## **TEAM NOTES**

- Today's kickoff temperature of 63 degrees marks the coldest home opener for Notre Dame in 92 years and eight months. The 1931 home opener against Drake (a 63-0 Irish victory), in which the temperature was 52 degrees at kickoff. It rained 1.4 inches that day in 1931.
- Northern Illinois won the toss and deferred its choice to the second half. Notre Dame received the opening kick off and started the game defending the north end zone.
- Attendance 77,622 seventh consecutive sell out in Notre Dame Stadium (the final game of the 2022 season vs. Boston College was not a sell out).
- Northern Illinois improves to 1–0 all-time against Notre Dame.
- Notre Dame is now 10–1 all–time against MAC teams.
- Notre Dame is now 110–95–2 all–time in home openers.

## **FIRSTS**

- Collegiate action for freshman RB Aneyas Williams on Notre Dame's second drive. Williams noted his first-career carry in the second quarter (four yards).
- Start in a Notre Dame uniform senior WR Kris Mitchell (26th of his career)
- Rushing touchdown at Notre Dame senior QB Riley Leonard on Notre Dame's first possession (20th of his career)
