# SYRACUSE NEWS AND NOTES

## LAST TIME OUT

Syracuse won its 25th-straight contest against Pittsburgh at the Petersen Events Center on Sunday. The Orange were led by Dyaisha Fair (22 pts, 6 assists) and Georgia Woolley (20 points) en route to their sixth ACC win of the season. Syracuse improved to 51-19 all-time against the Panthers with the 72-59 road win. Saniaa Wilson flirted with a double double grabbing a season-high 12 rebounds and adding nine points while Alaina Rice added 13 points.

## SERIES HISTORY - NOTRE DAME

Notre Dame leads the all-time series 39-6. Syracuse won the first meeting this season at the JMA Dome with an 86-81 upset of the #13 Irish. It was the first time Syracuse beat a ranked Notre Dame team in 20 years. The Orange are 0-19 all-time in South Bend and in search of their first road win and season sweep of the Irish in program history on Thursday.

## PLAYER OF THE WEEK

Syracuse was honored twice this week with a player of the week. Dyaisha Fair was named ACC Player of the Week on Monday following a 2-0 week for the Orange that was highlighted by a win over #15 FSU where Fair broke a program record for threes in a game (9) and scored 31 points to help SU erase its second 18-point third quarter deficit in as many games.

On Tuesday, Fair was named one of five USBWA National Players of the Week for her stellar week with the Orange.

## DOMINATION

Syracuse begins the season 11-0 at home for the first time under Felisha Legette-Jack. SU began 9-0 in 2022-23. The Orange have won 15-straight home games at the JMA Wireless Dome.

## MS. 3k - IT'S FAIR!

Dyaisha Fair used a 14-point fourth quarter to will the Orange to a win on Jan. 14 vs. Clemson and in doing so reached the 3,000 career point plateau. After being fouled on a three-point attempt which would have put her at 3,002 career points on a make, Fair headed to the free throw line. She sunk the first, to land perfectly on 3,000 before lining up twice more to complete the trifecta of shots at the charity stripe. She became the 16th player in women's basketball Division I history to score 3,000 points and just the 26th out of DI basketball players (10 men have accomplished this.)

Fair enters Thursday's game with 3,060 career points and is second among active players in all three NCAA Divisions behind Caitlin Clark. Fair is tied for 10th on the NCAA Division I Career Scoring List with Iowa State alum Ashley Joens.

## BRACKETOLOGY

In the latest Bracketology by ESPN's Charlie Creme (Jan. 23), the Orange are a 6 seed -- the highest projected seed for SU this season.

## CLEANING THE GLASS

Syracuse's frontcourt has some of the top rebounders in the ACC. Freshman Alyssa Latham ranks sixth in boards per game (7.9) while Kyra Wood (7.2) is ninth. SU is the only school with two players in the top-10 of rebounding in the ACC.

## DEFEND THE DOME

Syracuse has won 26-consecutive home non-conference games at The Dome. The last home non-conference loss for the Orange was against No. 1 Oregon on Nov. 24, 2020.

## BEST START!

Syracuse's 16-2 start is the best in over a decade. Last time SU began the season was the 2012-13 season.

6-1 is also the best start SU has ever had since joining the ACC. Prior to this season the best start for the Orange was 4-1. Last time Syracuse was 6-1 in conference Coach Jack and assistant coach Sue Ludwig were sophomores on the team (1985-86, Big East).

## BIGGEST COMEBACK OF THE FLJ ERA

Syracuse erased a 19-point deficit on Jan. 14 to defeat Clemson, 83-82, at the JMA Wireless Dome. Syracuse stormed back, with the help of 19 second half points from Dyaisha Fair, to win by the hands of an Alyssa Latham layup with seven seconds to play in regulation.

## NO PLACE LIKE DOME

Syracuse basketball is a combined 20-1 at home this season under the bright lights of the JMA Wireless Dome. Prior to the men's team's home loss vs. FSU on Tuesday night, the Orange were the only Power 5 school in the country undefeated at home in basketball. The 20-0 combined start at home is the best in almost a decade at 'Cuse. In 2017-18 the Orange started a combined 18-0 at home.

## GO HARD IN THE PAINT

Syracuse is 8-0 in games that the Orange score 40+ points in the paint. 'Cuse scored a season-high 68 points in the paint against Central Connecticut State on Nov. 10.

## NEW KID ON THE BLOCK

Maddy Potts arrived on campus Dec. 27 after traveling for 30 hours from her hometown in Victoria, Australia, and joined the Orange immediately in practices over the holiday break. The mid-year enrollee has been practicing with the Orange for several weeks now but has yet to dress for a game this season.

## WOOLLEY FROM DOWNTOWNUNDER

Junior Georgia Woolley, a Brisbane, Australia, native, scored her 1,000th career point against Saint Francis on Dec. 21. She drained a three to land perfectly on 1k in front of her parents and sister who were visiting from Australia and watching her play in person for the first time in college.

## ACC VS. SEC - WHO'S THE BEST

Women's college basketball fans will have to continue the debate for another year after the inaugural ACC/SEC Challenge saw a 7-7 split in 2023. The Orange were one of two ACC schools to have both its men's and women's basketball teams win their respective games; Virginia was the other.

Ironically, the men's ACC/SEC Challenge also was split 7-7 in the 14 games.

## ORANGE IN THE POLLS

Syracuse moved up to #22 in the USA Today Coaches Poll this week (Week 12) after making its debut at No. 25 last week. The Orange also earned a No. 22 ranking from the Associated Press (AP) Top-25 marking the first time this season the Orange are ranked in both polls.

## ROOKIE OF THE WEEK HONORS

Alyssa Latham was named ACC Freshman of the Week on Monday, Dec. 4. Her 23 point, 12 rebound performance helped lift the Orange to a win over Alabama in the ACC/SEC Challenge. Latham was the first Orange freshman to win ACC Freshman of the Week honors since Kamilla Cardoso in 2021.

## 30-PLUS WINS

Syracuse started the season with three-straight 30+ wins for the first time since the 1974 season and just the second time in program history.

## ORANGE OVERSEAS

Syracuse will travel overseas for a summer foreign tour in 2024. Felisha Legette-Jack and her squad is currently fundraising to take the team to Greece for an educational, cultural and competitive trip. It will be the first international trip for the Orange in almost a decade.

## WATCH LIST SEASON

Dyaisha Fair has been named to multiple preseason watch lists including the Nancy Lieberman Award Watch List which is for the nation's top point guard. She was also featured on the preseason watch lists for the John Wooden Award (Most Outstanding Player) and the Naismith Award (National Player of the Year).

## ORANGE PICKED 9TH IN THE ACC

Syracuse was picked to finish ninth in the ACC this season. The Orange went 9-9 in FLJ's first season and earned the No. 9 seed to the ACC Tournament. Additionally, Dyaisha Fair was selected as Preseason All-ACC.

## NEW FACES TO THE SQUAD

Syracuse added five newcomers for this season's team. Graduate transfers Dominique Camp and Izabel Varejao add experience while the freshman class of Sophie Burrows, Alyssa Latham and Marilena Triantafylli add athleticism and height to the Orange roster. Additionally, Syracuse signed Madeline Potts, a native of Victoria, Australia, who will enroll in the spring semester.

## OH CAPTAIN, MY CAPTAIN!

Dyaisha Fair, Dominique Camp and Kyra Wood will serve as team captains for the 2023-24 season. Team captains were decided by the student-athletes and coaching staff prior to the start of the season. This is the second-consecutive year Fair and Wood were named captain.

## FLJ IS HOME

Felisha Legette-Jack returned home to Syracuse on March 26, 2022 when she was named the eighth head coach in Syracuse women's basketball history. The Syracuse, N.Y., native led Nottingham High School to a pair of New York State Championships before playing for the Orange. In her freshman season, she was named BIG EAST Freshman of the Year and helped guide the team to the 1985 BIG EAST Tournament Championship and its first appearance in the NCAA Tournament.

By the time of her graduation, Legette-Jack was the all-time leader in career points and rebounds. Her 1,526 career points currently rank eighth in program history and she is fourth in career rebounds with 927. Legette-Jack was the first player in program history to be named Fast Break Magazine All-American honorable mention. She served as an assistant coach for the Orange for seven seasons from 1993-2000.

Her jersey became the first women's jersey to be retired in Syracuse Athletics history on Nov. 14, 2021.

## LEGACY LEX

Sophomore guard Lexi McNabb is no stranger to Syracuse University. She was born to BLEED ORANGE. The daughter of legendary Syracuse football and NFL quarterback Donovan McNabb '99 and women's basketball alumnae Raquel 'Roxy' (Nurse) McNabb '98, Lexi is here at Syracuse to write her own story and leave her own legacy. Originally committed to Buffalo, Lexi made the easy decision to join Coach Jack at Syracuse when she was named head coach. Roxy McNabb was a four-year letterwinner and point guard for the women's basketball team when Coach Jack was an assistant coach in the mid-1990s.

## FLI AND WEEZY REUNITED

Felisha Legette-Jack's biggest recruit when she was named head coach was former teammate and best friend of 38 years, Sue Ludwig. Fli and Weezy, their beloved college nicknames, reunited this past March when Ludwig stepped down as girl's basketball head coach of Westhill High School after 31 years. Ludwig is the all-time winningest high school girls basketball coach in the state of New York with a state championship and many federation championships under her belt.

Despite having never coached at the collegiate level, Legette-Jack knew that one day Ludwig would join her on the sidelines if she became the head coach of their alma mater. That dream came true in March.

## JOHN A. LALLY ATHLETICS COMPLEX

A The John A. Lally Athletics Complex entranceway is complete! The first milestone in the ongoing multi-million dollar, multi-year capital campaign to build a new home for the Orange welcomes alumni, friends, staff, coaches, student-athletes and prospective student-athletes and their families. When completed, the Lally Athletics Complex will stand as a state-of-the-art academics and athletics village serving all 20 Syracuse teams and more than 600 student-athletes.

A key priority of Forever Orange, Syracuse University's comprehensive capital campaign, the Lally Athletics

Complex will elevate the student-athlete experience and provide a first-rate facility to help the department continue to develop, recruit and retain high caliber student-athletes. Thanks to the leadership support of Lally, a three-time Orange football letterwinner, and his wife, Laura, this vision is steadily becoming a reality.

Lally, a graduate of the Martin J. Whitman School of Management and an offensive guard for the Orange from 1977-82, made a \$25 million gift commitment in 2019 to jumpstart the campaign and help inspire fellow alumni, fans and donors to support.

The new front entrance and expanded meeting space that features engaging interactive technology and state-of-the-art video boards opened on February 20, 2023. Future plans for the complex call for the second level of the entranceway to be expanded into a student-athlete academic success center.

Momentum for the campaign is building as the 'Cuse Athletics Fund ('CAF) and Syracuse University continue to fundraise for the next phases of the Lally Athletics Complex, which was known as Manley Field House for nearly 60 years. The \$150 million campaign includes the creation of a new Football Operations Center and the 'One Team' Olympic Sports Center, which house updated dining and nutrition facilities, renovated locker rooms, medical training and strength and conditioning facilities, and modernized displays honoring the history of Syracuse Athletics.

## JMA WIRELESS DOME & UPGRADES

On May 19, 2022, Syracuse University announced that JMA Wireless, a global leader in the wireless industry and 5G technology headquartered in Syracuse, entered a 10-year naming rights partnership, ending the 40-year legacy of the Carrier Dome name and ushering in the JMA Wireless Dome era (or JMA Dome for short).

The University announced last winter that it will build on that momentum with the installation of upgraded chairback seating and the introduction of new premium offerings throughout the venue. Bench seating will be replaced throughout the 100, 200 and 300 levels, resulting in added comfort and accessibility. It also means the JMA Dome will have a new seat map and revised capacities for football, men's basketball, women's basketball, men's lacrosse and women's lacrosse competitions.

## HEAD COACH FELISHA LEGETTE-JACK



Felisha Legette-Jack, a 1989 graduate of Syracuse University and Orange All-American, is home. The Syracuse native and 20-year collegiate head coach took the reins of the Orange basketball program on March 26, 2022.

Legette-Jack is synonymous with Syracuse women's basketball success. The 1985 BIG EAST Conference Freshman of the Year, three-time All-BIG EAST selection and Syracuse's first two-time honorable mention All-American. Legette-Jack helped lead the Orange to their first BIG EAST Championship and NCAA Tournament appearance in school history. More than 30 years later, she still ranks in the top-10 on Syracuse's career scoring and rebounding lists. She is one of three players in program history to score more than 1,500 points (1,526) and grab more than 900 rebounds (927).

The Orange laid a solid foundation in Legette-Jack's first season as head coach in 2022-23. The Orange legend led Syracuse to its first postseason appearance since 2021 and became the first head coach in program history to guide SU to the postseason in their first season at the helm. Syracuse posted a 20-13 record overall and reached the Super 16 of the Women's NIT. Under Legette-Jack's guidance, senior guard Dyaisha Fair was named All-ACC First Team and garnered WBCA All-America honorable mention.

Off the court, the Orange were active in the community and posted the best fall and spring semester grade point averages (GPAs) in the last decade. A record eight Orange were named to the ACC All-Academic Team paced by College Sports Communicators (previously CoSIDA) Academic All-District honoree Darianna Lewis.

One of the all-time Orange greats, Legette-Jack returned to her hometown with more than 30 years of coaching experience. She spent the last 10 years building the University at Buffalo's women's program into one of the perennial powers in the Mid-American Conference (MAC), leading the Bulls to four NCAA Tournaments, including the 2018 Sweet Sixteen. She is the all-time winningest coach in Bulls history with a 202-115 record and four MAC Tournament Championships. During her career she has guided three different Division I programs to a combined 13 winning seasons, nine postseason berths and six 20-win seasons, and has accrued a 343-279 record.

Legette-Jack led Nottingham High School to a pair of state titles before attending Syracuse, where she was a standout on Coach Barbara Jacobs' teams from 1984-89.

At Syracuse, Legette-Jack earned BIG EAST Freshman of the Year honors after helping lead the Orange to their first BIG EAST Championship in school history. As a sophomore, Legette-Jack averaged a double-double (15.8 ppg and 10.1 rpg) en route to honorable mention All-America honors and All-BIG EAST recognition. The next year she earned honorable mention All-America and All-BIG EAST Second Team recognition. After missing the 1987-88 season due to a knee injury, she returned to earn the court earn All-BIG EAST honors for the fourth time in 1988-89. She finished her career as the program's all-time leader in points, rebounds, field goals made and attempted, and free throws made and attempted.

After graduating from Syracuse with bachelor's degrees in child and family studies and psychology in 1989, Legette-Jack began her coaching career at Westhill Senior High School on the city's West side in 1989. She made the move to the collegiate level as an assistant at Boston College from 1991-93 and never looked back.

Following her stint at BC, Legette-Jack returned home to Syracuse as an assistant on Coach Marianna Freeman's staff from 1993-2000. She left in 2000 to become an assistant coach at Michigan State for two seasons, before landing her first head coaching job at Hofstra in 2002.

In four years, Legette-Jack turned Hofstra's program around. During her final season Hofstra was 19-12 and advanced to the second round of the Women's National Invitational Tournament (WNIT).

Named head coach at Indiana University in 2006, Legette-Jack guided the that program for six years. She led the Hoosiers to consecutive WNITs in her first three seasons, including a 20-win season and WNIT Quarterfinal appearance in 2009.

In 2012, she returned to the Empire State when she was named the head coach at Buffalo. Legette-Jack put the UB program on the map during her decade in the Queen City. She led four Buffalo teams to four NCAA Tournaments, most recently this season, and developed the first WNBA Draft pick in school history, Cierra Dillard, who was selected by the Minnesota Lynx in 2019. Her UB teams have had five 20-win seasons and averaged more than 19 wins a campaign during her tenure.

The 2021-22 Bulls posted a 25-9 record, including a 16-4 mark in MAC play, and were 14-1 at home. Legette-Jack developed three All-MAC honorees in Dyaisha Fair, Georgia Woolley and Summer Hemphill. Fair finished the season ranked fourth in the nation in scoring average (23.4 points per game) and Woolley also earned MAC Freshman of the Year honors.

The Bulls had their most successful season in 2017-18, posting a 29-6 record, including 12-0 at home. UB earned the first NCAA at-large bid for the MAC since 1996 and danced its way to the Sweet Sixteen for the first time in school history.

Legette-Jack is enshrined in multiple halls of fame, including the Greater Syracuse Hall of Fame, the Syracuse Urban Sports Hall of Fame and the Syracuse University Orange Plus Hall of Fame. She was named to the BIG EAST Silver Anniversary team in 2004 and became the first female in Syracuse University history to have her jersey retired last fall when her No. 33 jersey was raised to the rafters of the Carrier Dome on Nov. 14, 2021.

Born Sept. 4, 1966, in Syracuse, Legette-Jack and her husband David, have one son, David Maceo, who is currently playing professional basketball in England for the Cheshire Phoenix.

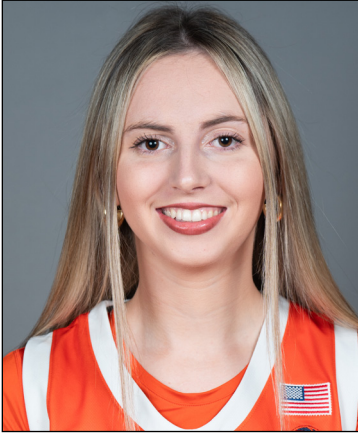
