TUESDAY'S TABLE SETTER

Glenn & Stacey Murphy Notre Dame head coach Micah Shrewsberry said back in the preseason that he planned for his team to be playing their best basketball come March. The Irish have now emerged on the other side of adversity and have won five of their last six. Last week at home, the Irish might have popped Wake Forest's NCAA bubble with a 70-65 victory, then followed that up with a 69-62 win over NCAA Tournament bound Clemson. Up next, the current ACC measuring stick: first-place North Carolina who is 15-3 in league play and 23-6 overall. That match will tip off at 7 p.m. ET on ACC Network.

Coach Shrewsberry is looking to earn his first top-10 ranked victory as a head coach with UNC entering at No. 7 in both polls. If successful, it would mark Notre Dame's first top-10 win since No. 10 Kentucky on Dec. 11, 2021. It would be the first true road top-10 win since knocking off No. 9/6 Duke on Jan. 16, 2016.

Tuesday night will feature the league's No. 1 offense in UNC vs. the league's No. 2 defense in Notre Dame. The Tar Heels are averaging 81.4 ppg, which ranks 28th in the country. The Irish are allowing just 65.4 ppg, which ranks 22nd in the country. The Irish will also have to deal with North Carolina's rebounding ability, as their 40.9 rpg ranks 8th in the nation.

The Irish defense will have to slow down RJ Davis, as his 21.4 ppg leads the ACC and ranks 10th in the country. Then there's Armando Bacot and his 14 double-doubles on the year. And of course, a familiar face in ND transfer Cormac Ryan.

Notre Dame is just 1-8 all-time in Chapel Hill, with the lone victory happening back on Jan. 5, 2015.

ND'S 5-1 SURGE

From Feb. 1 to March 1, Notre Dame was the biggest mover in kenpom AdjEM across the Power-Five conferences. The full chart can be seen below.

Another fun stat: when the first NET rankings came on Dec. 4, the Irish were 238. After beating Clemson on March 2, the Irish are up to 125.

The culture has set in and the guys don't want the season to end. Notre Dame is playing its best basketball of the season and that includes freshman sensation Markus Burton. During Notre Dame's 5-1 surge, Burton is averaging 21.7 ppg. He's followed by Braeden Shrewsberry's 12.5 ppg and Tae Davis' 10.8. Burton has also recorded 31 assists, 20 steals and 22 rebounds during this six-game swing.

During this stretch Notre Dame's offense is averaging 71.3 ppg compared to its season average of 63.6. They are shooting 43.6 percent compared to the season's 40.6 percent. Another big difference is the fact that the Irish are taking better care of the basketball, averaging just 8.5 turnovers compared to the season's 12.7.

BURTON LEAVING A FRESHMAN YEAR LEGACY

Freshman guard Markus Burton is grabbing the attention of Irish fans, ACC opponents and the national media, but what's crazy about it all is that he's doing something that has never been done before in the history of the program.

Burton is currently averaging over 17.0 points, 4.0 assists and 2.0 steals. If that stat line holds up upon the season's end, he'll be the first player to put up those numbers in Notre Dame history (aka at least 17 points, 4 assists and 2 steals). ND great Chris Thomas would be the closest one to that with his 15.6 points, 7.6 assists and 2.2 steals for the 2001-02 season.

Burton is the only rookie in the country and just 1-of-2 Power-Five players overall (other being Syracuse's Judah Mintz) averaging at least 17p-4a-2s. In fact, Burton and Mitz are just 2 of 4 total ACC players to produce that stat line since 1996 (Duke's Jason Williams & Maryland's Steve Francis).

BURTON SURGING

Burton has produced an incredible 80 points over the last three games. That's a 26.7 ppg on 52.9 percent shooting, plus a 20-24 from the free-throw line. He's also totaled 15 assists, 6 steals and 12 rebounds. Burton and Mississippi State's Josh Hubbard are the only 2 freshmen in the country to record at least 80 points in a three-game swing this season.

Last game vs. Clemson - Burton dropped 17 points in the first half before finishing with 21.

Vs. Wake Forest on Feb. 27 - poured in a career high 31 points, which included 19 in the first half. He converted a career best 11-for-11 from the free throw line. He also tallied three rebounds, three assists and four steals. Burton became 1-of-4 ND freshman all-time to record a 30-point game, joining the likes of Troy Murphy, Chris Thomas and Adrian Dantley.

At Syracuse on Feb. 24 - dropped 28 points which included 20 points in the 2nd half.

ACC ROOKIE OF THE YEAR?

Notre Dame has never taken home an ACC Rookie of the Year award and Markus Burton is looking to change that. He has proven himself to be one of the most dynamic freshman guards not just in the ACC, but in the entire country. Here are some quick hiiters for those who haven't been paying attention:

- His 17.3 ppg leads all ACC freshmen, with the next highest being Pitt's Carlton Carrington at 13.4. He also ranks 4th nationally amongst DI freshmen.
- ACC freshman rankings: 1st in scoring, 2nd in assists/game (4.3), 1st in steals/game (2.0).
- Double-digit points in all but 2 games. He's currently riding a 22-game streak.
- He's scored at least 16 points in 9 straight games. At least 20 points in 3 straight.
- ACC play only rankings: 17.6 points (5th), 2.3 steals (1st), 4.8 assists (3rd), .814 FT% (11th).

- Overall rankings: 7th in the ACC in scoring, 5th in Assists (4.3), 4th in Steals (2.0), 11th in FT% (.814).
- Only rookie in the country and 1-of-2 P5 players averaging at least 17 points, 4 assists and 2 steals.
- Produced two games with 15+ point, 5+ assists, 5+ steals. Since 1996, only one other Irish player (Chris Thomas) had produced two games in the same regular season with at least 15 points, 5 assists and 5 steals.
- Burton is 1-of-3 Power Five players this season with multiple 15p-5a-5s games.
- Averaging 8.9 points in the 2nd half - has scored double-digit points 12 times in the 2nd half alone this season, including a season high of 20.
- Averaging 18.1 points at home, shooting 44.5 percent from the field.
- 58 steals (1 away from cracking the program top-10 for a season); 2.0 spg -- would become just the 4th player in program history to average 2 spg in a season (Chris Thomas, David Rivers, Jerian Grant).
- Four-time ACC Rookie of the Week - set a new ND record.

1ST YEAR STAMP ON THE PROGRAM - DEFENSE

The year one Coach Shrewsbury stamp on the program has been the defensive intensity. 18 ACC games and 13 different ACC opponents - all but one (Syracuse on Feb. 24) were held under their season average, with Miami, Duke and Louisville each held to season low point totals.

Of the 18 ACC matchups that have already happened, only 4 opponents have reached the 70-point park against the Irish defense.

Notre Dame's scoring defense of 65.4 ranks 22nd in the country, plus 2nd in the ACC. According to KenPom, Notre Dame's defensive efficiency ranks 25th nationally.

In ACC play only, Notre Dame ranks 2nd in scoring defense (64.5) and 2nd in field goal percentage defense (.413).

Lastly, how does this year's defense match up historically? According to Stats Inc which goes back to the 1996-97 season, ND's 65.4 ranks 4th.

BURTON WINS 4TH ACC ROOKIE OF THE WEEK

Burton has now set a new program record with four ACC Rookie of the Week awards, topping the previous record holder in Blake Wesley. Burton has now earned the award

three times over the last four weeks.

The fourth one came on March 4 after a week in which the rookie averaged 26.0 points on 54.8 percent shooting, plus 4.5 rebounds, 3.5 assists and 2.5 steals. Burton's play inspired a 2-0 week in which the Irish knocked off both Wake Forest and Clemson at home. Burton dropped a career high 31 points against the Demon Deacons before following that up with 21 against the Tigers.

Burton's third honor came on Feb. 26. After scoring 16 points in the win at Louisville, Burton was a man possessed in the 2nd half at Syracuse, where he scored 20 points on 8-of-13 shooting from the field. Burton finished with 28 points plus a career-high tying 8 assists.

Markus Burton won his second ACC Rookie of the Week award on Feb. 12 after pouring in a team best 19 points then posting an incredible stat line in the win over Virginia Tech. Burton balled out with 16 points, a season high tying eight assists and a season best six steals - as the latter tied for the third most steals in a single game in program history. Since 1996, only two other Irish have finished with at least 16 points, eight assists and six steals in a game - Chris Thomas in 2001 and Jerian Grant in 2013.

FRESHMAN RECORD WATCH

We are officially on Burton freshman scoring record watch as we head into the final week of the regular season. The freshman guard enters Tuesday's matchup with 502 points on the season - which already puts him in the No. 5 spot and striking distance of No. 1 Troy Murphy and his 519 points. From a scoring average perspective, Burton's 17.3 ppg ranks 3rd all-time behind Troy Murphy (19.2) and Adrian Dantley (18.3).

SHARPSHOOTER SHREWS

Markus Burton won't be the only freshman leaving his name in the ND record book this season after Braeden Shrewsberry continues to light it up from three.

Shrewsberry has knocked down 54 three-pointers in ACC play, breaking the Notre Dame ACC record. The previous record was 51 held by Prentiss Hubb, Matt Farrell and V.J. Beachem.

FYI - those 54 threes in ACC play are tied for the fourth most this season and sit six behind UNC's RJ Davis (60) for the most.

Shrews' 71 made threes on the year are the 3rd most by a freshman in the entire country. Same goes for his 2.5 made threes/game.

As far as individual games - Shrewsberry tied the program record for made three-pointers by a freshman after draining seven against the Louisville Cardinals. He tied the likes of Pat Connaughton, Chris Thomas and Ryan Hoover. Shrews' 23 points marked his second highest points total on the season.

Lastly, Shrewsberry is shooting 42.9 percent from deep in ACC play - that number ranks 3rd amongst ACC players and would rank 5th all-time in Notre Dame ACC program history. His 3.0 made threes/game in league play ranks 4th.

YOUNG BUT NOT AFRAID

Two young freshman guards in Burton and Shrewsberry have proven they aren't afraid of a hostile environment. In true road games, Burton and Shrewsberry are averaging 16.2 points and 13.4 points, respectively.

Most recently for Burton - 28 points at Syracuse, 16 points at Louisville, 17 points at Pitt, 19 points at Duke.

For Shrewsberry, we've already mentioned his 18 points in the 2nd half at Syracuse and his 23-point showing at Louisville with seven made threes. Both of those were outdone by his season high 25-point effort in the OT win at Georgia Tech. He's averaging 3.4 made threes/game in road games.

#TRENDING

Here are some other under-the-radar stats

to keep an eye out for this week.

Tae Davis has recorded four double-digit scoring performances over the last five games. Davis is coming off an 18-point second half performance in the win over Clemson.

In addition, Davis has made 29 of his last 33 from the free-throw line, raising his percentage from .618 to its current .716.

Braeden Shrewsberry has produced three double-digit scoring performances over the last four games, totaling 60 points with 17 made three-pointers.

Carey Booth has totaled 44 points over the last 4 games (11.0 ppg). He's seeking his third straight game in double figures on Tuesday at UNC, which would mark a season best.

Team wise, Notre Dame is 6-0 this year when limiting their turnover total to single digits. They have produced single-digit turnovers five times over the last six games, with the lone double-digit one being Syracuse.

IN YOUR BAG

Speaking of trending, Markus Burton has ratcheted up his defensive intensity down the final stretch. The starting point guard is now up to 58 steals (1 away from cracking the program top-10 for a season).

He's averaging 2.0 spg. If that holds, he would become just the 4th player in program history to average 2.0 spg in a season (Chris Thomas, David Rivers, Jerian Grant).

His 2.0 steals per game ranks 4th in the ACC. Furthermore, his 2.3 steals/game in league play leads all ACC players.

BOARDS BATTLE

One of Notre Dame's greatest strengths this season has been its rebounding. In ACC play, the Irish rank 3rd in rebounding (36.7) and 4th in rebound margin (+2.9). In addition they rank 6th in offensive (9.8) rebounds per game and 3rd in defensive (26.9).

The Irish are 9-7 this season when outrebounding their opponent.

And it's been a total team effort on the rebounding front. Get this, Booth, Davis, Konieczny, Roper and Njie all average between 3.3-3.6 defensive rebounds/game.

Njie leads the team in rebounding (5.4) and in offensive boards (2.0). Davis ranks 2nd in rebounding (5.2) and 2nd in O-boards (1.7).

TALE OF 2 HALVES AT SYRACUSE

It would have been the greatest comeback in not just school history but by an ACC member institution as well, but Notre Dame fell a possession short at Syracuse on Feb. 24. Syracuse forced 11 early turnovers and shot 61 percent from the field to go up 29 points late in the first half. Notre Dame then closed the half on a 9-0 run to make it a 20-point game. Then magic happened in the second half.

The Irish scored a season-high 56 points in the second half. That's the most points the program has ever scored in a half of any ACC game. Notre Dame shot 68.8 percent from the field and 66.7 percent (10-of-15) from three. The Irish made five straight shots to slice into a deficit that was 10 (82-72) with 4:12 remaining to get within three, 86-83, with 1:07 left. Both Shrewsberry and Burton had cracks at a three-point attempt to tie but both fell short.

Burton and Shrewsberry scored 20 and 18 points respectively in the second half, thus 38 of the team's 56 points. Shrewsberry hit all six of his three-pointers in the second half.

WIN STREAK

The Irish held the Cardinals to a season low 50 points - it marked the third ACC opponent this season in which they've held to a season low. The Irish showed growth in the second half when Louisville cut the lead to eight points but they responded with a game-ending 16-2 run.

Then there was the 'gritty not pretty' 58-55 victory over Georgia Tech. The Irish shot just 31.6 percent from the field but got it done where it counted: tied season high in offensive rebounds (16), season high in second chance points (20), season high in free-throw attempts (22) and a season low in turnovers (6).

Against the Hokies, the Irish rallied down four at the half to outscore VT 39-27 in the second half. Notre Dame shot 54.2 percent in the second half and finished with their second highest assist total on the year with 14.

THIS CLOSE

Because of the defensive effort of this young team, Notre Dame has been in just about every single league contest and their 7-11 ACC record unfortunately doesn't reflect it.

Before the Duke loss on Feb. 7 - Notre Dame had been in eight straight tight battles (Pitt, Virginia, BC x2, Miami, FSU, Duke and NC State) with the average margin of defeat in those losses being 7.5.

In both Boston College games, the Irish had a three-point attempt to either tie or win the game in the closing seconds. Same goes for the recent 88-85 loss at Syracuse. The NC State loss came down to the final possession.

Overall on the season, Notre Dame has played in 16 games in which the margin of victory was 10 points or less and have gone 7-9. Diving deeper, the Irish are 3-5 in games decided by five points or less.

Lastly, in three of those losses (Boston College, Duke and Virginia), the Irish finished the game with both a higher shooting percentage and rebounding total.

FIRST SIGNATURE WIN

It took just the second ACC game of his career but Coach Shrewsberry delivered that first signature win in Notre Dame's 76-54 victory over Virginia. What Shrews' crew accomplished had never been done by an Irish crew against Virginia .. ever. It was the largest margin of victory against the Cavaliers in the all-time series. In addition, the 76 points were the most scored by an Irish squad against the Cavaliers in regulation in program history. Furthermore, the Irish handed Virginia its biggest loss to an ACC opponent since 2017 (65-41 loss to No. 10 UNC on Feb. 18, 2017).

J.R. Konieczny posted 17 points and eight rebounds, shooting 6-of-8 including a 4-for-5 mark from three. Konieczny made his

first six shots from the field and scored all his points in the first half. Then there was Markus Burton, who earned 15 points on 6-of-10 shooting, plus a career high eight assists. Burton is the first player to dish out 8 assists against Virginia since Virginia Tech's Justyn Mutts on Feb. 4, 2023.

LEGENDS CLASSIC TAKEAWAYS

A couple of Irish standouts from two games in Brooklyn during the Legends Classic. First, let's look at All-Tournament Team selection Markus Burton. The freshman took over the end of the Oklahoma State game scoring 16 of his team-high 20 points in the second half plus overtime (10 in 2H + 6 in OT). He averaged 16.0 points over the two games.

Next, it was a breakout week for Konieczny, as he produced back-to-back double-doubles, averaging 14.5 points and 10.5 rebounds. He also earned his first career start in the win over Oklahoma State (11/17). J.R. entered the Legends Classic week with 15 points and 3 rebounds to his name thru 8 career ND games. Then over those 2 games, he produced a total of 29 points and 21 rebounds. J.R. constantly attacked the offensive glass, grabbing 8 O-Boards over the 2 games.

Last but not least, there was Tae Davis who averaged 10.0 points on 57.1 percent shooting (8-14 FG), along with 5.0 rebounds per game. Davis recorded a career high 13 points against the Auburn Tigers.

HISTORIC DEBUT FOR BURTON

Not only did freshman point guard Markus Burton ball out in a historic debut in the season opener, but he got to do it in front of his hometown crowd and family. Burton poured in 29 points to lift the Irish to a 70-63 win over Niagara, marking the most points in program history in a freshman

debut. The previous record was 27 points from Laphonso Ellis back in 1988. Now a few other notes on Burton's performance.

- 1-of-5 freshmen in the history of the program to score 29 points or more, joining David Graves, Troy Murphy, Chris Thomas and Adrian Dantley.
- Burton absolutely took over the end of the game. From 8:38-2:20 in the second half, Burton recorded 16 points on 6-for-6 shooting.

FRESHMAN FOUNDATION

A little over a month into the job, Coach Shrewsberry had himself a top-30 ranked incoming freshmen class – Carey Booth, Logan Imes and Braeden Shrewsberry - all flipped from their Penn State commits. Then add in Mr. Indiana Basketball Markus Burton, who kept his commitment to Notre Dame. That brought the 2023 class to four signees which ranked 23rd in the country according to 247Sports.com.

Furthermore, cementing the bond amongst the freshmen class, there was an Indiana connection amongst most of them:

-- Imes and Shrewsberry played together throughout all four of their high school years with the Indiana Elite.

-- Imes and Burton were teammates on the 2023 Indiana All-Stars squad

CLEAN SLATE

Notre Dame only returns 35 points from a season ago, which equates to 1.6% of scoring returning. The table on the bottom page 11 displays the Division I schools returning the least amount of points ahead of the 2023-24 season.

Basketball. It marked the third time in program history in which a future Notre Dame player took home the honor. The two former winners were Chris Thomas in 2001 and Luke Zeller in 2005.

Burton averaged a state-best 30.3 points per game, along with 5.7 rebounds, 5.1 assists and 3.6 steals. Burton also secured the school single season scoring record by pouring in 909 points as a senior.

THE FOUNDATION GROWS

Coach Shrewsberry continued to build the foundation of Irish hoops by announcing three Class of 2024 signees. Cole Certa, Sir Muhammed and Garrett Sundra all signed their National Letters of Intent and officially became Irish on Nov. 6.

Shrewsberry, who started this current season with a talented four-member freshman class that was ranked in the top-30, has now built upon that with a 2024 class that is ranked as high as No. 19 by 247Sports. The trio of Cole Certa (6-5 guard from Le Roy, Illinois), Sir Muhammed (6-6 guard from Charlotte, North Carolina) and Garrett Sundra (6-11 forward from Ashburn, Virginia) also rank as the fifth best class in the ACC by 247Sports.

"We are thrilled to welcome three tremendous young men into the Notre Dame family. I am very proud of the job we were able to do on the recruiting trail in this class by landing Cole Certa, Sir Mohammed and Garrett Sundra. When we got the job here, we put a premium on bringing in players who fit our team on the court as well as off the court. All three of these young men are not only tremendous basketball players, as evidenced by the fact that this is ranked as one of the top recruiting classes not only in the ACC, but in the country as well, but they are also excellent students who fit the mission and the culture of Notre Dame."

1st Season at Notre Dame
3rd as a Head Coach at DI Level

An Indiana native has come home to kick start a new era of Notre Dame men's basketball. Vice President and James E. Rohr Notre Dame Director of Athletics Jack Swarbrick announced Micah Shrewsberry as the 18th head coach in Fighting Irish men's basketball history on March 23, 2023.

"We are so excited to have Coach (Shrewsberry) join the Notre Dame family," Swarbrick said. "Throughout this process, it reaffirmed for me that this job was among the best in the country as we had many great candidates express interest."

"During our two month process, we weekly reviewed our candidate pool and each week he (Micah) stayed at the top of our list due to his fit at the University and his commitment to the student-athlete experience. Not only do his personal & family values align with the University, but his dedication to the development of each member of his program as well."

Shrewsberry is fresh off a historic turnaround as the head coach at Penn State. After a 14-17 first season, Shrewsberry produced a 23-14 mark in 2022-23, just the 12th 20-win season in the 127-year history of Penn State basketball. Furthermore, he collected more Big Ten wins (17) in his first two seasons than any other Penn State head coach.

Shrewsberry brings a wealth of experience and success to the helm of the Notre Dame program. All-in-all he's coached in six NCAA Tournaments, two NCAA Final Fours, five NBA Playoffs and two NBA Conference Finals – in addition to coaching all-NBA honorees Jayson Tatum and Jaylen Brown.

"I'm very excited to be joining the University of Notre Dame family," Shrewsberry said. "The combination of top notch academics, plus a long storied history of success on the basketball court, made this a very attractive job for me. The power of the Notre Dame brand, and the passionate alumni family, will allow us to recruit the brightest student-athletes from coast to coast. I can't wait to get to campus and begin connecting with the students, faculty and staff which make this place special."

Shrewsberry and Penn State captured the nation's attention in late February and into March, going 9-3 over their last 12 games, which included six Quad 1 wins. Shrewsberry then made plenty of noise in the 2023 Big Ten Tournament in Chicago, defeating No. 7 Illinois, No. 2 Northwestern and No. 3 Indiana to reach the championship game as the No. 10 seed.

It marked the program's second-ever Big Ten title game appearance. Penn State was just the third double-digit seed to reach the Big Ten Tournament championship game and the first since 2008.

The Nittany Lions then made their first appearance in the NCAA Tournament since 2011. In the first round, Shrewsberry and the Nittany Lions knocked off No. 7 seed and SEC Tournament runner-up Texas A&M, winning the program's first NCAA Tournament game since 2001.

In year one at Penn State, Shrewsberry engineered the Big Ten's best scoring defense and guided the squad to their best defensive season (65.0 points allowed per game) in 11 years. The Nittany Lions advanced to the quarterfinal round of the Big Ten Tournament after winning two postseason games, making Shrewsberry one of just two first-year Big Ten coaches since 2008 to win two Big Ten Tournament games.

Recruiting-wise, Shrewsberry made an instant splash in Happy Valley. In his first year, Shrewsberry signed the highest-ranked recruiting class in program history, a consensus top-30 class. A year later, he signed his second-straight top-30 recruiting class, marking the first time in program history that the Nittany Lions had signed back-to-back top-30 recruiting classes.

Statistically speaking, the 2022-23 squad set the B1G and Penn State single-season team record for three-pointers made in a season with 385. The Nittany Lions compiled a total of five top-15 national

statistical rankings. In addition, Shrewsberry tutored an Associated Press All-American in Jalen Pickett and a total of three All-Big Ten players during the 2022-23 season.

Prior to his time with Penn State, Shrewsberry experienced two separate stints at Purdue – one as assistant coach from 2011-13 and another as associate head coach from 2019-21. Highlights include the 2020-21 season, in which Shrewsberry helped lead the Boilermakers to a 13-6 fourth-place finish in the Big Ten and an 18-10 overall mark, culminating in an NCAA Tournament at-large bid. Trevion Williams claimed first-team All-Big Ten honors, while Zach Edey and Jaden Ivey were All-Freshman Team selections. Shrewsberry played a major role in recruiting Ivey, who grew up in South Bend and is the son of Karen and Kevin Keyes Family Head Women's Basketball Coach Niele Ivey.

Another highlight from his time in West Lafayette includes the 2011-12 squad that produced a 22-13 record and reached the second round of the NCAA Tournament. Under Shrewsberry, Terone Johnson was one of the most improved players in the B1G, netting accolades from conference and national entities.

In-between his Purdue stints, Shrewsberry spent six seasons (2013-19) with the NBA's Boston Celtics as an assistant coach under Brad Stevens. During his tenure, the Celtics reached the playoffs in five consecutive seasons, including back-to-back appearances in the Eastern Conference Finals in 2017 and 2018.

Shrewsberry played a key role in the development of current NBA stars Brown and Tatum, who were the No. 3 picks in the 2016 and 2017 NBA Drafts, respectively. Tatum was an NBA All-Rookie Team first-team selection, while Brown earned second-team All-Rookie honors.

The Brad Stevens connection was previously made at Butler University, where Shrewsberry spent one year as the director of operations then three as an assistant coach. With Shrewsberry on the sidelines, the Bulldogs compiled an 87-21 record, won two Horizon League regular-season championships and two Horizon League Tournament titles and made three NCAA Tournament appearances – which included back-to-back runs to the national championship game in 2010 and 2011.

Also at Butler, he aided in the development of Gordon Hayward, who was the 2009 Horizon League Newcomer of the Year, the 2010 Horizon League Player of the Year and a 2010 Final Four All-Tournament Team selection. Hayward was the ninth overall pick in the 2010 NBA Draft by the Utah Jazz.

Continuing on Shrewsberry's basketball journey, he spent time as the director of basketball operations at Marshall University (2003-05) and an assistant coach at DePauw University (2001-03) and Wabash College (2000-01). At DePauw, Shrewsberry led the Tigers to a 42-12 record with a pair of conference championships.

Shrewsberry was also the first men's basketball head coach at Indiana University South Bend. Shrewsberry started his coaching career as a graduate assistant at the University of Indianapolis in 1999-2000.

An Indianapolis area native, Shrewsberry earned his bachelor's degree from Hanover College in 1999 and a master's degree from Indiana State in 2003. As a player at Hanover, Shrewsberry was a three-year starting guard and team tri-captain.

He and his wife, Molly, have four children, Braeden, Nicholas, Caitlin and Grace.
