RIGHT ACROSS THE BRIDGE

Before moving to the Indianapolis area, Coach Shrewsberry grew up right across the bridge from Louisville in the City of Jeffersonville. On Wednesday night, Coach Shrews plans on bringing a lot of family and friends to the KFC Yum! Center as a return home game of sorts.

WIN STREAK?

A streak isn't a streak until three and on Wednesday night the Notre Dame men's basketball team can win three in a row for the first time this season. The Irish are coming off a weekend bye, but previously produced wins over Virginia Tech and Georgia Tech. A win on Wednesday would not only give the Irish double-digit victories on the season, but also move them one step closer to possibly jumping up several seeds for the ACC Tournament, with three teams sitting at six league wins (Boston College, Virginia Tech and Miami).

Louisville enters with an 8-18 overall record and a 3-12 mark in league play. The Cards rank 18th in the country in free throws made per game (17.6) and 48th in FT percentage (.755). They average 72.1 ppg in league play, shooting 45.4 percent from the field, though they average just 5.6 made threes per game. They have five players averaging double figures, led by Mike James' 13.5 ppg, Tre White's 13.2 and Skyy Clark's 13.1.

LOOKING TO BUILD ON 2 WINS

Coach Shrewsberry saw the growth in his young team, just not the results yet. But on Feb. 10 vs. Virginia Tech, it clicked for the Irish as they emerged with the 74-66 win. Before the game, Coach Shrewsberry talked about how every player had a small role,

how if every player did their job, all those small parts would add up to a win over the Hokies.

The Fighting Irish rallied down four at the half to outscore the Hokies 39-27 in the second half. They turned what had been a problem for most of January, which was second half starts, into a strength, starting the second on a 9-0 run. Notre Dame shot 54.2 percent in the second half and finished with their second highest assist total on the year with 14. They also tallied their second lowest turnover total at eight and out-rebounded Virginia Tech 34-28.

Then there was the 'gritty not pretty' 58-55 victory over Georgia Tech. The Irish shot just 31.6 percent from the field but got it done where it counted: tied season high in offensive rebounds (16), season high in second chance points (20), season high in free-throw attempts (22) and a season low in turnovers (6).

Thus, just 14 combined turnovers over the last two games, which is Notre Dame's lowest two-game total all year. In fact, it marked the first time they produced back-to-back games with single-digit turnovers.

1ST YEAR STAMP ON THE PROGRAM - DEFENSE

The year one Coach Shrewsberry stamp on the program has been the defensive intensity. 14 games and 10 different ACC opponents - all held under their season averages in every single contest, with Miami and Duke being held to season lows at that point in time.

Of the 14 ACC matchups that have already

happened, only three opponents have reached the 70-point park against the Irish defense.

Notre Dame's scoring defense of 65.3 ranks 2nd in the ACC and 29th in the country. According to KenPom, Notre Dame's defensive efficiency ranks 40th nationally.

In ACC play only, Notre Dame ranks 2nd in scoring defense (64.0) and 2nd in field goal percentage defense (.410).

Lastly, how does this year's defense match up historically? According to Stats Inc which goes back to the 1996-97 season, ND's 65.3 ranks 4th.

BURTON LEAVING HIS FRESHMAN YEAR LEGACY

Virginia Tech - 16 points, 8 assists, 6 steals
Georgia Tech - 18 points, 5 assists, 5 steals

Since 1996, only one other Irish player had produced two games in the same regular season with at least 15 points, 5 assists and 5 steals. His name was Chris Thomas back in the 2001-02 season. Burton has not only achieved this feat but did so in back-to-back games! Thomas ultimately produced three of such games over his entire Irish career.

HITTING THE MARK

Point guard Markus Burton has put his name amongst the top freshmen in the country with his stellar play thus far. For those who aren't acquainted with the local standout from Mishawaka, here are some quick hitters:

- His 16.2 ppg leads all ACC freshmen,

with the next highest being Duke's Jared McCain at 13.8.

- Ranks 4th nationally amongst DI freshmen.
- 1-of-2 ACC players averaging over 16 points and 4.0 assists - other is Syracuse's Judah Mintz.
- ACC freshman rankings: 1st in scoring, 3rd in assists/game, 1st in steals/game.
- Double-digit points in all but 2 games. He's currently riding an 18-game streak.
- He's scored at least 16 points in 5 straight games.
- Ranks 10th in the ACC in scoring, 7th in Assists (4.2) and 4th in steals (2.0).
- In ACC play only: 15.7 points (ranks 12th), 4.9 assists (3rd) and leads the league in steals (2.3)..
- Averaging 8.4 points in the 2nd half.
- Averaging 17.1 points at home.
- Two-time ACC Rookie of the Week

BURTON WINS 2ND ACC ROOKIE OF THE WEEK

Markus Burton won his second ACC Rookie of the Week award on Feb. 12. Burton joined Blake Wesley as the only other multi-time ACC Rookie of the Week winner. Burton earned the honor after pouring in a team best 19 points then posting an incredible stat line in the win over Virginia Tech.

Burton balled out with 16 points, a season high tying eight assists and a season best six steals – as the latter tied for the third most steals in a single game in program history.

Burton joined very rare company with that performance. Since 1996, only two other Irish have finished with at least 16 points, eight assists and six steals in a game – Chris Thomas in 2001 and Jerian Grant in 2013.

FRESHMAN RECORD WATCH

We are officially on Burton Freshman Scoring Record watch as we head into the final stretch of the season. The freshman guard enters Wednesday's matchup with 406 points on the season - which already puts him in the No. 7 spot. Next up is No. 6 Jerian Grant's 418. To get to No. 1 Troy Murphy's 519, Burton would have to average 16.2 points over the next seven games.

From a scoring average perspective, Burton's 16.2 ppg ranks 3rd all-time behind Troy Murphy (19.2) and Adrian Dantley (18.3).

#TRENDING

Here are some other under-the-radar stats to keep an eye out for this week.

Braeden Shrewsberry is averaging 11.6 ppg in true road contests, shooting 42.5 percent.

Tae Davis has made 19 of his last 20 from the free-throw line, raising his percentage from .618 to its current .707.

Coming off the bench on Feb. 10, Logan Imes scored all 8 of his season high points in the 2nd half in the win vs. Virginia Tech. He went 3-fof-4 from the line (final 1:14 of the game) and hit a pivotal three-pointer with 7:23 left.

IN YOUR BAG

Speaking of trending, Markus Burton has ratcheted up his defensive intensity down the final stretch. The starting point guard has collected 21 steals over the last 5 games. He now averages a team best 2.0 steals per game, which ranks 4th in the ACC.

Furthermore, his 2.3 steals/game in league play now leads all ACC players.

SHREWSBERRY'S HOT HAND

Braeden Shrewsberry has secured 8 double-digit scoring performances over the last 11 games. Get this - since Jan. 6, Shrewsberry is averaging 3.0 made threes per game, which ranks 4th in the ACC in that timeframe. Furthermore, he's produced at least four made three-pointers in three of the last six

games.

One of those double-digit scoring games was when Shrewsberry put the team on his back with a season best 25 points in the OT win at Georgia Tech. He connected on a season high five made three pointers.

He's now averaging 10.5 points in ACC play (2nd most on team), while shooting 40.2 percent from the field & 40.7 percent from beyond the arc - ranks 7th in ACC. Lastly, he averages 2.6 made threes/game in league play, which ranks 5th.

BOARDS BATTLE

One of Notre Dame's greatest strengths this season has been its rebounding. In ACC play, the Irish rank 2nd in rebounding (37.1) and 4th in rebound margin (+3.4). In addition they rank 3rd in both offensive (10.4) rebounds per game and defensive (26.7).

The Irish are 8-6 this season when outrebounding their opponent.

Logan Imes has also upped his rebounding efforts. After amassing 23 rebounds over a 12-game span from Dec. 2 to Jan. 27 - Imes has accumulated the same 23 rebounds over the last 5 games.

Same goes for Julian Roper II. He's upped his rebounding intensity with 11 boards over the last 2 games - same amount as the five games prior.

THIS CLOSE

Because of the defensive effort of this young team, Notre Dame has been in just about every single league contest and their 4-10 ACC record unfortunately doesn't reflect it.

Before the Duke loss on Feb. 7 - Notre Dame had been in eight straight tight battles (Pitt, Virginia, BC x2, Miami, FSU, Duke and NC State) with the average margin of defeat in those losses being 7.5.

In both Boston College games, the Irish had a three-point attempt to either tie or win the game in the closing seconds.

Overall on the season, Notre Dame has played in 14 games in which the margin of victory was 10 points or less and have gone 6-8. Diving deeper, the Irish are 3-4 in games decided by five points or less.

Lastly, in three of those losses (Boston College, Duke and Virginia), the Irish finished the game with both a higher shooting percentage and rebounding total.

FIRST SIGNATURE WIN

It took just the second ACC game of his career but Coach Shrewsberry delivered that first signature win in Notre Dame's 76-54 victory over Virginia. What Shrews' crew accomplished had never been done by an Irish crew against Virginia .. ever. It was the largest margin of victory against the Cavaliers in the all-time series. In addition, the 76 points were the most scored by an Irish squad against the Cavaliers in regulation in program history. Furthermore, the Irish handed Virginia its biggest loss to an ACC opponent since 2017 (65-41 loss to No. 10 UNC on Feb. 18, 2017).

J.R. Konieczny posted 17 points and eight rebounds, shooting 6-of-8 including a 4-for-5 mark from three. Konieczny made his first six shots from the field and scored all his points in the first half. Then there was Markus Burton, who earned 15 points on 6-of-10 shooting, plus a career high eight assists. Burton is the first player to dish out 8 assists against Virginia since Virginia Tech's Justyn Mutts on Feb. 4, 2023.

LEGENDS CLASSIC TAKEAWAYS

A couple of Irish standouts from two games in Brooklyn during the Legends Classic. First, let's look at All-Tournament Team selection Markus Burton. The freshman took over the end of the Oklahoma State game scoring 16 of his team-high 20 points in the second half plus overtime (10 in 2H + 6 in OT). He averaged 16.0 points over the two games.

Next, it was a breakout week for Konieczny, as he produced back-to-back double-doubles, averaging 14.5 points and 10.5 rebounds. He also earned his first career start in the win over Oklahoma State (11/17). J.R. entered the Legends Classic week with 15 points and 3

rebounds to his name thru 8 career ND games. Then over those 2 games, he produced a total of 29 points and 21 rebounds. J.R. constantly attacked the offensive glass, grabbing 8 O-Boards over the 2 games.

Last but not least, there was Tae Davis who averaged 10.0 points on 57.1 percent shooting (8-14 FG), along with 5.0 rebounds per game. Davis recorded a career high 13 points against the Auburn Tigers.

HISTORIC DEBUT FOR BURTON

Not only did freshman point guard Markus Burton ball out in a historic debut in the season opener, but he got to do it in front of his hometown crowd and family. Burton poured in 29 points to lift the Irish to a 70-63 win over Niagara, marking the most points in program history in a freshman debut. The previous record was 27 points from Laphonso Ellis back in 1988. Now a few other notes on Burton's performance.

- 1-of-5 freshmen in the history of the program to score 29 points or more, joining David Graves, Troy Murphy, Chris Thomas and Adrian Dantley.
- Burton absolutely took over the end of the game. From 8:38-2:20 in the second half, Burton recorded 16 points on 6-for-6 shooting.

FRESHMAN FOUNDATION

A little over a month into the job, Coach Shrewsberry had himself a top-30 ranked incoming freshmen class – Carey Booth, Logan Imes and Braeden Shrewsberry - all flipped from their Penn State commits. Then add in Mr. Indiana Basketball Markus Burton, who kept his commitment to Notre Dame. That brought the 2023 class to four signees which ranked 23rd in the country according to 247Sports.com.

Furthermore, cementing the bond amongst the freshmen class, there was an Indiana connection amongst most of them:

-- Imes and Shrewsberry played together throughout all four of their high school years with the Indiana Elite.

-- Imes and Burton were teammates on the 2023 Indiana All-Stars squad

CLEAN SLATE

Notre Dame only returns 35 points from a season ago, which equates to 1.6% of scoring returning. The table on the bottom page 11 displays the Division I schools returning the least amount of points ahead of the 2023-24 season.

MR INDIANA BASKETBALL

On April 20, 2023, now freshman point guard Markus Burton, was named Mr. Indiana Basketball. It marked the third time in program history in which a future Notre Dame player took home the honor. The two former winners were Chris Thomas in 2001 and Luke Zeller in 2005.

Burton averaged a state-best 30.3 points per game, along with 5.7 rebounds, 5.1 assists and 3.6 steals. Burton also secured the school single season scoring record by pouring in 909 points as a senior.

THE FOUNDATION GROWS

Coach Shrewsberry continued to build the foundation of Irish hoops by announcing three Class of 2024 signees. Cole Certa, Sir Muhammed and Garrett Sundra all signed their National Letters of Intent and officially became Irish on Nov. 6.

Shrewsberry, who started this current season with a talented four-member freshman class that was ranked in the top-30, has now built upon that with a 2024 class that is ranked as high as No. 19 by 247Sports. The trio of Cole Certa (6-5 guard from Le Roy, Illinois), Sir Muhammed (6-6 guard from Charlotte, North Carolina) and Garrett Sundra (6-11 forward from Ashburn, Virginia) also rank as the fifth best class in the ACC by 247Sports.

"We are thrilled to welcome three tremendous young men into the Notre Dame family. I am very proud of the job we were able to do on the recruiting trail in this class by landing Cole Certa, Sir Muhammed and Garrett Sundra. When we got the job here, we put a premium on bringing in players who fit our team on the court as well

as off the court. All three of these young men are not only tremendous basketball players, as evidenced by the fact that this is ranked as one of the top recruiting classes not only in the ACC, but in the country as well, but they are also excellent students who fit the mission and the culture of Notre Dame."

HOMETOWN HOMAGE FEATURE

There had been the youth camps at Notre Dame, myriad Fighting Irish men's basketball games and a blossoming relationship with Demetrius Jackson – a name synonymous with Irish hoops success a decade ago.

And, then, there had been the fandom of another national college basketball power – about the only time the local kid from La Porte, Indiana, had found his way inside Purcell Pavilion for Notre Dame basketball.

Today, freshman point guard Markus Burton and redshirt-sophomore J.R. Konieczny are homegrown products at the foundational stage of first-year Notre Dame Glenn & Stacey Murphy head coach Micah Shrewsberry's program rebuild.

Though different in their paths to play beneath the fabled Golden Dome, both Burton and Konieczny embrace this moment to help reassert Irish basketball and fashion an example for area youth who may also foster dreams of wearing Irish green.

"It was sort of unreal for me, because I liked Notre Dame a lot, and it was basically a dream school for me, my hometown and a no-brainer," said Burton, who capped his record-shattering prep career at Penn High School with the coveted Indiana Mr. Basketball award – just the third Irish signee all-time to procure the accolade. "Blake Wesley and J.R. Konieczny, I was a really big fan of theirs too."

Initially, the rangy, 6-foot-7 Konieczny – a second-team Indiana All-State selection who had finished fifth in Mr. Basketball balloting in 2021 – had not envisioned a gilded path to Notre Dame.

"It just all felt super surreal," Konieczny, who sat out the 2022-23 season to hone his all-around game and ensure his overall health, said. "The whole recruitment process was super stressful for me, and then when

I committed to Notre Dame, it was a huge weight off my shoulders. I had never really expected myself to be at Notre Dame, but then the stars aligned."

As Burton transitions through the early months of his collegiate career and Konieczny begins in earnest the hardwood portion of his Notre Dame journey, they are mindful of this moment together – in their own career arcs and in a historic dawn of a new era of Irish basketball under Shrewsberry, also a Hoosier State native with basketball bona fides spanning the NCAA to the NBA.

"We talk about it a lot, but I mean right now, we kind of just have fun with it," said Burton of his conversations with Konieczny about the chance to be a hometown beacon of Notre Dame basketball. "We talk about how blessed we are to be able to go to Notre Dame and play basketball here, to have this opportunity.

"It's really fun. Coach Shrewsberry is a really good coach, loves his players and teaches us what need to do. A lot of us adapted really well, and I feel like once we get playing and people see how hard we play, we're going to show people how hard we work and take pride in everyday practice. It's going to be really fun."

A new era of Notre Dame basketball; a foundation formed in its community.

"We always have a good sense of what it means to rep the city and the area and rep Notre Dame and our hometown," Konieczny said. "We've been doing it for quite some years,; Markus being Mr. Basketball, had a great high school career that let people know who he was. I think it means a lot to both of us. We're going to do everything we can to win and see Notre Dame fans happy and South Bend fans happy and just everyone in this community.

"We're going to work our butts off no matter what's going on; every guy on our team has that dog in him. And I think that really stands to what we're trying to do."

1st Season at Notre Dame
3rd as a Head Coach at DI Level

An Indiana native has come home to kick start a new era of Notre Dame men's basketball. Vice President and James E. Rohr Notre Dame Director of Athletics Jack Swarbrick announced Micah Shrewsberry as the 18th head coach in Fighting Irish men's basketball history on March 23, 2023.

"We are so excited to have Coach (Shrewsberry) join the Notre Dame family," Swarbrick said. "Throughout this process, it reaffirmed for me that this job was among the best in the country as we had many great candidates express interest."

"During our two month process, we weekly reviewed our candidate pool and each week he (Micah) stayed at the top of our list due to his fit at the University and his commitment to the student-athlete experience. Not only do his personal & family values align with the University, but his dedication to the development of each member of his program as well."

Shrewsberry is fresh off a historic turnaround as the head coach at Penn State. After a 14-17 first season, Shrewsberry produced a 23-14 mark in 2022-23, just the 12th 20-win season in the 127-year history of Penn State basketball. Furthermore, he collected more Big Ten wins (17) in his first two seasons than any other Penn State head coach.

Shrewsberry brings a wealth of experience and success to the helm of the Notre Dame program. All-in-all he's coached in six NCAA Tournaments, two NCAA Final Fours, five NBA Playoffs and two NBA Conference Finals – in addition to coaching all-NBA honorees Jayson Tatum and Jaylen Brown.

"I'm very excited to be joining the University of Notre Dame family," Shrewsberry said. "The combination of top notch academics, plus a long storied history of success on the basketball court, made this a very attractive job for me. The power of the Notre Dame brand, and the passionate alumni family, will allow us to recruit the brightest student-athletes from coast to coast. I can't wait to get to campus and begin connecting with the students, faculty and staff which make this place special."

Shrewsberry and Penn State captured the nation's attention in late February and into March, going 9-3 over their last 12 games, which included six Quad 1 wins. Shrewsberry then made plenty of noise in the 2023 Big Ten Tournament in Chicago, defeating No. 7 Illinois, No. 2 Northwestern and No. 3 Indiana to reach the championship game as the No. 10 seed.

It marked the program's second-ever Big Ten title game appearance. Penn State was just the third double-digit seed to reach the Big Ten Tournament championship game and the first since 2008.

The Nittany Lions then made their first appearance in the NCAA Tournament since 2011. In the first round, Shrewsberry and the Nittany Lions knocked off No. 7 seed and SEC Tournament runner-up Texas A&M, winning the program's first NCAA Tournament game since 2001.

In year one at Penn State, Shrewsberry engineered the Big Ten's best scoring defense and guided the squad to their best defensive season (65.0 points allowed per game) in 11 years. The Nittany Lions advanced to the quarterfinal round of the Big Ten Tournament after winning two postseason games, making Shrewsberry one of just two first-year Big Ten coaches since 2008 to win two Big Ten Tournament games.

Recruiting-wise, Shrewsberry made an instant splash in Happy Valley. In his first year, Shrewsberry signed the highest-ranked recruiting class in program history, a consensus top-30 class. A year later, he signed his second-straight top-30 recruiting class, marking the first time in program history that the Nittany Lions had signed back-to-back top-30 recruiting classes.

Statistically speaking, the 2022-23 squad set the B1G and Penn State single-season team record for three-pointers made in a season with 385. The Nittany Lions compiled a total of five top-15 national

statistical rankings. In addition, Shrewsberry tutored an Associated Press All-American in Jalen Pickett and a total of three All-Big Ten players during the 2022-23 season.

Prior to his time with Penn State, Shrewsberry experienced two separate stints at Purdue – one as assistant coach from 2011-13 and another as associate head coach from 2019-21. Highlights include the 2020-21 season, in which Shrewsberry helped lead the Boilermakers to a 13-6 fourth-place finish in the Big Ten and an 18-10 overall mark, culminating in an NCAA Tournament at-large bid. Trevion Williams claimed first-team All-Big Ten honors, while Zach Edey and Jaden Ivey were All-Freshman Team selections. Shrewsberry played a major role in recruiting Ivey, who grew up in South Bend and is the son of Karen and Kevin Keyes Family Head Women's Basketball Coach Niele Ivey.

Another highlight from his time in West Lafayette includes the 2011-12 squad that produced a 22-13 record and reached the second round of the NCAA Tournament. Under Shrewsberry, Terone Johnson was one of the most improved players in the B1G, netting accolades from conference and national entities.

In-between his Purdue stints, Shrewsberry spent six seasons (2013-19) with the NBA's Boston Celtics as an assistant coach under Brad Stevens. During his tenure, the Celtics reached the playoffs in five consecutive seasons, including back-to-back appearances in the Eastern Conference Finals in 2017 and 2018.

Shrewsberry played a key role in the development of current NBA stars Brown and Tatum, who were the No. 3 picks in the 2016 and 2017 NBA Drafts, respectively. Tatum was an NBA All-Rookie Team first-team selection, while Brown earned second-team All-Rookie honors.

The Brad Stevens connection was previously made at Butler University, where Shrewsberry spent one year as the director of operations then three as an assistant coach. With Shrewsberry on the sidelines, the Bulldogs compiled an 87-21 record, won two Horizon League regular-season championships and two Horizon League Tournament titles and made three NCAA Tournament appearances – which included back-to-back runs to the national championship game in 2010 and 2011.

Also at Butler, he aided in the development of Gordon Hayward, who was the 2009 Horizon League Newcomer of the Year, the 2010 Horizon League Player of the Year and a 2010 Final Four All-Tournament Team selection. Hayward was the ninth overall pick in the 2010 NBA Draft by the Utah Jazz.

Continuing on Shrewsberry's basketball journey, he spent time as the director of basketball operations at Marshall University (2003-05) and an assistant coach at DePauw University (2001-03) and Wabash College (2000-01). At DePauw, Shrewsberry led the Tigers to a 42-12 record with a pair of conference championships.

Shrewsberry was also the first men's basketball head coach at Indiana University South Bend. Shrewsberry started his coaching career as a graduate assistant at the University of Indianapolis in 1999-2000.

An Indianapolis area native, Shrewsberry earned his bachelor's degree from Hanover College in 1999 and a master's degree from Indiana State in 2003. As a player at Hanover, Shrewsberry was a three-year starting guard and team tri-captain.

He and his wife, Molly, have four children, Braeden, Nicholas, Caitlin and Grace.

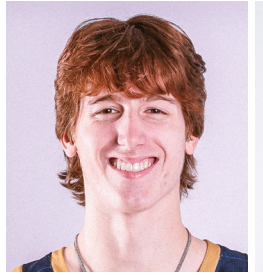
