BLUE-GOLD GAME FORMAT

- The game will be played with traditional scoring, there is no offense vs. defense scoring system that has been used for some previous editions of the spring game.
- There will be four 15-minute quarters with normal timing in the first half. The second half will feature a running clock and there is head coach discretion to return to normal clock rules if the game score is close at the end.
- There will be one live kickoff to start the game. All other change of possessions after a score will be ball placement.
- The teams were drafted by members of the program on Thursday, April 20. There will be some selected players who will wear green jerseys and can compete for both teams.
- There will be no punts in the game. If a team decides to punt, the ball will be moved 40 yards down field and possession of the ball will change.
- Field goals and PATs will be live.

NOTRE DAME SEASON REVIEW

- Notre Dame began the season in Ireland, taking part in the Aer Lingus College Football Classic against Navy. The Irish won their third game against Navy in Ireland by a score of 42-3 with Sam Hartman making his Notre Dame debut at quarterback and throwing four touchdown passes. **Jadarian Price** scored a touchdown on his first career carry, while **Jaden Greathouse** caught a touchdown pass on his first career reception.
- A 28-point second quarter highlighted the victory over Tennessee State (56-3) in Notre Dame Stadium on a historical weekend during which Notre Dame played its first game against a Football Championship Subdivision team and a Historically Black College or University. The sterling defensive performance marked the first time since 1975 that the Irish held their first two opponents of the season without a touchdown.
- A two-hour inclement weather delay that occurred early in the second quarter at NC State was quickly forgotten when Audric Estimé rumbled for an 80-yard touchdown on the first play back to action for both teams. Estimé finished the game with 134 yards, Sam Hartman threw four more touchdown passes and the Irish defense intercepted NC State QB Brennan Armstrong three times in the 45-24 victory.
- Notre Dame's offense continued rolling along in the first-ever meeting with Central Michigan, scoring 40 (41-17) points in the first four games of the season for the first time since 1914. Audric Estimé rushed for 176 yards while **Jack Kiser** piled up 10 tackles for the Irish defense.
- In one of the most anticipated games of the season, No. 9 Notre Dame battled No. 6 Ohio State into the game's final minutes, with the Buckeyes scoring the winning touchdown (17-14) with 1:25 remaining. Javontae Jean-Baptiste, a transfer from Ohio State, paced the Irish defense with eight tackles in the game while **Mitchell Evans** caught seven passes for 75 yards to lead the Irish offense.
- After the last-minute loss to Ohio State, Notre Dame battled back to earn a last-minute thrilling victory at No. 17 Duke the next weekend. Trailing by a point and buried on its own five-yard line, Notre Dame drove 10 plays for the game-winning touchdown, which was delivered by Audric Estimé on a 30-yard run with 31 seconds remaining. Sam Hartman's fourth-down 17-yard scramble set up Estimé's memorable play. **Howard Cross III**, who earned national defensive player of the week honors after a 13-tackle performance, ended the game with a strip-sack.
- Facing an unprecedented third consecutive night game against a ranked opponent at No. 25 Louisville, turnovers doomed Notre Dame's comeback bid against the upstart Cardinals who claimed a 33-20 victory. Louisville would go on to play in the ACC Championship game.
- The streak of night-time games against ranked opponents continued the next weekend against No. 10 Southern Cal, but the Irish defense overwhelmed defending Heisman Trophy quarterback Caleb Williams, intercepting him three times in the first half. **Xavier Watts** dominated on defense, intercepting two passes, returning a fumble for a touchdown and forcing a fumble to earn national defensive player of the week honors. The 48-20 victory was the most lopsided for the Irish in the series with Southern Cal since 1995.
- After a well-deserved week off, Notre Dame blitzed Pittsburgh in Notre Dame Stadium 58-7 as **Xavier Watts** became the first Irish defensive player to intercept multiple passes in consecutive games (Watts picked off two passes against the Panthers). Audric Estimé rushed for three touchdowns in the contest and the Irish special teams unit returned its first punt for a touchdown since 2015.
- A key road victory at Clemson eluded Notre Dame, as turnovers doomed an Irish comeback. Down 24-9 at halftime, the Irish rallied to cut it to one score and out-gained yardage-wise the Tigers in the game 329-285, but could not get the necessary late score and suffered the third loss of the season, 31-23.
- Senior Day against Wake Forest marked the 500th game in Notre Dame Stadium and a 45-7 victory over the Demon Deacons. Sam Hartman tossed four touchdown passes against his former team and Audric Estimé rushed for 115 yards.
- Audric Estimé capped his Notre Dame career with a legendary performance in the 56-23 victory at Stanford. Piling up 238 rushing yards (the fourth-most in a single game in Notre Dame history), Estimé finished the season with 1,341 rushing yards, which ranks fifth on the Notre Dame single-season list. He also posted four rushing touchdowns to set the Irish single-season record at 18.
- Notre Dame would finish the season with its 10th win, 40-8, over No. 21 Oregon State in the Sun Bowl. Irish quarterback **Steve Angeli** would make his first career start in the game, eventually finishing 15-of 19 for 232 yards and three touchdowns while freshman wideout **Jordan Faison** earned the game's Most Valuable Player Award with five catches for 115 yards and a touchdown.

ROSTER RESULTS

A review of 2023 for each member of the Irish roster.

Absher, Sullivan - The reserve offensive lineman made his Notre Dame debut at the end of the 2023 Sun Bowl victory.

Angeli, Steve - The Irish back up quarterback for the 2023 season, Angeli started the year 19-for-25 passing with four touchdowns in seven relief appearances of Sam Hartman. Hartman opted out of the 2023 Sun Bowl and Angeli made the most of his first career start, completing 15 of 19 passes for 232 yards and three touchdowns.

Auer, Marty - Saw action in 12 games this season on the Irish special teams unit and has appeared in 13 games throughout his two years with the program.

Ausberry, Jaiden - A true freshman linebacker, Ausberry appeared in the first four games of the season, then did not see action again until the Sun Bowl to preserve a year of eligibility (the NCAA allows four games to be played to preserve a year and bowl games do not count toward that four-game total). He posted a career-best three tackles in reserve duty against Tennessee State.

Baker, Tosh - A veteran reserve offensive lineman, Baker appeared in 11 games in 2023, starting two contests. Against Ohio State, he lined up as an extra tight end on Notre Dame's first offensive play, then started at right tackle in the 2023 Sun Bowl, helping the Irish rush for 236 yards (4.9 per carry) and two touchdowns in the victory. Baker also saw action at right tackle in the final two series of the game at Louisville.

Bauman, Kevin - Expected to be in the running for the starting tight end position, Bauman suffered a preseason knee injury and missed the entire 2023 season.

Bell, Micah - A true freshman cornerback, Bell appeared in three games in 2023 and recorded his first career tackle (which was for a one-yard loss) against Oregon State in the Sun Bowl.

Botelho, Jordan - In his first full season as Notre Dame's starting Vyper defensive end, Botelho recorded 32 tackles and four sacks in 2023. His '23 campaign ended on the highest of notes, as he was named the Sun Bowl Lineman of the Game after leading the Irish with five tackles in the victory.

Bowen, Drayk - As a true freshman linebacker playing behind leading tackler JD Bertrand, Bowen concentrated on special teams play during the 2023 campaign, where he appeared in 12 games (missing one contest with an injury) and recorded 14 stops and a forced fumble. In relief action as Notre Dame posted run-away victories to end the season against Wake Forest, Stanford and Oregon State, Bowen posted 10 of his 14 tackles overall in the three victories.

Burnham, Joshua - A young up-and-coming defensive lineman, Burnham was productive with limited snaps, eventually finishing the season with 18 tackles, four tackles-for-loss and a sack. In the 2023 Sun Bowl, Burnham sniffed out a fake punt attempt by Oregon State, dropping the runner for a loss and providing Notre Dame a momentum shift in the eventual 40-8 victory.

Chan, Ty - Focused on development behind the veteran players on the offensive line, Chan appeared in two games during his true freshman season in 2023.

Colzie, Deion - The season started out on a high note for Colzie, who caught three passes for 45 yards and a touchdown in the victory over Navy in Ireland. An injury curtailed his season, however, and he would end up appearing in just four games in the month of September then eventually returning for limited action in the Sun Bowl victory over Oregon State.

Coogan, Pat - Coogan earned the nod as Notre Dame's starting left guard during the 2023 preseason, making his first career start against Navy in the season opener, and eventually becoming the only Irish offensive lineman to start all 13 games in '23. He paved the way for the Irish to rush for 2,414 yards (185.7 per game) and surrender just 16 sacks to opposing defenses.

Craig, Ashton - In his second season in the program and a freshman eligibility-wise, Craig saw relief appearances against Navy, Tennessee State, NC State and Central Michigan. When starting center Zeke Correll was knocked out of the Clemson game with an injury and his replacement, Andrew Kristofic was hurt just a few plays later, Craig was called upon to finish the game at center. With his first snap coming deep in Notre Dame's own territory, Craig competed well and would end up starting the final three games of the season - which included Audric Estimé's amazing 238-yard rushing effort at Stanford. Craig also helped Notre Dame rush for over 200 yards in the Sun Bowl victory over Oregon State and was named to the Associated Press' All-Bowl team.

Cross III, Howard - Cross III established himself as one of the top playmaking interior defensive lineman in the country during the 2023 season.

Devezin, Dylan - A walk-on quarterback, Devezin served as Notre Dame's holder for the first four games of the year.

Diomede, Marcello - A walk-on kicker, Diomede was able to record his first career point, converting a PAT in the win over Wake Forest and also kicked off in the game (a kick which earned a touchback).

Dunn, Isaiah - A walk-on cornerack, Dunn made his Notre Dame debut in the victory over Tennessee State.

Evans, Mitchell - After a quiet start to the season, Evans led the Irish with seven catches for 75 yards from the tight end position in the battle with No. 6 Ohio State and would eventually lead the team in receiving over the next three games. That run included a six-catch, 134-yard effort in the come-from-behind victory at No. 17 Duke. Unfortunately, Evans' season came to an end when he suffered an injury in the Pittsburgh game. His production, however, would end up placing him as Notre Dame's leading receiver in 2023 with 29 catches for 422 yards.

Faison, Jordan - One of the main stories for the Irish offense was the emergence of Faison as one of the team's main receiving weapons.

Fisher, Justin - A walk-on tight end from Mishawaka, Indiana, Fisher is in his second season with the program and made his debut in the victory over Tennessee State.

Flanagan, Cooper - One of the most productive true freshman on the Irish roster, Flanagan appeared early and often on Notre Dame's special teams and would end up seeing action in all 13 games in 2023. When the Irish lost starting tight end Mitchell Evans to injury late in the season, Cooper moved into the starting lineup for the final two games of the year and catch his first career pass - a 19-yard touchdown reception from Steve Angeli in the Pittsburgh game.

Ford, Devyn - A jack-of-all-trades running back who transferred from Penn State, Ford immediately established himself as one of Notre Dame's top special teams players. He returned seven kickoffs, rushed eight times for 44 yards, caught four passes for 34 yards and a touchdown and made four special teams tackles in 2023. This spring, Ford has moved positions to safety.

Garrity, Henry - Did not see action in his first season as a walk-on tight end. Garrity is the son of legendary Irish basketball player Pat Garrity (1994-98).

Gobaira, Aiden - Starting to push for more playing time on the defensive line during the 2023 preseason, Gobaira suffered a knee injury in practice and missed the entire season.

Gray, Christian - Listed as a back up on the depth chart for his first career contest, true freshman cornerback Christian Gray saw action in 12 games, made 11 tackles and flashed his potential to push for a starting job in 2024. He intercepted his first career pass against Pittsburgh and finished the year with a career-best three tackles in the Sun Bowl victory over Oregon State.

Greathouse, Jaden - The first true freshman wideout to catch two touchdown passes in his first career game against Navy, Greathouse also became the first Notre Dame wide receiver to catch two touchdown passes in a season debut since 1996. Limited by an injury in the middle of the season (Greathouse would appear in four games without a reception) he finished off the year with six catches for 99 yards and two touchdowns in his final three games. His five touchdown catches during a rookie campaign are the most for a Notre Dame true freshman since KJ Stepherson also had five in 2016 and dating back to 1996, rank only behind Michael Floyd's seven in 2008 for an Irish freshman wide receiver.

Hinish, Donovan – The Notre Dame legacy defensive lineman continued his development in 2023, appearing in nine games and posting a career-best four stops in the win over Central Michigan.

Jagusah, Charles – It was a quiet true freshman season for the Irish offensive lineman until Unanimous All-American Joe Alt declared for the 2024 NFL Draft and opted out of the 2023 Sun Bowl. Jagusah would step in as Notre Dame's starting left tackle for the bowl game, helping the Irish rush for 236 yards in the 40-8 victory and average 4.9 yards-per-carry.

Kiser, Jack – Kiser will return for another year of eligibility in 2024 but his production in 2023 cannot be overlooked. Appearing on all of Notre Dame's special teams, Kiser piled up 62 tackles in 13 games, including a 10-tackle performance when he started for an injured JD Bertrand at Mike linebacker against Central Michigan. Kiser will make a run for the Notre Dame career games played record next year and assume a key leadership role on the Irish defense.

Kros, Andrew – A freshman walk-on long snapper, Kros made his debut in the home finale against Wake Forest.

Love, Jeremiyah – A true freshman running back, Love rushed for 385 yards on 71 carries, seeing at least three carries in all 13 games in 2023. He broke off two 30-yard runs, including a 36-yard scoring jaunt against Tennessee State. Poised to be one of Notre Dame's top rushing threats for the 2024 season.

Mickey, Jaden – Continued his development as a reserve cornerback, seeing action in all 13 games in 2023 and starting in the Sun Bowl. His season highlight was a 43-yard interception return for a touchdown against Pittsburgh.

Mills, Rylie – Became a disruptive force on the Irish defensive line in 2023, finishing with a career-high 47 tackles and piling up 5.5 tackles-for-loss over Notre Dame's final six games. His return for a final year of eligibility in 2024 instantly provides the Irish one of the most experienced defensive lines in the country.

Minchey, Kenny – In his first season with the program, served as Notre Dame's third-string quarterback and back up for the Sun Bowl. Completed the first two pass attempts of his career in relief during the Tennessee State Game for 12 yards and ended up appearing in three games.

Minich, Ben – A true freshman safety, Minich focused on his development during the season but was able to see extensive playing time in the Sun Bowl, recording his first career tackle.

Monteforte, Rino – The walk-on sophomore long snapper appeared in his first three career games in 2023 and performed clean snaps against Tennessee State, Pittsburgh and Stanford.

Morrison, Benjamin – Followed up his freshman All-America campaign in 2022 with an impressive 2023, intercepting three passes while making 31 tackles and breaking up 10 passes. Entering his third season as a full-time starter in 2024, Morrison will be among the top perimeter defensive players in the nation.

Mukam, Armel – A freshman reserve defensive lineman, Mukam made his Notre Dame debut in the home finale against Wake Forest and recorded his first two career tackles.

Onye, Jason – In his third season at Notre Dame, Onye emerged as a dependable reserve defensive lineman for the Irish. He also blocked two field goal attempts during the season, one of which came during his five-tackle performance against Tennessee State. He finished the year with 17 tackles, 1/2 sack and two quarterback hurries.

Onyike, Kobi – Saw action in two games as a walk-on reserve defensive lineman.

Otting, Joe – Did not appear on the Irish offensive line during his true freshman season in 2023.

Payne, Gi'Bran – Carving out an identity as Notre Dame's third-down back, Payne led the team with 11 third-down conversions. He finished the year with 45 carries for 168 yards and two touchdowns, while also catching nine passes for 58 yards and two scores.

Pendleton, Sam – A reserve true freshman offensive lineman, Pendleton saw action in three games during the 2023 season.

Price, Jadarian – Sideline for his true freshman campaign in 2022 with an injury, Price flashed his big-play potential throughout the 2023 season. That potential included a touchdown run on his first career carry, a touchdown reception on his second career catch and a 99-yard kickoff return against No. 10 Southern Cal on his fifth career return opportunity. He capped the season by leading the Irish in rushing with 106 yards on 13 carries with one touchdown in the 40-8 Sun Bowl victory over No. 21 Oregon State.

Raridon, Eli – Raridon's promising true freshman season in 2022 was ended by injury and he eventually worked his way back to appear in seven games at tight end during the 2023 season. The end of the year saw Raridon's production on the rise as he caught five passes for 51 yards and a touchdown in the season's final three games.

Reader, Tre – A walk-on freshman linebacker, Reader made his first and only career appearance against Tennessee State.

Scheidler, Leo – In his second year as a walk-on, Scheidler appeared in his first two games against Tennessee State and Stanford.

Schrauth, Billy – Seeing action in all 13 games, Schrauth was an extra offensive lineman on Notre Dame's PAT unit until 10-game starting right guard Rocco Spindler was injured against Clemson. Schrauth stepped into the starting lineup for the final three games of the season, helping the Irish rush for over 300 yards at Stanford and over 230 yards in the Sun Bowl victory over Oregon State.

Sherwood, Davis – A 'glue guy' in the Irish offense, Sherwood has played fullback and tight end during his career at Notre Dame. Appearing in 38 career games, he caught his first career touchdown on a key third down play at NC State this season while continuing to play a big role on the Irish special teams units.

Shuler, Adon – A true freshman safety, Shuler retained a year of eligibility while appearing in four regular-season games and the Sun Bowl. He showed his play making ability late in the season, posting all six career tackles in the final three games of the year against Wake Forest, Stanford and Oregon State.

Smith, KK – A true freshman wide receiver, Smith's season was over before it began, beginning his time at Notre Dame recovering from an injury. His hard work over the year allowed Smith to return to practice during bowl prep and make his Notre Dame debut in the Sun Bowl victory over Oregon State.

Sneed, Jalen – One of the most athletic players on the Irish defense, Sneed appeared in all 13 games supporting Notre Dame's veteran group of linebackers. He finished the year with 14 tackles, five quarterback hurries and two passes broken up.

Spindler, Rocco – In his third year with the program, Spindler won the starting right guard position in preseason camp and started the first 10 games of the season. He played a key role in Notre Dame's selection as Joe Moore Award semifinalists.

Talich, Luke – A preferred walk-on, Talich quickly established himself as a special teams mainstay during his freshman season in 2023. He would end up making two special teams tackle and appearing in eight games before an injury suffered against Clemson ended his season prematurely.

Thomas, Jayden – Thomas entered the season as Notre Dame's leading returning receiver and served in that role in the first four games of the year, catching 12 passes for over 180 yards and a touchdown. Over the next six games, Thomas would deal with a nagging hamstring injury that dropped his production to five total catches.

He returned to full strength during bowl preparations and finished the year with four catches for 59 yards and a touchdown in the victory over Oregon State.

Traore, Boubacar – A true freshman rush defensive end, Traore posted his first career sack in the victory over No. 10 Southern Cal. Preserving a year of eligibility, Traore played in four regular-season games and in the Sun Bowl victory over Oregon State.

Tucker, Chance – In his third season with the program, Tucker appeared in nine games and recorded his first career tackle in the victory over Pittsburgh.

Tuihalamaka, Junior – Tuihalamaka continued his development in his second year with the Irish in 2023, putting in time as a reserve defensive end and appearing across the Irish special teams units. He finished the year appearing in all 13 games while posting 10 tackles.

Vernon, Brennan – It was a developmental year for the talented true freshman who made two game appearances and logged his first career tackle against Tennessee State.

Wagner, Aamil – In his second year with the program, Wagner saw action in seven games as a reserve offensive lineman. One of the most athletic players in the OL room, Wagner served as a back up to right tackle Blake Fisher throughout the season.
