BOSTON COLLEGE VS. NOTRE DAME - ALL-TIME SERIES

- Today's game marks the 43rd meeting between the two schools.
- Boston College is 15-27 all-time vs. Notre Dame on the hardwood.
- BC is 5-15 vs. ND in ACC play but has won four of the last five.
- Last year, BC swept the season series for the first time in 26 years.
- The Eagles downed the Irish, 70-63, at home on Jan. 3, 2023.
- Boston College won 84-72 at Notre Dame on Jan. 21, 2023.
- The two teams held serve on their respective home courts in 2019-20, 2020-21, and 2021-22.
- BC is 10-11 at home against Notre Dame, having captured the previous three matchups at Conte Forum.
- From 1995-2005, the two teams were members of the Big East.
- BC compiled a 5-7 mark against the Irish in those 12 matchups.

MOST IMPROVED MCGLOCKTON

- Devin McGlockton is staking an early claim for a spot on the All-ACC team and the league's Most Improved Player award.
- In his second full season, McGlockton is showing major jumps in virtually every statistical category, year over year.
- Through 15 games, McGlockton ranks fourth on the Eagles in scoring (10.3) and second in rebounding (6.4) and blocks (1.1).
- McGlockton's per game averages have increased across the board: scoring +4.4, rebounding +2.5, and blocked shots +0.4.
- He is connecting on nearly 60% of his shot attempts from the floor, up from 55%.
- From beyond the arc, McGlockton has already surpassed his 3-point total (7) from a season ago.
- In ACC play, McGlockton is 17th in the league in scoring (15.6), seventh in rebounding (8.2), and first in FG% (.653).
- McGlockton has registered the highest single-game scoring total in conference play - a 30-point performance at Georgia Tech.
- On Jan. 10, the Cumming, Ga. product logged his first double-double of the season, with 15 points and 14 boards at Syracuse.
- He has set new single-game career-highs in scoring (30), rebounding (14), and blocks (3) this year.

YEAR OVER YEAR IMPROVEMENTS

- Boston College ranks 75th nationally (6th ACC) in scoring, at 78.9 points per game.
- A year ago, the Eagles were 303rd (14th ACC) in points per game, at 66.6 per outing.
- BC currently ranks 78th nationally (5th ACC) in field goal percentage, connecting on 46.9% of its shot attempts.
- A season ago, the Eagles were 222nd (11th ACC), making only 43.7% of its shots from the floor.
- BC has seen similar jumps, year-over-year, in its 3-point field goal percentage.
- This year, the Eagles rank 66th nationally (5th ACC) in 3FG%, connecting on 36.3% of their long-distance tries.
- In 2022-23, BC ranked among the bottom nationally - 294th (14th ACC) at 31.9%.

ON THIS DATE: JANUARY 15

- Boston College is 10-10 overall and 3-1 in ACC play all-time in games played on January 15.
- January 15 marks the tri-celebration of National Bagel Day, National Hat Day, and National Strawberry Ice Cream Day.
- On this day in history on January 15 - 1535: Henry VIII declares himself head of the Church of England; 1892: the rules of "basket-ball" were printed in Springfield College's "Triangle Magazine;" 1919: 2 million gallons of molasses floods Boston's North End; 1967: Green Bay wins the first Super Bowl, 35-10, versus Kansas City; 1971: George Harrison's "My Sweet Lord" debuts; 2009: Capt. Chelsey Sullenberger lands US Airways flight 1549 in the Hudson River after striking a bird shortly after takeoff.
- Notable January 15 birthdays: Dr. Martin Luther King Jr., playwright Moliere, actor Lloyd Bridges, NFL QB Drew Brees, and Saint and national heroine of France Jeanne D'Arc.

ANALYTICALLY CORRECT

- Per KenPom, Boston College ranks 52nd nationally in adjusted offensive efficiency with a 113.6 rating.
- The metric measures the total points scored per 100 possessions.
- BC ranks fourth overall in the ACC in adjusted offensive efficiency.
- It is the highest national ranking in the key offensive metric since the 2013-14 season, when BC was 32nd with a 114.3 mark.

POST, PARTY OF ONE

- Quinten Post is one of the best players in the country and his stat line for the Eagles this season is perfect evidence.
- **He is the only player in the country averaging at least 16.9 points, 7.7 boards, 3.3 assists, and 2.1 blocks per game.**
- Using only points and rebounds: Post is one of eight major conference players averaging at least 16.9 points and 7.7 rebounds per game; four of those players are on the Wooden midseason list.
- Using only points and assists: Post is one of 17 major conference players to average at least 16.9 points and 3.3 assists per game. The other 16 players are all guards. Seven of those players are on the Wooden midseason list.
- Post is also posting a 50/40/80 line of shooting percentages - connecting on 51.1 FG%, 44.7 3FG%, and 82.0 FT%.
- **Post and Colorado's KJ Simpson are the only two players in the nation posting those percentages (min. 15.0 ppg).**
- **It's not a small sample**: in 65 games at BC since 2021-22, Post has registered nearly a 50/40/80 shooting line - .517 FG; .414 3FG; .792 FT. - the only active player (min. 12.0 ppg) to post such shooting lines since the start of 2021-22-present.
- Over the past two seasons vs. major conference opponents (24 games), Post is averaging nearly 15.0 points, 6.0 rebounds, 2.0 assists, and 1.2 blocks while shooting .522/.438/.814.

JUST PEACHY

- Devin McGlockton poured in a career-high 30 points in a sort of homecoming at Georgia Tech on Jan. 6.
- The sophomore from Cumming, Ga. - about 45 min. from Atlanta - added five rebounds, two assists, two steals, and a block.
- McGlockton connected on a career-best 12 field goals, including three 3-pointers, in the win.
- He is the second Eagle to reach the 30-point mark this season; Quinten Post poured in 31 points in BC's lidlifter vs. Fairfield.

ALWAYS LOOK FOR THE HELPERS

- Boston College's top three scorers - Quinten Post, Claudell Harris Jr., and Jaeden Zackery - are also its top three assists men.
- Zackery ranks third in scoring (11.7) and first in assists (4.4), Post is first in scoring (16.9) and second in assists (3.3), and Harris is second in scoring (15.7) and third in assists (1.8). The trio combines for 9.5 of the Eagles' 14.4 assists per game.
- Wake Forest is the only other ACC school to have its top three scorers rank as its top three passers.

THAT'S OFFENSIVE

- Devin McGlockton's seven offensive rebounds vs. Wake Forest were the most by a Boston College player in an ACC game since Feb. 8, 2022 when James Karnik had seven offensive rebounds vs. Duke on Feb. 12, 2022.
- Quinten Post also had seven offensive boards at home versus Syracuse on Feb. 8, 2022.
- Post ranks ninth (2.36 OReb/g) and McGlockton 12th (2.14) in the ACC in offensive rebounds per game.

UNPRECEDENTED

- This season, Quinten Post set new single-game career-highs in scoring (31), rebounding (19), assists (9), blocked shots (5), and steals (6).
- **Since 1996-97, no player has equalled those game high statistical figures in a single-season.**
- In fact, since 1996-97, only four other players have tallied career-highs equal to what Post has done this season alone.
- Included in that list - 2002-23 National Player of the Year and 15-year NBA veteran David West (Xavier).

CAN'T KNOCK THE HUSTLE

- Boston College is 3-2 this year, 7-1 in 2022-23 and 11-4 since Feb. 21, 2022 when Jaeden Zackery scores at least 15 points.
- Zackery tallied a career-high 21 points in nearly 39 minutes of play at The Citadel on Nov. 10.
- On Dec. 8 against Holy Cross, Zackery led BC with 18 points to go with five boards, four assists, and a steal.
- Against N.C. State, Zackery had a team-high 20 points, grabbing six rebounds, and dropping four dimes.
- When Zackery goes to the free throw line at least five times, BC is 3-2 this year, was 7-2 in 2022-23, and is 12-5 all-time.
- Zackery has committed one or fewer turnovers in 10 games in 2023-24 and has 24 total turns in 518 minutes of play so far.
- Boston College has won 10 of its last 13 games when Zackery commits one or fewer turnovers in a game.
- **Zackery is the only ACC player with at least eight games of 10 points/4 assists/2 steals.**
- Last season, Zackery had nine games with four or more assists. He's done so in 13 of 15 games this season.

COMEBACK KINGS

- Four of Boston College's 10 wins have come when the Eagles have trailed by double digits: Richmond (14, 1st half); Harvard (10, 2nd half); St. John's (10, 2nd half), and Georgia Tech (16, 2nd half).
- Boston College's 16-point comeback win at Georgia Tech was the largest for the Eagles since Jan. 15, 2022.
- On that date, the Eagles came back from 23 down in the first half at Clemson to win by two - 70-68.
- The 16-point comeback at GT was the third-most in BC history, behind Clemson (23) and Kent State (18) on Dec. 29, 2004.

IF THIS, THEN THAT...

WITH A WIN VS. NOTRE DAME...

- BC would move to 11-6 overall and 2-4 in ACC play
- The Eagles would improve to 16-27 all-time against Notre Dame, including a 6-15 mark in ACC play
- It would mark the first three-game win streak vs. Notre Dame in 27 years (Jan. 6, 1996-March 1, 1997)
- BC would improve to 7-2 at home, 2-3 in January, 9-2 in night games, and 8-4 in weekday games.
- Head coach Earl Grant would earn his 40th win at Boston College and his 166th as a collegiate head coach.
- BC would earn victory #1,264 all-time through 91 seasons of basketball, dating back to 1904-05.

WITH A LOSS VS. NOTRE DAME...

- BC would fall to 10-7 overall and 1-5 in ACC play
- It would mark the first three-game losing streak of 2023-24
- The Eagles would drop to 15-28 all-time vs. Notre Dame
- BC would move to 6-3 at home, 1-4 in January, 8-3 in night games, and 7-5 on weekdays
- Boston College would register the 1,089th loss all-time in program history, dating back to the 1904-05 season.

BRINGING YOU THE BEST OF THE 80'S AND 90'S

- Boston College has put forth two games with at least 95 points on the scoreboard - at Georgia Tech and vs. Holy Cross.
- Prior to this season, it marks the team's highest scoring total since Feb. 16, 2022 vs. Notre Dame (95).
- The 95 points at Georgia Tech ties for the third-most points scored by BC in an ACC game since joining the league in 2005-06.
- It the most points in a regulation game for BC since Jan. 1, 2017, when BC tallied 96 points in a home win over Syracuse.
- It ties as the highest single-game scoring total of the Earl Grant era and tied for the most points in a regulation Division I game under Grant as a head coach (95 pts at CofC vs. Hofstra - Feb. 14, 2019)
- In nine-plus seasons between College of Charleston and Boston College, Earl Grant-coached teams are 45-6 when they score at least 80 points, 23-3 when they score at least 85, and 8-2 when scoring 90 or more.
- Since 1981, Boston College is 316-57 when it scores at least 80 points in a game.

BOSTON'S NEW BIG THREE FOUR

- Quinten Post (16.9 ppg), Claudell Harris Jr. (15.7), Jaeden Zackery (11.7), and Devin McGlockton (10.3) account for over 68% of BC's scoring. Through 16 games, the trio is averaging nearly 55 of BC's 79 points per outing.
- The four account for over 55% of BC's rebounds, 70% of assists, 80% of blocks, 60% of steals, and 63% of 3-pointers made.
- In ACC games, the quartet accounts for nearly 80% of the Eagles' scoring output.

McBLOCKTON

- BC is 19-8 when Devin McGlockton blocks at least one shot and 9-2 when he blocks at least two shots.
- The sophomore forward has registered at least one block in 12 of 16 games in 2023-24 and two blocks in five games.
- The versatile 6-7 post presence is averaging 1.1 blocked shots per game in nearly 29 minutes of playing time.

WELCOME TO THE 30/25 CLUB

- Devin McGlockton (30) and Claudell Harris Jr. (26) joined a rare club in Boston College Men's Basketball history.
- It marked the first time since the 2006-07 season that BC had a game where a player had at least 30 points and another 25.
- On Dec. 28, 2006, Sean Marshall (30) and Tyrese Rice (29) did so in an overtime loss to Duquesne.
- Troy Bell had 30 and Craig Smith 27 in an overtime win against St. Bonaventure on Dec. 4, 2002.
- The only other regulation game in which this occurred came on Feb. 19, 2000, when Bell (31) and Xavier Singletary (25) did so in an 80-76 win at West Virginia.

HARRIS SHINES AMONG THE BRIGHT LIGHTS OF THE HEIGHTS

- Claudell Harris Jr. has scored in double figures in 13 of the 15 games in which he has appeared this season.
- He scored a season-high 29 points - including the 1,000th of his career - knocking down 7-of-10 3FG against Lehigh.
- At Georgia Tech, Harris connected on 8-of-10 from the floor - and 4-of-4 from beyond the arc - in the comeback road win.
- The junior guard also added 22 points at Vanderbilt, making 9-of-13 shots - including 4-of-6 from beyond the arc.
- Harris ranks second on the team in scoring (15.7), while leading the Eagles in 3FG made (40).
- Harris arrived at BC as a transfer from Charleston Southern and will have two seasons of eligibility remaining.
- He shined for CSU for two seasons, earning All-Big South second team honors as a sophomore a season ago.
- The 6-3 guard averaged 17.5 points per game last year - the second-best scoring mark in the Big South.
- Harris scored in double figures in 28 of 30 games for the Buccaneers in 2022-23 - including two consecutive 30-point games.
- He scored at least 20 points on 14 occasions and also connected on three or more 3-pointers in 14 of CSU's 30 contests. Harris spent two seasons at Charleston Southern and was named to the 2021-22 Big South All-Freshman Team, averaging 10.3 points, 4.2 rebounds, and 2.0 assists in 31 games played (14 starts) in his first collegiate season.

A HELPING HAND FOR 2023-24

- Donald Hand Jr. is averaging better than 6.0 points and connecting on nearly 36% from 3-point land off the bench for BC.
- Hand scored a career-best 16 points against CCSU on Dec. 5, making 5-of-9 shots - including 3-of-6 from the perimeter.
- The redshirt freshman scored 11 of his 16 points in the second half, also adding three rebounds and two steals.
- On Dec. 10, Hand Jr. scored 11 points in a win over St. John's in 17 minutes of play.
- Against Lehigh, he had nine points to go with a career-best six rebounds while tallying seven points against Wake Forest.
- He has reached double-digits in the scoring column on four occasions; he had 13 points vs. Holy Cross and 14 at The Citadel.
- Last year, Hand Jr. tore his ACL after :37 of play in the first half vs. Detroit Mercy - game two of the season - on Nov. 11, 2022.
- After successful surgery on Nov. 30, 2022, the 6-5 guard relentlessly attacked his rehabilitation.
- Despite being fully cleared for action during this past summer, Hand did not play in the Eagles' three-game European tour.

MADSEN WITH CONSISTENT CONTRIBUTIONS

- Through the first 16 games this season, Mason Madsen has made big plays for the Eagles.
- The 6-4 guard leads BC in 3-point field goal percentage (.489) and has made all 16 of his attempts from the free throw line.
- On Dec. 8 vs. Holy Cross, Madsen had a season-high 17 points, knocking down 5-of-6 from the perimeter.
- The game prior - vs. CCSU, he had 15 points, seven boards, four assists, and three steals. All were season highs.
- One of the most consistent guards for BC, Madsen has only 21 turnovers over his last 32 games/587 minutes played.
- He has made 17 of his last 27 shots from the perimeter and has connected on 22-of-45 (.489) this year.
- Madsen led BC in 3-pointers made last season, connecting on 40 shots from beyond the arc.

PRINCE-IPAL

- BC is 5-3 this year and 13-7 all-time when Prince Aligbe grabs at least six rebounds, including a 7-6 record in ACC contests.
- He is averaging nearly 5.0 boards per game; 22 of his 72 rebounds have come on the offensive glass.
- His best scoring and rebounding performance of the season came on Nov. 15, when he tallied his first double-double.
- The Minneapolis product scored 15 points (6-8 FG) and grabbed 10 rebounds, including four on the offensive glass.
- When Aligbe scores in double figures, Boston College is 6-4, including a 5-2 mark in 2022-23.
- The 6-7 swingman started 24 of the 27 games he played in 2022-23, missing seven games in November (high ankle sprain).
- In his first collegiate game, Aligbe made an immediate impact - connecting on the gamewinner in the opener vs. Cornell.

CLAUDELL HARRIS JR. REACHES 1,000-POINT MARK

- Claudell Harris Jr. scored his 1,000th point on Dec. 21 vs. Lehigh. The milestone basket was a 3-pointer with 4:45 remaining.
- Entering the game, Harris needed 28 points to reach 1,000 - he scored a season-high 29 points, connecting on seven 3FG.
- Prior to arriving at BC, Harris tallied 840 points in 61 games at Charleston Southern.
- Harris became the third transfer player in the past three seasons to score his 1,000th career point at BC (Makai Ashton-Langford, 2022-23; James Karnik, 2021-22).

CK3

- For a three-game stretch in the starting lineup on Dec. 5, Chas Kelley III averaged 6.3 points, 3.7 rebounds, and 1.7 assists.
- In 20 minutes of play over the span, the sophomore guard registered a 1.25:1 assist/turnover ratio.
- His best outing of the season came vs. St. John's on Dec. 10, tallying season-highs with 13 points and five rebounds.
- In BC's two games in the MTE in Kansas City, Kelley posted solid back-to-back performances.
- The sophomore guard averaged 7.5 points, 2.5 rebounds, and 1.5 assists while making 50% (6-12) of his shot attempts.
- Kelley registered eight points (2-4 3FG), three boards, three assists, and a steal against Loyola Chicago.
- He had seven points and two boards against Colorado State in the opening game of the MTE.
- Over the final 12 games of the 2022-23 season, Kelley posted a 1.54:1 assist/turnover ratio and made nearly 38% 3FG.
- Included in those 12 games was Kelley's best game of his career - a 17-point outburst at Virginia Tech on Feb. 8.
- Filling in for the injured Jaeden Zackery, Kelley made 5-of-8 shots (4-7 3FG) and dished out four assists in 31 minutes of play.
- For his efforts in that win, the Houston product was named ACC Rookie of the Week on Feb. 13.

BACK TO DECEMBER

- BC closed out a 4-1 December with four straight victories, including an 86-80 win over St. John's in Brooklyn.
- Over those five games, Claudell Harris Jr. led the Eagles in scoring, at nearly a 17.0 ppg clip.
- Harris scored the 1,000th point of his career en route to pouring in a season-high 29 vs. Lehigh.
- During the month of December, Harris drilled nearly 55% of his 3-point attempts (13-24) - including 7-10 vs. Lehigh.
- Jaeden Zackery averaged 15.2 points, 3.6 rebounds, 4.2 assists, and 1.8 steals in five December games.
- The junior guard connected on nearly 61% from the floor (31-51), while registering a 3.50:1 assist/turnover ratio.
- In 151 minutes played in five December games, Zackery committed only six turnovers.
- Quinten Post dominated the stat sheet in December: 14.0 points, 8.3 boards, 4.4 assists, 2.0 blocks, and 1.2 steals per game.
- Only Post and Kyle Filipkowski (Duke) posted those per-game averages during the month of December.
- The 7-footer set new career-highs in assists (9 vs. St. John's) and blocked shots (6 vs. Holy Cross) in December.

DOUBLE IT UP

- For the first time since the 2018-19 season, two Boston College players logged double-doubles in the same game.
- Prince Aligbe (15 pts/10 reb) and Quinten Post (17 pts/10 reb) led the way for the Eagles in the win over Richmond.
- Previously, Nik Popovic (15 pts/10 reb) and Ky Bowman (24 pts/16 reb) did so at Notre Dame on Jan. 12, 2019.
- Aligbe's 10 rebounds were a career-high and the double-double the first in his collegiate career.
- Post has recorded five double-doubles this season and nine in his career. BC is 8-1 when Post registers a double-double.

QP, THE LANDLORD, AND THE BIG FUNDAMENTAL - "VIDEO GAME NUMBERS"

- Against Harvard, Quinten Post registered 20 points, 19 rebounds, five blocked shots, a steal and two assists in the win.
- The double-double was Post's third in four games and his 19 rebounds and five blocks were new career-highs.
- Since 1996-97, only two other players in the ACC have posted similar stat lines: Sheldon Williams (Duke); Tim Duncan (Wake)
- Williams had 21 points, 19 rebounds, five blocks, three assists, and two steals on Dec. 4, 2005 against Virginia Tech.
- Duncan posted 22 points, 22 boards, five blocks, and two assists in a win over Saint Mary's on March 14, 1997.
- Over the last 25 years, two Boston College players have had games with at least 20 points and 19 rebounds.
- Ryan Anderson had 23 points and 19 boards (three blocks) against UNH on Dec. 16, 2012 and Ryan Sidney had 22 points and 19 rebounds (9 assists) against St. Bonaventure on Dec. 4, 2002.

QUINTEN POST EARNS USBWA NATIONAL & ACC PLAYER OF THE WEEK HONORS

- Quinten Post was named one of five Oscar Robertson National Players of the Week by the USBWA on Nov. 21.
- A day earlier, he was named the ACC Player of the Week, it was announced by the conference office on Nov. 20.
- It marked the first time since Feb. 12, 2018 that a BC player was honored as ACC Player of the Week (Jerome Robinson).
- He averaged 18.5 points, 14.5 rebounds, 3.5 assists, and 3.0 blocks - including two double-doubles - in a 2-0 week.
- Post had 17 points, 10 rebounds, and a career-best five assists in a win over Richmond on Nov. 15.
- He followed that up with another historic performance in the win over Harvard on Nov. 18.
- The 7-footer scored 20 points and set new career-highs with 19 rebounds and five blocked shots.

QP POURS IN CAREER-HIGH 31 VS. FAIRFIELD

- Quinten Post poured in a career-high 31 points in Boston College's season opening win over Fairfield.
- Post was 11-of-14 from the floor, including 5-of-6 from 3FG, and 4-of-5 from the FT line.
- The 7-footer added 11 rebounds and a career-high four blocked shots in 29 minutes of play.
- He is the first Boston College player since Ky Bowman (37 vs. FSU; Jan. 20, 2019) to score at least 30 points in a game.
- It was the highest point total by a BC player in a season opener since Troy Bell had 31 vs. St. Peter's on Nov. 19, 2000.
- Since 1996-97, there have been eight occasions where a BC player registered a double-double with at least 30 points.
- Additionally, since 1996-97, there have been a total of 134 games where a player tallied at least 30 points, 10 rebounds, and four blocked shots. **Only 15 have done it in 29 minutes of game action or less.**

ROAD-TESTED

- Boston College began the season 3-0 in true road games, earning wins at The Citadel, Vanderbilt, and Georgia Tech.
- It marked the first time since the 2004-05 campaign that BC has won its first three road games to start the year.
- Dating back to last season, the Eagles are 5-3 in their previous eight ACC road tilts.

BOSTON COLLEGE OPENS THE HOAG BASKETBALL PAVILION

- On September 28, Boston College officially dedicated the Hoag Basketball Pavilion.
- The new home for its men's and women's basketball programs was made possible by a \$15 million gift - the largest in BC athletics history - from University Trustee Michaela "Mikey" Hoag '86 and her husband Jay.
- Located at the northwest corner of Conte Forum, the Hoag Basketball Pavilion features a grand illuminated glass entrance and walls, which provide a significant infusion of natural light and views to and from the campus.
- The nearly 40,000-square-foot facility features new player locker rooms and lounge areas, a sports medicine center, and a nutrition center on the first floor.
- Upstairs, the crown jewel of the Hoag Basketball Pavilion is the renovated 10,700-square-foot practice gym, adjacent to the newly created strength & conditioning center and team video rooms.

EAGLES PERFECT FROM THE LINE VS. COLORADO STATE

- Boston College put forth the second-best FT proficiency mark in program history (min. 20 FTA) vs. Colorado State.
- BC made 20-of-20 from the charity stripe vs. the Rams. The next game, BC made 10-of-11 free throws vs. Loyola Chicago.
- The Eagles' all-time best single-game mark (22-of-22) - came at Providence on Jan. 10, 1995.
- The Eagles rank 26th nationally in free throw percentage, having connected on a 77.4% (103-133) clip this season.

POST TABBED AS PRESEASON ALL-ACC SELECTION; EAGLES PICKED TO FINISH 12TH

- Quinten Post was named to the 2023-24 Preseason All-ACC second team.
- Post is the first Boston College player to earn preseason honors from the ACC since 2018-19 (Ky Bowman).
- The 7-footer is the ACC's seventh-best returning scorer (15.1) and holds its fourth-best FG% mark (.539) among returners.
- Boston College was tabbed to finish 12th in the ACC by a vote of local, regional, and national media.

QP POSTS THE FIRST 50/40/80 LINE IN A DECADE

- Last year, Quinten Post became the first player in 10 years to post a 50/40/80 shooting line while scoring better than 15.0 ppg.
- Post connected on 53.9% from the floor, 42.6% from the perimeter, and 86.0% from the free throw line in 2022-23.
- The 7-footer made 111-of-204 shots from the floor, including 23-of-54 from the perimeter. Post also made 43-of-50 FT.
- Post - the 2022-23 ACC Most Improved Player - averaged a team-best 15.1 points in 19 games.
- He scored 20 or more points six times and reached double figures on 13 occasions.

EARL GRANT

THE CLEMENT AND ELIZABETH IZZI FAMILY HEAD MEN'S BASKETBALL COACH



Earl Grant enters his third season as the Clement and Elizabeth IZZI Family Head Men's Basketball Coach at Boston College. Throughout his first two seasons at the Heights, Grant has established a culture of gritty and relentless play on the court, combined with selfless humility family atmosphere, and holistic development as people and players off the court.

Grant guided BC to 16 wins during the 2022-23 season, including nine in ACC play. As a result, BC and Grant extended their partnership through the 2028-29 season.

During the 2022-23 campaign, Grant's gritty group tallied three wins over nationally ranked opponents, including a 63-48 drubbing of No. 6 Virginia - the first win over a top 10 team in nearly six seasons. Led by ACC Most Improved Player Quinten Post, Boston College won nine games in ACC play - the most since the 2010-11 campaign. Four of the Eagles nine ACC wins came on the road - the highest win total in away games since 2008-09.

In his first season, Grant's Eagles advanced to the quarterfinals of the 2022 New York Life ACC Tournament in Brooklyn, narrowly missing a trip to the semis after a two-point overtime loss to Elite Eight participant Miami. Grant also orchestrated one of the highest-rated recruiting classes in program history, signing two four-star ranked players in the same class for the first time ever. The incoming class of newcomers ranked 30th nationally by Rivals.com and 33rd by 247sports.com.

On March 17, 2021 Grant was introduced as Boston College's 13th head men's basketball coach, bringing an impressive track record to Chestnut Hill after he turned the College of Charleston men's basketball program into a consistent championship contender in the Colonial Athletic Association.

Under Grant's leadership, the College of Charleston was one of only 21 NCAA Division I schools to have players drafted in both the 2019 and 2020 NBA Drafts. Grant led the Cougars to a top-four finish in the CAA in each of the last five seasons, including the 2018 regular season and conference tournament championship.

A finalist for the 2019 Skip Prosser Man of the Year Award, presented annually to a coach who not only achieves success on the basketball court, but who also displays moral integrity off the court, Grant led the Cougars to a memorable run in 2017-18 that included the program's second-straight 25-win campaign, an impressive 26-8 overall record and 14-4 mark in Colonial Athletic Association play. The co-regular-season champions earned the No. 1 seed in the CAA Men's Basketball Championship and defeated No. 2 seed Northeastern in an overtime thriller to punch the program's first ticket to the NCAA Tournament since 1999.

Grant guided the Cougars to three 20-win campaigns and a 67-22 home-court winning record over the previous six years and produced 12 all-conference honorees.

For the first time in program history, College of Charleston's men's basketball was recognized by the NCAA for the 2018-19 academic year. Under the guidance of Grant, the programs' four-year rolling APR was in the Top 10% of all men's basketball programs in the country. The Cougars were one of only 51 men's basketball programs honored nationally. In all, 24 players have gone on to earn their degree at The College.

In 2018-19, CofC posted a 24-9 overall record with non-conference victories over Rhode Island, VCU and Memphis. Two players - Grant Riller and Jarrell Brantley - were named to the All-CAA First Team. Known for their gritty defense, the Cougars led the CAA in scoring defense for the fourth-straight year holding opponents to 68.6 points per game. CofC also ranked No. 17 in the nation in turnovers per game (10.5 avg.) and No. 16 in free-throw percentage (76.4%).

Known as a player's coach, Grant and his staff helped develop Brantley into a 2019 NBA Draft Pick and Riller into a 2020 NBA Draft Pick - the third and fourth-ever College of Charleston players to be drafted. Brantley is currently a two-way player with the Utah Jazz and was named to the 2020 NBA G League First Team and All-Rookie Team as a member of the Salt Lake City Stars. He was second in voting for NBA G League Rookie of the Year honors. Riller was selected in the second round by the Charlotte Hornets giving the Cougars back-to-back NBA Draft picks for the first time in school history.

In 2016-17, Grant led the Cougars to a 25-10 overall record and 14-4 mark in Colonial Athletic Association play. It marked the program's first 20-win campaign since 2013. Charleston, seeded a program-best No. 2, advanced to the championship game of the CAA Tournament for the first time since CofC joined the Colonial in 2013. They were also selected and made their fifth all-time appearance in the Postseason NIT. It was their first postseason berth (NCAA or NIT) since 2011.

In his second season with the Cougars, Grant and his staff turned the program into one of the most improved in NCAA Division I and developed four all-conference players including Colonial Athletic Association Rookie of the Year and All-CAA Third Team selection Jarrell Brantley - the first freshman to receive such honors since 2006.

Known as a top recruiter, Grant has shown impressive credentials in both identifying and developing top-flight talent. No stranger to the ACC, he previously spent four seasons as an assistant coach at Clemson under Brad Brownell, where he made a positive impact on the Tiger men's basketball program, both in recruiting and with player development. He worked primarily with Clemson's point guards.

He recruited 2014 first-team All-ACC selection K.J. McDaniels to Clemson, where he ultimately ended up averaging 17 points per game as a junior and was named ACC Defensive Player of the Year, before declaring early for the NBA Draft. McDaniels was selected 32nd overall in the 2014 NBA Draft by the Philadelphia 76ers.

Several Tiger point guards have flourished under Grant's mentoring including incumbent starter Rod Hall. After recruiting the Augusta, Ga., native to Clemson, Grant has seen Hall develop into one of the leaders of the program. During the 2013-14 season, Hall was second on the team in scoring average and ranked among the ACC's top 10 in both assists per game and assist-to-turnover ratio.

In 2010-11, Grant worked with Demontez Stitt, who was named third-team All-ACC and was a member of the All-ACC Tournament Team. That same season, Grant helped Andre Young to an ACC-leading 2.55 assist-to-turnover ratio. Young went on to lead the conference in steals per game as a senior in 2011-12, earning All-ACC Defensive Team honors. He also led the Tigers in scoring under Grant's direction.

Clemson put together strong team results with Grant in the fold as well. In 2013-14, the Tigers went 23-13 overall and recorded a 10-win improvement from the previous season. Clemson advanced to the NIT semifinals and was 10-8 during the ACC regular season.

In Grant's first season in 2010-11, Clemson put together a 22-12 overall record and 9-7 league mark in the ACC. The Tigers earned the No. 4 seed at the ACC Tournament and advanced to the semifinals in Greensboro, N.C. Clemson also went to a fourth-consecutive NCAA Tournament and won its first-round game over UAB, 70-52, in Dayton, Ohio.

Clemson was strong defensively in four seasons with Grant part of its coaching staff. In 2010-11, the Tigers ranked No. 24 nationally in scoring defense. In 2011-12, Clemson yielded just 60.6 points per game to the opposition, the second-best figure among ACC schools. In 2012-13, the Tigers dropped their average even further to 60.1 points per game. That figure dropped to an ACC era-best at Clemson - 58.4 points per game - in 2013-14. The Tiger perimeter defense was No. 1 nationally defending the three-pointer (.286).

Grant personally signed 10 of Clemson's 15 players recruited by Brownell's staff. He was Clemson's lead recruiter for players such as Austin Ajuikwa, Jaron Blossomgame, Gabe DeVoe, Ibrahim Djambo, Sidy Djitte, Hall, K.J. McDaniels and Patrick Rooks.

Prior to Clemson, Grant served as an assistant coach first at Winthrop and then at Wichita State. He helped the Eagles to three consecutive Big South championships and three straight NCAA Tournament appearances. In 2004-05, the Eagles were 27-6 overall. The next season, Winthrop finished the year with a 23-8 overall record and came within two points of upsetting Tennessee in the NCAA Tournament. In 2007, Grant helped the Eagles to a 29-5 overall record and unblemished 14-0 mark in Big South play.

The 2007 campaign was a memorable one for Winthrop. With Grant's assistance, the Eagles claimed a 74-64 upset over No. 6 seed Notre Dame in the opening round of the NCAA Tournament. It was Winthrop's first-ever NCAA Tournament win in seven tries.

Grant was at Wichita State from 2007-10, when the Shockers made gradual improvement each season. In 2008-09, Wichita State made its first postseason appearance in three years and also defeated one of the nation's top mid-major programs in Siena during the regular season. In 2009-10, Wichita State improved its win total by eight and finished 25-10 overall, 12-6 in the Missouri Valley Conference. The Shockers advanced to the championship game of the conference tournament and also earned a bid to the National Invitation Tournament.

Prior to his stint at Winthrop, Grant was an assistant coach at The Citadel from 2002-04. Grant played two years at the Division II level at Georgia College. He led the school to two appearances in the NCAA Tournament and to consecutive Peach Belt Conference championships (1999, 2000). In 2000, the Bobcats advanced to the Elite Eight of the Division II national tournament.

A native of North Charleston, S.C., Grant earned his bachelor's degree in psychology from Georgia College in 2000. He and his wife, Jacqui, have three sons: Trey, Eyaiah and Elonzo.
