FINAL SCORE

- No. 16/14 Notre Dame (4-1) 31, No. 15/17 Louisville (3-1) 24

TEAM NOTES

- Louisville won the toss and deferred its choice to the second half. Notre Dame received the opening kick off and started the game defending the south end zone.
- Attendance was a capacity crowd of 77,622, the ninth consecutive sellout in Notre Dame Stadium.
- For the Irish Wear Green game today, Notre Dame donned their green tops with white pants. It marks the first time for a home game in Notre Dame Stadium the Irish have worn white pants.
- Notre Dame's opening drive touchdown, a six-yard Jeremiyah Love run, broke Louisville's streak of 21 consecutive games without giving up an opponent touchdown on their first drive of the game.
- Notre Dame improves to 3-2 all-time in the series with Louisville.
- Notre Dame improves to 216-84-3 all-time against ACC opponents.
- Notre Dame improves to 4-0 when the game is broadcast exclusively on Peacock.
- The victory over Louisville is the ninth-ranked win of the Marcus Freeman era at Notre Dame. Only Frank Leahy (10 such wins) earned more ranked victories in his first three years on the Irish sidelines.
- ND improves its win streak to 19 games over ACC teams in Notre Dame Stadium.

NOTABLE

- Xavier Watts' interception in the second quarter is the second of the season for the Irish safety and ninth of his career. That ties him with several Irish players for 17th all-time in career interceptions.

FIRSTS

- Career start for freshman cornerback Leonard Moore.
- Career forced fumble - Leonard Moore on Louisville's second drive, which led to Jaiden Ausberry's first career fumble recovery.
- Touchdown reception of the season for Jaden Greathouse (the fifth of his career).
- Career sack for freshman Kyngstonn Viliam-Asa in the third quarter.
