

Team Race Assignments:

- Blue Division race assignments are by Invitation only. To be considered for the Blue Division, please contact David Beauchem (850-228-1916 / dbeauch2@nd.edu). All other teams will be assigned to the either the Gold or Open Division Race.
- We make a final decision on the Open Race being separate or combined, as we get closer to the meet date. If we combine to one Open Division Race, we will adjust the Meet Schedule back to the listed time slots.

Entry Procedure:

- All entries must be completed online via Direct Athletics.
- Entries are due by Monday, September 30th at 5:00 pm (EDT).
- Teams may enter up to 15 Competitors.
- Unattached Entries should contact David Beauchem for entry.

Team Limitations:

- Teams assigned to the Blue or Gold Division will be limited to 9 runners in their assigned race.
- Teams assigned to the Blue or Gold Division may compete additional 6 runners per gender in the Open Division race.
- Teams assigned to the Open Division may compete 15 runners in the race.

Entry Fees:

- \$500 per gender, per team competing in the Blue Division / Gold Division.
- \$300 per gender, per team competing only in the Open Division.
- Entry fees can be paid via cash or check on the day of competition at packet pick-up, or prior to the event on DirectAthletics.
- Please make all checks payable to: University of Notre Dame.
- Notre Dame Students with a valid Irish1Card & proof of fitness can compete in the Open Division Race for FREE.
- Unattached Entries will pay \$30 per person, payable at Packet Pick-up.

Packet Pick-up:

- Team packet pick-up will be located at the operations tent located near the finish line / timing trailer.
- Team packets will be available during a portion of the course preview time on Thursday, October 3rd and Friday, October 4th.
- Entry fees must be paid in full before collecting packets.

Declaration & Scratches:

• To properly facilitate the NCAA results reporting rules for "Did Not Start" / "Did Not Finish" please return bib numbers of scratched entrants to the packet pick-up tent, no less than 15 minutes prior to the start of your assigned race.

Course Inspection & Practice:

• The Cross Country Course will be available for Pre-Meet Workout from 12:00-6:00 pm on Thursday, October 3rd.

Parking:

• Team and spectator parking will be located just north of Burke Golf Course on Door Road in Lot D6 North / D6 South.

Team Camps / Facilities:

- Team camp / drop-off area will be located outside of the Golf Course (behind the starting line, just to the east).
- Team tent rental will be through AAYS Rental by contacting Pam at pam@aaysrental.com or 574-256-1110.
- Please submit the Team Tent Rental Form. The deadline to reserve a team tent will be Thursday, September 19.
- The team camp area should only be Team Personnel and Competitors.



Sports Medicine:

- Athletic Trainers will be located in the tents just South of the finish line.
