

FINAL SCORE

No. 8/7 Notre Dame (9-1) 35, Virginia (5-5) 14

TEAM NOTES

- Notre Dame won the toss and deferred its choice to the second half. Virginia received the opening kick off and started the game defending the south zone.
- Attendance, 77,622, the 12th consecutive sell out in Notre Dame Stadium. It also marks the second consecutive season the Irish have sold out all of their home games.
- Notre Dame improves to 5-0 all-time against Virginia and 2-0 at Notre Dame Stadium.
- Notre Dame improves to 220-84-3 all-time against teams from the Atlantic Coast Conference and 5-0 against the ACC in 2024.
- Notre Dame improves to 526-131-13 all-time in home games and 382-199-5 in Notre Dame Stadium.
- Notre Dame improves to 9–5–1 all-time on November 16 and have won three in a row on the date, 60–6 against Pitt in a 1996 and 52–20 vs. Navy in 2019. The Irish have not lost at home on November 6 since a 7–0 setback to lowa in 1940 (six total games).
- Notre Dame improves 3-0 on 'Senior Day' final home game of the season during the Marcus Freeman era.
- Notre Dame improves to 103–25–5 all-time on Senior Day and have won the last eight final home games of the season.
- Including the 2021–23 final home game shutouts, Notre Dame has outscored its last four Senior Day opponents 179–21. Dating back to 2018 Notre Dame has outscored its Senior Day opponents 306-62.

NOTABLE

- Jack Kiser has passed Houston Griffith (62, 2018-22) for the Notre Dame record of career games played with his appearance this afternoon 63.
- Xavier Watts' interception late in the first half was the 11th of his career, moving him into a tie with four other players for ninth on the Notre Dame career list.
- Jeremiyah Love, highlighted by a 76-yard touchdown run in the third quarter, posted his third 100-yard rushing game of the season and his career, finishing with career-best 137 yards.
- Jeremiyah Love scored a rushing touchdown for the 10-straight game (all 10 games of 2024) which is tied for the fourth-best streak in Notre Dame history with Vagas Ferguson (last nine games of 1979). The Notre Dame record is 11 by Wayne Bullock from 1973–74.
- Love's streak matches Autry Denson's run in 1998 of 10-straight games with a rushing touchdown as the best streak to start a season in school history.

FIRSTS

- Career start sophomore DL Donovan Hinish
- Touchdown reception at Notre Dame senior WR Jayden Harrison, fifth of his career

CAREER HIGHS

- 64-yard punt senior punter James Rendell. It was the longest punt for Notre Dame since Jon Sot's 61-yard effort against Marshall.
- Seven carries, along with three receptions and 35 receiving yards, all career highs for freshman RB Aneyas Williams
