» THE OPENING TIP

- Duke tips off the week with another ACC test, playing host to No. 16 Notre Dame on Monday, February 19 at 7 p.m., in the Blue Devils' annual Pink Game. The action is set to air live on ESPN2 with Beth Mowins and Stephanie White on the call.
- The Blue Devils are amid another daunting stretch of games to close out the regular season slate, with three of their final five games coming against Top-25 teams -- Notre Dame (#16), Syracuse (#19) and NC State (#6). Duke and Notre Dame meet for the 22nd time on Monday. The Fighting Irish hold a 17-4 lead all-time but Duke has won three straight in the series, including a thrilling, 57-52, road victory last season in South Bend (2.5.23).
- The Blue Devils are looking to bounce back from Thursday's hard-fought setback at Virginia Tech. Duke is 5-2 this season when coming off a loss.
- Duke has taken on one of the nation's toughest schedules this season as the Blue Devils' SOS checks in at No. 8 nationally (NCAA rankings as of Feb. 16). The Blue Devils are also in the top 25 of the NCAA NET, ranking No. 21 in that metric.
- The Blue Devils rank third nationally in blocks per game with an average of 6.4 rejections -- first in the ACC (NCAA rankings as of Feb. 16). Graduate student **Camilla Emso**, senior **Kennedy Brown** and rookie **Jadyn Donovan** have all posted 30-plus blocks each, leading the way with 36, 33 and 30 rejections, respectively.
- In addition to leading the league in rejections, the Blue Devils also rank among the top five in the ACC in nine additional categories.
- On the defensive end, Duke sits atop the ACC in rebounding defense (31.5) and scoring defense (57.8).
- The squad also ranks second in defensive points per possession (0.723), field goal percentage defense (.356) and rebounding margin -- a +5.9 advantage, and fifth in defensive rebounding percentage (.705) scoring margin (+8.4).
- Offensively, the Blue Devils rank second in field goal percentage (.449) and fourth in offensive rebounding percentage (.350).
- Three Blue Devils average double figures in scoring -- **Reigan Richardson** (11.2), **Oluchi Okananwa** (10.8), **Taina Mair** (10.5).
- The Blue Devils have assists on more than 50 percent of their field goals (.549) with 350 dimes on 638 made buckets. Mair leads the team with 3.5 per contest.
- 23 of Duke's 24 opponents have been held below their respective season scoring averages. Virginia Tech's 61 points were 16.3 points below its average of 77.3.
- As a team Notre Dame ranks among the top-15 nationally in scoring offense (11th), scoring margin (12th) and steals per game (12th).
- In the individual NCAA rankings, Hidalgo is slotted among the top 10 in eight different categories -- steals/steals per game (1st), total points/points per game (3rd), triple doubles (6th), field goals/field goal attempts (7th) and free throw attempts (9th).

HITTIN' FROM DISTANCE

- Duke has knocked down 143 threes this season - an average of 6.0 per game. The Blue Devils are cashing in their triples at a .336 percent clip and have made at least five threes in 14 games, including 10 contests with seven or more.
- Five Blue Devils have cashed in double-digit trifectas -- **Ashlon Jackson** (36), **Taina Mair** (29), **Oluchi Okananwa** (25), **Reigan Richardson** (21), **Emma Koabel** (20).
- Earlier this season Duke set a single-game record for most threes in a game, knocking down 14 against Coastal Carolina.
- Duke shot a season-best 59.1 percent from distance in the victory over Georgia Tech (1.14-24) draining 13 of 22 attempts. It marked the first time since Jan. 15, 2005, against Boston College, Duke knocked down 13 or more triples in an ACC game.
- If the 2023-24 campaign ended today, Duke's 6.0 triples per game would rank fourth on the Duke single season charts for average three-pointers made. Duke averaged 7.25 in 2020-21, but only played four games.

SUPERLATIVE SPOTLIGHT

- Duke's reserves are providing a spark for the Blue Devils, boasting an average of 24.3 points per game. The Blue Devils have scored more bench points than their foes in 21 games, totaling 583 points while opponents have put up just 262. In 14 games, the Blue Devils have finished with at least a 10-point margin in bench production.
- Duke has had strong production on the offensive glass this season, tallying 12.3 offensive rebounds per game. The Blue Devils have held the advantage on the offensive boards in 15 games and parlayed the extra possessions into 280 total second-chance points.
- On the fastbreak, the Blue Devils hold a 281-141 edge and have limited 18 opponents to fewer than eight points in transition. Duke held Virginia Tech to zero fastbreak points through two games against the Hokies, going 1-1 in those contests.
- Duke has commanded the inside this season, outscoring its foes 786-542. The Blue Devils own a plus-10 margin in the paint, 32.8 to 22.6, and have finished with double-digit margins in 14 contests.

SHARING THE WEALTH

- Duke has seen a balanced attack on offense with three players averaging double figures.
- Junior **Reigan Richardson** (11.2) leads the charge and is joined in double figures by freshman **Oluchi Okananwa** (10.8) and sophomore **Taina Mair** (10.5).
- The Blue Devils have assists on more than 50 percent of their field goals (.549) with 350 dimes on 638 made buckets. Mair leads the team with 3.5 per contest.
- Duke has had six different leading scorers this season led by Mair and Richardson with six. Okananwa follows with five, sophomore **Ashlon Jackson** next in line having posted the team-high on four occasions. Senior **Kennedy Brown** has led the Blue Devils in scoring twice while freshman **Delaney Thomas** rounds out the quintet with one game as the leading scorer.

THE SERIES / SCOUTING THE FIGHTING IRISH

- Duke and Notre Dame will meet for the 22nd time on Monday.
- The Fighting Irish hold a 17-4 lead all-time but Duke has won three straight in the series, including a hard fought, 57-52, road victory last season in South Bend (2.5.23).
- Ranked 16th nationally and checking in at No. 14 in the NET rankings, Notre Dame enters Monday's game at 18-6 overall and 8-5 in ACC action.
- Freshman Hannah Hidalgo spearheads the offensive charge for Notre Dame as she leads the squad in scoring (24.5) and assists (5-4). She is joined in double figures by Sonia Cotton (16.2) and Maddy Westbed (13.9) -- the latter also pacing the Fighting Irish on the glass with 9.3 caroms per game.
- As a team Notre Dame ranks among the top-15 nationally in scoring offense (11th), scoring margin (12th) and steals per game (12th).
- In the individual NCAA rankings, Hidalgo is slotted among the top 10 in eight different categories -- steals/steals per game (1st), total points/points per game (3rd), triple doubles (6th), field goals/field goal attempts (7th) and free throw attempts (9th).

BLUE DEVILS SIGN FOUR TO 2024 CLASS

- Duke women's basketball unveiled its 2024 freshman class as the Blue Devils announced the signings of **Louann Battiston**, **Jenessa Cotton**, **Toby Fournier** and **Arianna Roberson** during the NCAA's early signing period.
- Battiston will enroll at Duke early and join the Blue Devils in January of 2024 to be on campus with the team. The trio of Cotton, Fournier and Roberson are slated to step foot in Durham later in 2024.
- The class, which checks in at No. 5 nationally per espnW, is Lawson's second top-10 class in as many seasons, after inking the sixth-ranked group in 2022. Her first recruiting haul - the 2021 class - checked in just outside the top 10 at No. 11.
- The Blue Devils landed a top-10 prospect for the second consecutive year and their seventh top-30 prospect in the past three.
- According to the espnW recruiting rankings, only one team in women's college basketball has signed more players ranked in the top 30 over the last three seasons than Duke.
- South Carolina holds a slight edge over the Blue Devils, having signed eight top-30 prospects to the Blue Devils' seven during this stretch. UConn and UCLA are right behind with six apiece.

52ND SEASON OF DUKE WOMEN'S BASKETBALL

- The 2023-24 season signifies the 52nd season of Duke women's basketball.
- Duke has compiled a 1,021-472 all-time record (.684).
- Over the history of the program, Duke has captured 12 ACC regular season crowns and eight conference tournament titles, made 25 NCAA Tournament appearances and played in four Final Fours (1999, '02, '03, '06), including two appearances in the national final (1999, '06).

LAWSON ENTERS YEAR FOUR

- Head coach **Kara Lawson** enters her fourth season at the helm of the Duke women's basketball program and owns an overall career record of 62-29.
- In her third year, Lawson led the Blue Devils to one of their most successful seasons in recent history, as the squad finished the year with a 26-7 overall record, a 14-4 mark in ACC play, a 14-2 record at Cameron Indoor Stadium and an appearance in the second round of the NCAA Tournament.
- The Blue Devils featured one of the nation's most elite defenses last season, ending the campaign ranked second in scoring defense, ninth in field goal percentage defense and 10th in blocks. Duke held each of its opponents below its season scoring average, including 17 to 50 points or less.
- Since arriving in Durham, Lawson has also helped the Blue Devils return to relevance on the recruiting trail, signing a trio of top-15 classes (2022 - No. 11 | 2023 - No. 6 | 2024 - No. 5).

JD EARNING PRESEASON BUZZ

- Freshman **Jadyn Donovan** received some preseason buzz heading into the 2023-24 slate as she enters her first season at Duke as the Blue Devils' most highly touted rookie in nearly a decade -- checking in at No. 3 in the 2023 Class.
- She was most recently tabbed to ESPN's list of the top impact freshmen in women's college basketball this season and was also named to the 2023 ACC Preseason Newcomer Watch List.
- A 2023 McDonald's and BallisLife All-American, Donovan was tabbed the Gatorade District of Columbia Girls Basketball Player of the Year after leading Sidwell Friends to a 28-3 overall record and the team's second straight DCSAA Girls AA State Championship. Slotted No. 3 in the 2023 Class rankings, Donovan led Sidwell Friends in scoring (14.8) and rebounds (8.2), ranked second in blocks (1.1) and field goal percentage (50.0 percent) as well as third in both assists (3.2) and steals (2.1) per game.

- » Duke added six newcomers to the roster ahead of the season - a pair of impact transfers and four freshmen.
- » The transfers include graduate student **Camilla Emsbo** (Yale) along with sophomore **Taina Mair** (Boston College).
- » Duke's freshman class features **Jadyn Donovan** (Upper Marlboro, Md.), **Oluchi Okanawa** (Boston, Mass.), **Delaney Thomas** (Charles Town, W.Va.) and **Jordan Wood** (Chicago, Ill.)
- » Duke returned five letterwinners and two starters from the 2022-23 roster, including key contributors **Reigan Richardson**, **Kennedy Brown** and **Ashlon Jackson**.

THE FRESHMAN FOUR

- » Head coach **Kara Lawson** signed four players to the Blue Devils' 2023 freshman class welcoming **Jadyn Donovan**, **Oluchi Okanawa**, **Delaney Thomas** and **Jordan Wood**.
- » The 2023 class marked Duke's first recruiting haul since 2015 with a player ranked in the top-five nationally by ESPN and the first group since the 2014 class with at least three prospects ranked in the ESPN top 30.
- » Donovan, a five-star wing ranked No. 3 in the 2023 Class by ESPN, is Duke's highest-rated signee since the 2015 class. She was the No. 1 overall ranked Maryland prospect in the class of 2023, according to PrepGirlsHoops.
- » Okanawa is a physical, four-star combo guard ranked in the top 30 of the 2023 class. The top-ranked player in New England according to the PrepGirlsHoops 2023 rankings, Okanawa enjoyed sensational spring and summer 2022 sessions that saw her skyrocket from unranked to the 27th-ranked player overall.
- » A versatile, agile post that brings great court size, defensive prowess and shot blocking ability, Thomas was a four-star forward who checked in at No. 29 in the 2023 ESPN rankings and was the second-highest ranked Maryland prospect according to PrepGirlsHoops.
- » Wood, ranked No. 62 in the ESPN 2023 Class Rankings, was a four-time All-East Suburban Catholic Conference Selection and four-star forward who brings great size, versatility and length to both sides of the ball. She brings face-up scoring, a lethal midrange game and a strong passing skillset to the front court.

BROWN TABBED TO 2024 LISA LESLIE AWARD PRESEASON WATCH LIST

- » Senior **Kennedy Brown** was tabbed to the 20-player preseason watchlist for the 2024 Lisa Leslie Award, the Naismith Memorial Basketball Hall of Fame and the Women's Basketball Coaches Association (WBCA) announced.
- » Named after the three-time All-American, 1994 National Player of the Year and Class of 2015 Hall of Famer, the annual award in its sixth year recognizes the top centers in women's NCAA Division I college basketball. A national committee of top college basketball personnel determined the watch list of 20 candidates.
- » Brown enters her second season with the Blue Devils in 2023-24. The Derby, Kan., product started all 33 games for Duke during the 2022-23 campaign, registering eight double-figure scoring outings, 16 contests with five or more rebounds - including a pair of double-digit rebounding efforts - and posted a career-best five blocks on two separate occasions.

DISRUPTING THE PEACE: A LOOK BACK AT THE 2022-23 BLUE DEVIL DEFENSE

- » Disruptive defense was the calling card for the Blue Devils during the 2022-23 season as the team featured one of the nation's most elite defenses over the course of the year.
- » Duke ended the season ranked second in scoring defense, ninth in field goal percentage defense and 10th in blocks. The Blue Devils also held each of their opponents below its season scoring average, including 17 to 50 points or less.
- » Duke tied for fourth in Defensive Rating, allowing its opponents just 0.671 points per possession.
- » In the NCAA Tournament first round win over Iona, Duke limited the Gaels to just 14 total rebounds - tied for the fewest by a Duke opponent all-time. Iona's three offensive boards also tied for second fewest by a Blue Devil foe in program lore.
- » Duke held its opponents to single digits in seven straight quarters, spanning from the 4th quarter at Notre Dame (Feb. 5) through the first half against Miami (Feb. 12).

LAWSON ADDS MIDDLETON, MILLER TO COACHING STAFF

- » Head coach **Kara Lawson** announced two additions to the Duke women's basketball coaching staff during the offseason -- **Karen Middleton** and **Pierre Miller**.
- » Middleton, a 30-year coaching veteran with 13 years of head coaching experience, comes to Duke after serving as head coach of the UW-La Crosse women's basketball team from 2016-2023. During her seven-year tenure with the Eagles, Middleton compiled a 111-58 record (.657), coached 18 players to All-WIAC honors while leading the squad to an at-large bid to the 2020 NCAA Division III Tournament.
- » In addition to UW-La Crosse, Middleton's previous stops include Cal State Fullerton (2015-16), Western Carolina (2009-15), Illinois (2007-09), Stanford (1997-2007), Eastern Washington (1994-97) and South Carolina (1991-92).
- » A decorated player for South Carolina, Middleton played for the Gamecocks from 1987-1991, amassing 1,714 career points - currently No. 9 in school history - while setting the single-season (115) and career (317) school records for three-point field goals made. She was also a team captain, team MVP and two-time All-Metro Conference selection.
- » Miller joins the Blue Devil family after serving as an assistant coach at Louisiana Tech during the 2022-23 season. In his lone year with the Lady Techsters, Miller helped guide the team to 19 wins, 12 in Conference USA, and an at-large selection to the WNIT. The 12 conference wins marked the most for the program since 2016.
- » Additionally, Miller worked on the defensive side of the ball and helped guide the LA Tech defense, which ranked No. 2 in C-USA in points per game (61.2) and opponent field goal percentage (.387), while checking in third in opponent three-point percentage (.298).
- » Prior to La Tech, Miller served a six-year stint on staff with Campbell women's basketball, working as an assistant coach for five seasons before being promoted to associate head coach ahead of the 2021-22 campaign.
- » During his time with the Camels, Miller helped the team compile a 119-61 record (.661), a pair of Big South regular season titles (2019-20, 2021-22) and postseason appearances in the WBI (2018-19) and WNIT (2021-22).
- » Before Campbell, Miller spent three seasons (2013-2016) as an assistant coach for his alma mater, Presbyterian. During his time with the Blue Hose, Miller helped mentor four all-conference selections, including 2015 Big South Freshman of the Year **Desean Murray**.
- » Miller was a standout guard for the Blue Hose from 2007-2012. He finished his career just shy of 1,000 points and over 300 assists. He owned numerous records in the Presbyterian Division I record book at the time of his graduation, including program-bests in assists (328) and games played (119), while ranking third with 207 made three-pointers.

PRESEASON POLLIN'

- » The preseason ACC poll along with All-ACC teams were released in mid October. Duke was tabbed No. 7 by the Blue Ribbon Panel comprised of the ACC's 15 head coaches and a select voting panel. Duke also checked in at No. 19 in the USA Today Preseason Coaches Poll.

VANESSA DE JESUS TO MISS 2023-24 SEASON WITH INJURY

- » Senior guard **Vanessa de Jesus** will miss the upcoming 2023-24 season after sustaining a knee injury in late July.
- » Through three seasons at Duke, de Jesus has appeared in 66 games with 18 starts for the Blue Devils, averaging 5.1 points and 2.0 assists per contest.
- » She has scored in double figures eight times during her Duke tenure with four of those coming during the 2022-23 campaign, including tying a career-high with 17 points in a 100-49 victory at Richmond.

HEAD COACH KARA LAWSON



BIO SNAPSHOT

Former WNBA and Olympic Champion Kara Lawson was named Duke University's sixth head women's basketball coach on July 11, 2020. Lawson enters her fourth year at the helm in 2023-24.

Lawson brought her decorated basketball career, both on and off the court, to the Blue Devils after spending the 2020 season as an assistant coach with the Boston Celtics. She helped Boston to a 43-21 record and a third-place standing in the Eastern Conference prior to the stoppage of the 2019-20 NBA season due to COVID-19. Lawson was the Celtics' first female coach in the franchise's 73-year history.

Lawson helped Team USA make history in the summer of 2021 as she guided the United States 3x3 Women's National Team to a gold medal in its Olympic debut in Tokyo. It marked her 10th overall gold medal in USA Basketball competition and seventh as a coach. Lawson is one of only three women in Olympic history to win gold as both a player and head coach in basketball, joining Anne Donovan and Dawn Staley.

Her impact on the women's basketball community is evident as she was named one of the 100 most influential people in women's college basketball, as announced by Silver Waves Media in the summer of 2020. Lawson is also a founding board member for the Boston Celtics United for Social Justice.

Following an exceptional playing career, Lawson spent two years as the primary television analyst for the Washington Wizards while also broadcasting games for ESPN Radio. In addition to her role covering the Wizards for NBC Sports Washington, Lawson served as a game and studio analyst for men's and women's college basketball and the NBA for ESPN. On January 12, 2007, she became the first female analyst for a nationally-televised NBA game. Lawson also served as a color announcer during the 2021 Olympics in Tokyo with NBC.
