1ST ACC RETURN MATCH

This week in South Bend, the Fighting Irish will have an opportunity to get back two road losses by welcoming Miami (Wednesday) and Boston College (Saturday) to Purcell Pavilion. This Wednesday marks the first time Notre Dame will challenge a repeat opponent in league play.

The first time around, Miami escaped with a 62-49 victory. While the Irish struggled to convert on the offensive end at times, Notre Dame's defensive efforts limited the Hurricanes to a season low in points. The Irish forced 13 Miami turnovers and dominated the offensive boards, 15-6. Where Miami got the best of ND - they scored 16 points in transition. The Irish had good looks, but just couldn't capitalize offensively as they finished the day shooting 18-63 (.286) from the floor and 6-32 (.188) from beyond the arc.

Miami enters the game ranked 10th in the country in three-point percentage (.393), 26th in offense (82.4), 16th in effective field goal percentage (.567) and 24th in free-throw percentage (.767).

1ST YEAR STAMP ON THE PROGRAM - DEFENSE

The year one Coach Shrewsbury stamp on the program has been the vast improvement defensively from this young Irish squad.

The Irish have held all seven of its ACC opponents to under their season averages, with Miami and Duke being held to season lows at that point in time.

Furthermore, an Irish opponent has not recorded 70 points or more since Georgetown on Dec. 16 (eight-game streak). With that said, Notre Dame's scoring defense of 65.1 ranks 2nd in the ACC and 38th in the country. According to KenPom, Notre Dame's defensive efficiency ranks 43rd nationally.

In ACC play only, Notre Dame leads the league in defense (62.1) and ranks second in both field goal percentage defense (.373) and three-point field goal percentage defense (.302).

Lastly, how does this year's defense match up historically? According to Stats Inc which

goes back to the 1996-97 season, ND's 65.1 ranks 4th.

HITTING THE MARK

Point guard Markus Burton has put his name amongst the top freshmen in the country with his stellar play thus far. For those who aren't acquainted with the local standout from Mishawaka, here are some quick hitters:

- His 16.3 ppg leads all ACC freshmen and ranks 4th nationally amongst DI freshmen.
- He is 1-of-4 players in the ACC averaging over 15 points and 3.5 assists.
- If the season ended today, Burton's 16.3 ppg would rank 3rd all-time in the ND freshman record book. The two in front of him - Adrian Dantley (18.3) and Troy Murphy (19.2).
- Double-digit points in all but 2 games. He's riding a current 11-game streak
- Burton picked up his 5th game of 20 or more points against Florida State on Jan. 13. The following is a list of the most 20-point games by an Irish freshman: Adrian Dantley (13 in '73-74), Troy Murphy (10 in '98-99) and David Rivers (10 in '84-85).

- Ranks 10th in the ACC in scoring, 8th in Assists (3.9), 15th in steals (1.4) and 12th in FT% (.813).
- Averaging 4.9 assists in ACC play which ranks 4th. Also averaging 15.4 points in league action.

THIS CLOSE

Consider this note a part two to the defensive note one page prior. Because of the defensive effort, Notre Dame's 2-5 ACC record could easily be 4-3 or even flipped to 5-2. For Notre Dame's last four losses - so looking at BC, FSU, Duke and NC State - the average margin of defeat was 5.8 points.

In both the NC State and Boston College games, Notre Dame boasted a lead as large as 12 points in the first half. Against Duke, the Irish built a lead as large as nine.

Ultimately second half starts or finishes have been the difference maker. NC State ended the game on a 19-6 run to win by two. Duke started the second half on a 12-6 run. Both FSU and BC started the second half on identical 8-0 runs.

SHREWSBERRY'S HOT HAND

Braeden Shrewsberry has been hitting his stride as of late. Over the last 4 games he's averaging 14.3 points, shooting 13-of-26 (.500) from three. He's shooting 19-of-39 overall (.487). Shrewsberry has produced three double-digit scoring games in that span.

One of those double-digit scoring games was when Shrewsberry put the team on his back with a season best 25 points in the OT win at Georgia Tech. He connected on a season high five made three pointers.

He's now averaging 10.1 points in ACC play (2nd most on team), shooting 41.1 percent from the field and 41.5 percent from deep. Shrewsberry is averaging 2.4 made threes/game in league play which ranks 10th.

BOARDS BATTLE

Team wise, ND's rebounding numbers and rankings have risen as of late. In league play, the Irish rank 2nd in rebounding (41.1), and overall they rank 5th (37.8) in the ACC.

Kebba Njie has been a beast on the boards

as of late. Over the last five games, he's reeled in 48 rebounds (9.6 rpg). That stretch includes a career high 11 rebounds vs. NC State. He also nearly achieved his first career double-double when he had nine points and 10 rebounds against #14/13 Duke.

Njie leads the team in rebounding (6.3), O-Boards (2.2) and D-Boards (4.1). Plus, his numbers are higher In ACC play, where he ranks 9th in rebounding (8.0), 8th in O-Reb (2.4) & 11th in D-Reb (5.6).

Next, Carey Booth has been a rebounding machine as well. He reeled in a career best 13 rebounds at Boston College on Jan. 15, which included 10 defensive boards. It marked his first double-digit rebound game of the season.

In addition, Booth now averages 4.0 defensive rebounds/game, which ranks as the second most on the team.

LEFT ON THE TABLE

It was three straight ACC games at home to essentially kick off league play. After a big win over Virginia to start the homestand, the Irish know they left two on the table. A slight difference maker in both those losses were missed opportunities at the free-throw line.

First, it was NC State. The Wolfpack shot 28.8 percent from the field and finished with 54 points - just two more than their season low. On the flip side, Notre Dame had a six-point lead with 2:10 left on the clock. Then adversity hit. The next four possessions consisted of two turnovers and two misses on the front end of a one-and-one from the free-throw line. It all resulted in a Wolfpack 8-0 run to end the game to escape with the win.

Then there was No. 14/13 Duke. The Fighting Irish held the Blue Devils to a season low in both points and shooting percentage but ultimately fell by the slim margin of 67-59. The Irish had a lead as large as nine in the first half, but the Blue Devils stormed into halftime on a 14-3 scoring run, which was extended to 19-3 at the start the second half. The Irish would continue to fight hard throughout, rallying down eight points to cut the deficit to just two with 2:44 remaining. Notre Dame and Duke took the same amount of shots (59) with the Irish

converting two more (23). ND also won the rebounding battle 42-40. A difference maker came on the free-throw line in which Duke went 17-of-21 to Notre Dame's 8-of-16.

Notre Dame converted 19-of-21 from the free-throw line to help lift them to victory on the road against Georgia Tech on Jan. 9. Then in the very next game against Florida State on Jan. 13, the Irish struggled from the line, going 3-for-11 in what was just a nine-point loss.

Boston College on Jan. 15 had an eerie similarity to the Duke loss, with the Irish finishing with a higher shooting percentage + outrebounded its opponent.

FIRST SIGNATURE WIN

It took just the second ACC game of his career but Coach Shrewsberry delivered that first signature win in Notre Dame's 76-54 victory over Virginia. What Shrews' crew accomplished had never been done by an Irish crew against Virginia .. ever. It was the largest margin of victory against the Cavaliers in the all-time series. In addition, the 76 points were the most scored by an Irish squad against the Cavaliers in regulation in program history. Furthermore, the Irish handed Virginia its biggest loss to an ACC opponent since 2017 (65-41 loss to No. 10 UNC on Feb. 18, 2017).

574 BOYS BALL OUT ON 574 DAY

It was just meant to be. It was 574 Day when Notre Dame hosted Virginia, celebrating the combination of the local 574 community and our two local players on the team. And it just so happened that the 574 boys went off. South Bend native J.R. Konieczny posted 17 points and eight rebounds, shooting 6-of-8 including a 4-for-5 mark from three. Konieczny made his first six shots from the field and scored all his points in the first half. Then there was Mishawaka native Markus Burton, who earned 15 points on 6-of-10 shooting, plus a career high eight assists. Burton is the first player to dish out 8 assists against Virginia since Virginia Tech's Justyn Mutts on Feb. 4, 2023.

SECOND HALF SURGE

Burton has had a knack for surging at the right moments in the second half. Six times

this season, Burton has scored double-digit points in the second half alone: Niagara, Oklahoma State, Western Michigan, Marquette, Marist and Florida State.

Burton is averaging a team best 8.0 points in the second half.

HOME BOOST

Call it a home bonus, but Markus Burton has thrived inside Purcell Pavilion. The Mishawaka native is averaging 17.9 points on 44.8 percent shooting.

LEGENDS CLASSIC TAKEAWAYS

A couple of Irish standouts from two games in Brooklyn during the Legends Classic. First, let's look at All-Tournament Team selection Markus Burton. The freshman took over the end of the Oklahoma State game scoring 16 of his team-high 20 points in the second half plus overtime (10 in 2H + 6 in OT). He averaged 16.0 points over the two games.

Next, it was a breakout week for Konieczny, as he produced back-to-back double-doubles, averaging 14.5 points and 10.5 rebounds. He also earned his first career start in the win over Oklahoma State (11/17). J.R. entered the Legends Classic week with 15 points and 3 rebounds to his name thru 8 career ND games. Then over those 2 games, he produced a total of 29 points and 21 rebounds. J.R. constantly attacked the offensive glass, grabbing 8 O-Boards over the 2 games.

Last but not least, there was Tae Davis who averaged 10.0 points on 57.1 percent shooting (8-14 FG), along with 5.0 rebounds per game. Davis recorded a career high 13 points against the Auburn Tigers.

HISTORIC DEBUT FOR BURTON

Not only did freshman point guard Markus Burton ball out in a historic debut in the season opener, but he got to do it in front of his hometown crowd and family. Burton

poured in 29 points to lift the Irish to a 70-63 win over Niagara, marking the most points in program history in a freshman debut. The previous record was 27 points from Laphonso Ellis back in 1988. Now a few other notes on Burton's performance.

- 1-of-5 freshmen in the history of the program to score 29 points or more, joining David Graves, Troy Murphy, Chris Thomas and Adrian Dantley.
- Burton absolutely took over the end of the game. From 8:38-2:20 in the second half, Burton recorded 16 points on 6-for-6 shooting.
- Burton's 29 points is the 2nd highest from a DI freshman this season (only behind Harvard's Malik Mack's 32).

FRESHMAN FOUNDATION

A little over a month into the job, Coach Shrewsberry had himself a top-30 ranked incoming freshmen class – Carey Booth, Logan Imes and Braeden Shrewsberry - all flipped from their Penn State commits. Then add in Mr. Indiana Basketball Markus Burton, who kept his commitment to Notre Dame. That brought the 2023 class to four signees which ranked 23rd in the country according to 247Sports.com.

Furthermore, cementing the bond amongst the freshmen class, there was an Indiana connection amongst most of them:

-- Imes and Shrewsberry played together throughout all four of their high school years with the Indiana Elite.

-- Imes and Burton were teammates on the 2023 Indiana All-Stars squad

CLEAN SLATE

Notre Dame only returns 35 points from a season ago, which equates to 1.6% of scoring returning. The table on the bottom page 11 displays the Division I schools returning the least amount of points ahead of the 2023-24 season.

MR INDIANA BASKETBALL

On April 20, 2023, now freshman point guard Markus Burton, was named Mr. Indiana Basketball. It marked the third time in program history in which a future Notre Dame player took home the honor. The two former winners were Chris Thomas in 2001 and Luke Zeller in 2005.

Burton averaged a state-best 30.3 points per game, along with 5.7 rebounds, 5.1 assists and 3.6 steals. Burton also secured the school single season scoring record by pouring in 909 points as a senior.

THE FOUNDATION GROWS

Coach Shrewsberry continued to build the foundation of Irish hoops by announcing three Class of 2024 signees. Cole Certa, Sir Muhammed and Garrett Sundra all signed their National Letters of Intent and officially became Irish on Nov. 6.

Shrewsberry, who started this current season with a talented four-member freshman class that was ranked in the top-30, has now built upon that with a 2024 class that is ranked as high as No. 19 by 247Sports. The trio of Cole Certa (6-5 guard from Le Roy, Illinois), Sir Muhammed (6-6 guard from Charlotte, North Carolina) and Garrett Sundra (6-11 forward from Ashburn, Virginia) also rank as the fifth best class in the ACC by 247Sports.

"We are thrilled to welcome three tremendous young men into the Notre Dame family. I am very proud of the job we were able to do on the recruiting trail in this class by landing Cole Certa, Sir Mohammed and Garrett Sundra. When we got the job here, we put a premium on bringing in players who fit our team on the court as well as off the court. All three of these young men are not only tremendous basketball players, as evidenced by the fact that this is ranked as one of the top recruiting classes not only in the ACC, but in the country as well, but they are also excellent students who fit the mission and the culture of Notre Dame."

HOMETOWN HOMAGE FEATURE

There had been the youth camps at Notre Dame, myriad Fighting Irish men's basketball games and a blossoming relationship with

Demetrius Jackson – a name synonymous with Irish hoops success a decade ago.

And, then, there had been the fandom of another national college basketball power – about the only time the local kid from La Porte, Indiana, had found his way inside Purcell Pavilion for Notre Dame basketball.

Today, freshman point guard Markus Burton and redshirt-sophomore J.R. Konieczny are homegrown products at the foundational stage of first-year Notre Dame Glenn & Stacey Murphy head coach Micah Shrewsberry's program rebuild.

Though different in their paths to play beneath the fabled Golden Dome, both Burton and Konieczny embrace this moment to help reassert Irish basketball and fashion an example for area youth who may also foster dreams of wearing Irish green.

"It was sort of unreal for me, because I liked Notre Dame a lot, and it was basically a dream school for me, my hometown and a no-brainer," said Burton, who capped his record-shattering prep career at Penn High School with the coveted Indiana Mr. Basketball award – just the third Irish signee all-time to procure the accolade. "Blake Wesley and J.R. Konieczny, I was a really big fan of theirs too."

Initially, the rangy, 6-foot-7 Konieczny – a second-team Indiana All-State selection who had finished fifth in Mr. Basketball balloting in 2021 – had not envisioned a gilded path to Notre Dame.

"It just all felt super surreal," Konieczny, who sat out the 2022-23 season to hone his all-around game and ensure his overall health, said. "The whole recruitment process was super stressful for me, and then when I committed to Notre Dame, it was a huge weight off my shoulders. I had never really expected myself to be at Notre Dame, but then the stars aligned."

As Burton transitions through the early months of his collegiate career and Konieczny begins in earnest the hardwood portion of his Notre Dame journey, they are mindful of this moment together – in their own career arcs and in a historic dawn of a new era of Irish basketball under Shrewsberry, also a Hoosier State native with basketball bona fides spanning the NCAA to the NBA.

"We talk about it a lot, but I mean right now, we kind of just have fun with it," said Burton of his conversations with Konieczny about the chance to be a hometown beacon of Notre Dame basketball. "We talk about how blessed we are to be able to go to Notre Dame and play basketball here, to have this opportunity.

"It's really fun. Coach Shrewsberry is a really good coach, loves his players and teaches us what need to do. A lot of us adapted really well, and I feel like once we get playing and people see how hard we play, we're going to show people how hard we work and take pride in everyday practice. It's going to be really fun."

A new era of Notre Dame basketball; a foundation formed in its community.

"We always have a good sense of what it means to rep the city and the area and rep Notre Dame and our hometown," Konieczny said. "We've been doing it for quite some years,; Markus being Mr. Basketball, had a great high school career that let people know who he was. I think it means a lot to both of us. We're going to do everything we can to win and see Notre Dame fans happy and South Bend fans happy and just everyone in this community.

"We're going to work our butts off no matter what's going on; every guy on our team has that dog in him. And I think that really stands to what we're trying to do."

1st Season at Notre Dame
3rd as a Head Coach at DI Level

An Indiana native has come home to kick start a new era of Notre Dame men's basketball. Vice President and James E. Rohr Notre Dame Director of Athletics Jack Swarbrick announced Micah Shrewsberry as the 18th head coach in Fighting Irish men's basketball history on March 23, 2023.

"We are so excited to have Coach (Shrewsberry) join the Notre Dame family," Swarbrick said. "Throughout this process, it reaffirmed for me that this job was among the best in the country as we had many great candidates express interest."

"During our two month process, we weekly reviewed our candidate pool and each week he (Micah) stayed at the top of our list due to his fit at the University and his commitment to the student-athlete experience. Not only do his personal & family values align with the University, but his dedication to the development of each member of his program as well."

Shrewsberry is fresh off a historic turnaround as the head coach at Penn State. After a 14-17 first season, Shrewsberry produced a 23-14 mark in 2022-23, just the 12th 20-win season in the 127-year history of Penn State basketball. Furthermore, he collected more Big Ten wins (17) in his first two seasons than any other Penn State head coach.

Shrewsberry brings a wealth of experience and success to the helm of the Notre Dame program. All-in-all he's coached in six NCAA Tournaments, two NCAA Final Fours, five NBA Playoffs and two NBA Conference Finals – in addition to coaching all-NBA honorees Jayson Tatum and Jaylen Brown.

"I'm very excited to be joining the University of Notre Dame family," Shrewsberry said. "The combination of top notch academics, plus a long storied history of success on the basketball court, made this a very attractive job for me. The power of the Notre Dame brand, and the passionate alumni family, will allow us to recruit the brightest student-athletes from coast to coast. I can't wait to get to campus and begin connecting with the students, faculty and staff which make this place special."

Shrewsberry and Penn State captured the nation's attention in late February and into March, going 9-3 over their last 12 games, which included six Quad 1 wins. Shrewsberry then made plenty of noise in the 2023 Big Ten Tournament in Chicago, defeating No. 7 Illinois, No. 2 Northwestern and No. 3 Indiana to reach the championship game as the No. 10 seed.

It marked the program's second-ever Big Ten title game appearance. Penn State was just the third double-digit seed to reach the Big Ten Tournament championship game and the first since 2008.

The Nittany Lions then made their first appearance in the NCAA Tournament since 2011. In the first round, Shrewsberry and the Nittany Lions knocked off No. 7 seed and SEC Tournament runner-up Texas A&M, winning the program's first NCAA Tournament game since 2001.

In year one at Penn State, Shrewsberry engineered the Big Ten's best scoring defense and guided the squad to their best defensive season (65.0 points allowed per game) in 11 years. The Nittany Lions advanced to the quarterfinal round of the Big Ten Tournament after winning two postseason games, making Shrewsberry one of just two first-year Big Ten coaches since 2008 to win two Big Ten Tournament games.

Recruiting-wise, Shrewsberry made an instant splash in Happy Valley. In his first year, Shrewsberry signed the highest-ranked recruiting class in program history, a consensus top-30 class. A year later, he signed his second-straight top-30 recruiting class, marking the first time in program history that the Nittany Lions had signed back-to-back top-30 recruiting classes.

Statistically speaking, the 2022-23 squad set the B1G and Penn State single-season team record for three-pointers made in a season with 385. The Nittany Lions compiled a total of five top-15 national

statistical rankings. In addition, Shrewsberry tutored an Associated Press All-American in Jalen Pickett and a total of three All-Big Ten players during the 2022-23 season.

Prior to his time with Penn State, Shrewsberry experienced two separate stints at Purdue – one as assistant coach from 2011-13 and another as associate head coach from 2019-21. Highlights include the 2020-21 season, in which Shrewsberry helped lead the Boilermakers to a 13-6 fourth-place finish in the Big Ten and an 18-10 overall mark, culminating in an NCAA Tournament at-large bid. Trevion Williams claimed first-team All-Big Ten honors, while Zach Edey and Jaden Ivey were All-Freshman Team selections. Shrewsberry played a major role in recruiting Ivey, who grew up in South Bend and is the son of Karen and Kevin Keyes Family Head Women's Basketball Coach Niele Ivey.

Another highlight from his time in West Lafayette includes the 2011-12 squad that produced a 22-13 record and reached the second round of the NCAA Tournament. Under Shrewsberry, Terone Johnson was one of the most improved players in the B1G, netting accolades from conference and national entities.

In-between his Purdue stints, Shrewsberry spent six seasons (2013-19) with the NBA's Boston Celtics as an assistant coach under Brad Stevens. During his tenure, the Celtics reached the playoffs in five consecutive seasons, including back-to-back appearances in the Eastern Conference Finals in 2017 and 2018.

Shrewsberry played a key role in the development of current NBA stars Brown and Tatum, who were the No. 3 picks in the 2016 and 2017 NBA Drafts, respectively. Tatum was an NBA All-Rookie Team first-team selection, while Brown earned second-team All-Rookie honors.

The Brad Stevens connection was previously made at Butler University, where Shrewsberry spent one year as the director of operations then three as an assistant coach. With Shrewsberry on the sidelines, the Bulldogs compiled an 87-21 record, won two Horizon League regular-season championships and two Horizon League Tournament titles and made three NCAA Tournament appearances – which included back-to-back runs to the national championship game in 2010 and 2011.

Also at Butler, he aided in the development of Gordon Hayward, who was the 2009 Horizon League Newcomer of the Year, the 2010 Horizon League Player of the Year and a 2010 Final Four All-Tournament Team selection. Hayward was the ninth overall pick in the 2010 NBA Draft by the Utah Jazz.

Continuing on Shrewsberry's basketball journey, he spent time as the director of basketball operations at Marshall University (2003-05) and an assistant coach at DePauw University (2001-03) and Wabash College (2000-01). At DePauw, Shrewsberry led the Tigers to a 42-12 record with a pair of conference championships.

Shrewsberry was also the first men's basketball head coach at Indiana University South Bend. Shrewsberry started his coaching career as a graduate assistant at the University of Indianapolis in 1999-2000.

An Indianapolis area native, Shrewsberry earned his bachelor's degree from Hanover College in 1999 and a master's degree from Indiana State in 2003. As a player at Hanover, Shrewsberry was a three-year starting guard and team tri-captain.

He and his wife, Molly, have four children, Braeden, Nicholas, Caitlin and Grace.
