ABOUT THE MATCHUP

- Georgetown is 2-0 after a 69-57 win over the visiting Fairfield University Stags at Capital One Arena last Saturday. Thomas Sorber led the way for the Hoyas, tallying 25 points on 11-for-16 shooting from the floor. The freshman also led the team pulling down nine boards. Jayden Epps finished with 12 points while Micah Peavy paced the offense with five assists and a career-best seven steals. Georgetown shot 47.4% (27-for-57) from the floor and held the Stags to a 33.3% (20-for-60) performance from the field. On the glass, Georgetown outrebounded Fairfield 39-32.
- For his efforts in a 2-0 week for the Blue & Gray, Sorber was named the BIG EAST Freshman of the Week on Monday after averaging a double-double (22.5 ppg / 11.0 rpg) to go along with 2.0 bpg and 2.0 spg.
- Sorber's 22.5 ppg ranks fourth in the BIG EAST and leads a quarter of Hoyas in double figures followed by Epps (14.5), Peavy (14.0) and Mack (11.0). Sorber is also leading the league and the team on the glass with 11.0 rpg followed by Drew Fielder and Jordan Burks, each with 6.0 rpg. Mack's 4.5 apg paces the offense and ranks eighth in the BE while Epps and Peavy dish out 3.5 apg. Peavy's 5.0 spg is the best in the BIG EAST Conference while Sorber's 2.0 bpg ranks fifth in the league.
- Notre Dame enters Saturday's contest with a 2-0 record, after defeating the University at Buffalo on Monday 86-77. Tae Davis' 27 led a quartet of Irish in double figures.

JAYDEN EPPS - PRESEASON ALL-BIG EAST

- JAYDEN EPPS IS COMING OFF A SOPHOMORE SEASON WHERE HE LED THE TEAM IN SCORING, AVERAGING 18.5 POINTS PER GAME ON 39.2% SHOOTING FROM THE FIELD AND HITTING 30.5% FROM 3-POINT LAND.
- HE FINISHED THIRD IN THE BIG EAST IN SCORING, AND RECORDED DOUBLE FIGURES 24 TIMES THROUGHOUT THE SEASON.
- HE WAS THE HOYA LEADER IN POINTS, ASSISTS AND STEALS.

- GEORGETOWN SOPHOMORE MALIK MACK HAS BEEN NAMED TO THE 20-PERSON PRESEASON WATCH LIST FOR THE 2025 BOB COUSY AWARD.
- MACK ARRIVED ON THE HILLTOP OVER THE SUMMER AS AN ADDITION FROM THE TRANSFER PORTAL FROM HARVARD. AT HARVARD, HE PLAYED IN AND STARTED 24 GAMES; MISSING THREE GAMES DUE TO ILLNESS. HE AVERAGED 33.2 MINUTES, 17.2 POINTS, 4.8 ASSISTS, AND 4.0 REBOUNDS PER GAME WHILE SHOOTING 34.1 PERCENT FROM BEHIND THE ARC.

POT OF GOLD

- Notre Dame enters Saturday's contest with a 2-0 record, after defeating the University at Buffalo on Monday 86-77. Tae Davis' 27 led a quartet of Irish in double figures followed by Markus Burton (19), Braeden Shrewsbury (19) and Kebba Nije (17). Burton was the leader on the glass, pulling down nine boards. The Fighting Irish shot 50.8% (30-59) from the field.
- Notre Dame is led by the quartet of Burton (18.5 ppg), Shrewsbury (18.5 ppg), and Davis (18.0 ppg) who have accounted for 62.8% of the Irish scoring. Nije rounds out those in double figures with 10.5 ppg.
- On the glass, Nije grabs 7.5 rpg to lead the Irish followed by Burton's 6.0 rpg.
- Notre Dame has eight returners coming back to South Bend, including their top four scorers from last season (Markus Burton, Braeden Shrewsbury, Tae Davis, J.R Konieczny).
- Head Coach Micah Shrewsbury enters his second season at the helm of Notre Dame. Shrewsbury was previously the head coach of Penn State University from 2021-23, tallying a 37-31 record with the Nittany Lions and leading them to an NCAA Tournament appearance in 2023.

LAST TIME OUT: SORBER'S 27 LIFT HOYAS PAST STAGS

- Thomas Sorber led the way for the Hoyas, tallying 25 points on 11-for-16 shooting from the floor. The freshman also led the team in rebounds pulling down nine boards and falling one shy of a double-double.
- Jayden Epps was also in double figures, finishing with 12 points on 3-for-8 shooting to go along with a 5-for-6 performance from the charity stripe shooting.
- Micah Peavy paced the offense with five assists followed by Malik Mack and Epps who had four apiece.
- Peavy was sensational on the defensive end tallying a career-best seven steals. This is the third time in his collegiate career that he has recorded five or more steals in a game.
- Georgetown shot 47.4% (27-for-57) from the floor and held the Stags to a 33.3% (20-for-60) performance from the floor.
- On the glass, Georgetown outrebounded Fairfield 39-32.
- The Blue & Gray controlled the interior, outscoring the Stags 34-22 in the paint.
- The Hoyas were tremendous on the defensive end in the second half, holding Fairfield to 24 points on 27.6% shooting from the floor.

HOYAS PUSH PAST LEHIGH

- Micah Peavy and Thomas Sorber both led a quartet of Hoyas in double figures with 20 points each.
- In his first collegiate game, Sorber managed a double-double with a squad-best 13 rebounds and 10 made free throws.
- Jayden Epps and Malik Mack also managed double figures scoring 17 and 15 respectively.
- Mack paced the Hoya offense with five assists followed by Epps who chipped in three.
- Peavy and Sorber both led the squad in steals with three apiece while Sorber and Jordan Burks each recorded a pair of blocks.
- Georgetown shot 48.4% from the floor narrowly edging the Mountain Hawks who shot 47.5%.
- The Blue & Gray were dominant on the glass pulling down 42 rebounds to Lehigh's 26. The Hoyas recorded eight blocks to the Mountain Hawks' one.

TOMMY BOY: BIG EAST FRESHMAN OF THE WEEK

- The Trenton, New Jersey native was named the BIG EAST Freshman of the Week after averaging a double-double with 22.5 ppg and 11.0 rpg, ranking fourth and first in the BIG EAST, respectively. In both his collegiate and Hoya debut, the freshman recorded a double-double scoring 20 points and grabbing 13 rebounds.
- Against Fairfield, the big man had another outstanding performance tallying 25 points while grabbing nine boards, one shy of his second double-double in as many games.
- In the Hoyas' season opener, Sorber had a game-best three steals on the day as well as a game-best two blocks in nearly 30 minutes of playing time.

BLOCK PARTY

- The Hoyas tallied eight rejections against Lehigh in the season opener with five in the second half alone.
- Thomas Sorber and Jordan Burks, coming off the bench, each tallied a pair of rejections while the quartet of Drew Fielder, Malik Mack, Micah Peavy and Kayvaun Mulready each recorded one.
- Tallying eight blocks, the Hoyas achieved the feat for just the second time under Head Coach Ed Cooley with the first coming on November 29, 2023 as the Blue & Gray defeated Merrimack, 69-67.
- The Hoyas recorded six blocks against Fairfield, with Sorber and Peavy each contributing two, while Julius Halaifonua and Curtis Williams Jr. added one apiece.
- Georgetown limited the Stags to just one block in Saturday's matchup.

HOYAS UNDER THE HOOP

- Against Fairfield on Saturday, Georgetown outrebounded the Stags 39-32. The Hoyas have outrebounded the opposition 81-58 thus far this season.
- Thomas Sorber tallied 13 rebounds and nine rebounds in GU's two games last week.
- Jordan Burks added seven boards while Drew Fielder tallied six, including five on the offensive side against Lehigh.
- Drew McKenna, Burks, Mack and Peavy each collected five boards against Fairfield.

IN THE PAINT

- In the season opener, GU made its presence felt in the paint, outscoring the Mountain Hawks 34-28 inside.
- For the game, the Blue & Gray went 31-for-64 from the field and shot an impressive 26-for-42 (61.9%) from inside the arc.
- In Saturday's match against Fairfield, the Hoyas outscored the Stags 27-20 inside. Georgetown went 27-for-57 (47.4%) from the field goal range in their matchup against Fairfield.

ROTHSTEIN'S PRESEASON LISTS

Under the Radar Transfers - Malik Mack

- "The Hoyas only won nine games last season in their first year under Ed Cooley and how big of a jump they make in Year Two will depend on how quickly Mack adjusts to the Big East. The dynamic floor general averaged 17.2 points, 4.8 assists, and 4.0 rebounds last season as a freshman at Harvard."

Under the Radar Freshmen - Thomas Sorber

- "Sorber has to be in the mix for Big East Freshman of the Year if the Hoyas are going to finish in the middle of the conference standings in their second season under Ed Cooley. The 6-9 big man is the strong favorite to be Georgetown's starting center during the 2024-25 season."

BIG MAN U

- Eight of the 17 Hoyas on the roster are over 6-8, with the average height on the team being 78.6" per player (6-6).
- Julius Halaifonua (7-0) tops the squad followed by Drwe Fielder (6-11), Thomas Sorber (6-10), Jordan Burks (6-9), Seal Diouf (6-9), Jayden Fort (6-9), Drew McKenna (6-8) and Micah Peavy (6-8).

MALIK MACK - BOB COUSY AWARD PRESEASON WATCH LIST

- Georgetown sophomore Malik Mack has been named to the 20-person Preseason Watch List for the 2025 Bob Cousy Award, as announced by the Naismith Basketball Hall of Fame on Monday.
- The annual Bob Cousy Award, named after the Class of 1971 Hall of Famer and former Boston Celtic and Holy Cross guard, celebrates its 22nd year by highlighting the top point guard in Division I men's college basketball.
- Mack arrived on the Hilltop over the summer as an addition from the transfer portal from Harvard.
- At Harvard, he played in and started 24 games; missing three games due to illness. He averaged 33.2 minutes, 17.2 points, 4.8 assists, and 4.0 rebounds per game while shooting 34.1 percent from behind the arc.
- The product out of Oxon Hill, Maryland was named Ivy League Rookie of the Year while also garnering All-Ivy Honorable Mention and First Team NABC All-District.
- Mack was tabbed as the ECAC Rookie of the Year and earned a nod to the First Team All-ECAC while being named a finalist for the Lou Jenson Award and the Kyle Macy Award. Named Raymond P. Lavietes '36 Most Valuable Player Award for his contributions during his freshman campaign.
- Mack was the lone BIG EAST representative on the preseason watch list.
- The last Hoya to be on the 20-person watch list was D'Vauntes Smith-Rivera for the 2016 Bob Cousy Award, as announced in October 2015.

FANTA FIVE

- Thomas Sorber was named to John Fanta's "[Fanta Five](#)" as released by the BIG EAST Men's Basketball X account (formerly Twitter) recognizing his top five performers of the Week.
- Sorber joined Creighton's Ryan Kalkbrenner, Marquette's Kam Jones, UConn's Alex Karaban and Xavier's Ryan Conwell.

PUSHIN' PEAVY

- In his Hoya debut, Peavy was unstoppable, tallying 20 points on 8-13 shooting from the floor while grabbing four rebounds and swiping three steals.
- Against Fairfield in the Hoyas second outing of the season, Peavy tallied a career-high seven steals against the Stags. It was the third time in his collegiate career that he has recorded five or more steals in a game.
- Through two games, he is averaging 14.0 points, 4.5 rebounds, 3.5 assists and 5.0 steals. His 10 steals over two games (5.0 spg) leads the BIG EAST while he is tied for 21st in scoring.
- Peavy is the most experienced player on the team with nearly 3,000 minutes played in his collegiate career.
- The graduate student is one of three guys (Epps, Burks) on the roster with NCAA Tournament experience. Across four seasons, Peavy has competed in seven NCAA Tournament games.
- Peavy is the lone player on the roster that has recorded a collegiate triple-double. Peavy tallied 13 points, 12 rebounds and 10 assists on December 16 against Arizona State.

RETURN OF THE MACK

- Mack, an experienced sophomore coming to the Hilltop, recorded 800 minutes of game action during his rookie season at Harvard. The sophomore has started all 26 games of his collegiate career.
- Recorded a career-high 32 points against the University of Massachusetts Amherst on November 17, 2023.
- At Harvard, Mack scored in double figures 21 times, including eight games with 20+ points.
- In his Georgetown debut against Lehigh, Mack scored 15 points, adding five assists and three rebounds. The sophomore followed up with seven points against Fairfield and currently holds a 40% shooting percentage from the field.
- As the Ivy League Rookie of the Year and an eight-time Ivy League Rookie of the Week, he led Harvard in points, minutes, assists, and steals per game.

ELECTRIC EPPS

- Epps is averaging 14.5 ppg and 3.5 apg through the first two contests of the season. The junior played 1011 minutes last season and was named to the 2024-25 Preseason All-BIG EAST Third Team.
- The Norfolk, Virginia native was the leading scorer for the Hoyas in 2023-24, averaging 18.5 ppg.
- Epps scored in double figures 24 times last season bringing his career total to 44 games in double figures. He finished third overall in the BIG EAST in scoring.
- Recorded a career-high 34 points against Jackson State (Nov. 25), going 10-18 from the field and 7-9 from three.
- Epps has totaled 860 total points in his collegiate career, including 537 points last season with the Hoyas. The junior is just 140 points away from 1000 for his career and 434 points away from 1000 with the Blue & Gray.

LEANING TOWER OF FIELDER

- Fielder appeared in all 32 games for the Hoyas, starting two and averaging 5.2 points and 3.1 rebounds per game.
- Posted a season-high 16 points against Notre Dame on December 16, 2023 shooting 5-for-7 from the field and 4-for-5 from beyond the arc.
- Pulled a season-high seven rebounds against Marquette on February 3, 2024 adding 11 points.
- As a freshman, Fielder scored in double-figures six times.

WILD WILD WILLIAMS JR.

- Williams Jr. appeared in all 32 games for Louisville, starting in four of those games and averaging 5.3 points and 1.3 rebounds per game.
- Scored in double figures six times during the 2023-24 season, including a career-high 19 points versus Florida State, going 7-7 from the charity strike.
- Tallied four 3-pointers in three different games last season, doing so against Pepperdine (12/17/23), at Virginia (01/03/24) and vs North Carolina State (01/13/24).
- Named runner-up for Michigan's 2023 Mr. Basketball award.

TAKE IT TO THE BANK BURKS

- Burks has averaged 24.5 minutes through his first two games with the Blue & Gray. Burks has averaged 3.0 points and 6.0 rebounds per game.
- In his first game with the Hoyas, Burks tied Sorber as the leader in blocks with two. Burks was also second on the team in rebounds totaling seven boards en route to a 85-77 win over Lehigh.
- In Saturday's contest, Burks was a part of a quartet of Hoyas that tallied five rebounds. Burks finished Saturday's contest with four points and a steal to help Georgetown secure a 69-57 victory over Fairfield and improve to 2-0.
- Burks appeared in 20 games in his freshman season at Kentucky and averaged 1.9 points, 1.7 rebounds and shot 60% from the floor.
- Scored a career-high 13 points against Vanderbilt (2/6/24) while shooting 6-for-6 from the field on the day.
- Recorded a career-high five rebounds against the Commodores and Texas A&M-Commerce.
- Burks, while with Overtime Elite, led the league with 27.1 points per game in 2022-23 while chipping in 7.5 rebounds, 2.9 assists and 1.4 steals per game.

NBA GLOBAL ACADEMY PRODUCT - JULIUS HALAIFONUA

- Attended Rosmini College Preparatory School in Auckland, New Zealand before moving on to the NBA Global Academy in Australia in 2024, where he averaged 12.8 points per game, shooting 57% from the floor across 16 games.
- Earned a silver medal in the 2023 U17 Oceania Championship, where he averaged 9.0 points and 5.0 rebounds across four games.
- Ranked No. 59 nationally by 247Sports and is listed as the No. 14 center in the 2024 class.

SENSATIONAL SORBER

- Sorber was ranked the No. 45 recruit in the nation by 247Sports, he is GU's highest ranked recruit since Aminu Mohammed (No. 25) in 2021.
- As a senior at Archbishop Ryan, Sorber averaged a double-double as he tallied 18.9 points per game and grabbed 11.2 rebounds per game. He also recorded 4.8 blocks per game to go along with 2.5 assists per game and 1.3 steals per game according to MaxPreps.
- On the EYBL circuit, Sorber averaged 10.2 points, 7.2 rebounds, 2.2 blocks and 1.7 assists per game for Team Final at 2023 Nike EYBL Peach Jam.
- Through his first two collegiate games, Sorber is averaging 22.5 ppg and 11.5 rpg on 55.2% shooting from the floor. The freshman ranks fourth in the BIG EAST in scoring and is the leading rebounder in the conference.

- Led Sidwell Friends to a DCSAA Tournament Championship while averaging 13.1 points to go along with 5.3 rebounds while dishing out 2.1 assists per game.
- As a junior, Williams was part of the Sidwell Friends squad that won the 2023 State Champions Invitational. His squad overcame a seven-point deficit going into the fourth quarter but were able to outscore the Wheeler Wildcats 17-7 in the final quarter to solidify the 57-54 win. Williams led the way with 24 points and earned tournament MVP honors.

- In his collegiate debut against Fairfield, McKenna was able to pull down five boards in only 11 minutes of action.
- McKenna enrolled in January of 2024 and did not see game action while redshirting last spring.

LARGER THAN LIFE: REMEMBERING DIKEMBE MUTOMBO

- The Georgetown University community mourns the passing of Dikembe Mutombo (C'91, HON '10, P'19 P'23 P'24), an All-American on the men's basketball team at Georgetown who would go on to a Hall of Fame career in the NBA.
- During the season, Georgetown's uniforms will be adorned with a "55" patch to honor Dikembe Mutombo.
- In addition to his success on the court, Mutombo dedicated his life to philanthropic and humanitarian work, and being a full-time advocate for those in need.
- Mutombo passed away on September 30 at the age of 58 from brain cancer.
- In three seasons as a letterwinner on the Hilltop, Mutombo was a two-time All-BIG EAST selection and twice named BIG EAST Defensive Player of the Year.
- During his tenure, the Hoyas captured one BIG EAST regular season title (1988-89) and the 1989 BIG EAST Tournament title. That same season, the Blue & Gray advanced to the NCAA Elite Eight.
- Mutombo was selected to Georgetown's "All Century Team" in 2007 and still ranks among the all-time leaders in blocked shots (3rd, 354) and rebounds (12th, 8.6 per game).
- In 2012, he was inducted into the Georgetown Athletics Hall of Fame. In 2016, Mutombo was recognized with the NCAA Silver Anniversary Award that recognizes distinguished individuals on the 25th anniversary of the conclusion of their college athletics careers.
- Mutombo played 18 seasons in the NBA culminating in Mutombo's enshrinement into the Naismith Memorial Basketball Hall of Fame in 2015.
- Nicknamed "Mount Mutombo" for his defensive prowess, he is tied for the most NBA Defensive Player of the Year Awards with four (1995, 1997, 1998, 2001).

- During his career, he was a two-time recipient of the NBA's J. Walter Kennedy Citizenship Award (2001, 2009), presented annually to a player, coach or athletic trainer who shows outstanding service and dedication to the community.
- In 2009, then-NBA Commissioner David Stern appointed him to the role of the first ever NBA Global Ambassador, where he continued to work to grow and celebrate the game of basketball through international sporting events while working with NBA Cares to bring attention to important social issues.
- In 2007, Mutombo was the first recipient of the Naismith Hall of Fame's Mannie Jackson - Basketball's Human Spirit Award.

IN MEMORIAM

- During the offseason, Georgetown men's basketball lost two other pillars of the community in addition to Dikembe Mutombo.
- On September 17, longtime Georgetown Men's Basketball Head Athletic Trainer Lorry Michel passed away at the age of 71 following a long battle with cancer.
- Inducted into the Georgetown Athletics Hall of Fame in 2013, Michel was the longtime men's basketball athletic trainer and even had stints as an athletic trainer in international competition, including the Barcelona 1992 Olympic Games.
- Michel began her career at Georgetown as an assistant trainer in 1977, working with all student-athletes. Four years later, she became the head trainer for men's basketball at the request of Head Coach John Thompson Jr.
- During the first four years in Michel's new position, the Hoyas advanced to three national championship title games and captured the championship trophy in 1984. For more than 30 years, she labored tirelessly to keep all Hoya men's basketball players healthy and ready to compete, day in and day out.
- In 2013, Michel was inducted into the Georgetown University Athletics Hall of Fame as part of a six-person class. Her legacy on the Hilltop was further cemented in 2016 when the John R. Thompson Jr. Intercollegiate Athletic Center opened its doors. In recognition of her selfless dedication and her outstanding contribution to the safety, health and welfare of Georgetown student-athletes, the sports medicine facility was named in her honor. The Lorry Michel Sports Medicine Center, a state-of-the-art facility, provides services for all of Georgetown's 30 varsity sports and more than 700 student-athletes.
- Former Hoya Anthony Allen (CAS '90), who was part of the men's basketball team from 1986-90, passed away suddenly in early September.
- After his basketball career on the Hilltop, Allen returned to campus in 1994 as part of the Department of Public Safety, serving in that department ever since.
- A fixture of not just the basketball community, but the entire University community, Allen was often visible during nearly all campus events.

Ed Cooley opens the 2024-25 season in his second season as the head coach of the Georgetown University men's basketball program.

Following his inaugural season on the Hilltop, Cooley owns a 343-245 record over 18 seasons.

Cooley arrived on the Hilltop ahead of the 2023-24 season after spending the previous 12 seasons at Providence College. At PC, Cooley posted a 242-153 record, which included seven trips to the NCAA Tournament, advancing to the Sweet 16 in 2022, a BIG EAST regular season title (2022) and a BIG EAST Tournament title (2014). In 2022, Cooley was the recipient of the Naismith Coach of the Year Award, named the Sporting News Coach of the Year, the BIG EAST Coach of the Year, the NABC District 5 Coach of the Year and the USBWA District 1 Coach of the Year.

Cooley was responsible for turning around the Friar program. Prior to his arrival in 2011, Providence had finished under .500 in six of the 10 previous seasons and made just one trip to the NCAA Tournament (2004) in that 10-year span. Following Cooley's arrival, he led the Friars to nine postseason tournament berths, including seven straight from 2013-19. In 2022, he guided the team to the NCAA Sweet 16 and the program's first BIG EAST regular season title. In 2014, he led the team to the BIG EAST Tournament title.

During his time at Providence, Cooley has coached five All-Americans. He also has had players earn two BIG EAST Player of Year honors, two BIG EAST Defensive Player of the Year accolades, three BIG EAST Most Improved Player awards, one BIG EAST Tournament MVP, five BIG EAST All-Tournament Team accolades, two BIG EAST All-Rookie Team awards, one BIG EAST Sportsmanship honor and 12 All-BIG EAST honors.

Prior to his time at Providence, Cooley guided Fairfield University to a school-record 25 wins and a Metro Atlantic Athletic Conference regular season title in 2010-11. He was named the 2011 MAAC Coach of the Year and the 2011 United States Basketball Writers Association (USBWA) District I Coach of the Year honors as his squad advanced to the second round of the NIT.

In five seasons at Fairfield, Cooley's teams posted a 92-69 mark, including a 58-32 record in MAAC action. In 2010 Cooley was the first recipient of the Ben Jobe Award, presented annually to the top minority men's basketball coach in the nation.

Prior to taking the Fairfield position, Cooley spent 10 seasons as an assistant coach for Al Skinner (Rhode Island - 1996-97; Boston College - 1997-2006). During his time with BC, the Eagles advanced to five NCAA Tournaments and one NIT, secured the 2001 BIG EAST Tournament title and three BIG EAST regular season titles (2001, 2003 and 2005).

A 1994 graduate of Stonehill College, he was a three-time captain for the basketball team and was inducted into its Athletics Hall of Fame in 2019. Cooley began his coaching career at UMass-Dartmouth. He helped lead UMass-Dartmouth to a 25-4 mark and a No. 3 national ranking (1994-95). He returned to his alma mater to serve as an assistant coach for one season (1995-96).

Cooley is a native of Providence, Rhode Island and attended Central High School, earning two Rhode Island High School Player of the Year honors. He did a postgraduate year at New Hampton Prep before attending Stonehill. He and his wife Nurys have a daughter Olivia, who is a graduate of Georgetown University, and a son Isaiah.
