averaging 73.0 points on 49.3% shooting from the floor, with a .359 mark from three-point range. Away from Purcell, the Irish are averaging just 56.8 points on 34.2% shooting, with a .212 mark from three.

SECOND HALF SURGE

Speaking of Burton, he's had a knack for surging at the right moments in the second half. Four times this season, Burton has scored double-digit points in the second half alone: Niagara, Oklahoma State, Western Michigan and Marquette.

Burton is averaging a team best 8.8 points in the second half.

CRASHING THE GLASS

The Irish dominated the offensive boards at #8 Miami as they outrebounded the Hurricanes 15-6. It marked the first time Notre Dame achieved at least 15 O-boards since they grabbed 19 against High Point on Nov. 16, 2021.

Tae Davis was a big part of that, reeling in four offensive rebounds to ultimately collect a career high 10 boards.

Davis leads the team in offensive rebounding with 1.9 per game.

THAT'S IRISH BASKETBALL

There was a lot to be happy with after the 75-55 win over UMES on Nov. 22. For starters, the ball was moving quickly and efficiently on the offensive end as Notre Dame posted a season best 18 assists on 28 made field goals.

The ball movement then directly led to better looks from three, as the Irish hit double-digit treys for the first time this season - 13 to be exact. What was also great to see was nine different Irish recorded a made three.

"We've put a huge emphasis on it," Shrewsberry said. "Guys are doing it. I thought we passed up average or OK shots for great shots. We need to be this kind of team."

Next, the defense was stifling, allowing just 55 points - a season best for ND.

"Every little thing that happens is just more and more belief," Shrewsberry said. "More and more belief in what we're doing, how we're playing, what we're talking about."

Quotables from South Carolina

"Who is going to be our go to guy. Who's our guy we can turn to to get a bucket when tough times happen. That's what we're searching for. Until we find that, things will keep happening like this. When things get tough, we have to trust the system and stay with it."

"We are only going to get better and better. I still believe in our guys. I will roll with them anywhere. We are mainly rolling with freshmen and sophomores. We gave ourselves a chance and let off the rope for a bit in the 2nd half."

LEGENDS CLASSIC TAKEAWAYS

A couple of Irish standouts from two games in Brooklyn during the Legends Classic. First, let's look at All-Tournament Team selection Markus Burton. The freshman took over the end of the Oklahoma State game scoring 16 of his team-high 20 points in the second half plus

overtime (10 in 2H + 6 in OT). He averaged 16.0 points over the two games.

Next, it was a breakout week for Konieczny, as he produced back-to-back double-doubles, averaging 14.5 points and 10.5 rebounds. He also earned his first career start in the win over Oklahoma State (11/17). J.R. entered the Legends Classic week with 15 points and 3 rebounds to his name thru 8 career ND games. Then over those 2 games, he produced a total of 29 points and 21 rebounds. J.R. constantly attacked the offensive glass, grabbing 8 O-Boards over the 2 games.

Last but not least, there was Tae Davis who averaged 10.0 points on 57.1 percent shooting (8-14 FG), along with 5.0 rebounds per game. Davis recorded a career high 13 points against the Auburn Tigers.

HISTORIC DEBUT FOR BURTON

Not only did freshman point guard Markus Burton ball out in a historic debut in the season opener, but he got to do it in front of his hometown crowd and family. Burton poured in 29 points to lift the Irish to a 70-63 win over Niagara, marking the most points in program history in a freshman debut. The previous record was 27 points from Laphonso Ellis back in 1988. Now a few other notes on Burton's performance.

- 1-of-5 freshmen in the history of the program to score 29 points or more, joining David Graves, Troy Murphy, Chris Thomas and Adrian Dantley.
- Burton absolutely took over the end of the game. From 8:38-2:20 in the second half, Burton recorded 16 points on 6-for-6 shooting.
- Burton's 29 points is the 2nd highest from a DI freshman this season (only behind Harvard's Malik Mack's 32).

FRESHMAN FOUNDATION

A little over a month into the job, Coach Shrewsberry had himself a top-30 ranked incoming freshmen class – Carey Booth, Logan Imes and Braeden Shrewsberry - all flipped from their Penn State commits. Then add in Mr. Indiana Basketball Markus

Burton, who kept his commitment to Notre Dame. That brought the 2023 class to four signees which ranked 23rd in the country according to 247Sports.com.

Furthermore, cementing the bond amongst the freshmen class, there was an Indiana connection amongst most of them:

- -- Imes and Shrewsberry played together throughout all four of their high school years with the Indiana Elite.
- -- Imes and Burton were teammates on the 2023 Indiana All-Stars squad

CLEAN SLATE

Notre Dame only returns 35 points from a season ago, which equates to 1.6% of scoring returning. The table on the bottom page 11 displays the Division I schools returning the least amount of points ahead of the 2023-24 season.

MR INDIANA BASKETBALL

On April 20, 2023, now freshman point guard Markus Burton, was named Mr. Indiana Basketball. It marked the third time in program history in which a future Notre Dame player took home the honor. The two former winners were Chris Thomas in 2001 and Luke Zeller in 2005.

Burton averaged a state-best 30.3 points per game, along with 5.7 rebounds, 5.1 assists and 3.6 steals. Burton also secured the school single season scoring record by pouring in 909 points as a senior.

THE FOUNDATION GROWS

Coach Shrewsberry continued to build the foundation of Irish hoops by announcing three Class of 2024 signees. Cole Certa, Sir Muhammed and Garrett Sundra all signed their National Letters of Intent and officially became Irish on Nov. 6.

Shrewsberry, who started this current season with a talented four-member freshman class

that was ranked in the top-30, has now built upon that with a 2024 class that is ranked as high as No. 19 by 247Sports. The trio of Cole Certa (6-5 guard from Le Roy, Illinois), Sir Muhammed (6-6 guard from Charlotte. North Carolina) and Garrett Sundra (6-11 forward form Ashburn, Virginia) also rank as the fifth best class in the ACC by 247Sports.

"We are thrilled to welcome three tremendous young men into the Notre Dame family. I am very proud of the job we were able to do on the recruiting trail in this class by landing Cole Certa, Sir Mohammed and Garrett Sundra. When we got the job here, we put a premium on bringing in players who fit our team on the court as well as off the court. All three of these young men are not only tremendous basketball players, as evidenced by the fact that this is ranked as one of the top recruiting classes not only in the ACC, but in the country as well, but they are also excellent students who fit the mission and the culture of Notre Dame "

HOMETOWN HOMAGE FEATURE

There had been the youth camps at Notre Dame, myriad Fighting Irish men's basketball games and a blossoming relationship with Demetrius Jackson – a name synonymous with Irish hoops success a decade ago.

And, then, there had been the fandom of another national college basketball power - about the only time the local kid from La Porte, Indiana, had found his way inside Purcell Pavilion for Notre Dame basketball.

Today, freshman point guard Markus Burton and redshirt-sophomore J.R. Konieczny are homegrown products at the foundational stage of first-year Notre Dame Glenn & Stacey Murphy head coach Micah Shrewsberry's program rebuild.

Though different in their paths to play beneath the fabled Golden Dome, both Burton and Konieczny embrace this moment to help reassert Irish basketball and fashion an example for area youth who may also foster dreams of wearing Irish green.

"It was sort of unreal for me, because I liked Notre Dame a lot, and it was basically a dream school for me, my hometown and a no-brainer." said Burton, who capped his record-shattering prep career at Penn High School with the coveted Indiana Mr. Basketball award – just the third Irish signee all-time to procure the accolade. "Blake Wesley and J.R. Konieczny, I was a really big fan of theirs too."

Initially, the rangy, 6-foot-7 Konieczny - a second-team Indiana All-State selection who had finished fifth in Mr. Basketball balloting in 2021 - had not envisioned a gilded path to Notre Dame.

"It just all felt super surreal," Konieczny, who sat out the 2022-23 season to hone his all-around game and ensure his overall health, said. "The whole recruitment process was super stressful for me, and then when I committed to Notre Dame, it was a huge weight off my shoulders. I had never really expected myself to be at Notre Dame, but then the stars aligned."

As Burton transitions through the early months of his collegiate career and Konieczny begins in earnest the hardwood portion of his Notre Dame journey, they are mindful of this moment together - in their own career arcs and in a historic dawn of a new era of Irish basketball under Shrewsberry, also a Hoosier State native with basketball bona fides spanning the NCAA to the NBA.

"We talk about it a lot, but I mean right now, we kind of just have fun with it," said Burton of his conversations with Konieczny about the chance to be a hometown beacon of Notre Dame basketball. "We talk about how blessed we are to be able to go to Notre Dame and play basketball here, to have this opportunity.

"It's really fun. Coach Shrewsberry is a really good coach, loves his players and teaches us what need to do. A lot of us adapted really well, and I feel like once we get playing and people see how hard we play, we're going to show people how hard we work and take pride in everyday practice. 1st Season at Notre Dame 3rd as a Head Coach at DI Level An Indiana native has come home to kick start a new era of Notre Dame men's basketball. Vice President and James E. Rohr Notre Dame Director of Athletics Jack Swarbrick announced Micah Shrewsberry as the 18th head coach in Fighting Irish men's basketball history on March 23, 2023.

"We are so excited to have Coach (Shrewsberry) join the Notre Dame family," Swarbrick said. "Throughout this process, it reaffirmed for me that this job was among the best in the country as we had many great candidates express interest."

"During our two month process, we weekly reviewed our candidate pool and each week he (Micah) stayed at the top of our list due to his fit at the University and his commitment to the student-athlete experience. Not only do his personal & family values align with the University, but his dedication to the development of each member of his program as well."

Shrewsberry is fresh off a historic turnaround as the head coach at Penn State. After a 14-17 first season, Shrewsberry produced a 23-14 mark in 2022-23, just the 12th 20-win season in the 127-year history of Penn State basketball. Furthermore, he collected more Big Ten wins (17) in his first two seasons than any other Penn State head coach.

Shrewsberry brings a wealth of experience and success to the helm of the Notre Dame program. All-in-all he's coached in six NCAA Tournaments, two NCAA Final Fours, five NBA Playoffs and two NBA Conference Finals — in addition to coaching all-NBA honorees Jayson Tatum and Jaylen Brown.

"I'm very excited to be joining the University of Notre Dame family," Shrewsberry said. "The combination of top notch academics, plus a long storied history of success on the basketball court, made this a very attractive job for me. The power of the Notre Dame brand, and the passionate alumni family, will allow us to recruit the brightest student-athletes from coast to coast. I can't wait to get to campus and begin connecting with the students, faculty and staff which make this place special."

Shrewsberry and Penn State captured the nation's attention in late February and into March, going 9-3 over their last 12 games, which included six Quad 1 wins. Shrewsberry then made plenty of noise in the 2023 Big Ten Tournament in Chicago, defeating No. 7 Illinois, No. 2 Northwestern and No. 3 Indiana to reach the championship game as the No. 10 seed.

It marked the program's second-ever Big Ten title game appearance. Penn State was just the third double-digit seed to reach the Big Ten Tournament championship game and the first since 2008.

The Nittany Lions then made their first appearance in the NCAA Tournament since 2011. In the first round, Shrewsberry and the Nittany Lions knocked off No. 7 seed and SEC Tournament runner-up Texas A&M, winning the program's first NCAA Tournament game since 2001.

In year one at Penn State, Shrewsberry engineered the Big Ten's best scoring defense and guided the squad to their best defensive season (65.0 points allowed per game) in 11 years. The Nittany lions advanced to the quarterfinal round of the Big Ten Tournament after winning two postseason games, making Shrewsberry one of just two first-year Big Ten coaches since 2008 to win two Big Ten Tournament games.

Recruiting-wise, Shrewsberry made an instant splash in Happy Valley. In his first year, Shrewsberry signed the highest-ranked recruiting class in program history, a consensus top-30 class. A year later, he signed his second-straight top-30 recruiting class, marking the first time in program history that the Nittany Lions had signed back-to-back top-30 recruiting classes.

Statistically speaking, the 2022-23 squad set the B1G and Penn State single-season team record for three-pointers made in a season with 385. The Nittany Lions compiled a total of five top-15 national

statistical rankings. In addition, Shrewsberry tutored an Associated Press All-American in Jalen Pickett and a total of three All-Big Ten players during the 2022-23 season.

Prior to his time with Penn State, Shrewsberry experienced two separate stints at Purdue — one as assistant coach from 2011-13 and another as associate head coach from 2019-21. Highlights include the 2020-21 season, in which Shrewsberry helped lead the Boilermakers to a 13-6 fourth-place finish in the Big Ten and an 18-10 overall mark, culminating in an NCAA Tournament at-large bid. Trevion Williams calimed first-team All-Big Ten honors, while Zach Edey and Jaden Ivey were All-Freshman Team selections. Shrewsberry played a major role in recruiting Ivey, who grew up in South Bend and is the son of Karen and Kevin Keyes Family Head Women's Basketball Coach Niele Ivey.

Another highlight from his time in West Lafayette includes the 2011-12 squad that produced a 22-13 record and reached the second round of the NCAA Tournament. Under Shrewsberry, Terone Johnson was one of the most improved players in the B1G, netting accolades from conference and national entities.

In-between his Purdue stints, Shrewsberry spent six seasons (2013-19) with the NBA's Boston Celtics as an assistant coach under Brad Stevens. During his tenure, the Celtics reached the playoffs in five consecutive seasons, including back-to-back appearances in the Fastern Conference Finals in 2017 and 2018.

Shrewsberry played a key role in the development of current NBA stars Brown and Tatum, who were the No. 3 picks in the 2016 and 2017 NBA Drafts, respectively. Tatum was an NBA All-Rookie Team first-team selection, while Brown earned second-team All-Rookie honors.

The Brad Stevens connection was previously made at Butler University, where Shrewsberry spent one year as the director of operations then three as an assistant coach. With Shrewsberry on the sidelines, the Bulldogs compiled an 87-21 record, won two Horizon League regular-season championships and two Horizon League Tournament titles and made three NCAA Tournament appearances — which included back-to-back runs to the national championship game in 2010 and 2011.

Also at Butler, he aided in the development of Gordon Hayward, who was the 2009 Horizon League Newcomer of the Year, the 2010 Horizon League Player of the Year and a 2010 Final Four All-Tournament Team selection. Hayward was the ninth overall pick in the 2010 NBA Draft by the Utah Jazz.

Continuing on Shrewsberry's basketball journey, he spent time as the director of basketball operations at Marshall University (2003-05) and an assistant coach at DePauw University (2001-03) and Wabash College (2000-01). At DePauw, Shrewsberry led the Tigers to a 42-12 record with a pair of conference championships.

Shrewsberry was also the first men's basketball head coach at Indiana University South Bend. Shrewsberry started his coaching career as a graduate assistant at the University of Indianapolis in 1999-2000.

An Indianapolis area native, Shrewsberry earned his bachelor's degree from Hanover College in 1999 and a master's degree from Indiana State in 2003. As a player at Hanover, Shrewsberry was a three-year starting quard and team tri-captain.

He and his wife, Molly, have four children, Braeden, Nicholas, Caitlin and Grace.
