TEAM NOTES

- Florida State won the toss and deferred its choice to the second half. Notre Dame received the opening kick off and started the game defending the north end zone.
- Attendance, 77,622, the 11th consecutive sell out in Notre Dame Stadium.
- Notre Dame improves to 6-6 all-time against Florida State and 4-2 at Notre Dame Stadium.
- Notre Dame improves to 219-84-3 all-time against teams from the ACC and 4-0 against ACC teams in 2024.
- Notre Dame improves to 23-7 all-time at home in night games.
- Notre Dame improves to 525-131-13 all-time in home games and 381-199-5 in Notre Dame Stadium.
- Notre Dame improves to 11-5-2 all-time on November 9, 5-3-1 at home and 3-3 at Notre Dame Stadium.
- Notre Dame improves to 5-0 off bye weeks during the Marcus Freeman era.
- Notre Dame's eight sacks were the most since the team also had eight against Virginia in 2019.
- The 52 points scored by Notre Dame are the most against Florida State this season and the most against the Seminoles since Miami FL scored 52 in 2020.
- Notre Dame held Florida State to 208 total yards, marking the fifth Irish opponent who have been unable to compile 250 total yards this season (Texas A&M 246, Purdue 162, Miami OH 229, Stanford 200). The last time the Irish held five opponents under 250 total yards was 1988, the last time the team did it six times was 1983.

NOTABLE

- Jack Kiser has tied Houston Griffith (2018-22) for the Notre Dame record of career games played with his appearance this evening at 62. Howard Cross III appeared in his 60th game which is fifth on the Notre Dame all-time list.
- Riley Leonard's rushing touchdown to open the game's scoring was his 12th of the season, which ranks second on the Notre Dame season-season list for quarterbacks behind Brandon Wimbush (14 in 2017). It also marked the eighth-straight game Leonard has scored on the ground. Leonard added his 13th rushing score in the third quarter.
- Jeremiah Love scored a rushing touchdown for the ninth-straight game (all nine games of 2024) which is tied for the fourth-best streak in Notre Dame history with Vegas Ferguson (last nine games of 1979). The Notre Dame record is 11 by Wayne Bullock from 1973-74.

- Three sacks - senior Rylie Mills, who also posted back-to-back sacks in the second quarter.
- Two sacks - sophomore Donovan Hinish, who also had a career-high matching five tackles
- Five receptions - career-high matching for sophomore Jaden Greathouse (66 yards)
