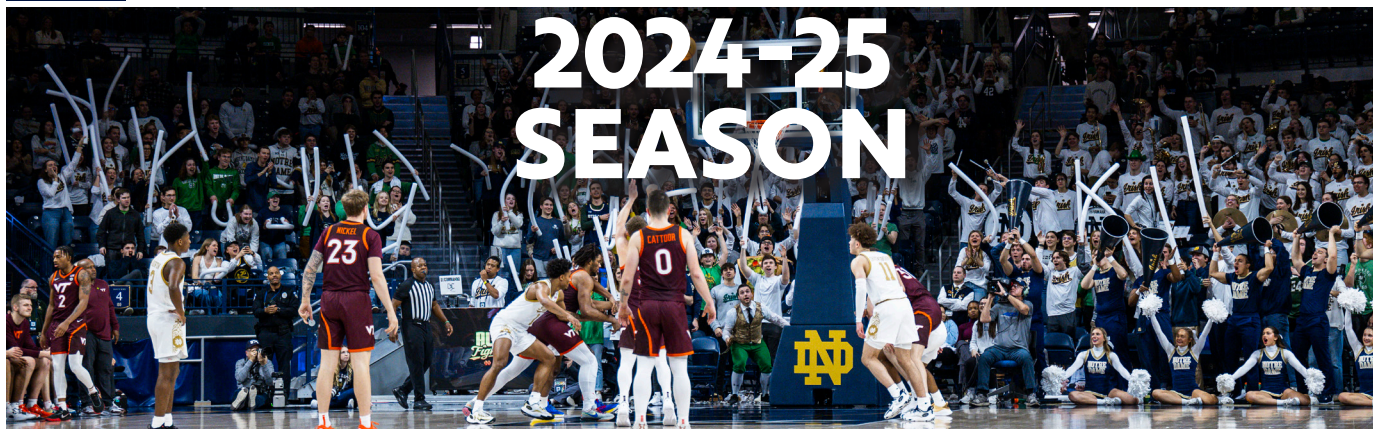

REVENGE ON THE BRAIN

The Fighting Irish (9-10, 3-5) look to make it two wins in a row when they return home to complete the two-game series with Georgia Tech (9-11, 3-6). They'll also have revenge in the back of their minds, trying to avenge a 75-86 loss in Atlanta on NYE.

The first matchup was a tale of two halves and it also was a game that didn't feature Markus Burton. The Irish found themselves in a 19-point halftime deficit after a poor shooting start; however, the Irish fought back in the second half and cut it to a one-possession game with just under six minutes left. The Irish ultimately shot 60.0 percent in the second half, scoring 51 points. Tae Davis tied his career high in points with 27, with 22 being scored in the second half.

For whatever reason, these two teams always play close and it's always a battle. Twenty-one of the last 24 games between these two have been decided by single digits. Five of those games have gone to overtime. Of those 21 games that have been decided by single digits, the average margin of victory has been 4.9.

The Irish and Yellow Jackets will tip off at 9 p.m. ET on ACC Network. ND leads the overall series 18-14 with an impressive 12-2 mark at home.

BURTON EMPHATICALLY BACK

After 39 days away rehabbing his knee injury, Burton has returned and amplified the ND offense. If you discount the Rutgers game since Burton got injured in the first four minutes, the sophomore has recorded 20+ points in seven of his last eight games.

When you look at January-only scoring

averages amongst ACC players, Burton ranks second, trailing only Duke's Cooper Flagg (25.0). Burton is averaging 21.7 ppg in January, which coincides with his ACC scoring average.

Markus Burton has produced four straight games with 20+ points and if he gets to five, he'll be the first Irish player to achieve said feat since Ben Hansbrough in February of 2011.

The sophomore has recorded incredible stretches during this four-game stint. He scored the first nine points at Virginia before finishing with a team best 21 in the win - tying his season high of four made threes. Prior, Burton dropped a first-half career high 22 points at Syracuse, finishing with 28.

We'll end on this note ... even despite that 2-point Rutgers game dragging down his scoring average, Burton is still averaging 19.9 ppg on the year.

CHASING ACHIEVEMENTS

Burton is currently averaging 19.9 ppg and 3.3 apg. If he finishes the season at 20.0+ ppg and 3.0+ apg, he'll **become the first Irish player ever to do so**. When we broaden the scope, he would become just the 15th ACC player to do so since 1996.

However, Burton isn't the only one who can cement their name in the Irish record books this season. Grad transfer Matt Allocco **owns a 3.50 assist-to-turnover ratio**. The highest A/TO ratio in program history for a season was 3.16 by Martin Inglesby back in 2000-01.

Allocco is also converting 47.9 percent from deep which would rank second all-time in program history for a season. The top two spots both belong to Joe Fredrick who shot 47.2 percent in 1989-90 and 52.1 percent in 1988-89.

THREE BALL HEATING UP

The three ball is starting to flow for the Fighting Irish. In ACC play, Notre Dame is converting 41.0 percent from beyond the arc, which leads all league schools.

Overall on the year, the Irish have drained 37.6 percent from deep which ranks 31st in the country.

Twice over the past four games, the Irish have connected on double-digit threes. They sunk 14 at Duke (which tied their season high) and 12 in the win at Virginia.

PROGRAM FIRST IN CHARLOTTESVILLE

There's not a better way to correct a certain ACC road narrative than by claiming a road victory in a building you've never won in. The Irish did just that this past Saturday with a 74-59 victory at Virginia. Coach Shrewsbury has now defeated Virginia twice in three matchups.

The Irish were led by Markus Burton with 21 points, shooting 50% on the night and 4-6 from behind the arc. Tae Davis finished with 16 points and six rebounds.

Notre Dame shot 48% on the game and an impressive 52% from three, knocking down 12 from deep. The Irish held the Cavaliers to 40% from the floor as they outrebounded Virginia 39-27.

THE TAE-KOVER

Tae Davis has emerged as one of the top talents in the ACC and should be a candidate for Most Improved.

Tae is averaging a career best 16.4 ppg, up from last year's 9.2 ppg. His scoring average

ranks 10th amongst ACC players.

The Indy native is also shooting a career best 50.5 percent, up from last year's 48.4. In ACC play, Tae's scoring average is slightly higher at 17.3 ppg.

Tae is ultimately riding a career best 14 straight games in double figures. Where is he getting it done at? Well, the junior has been highly proficient around the rim where he's 70-of-104 (.673).

He's also improved from the free-throw line over the course of the season. He's 22 for his last 27, raising his FT% to a career best 76.7 percent.

Tae is averaging 6.3 FD/40 which ranks 49th nationally according to KenPom. Tae ranks third in the league in FT attempts and seventh in makes.

EVOLVING

When Burton was recovering, other Irish had to step up and evolve and we saw it unfold. We've already mentioned how Tae Davis is posting career numbers, but so is Braeden Shrewsberry.

The sophomore guard is averaging 14.7 ppg, up from last year's 10.2. He's shooting 43.5 percent, which is up from last year's 39.8.

He's connecting on 2.8 threes per game this season, with a .371 clip from beyond the arc. Shrewsberry's sweet spot has been the corner three where he's 14-31 (.452), which is 9.7 percent above the DI average.

Shrewsberry boasts higher three ball numbers in ACC play where he ranks third in 3pt FG% (.431) and second in in threes/game (3.1).

However, it's important to point out that he's added to his overall arsenal with a dangerous floater that keeps defenders guessing. He's shooting 47.1 percent from midrange twos and 48.6 percent from the paint. He's 53.9 percent overall from two-point range.

VET LEADER

When Coach Shrews added grad transfer Matt Allocco to the roster he got two things - a talented guard with NCAA Tournament experience and a leader by every definition of the word. Coach Shrews hoped that his

young core of players would pick up those characteristics and then be leaders to the next group coming in.

This season, Allocco is averaging 10.1 ppg on 46.7 percent shooting. **He's draining a career best 47.9 percent from three, which would rank as the second highest for a season in program history.**

As previously mentioned, Allocco is also on pace for the highest A/TO ratio in program history at 3.50.

Allocco also leads the team in defensive rebounds per game at 4.3 and leads in +/- at +94 on the year. Lastly, the Ohio native is averaging 1.5 steals in ACC play which ranks ninth.

NOTRE NOTABLES

- With 13 points in the win over BC on Jan. 13, Matt Allocco officially crossed over the 1,000 career point milestone. He currently sits at 1,027.
- Allocco boasts a true shooting percentage of 70.8 over the last five games, which according to CBB Analytics ranks in the 99th percentile.
- Kebba entered the year with just four double-digit scoring performances to his name. He's posted three in ACC play including his first career double-double at NC State.
- Speaking of Kebba, the junior is averaging 2.9 offensive rebounds/game in ACC play, which ranks fourth in the league.
- Braeden is comfortable playing at home where he averages 15.8 ppg on 48.0 percent shooting.
- Burton is averaging 2.2 made threes per game in ACC play which ranks eighth in the league.
- Yes Sir! - The freshman guard impressed at #4 Duke, recording his first double-digit scoring performance with 11 points on 4-7 shooting, plus 2-4 from three.
- Notre Dame continues to raise its KenPom Offense Adj. Efficiency. Over the last several games, it has risen from 56th to 40th with a rating of 116.6. Notre Dame's overall KenPom rating sits at No. 76.

FAITH OVER DOUBT

Coach Shrews had it written on the team board both after the close Duke loss and again after the BC win just a few days later. Have faith in this team and don't let the

doubt creep in after tough losses that should have been wins.

That faith and belief got the Irish back in the win column with a decisive 78-60 victory over Boston College.

Tae Davis led the Irish in scoring for the seventh time this season, pouring in 26 points, which was one shy of his career high. Another MVP was Julian Roper II who led the team in +/- with +26.

The Irish tied their season high in offensive boards (17) and recorded a season best in second-chance points (25). Defensively, the Irish achieved a season high in steals with 13.

TAKING THE POSITIVES WITH THE NEGATIVES

A terrible sense of deja vu. First, it was North Carolina on Jan. 4. The Irish fought hard and erased a 12-point deficit to claim a three-point lead with under 20 seconds to go. That's when Elliott Cadeau converted a four-point play to give UNC the eventual 74-73 win. The returning Markus Burton drove the length of the court with four seconds left but couldn't convert a very tough contested driving layup.

The positive is that the Irish were finally back to full strength and what a gutsy return it was for Burton. Playing in his first game back since injuring his knee against Rutgers on Nov. 26, the All-ACC guard registered 23 points in 23 minutes.

Then four days later it happened again. The Irish were up four with two minutes left but NC State rallied to take a 66-65 lead. With 10 seconds left the ball was put in Burton's hand but he was double-teamed and was forced to take a tough step-back jumper.

The positive here - all five starters finished in double figures for the first time in the Shrewsberry era. Junior forward Kebba Njie was the highlight with his first career double-double. Njie posted 10 points behind 5-8 shooting, plus a career-high tying 11 rebounds. Tae Davis tallied a career high six assists to go with his 14 points.

On Jan. 11, the Irish then competed at #4 Duke. Despite Cooper Flagg dropping 42 points, the Irish fought hard the whole way. They erased an 18-point deficit and made it a four-point game late with under a minute remaining with a 15-1 scoring run.

PLAYERS ERA RECAP

The reigning ACC Rookie of the Year Markus Burton was averaging just over 21 ppg heading into Vegas for the Players Era Festival. Burton then got hurt in the first four minutes of the Rutgers game and will be out of competition on a week-to-week basis. Not to mention Sir Mohammed, Notre Dame's primary guard off the bench, was already out recovering from his respective knee injury.

And despite losing their top scorer and primary ball handler, all three games in Vegas were there for the taking.

1. Matt Allocco put the team on his back against Rutgers and had a 'March worthy' performance. He forced overtime with a last-second three in regulation. Then in OT, he converted three triples in under 30 seconds to force a tie with under 15 seconds left. He ended up with a 24-point, 10-rebound double-double with 5 assists. He was 6-for-9 from three.

2. Versus #6/7 Houston, the Irish recorded a 7-0 run in the second half to pull within one at 44-45. Unfortunately, ND only scored 10 points in the final 13 minutes as Houston pulled away to win 65-54. Tae Davis led the Irish in scoring with 22 points on 9-of-15 shooting. It marked his second 20+ point performance of the season. He also tallied a team-high eight rebounds and a team-high four assists.

3. #21/19 Creighton was very similar. The Irish ultimately erased a 17-point deficit to take a lead 53-52 lead with 10:19 remaining. Yet, Creighton countered with four triples over the next four minutes and that ended up being the difference maker. Tae Davis and Braeden Shrewsberry led the Irish with 17 points each.

SHREWSBERRY SIGNS HIGHEST-RATED ND RECRUITING CLAS IN THE MODERN ERA

When Micah Shrewsberry became the Glenn & Stacey Murphy Notre Dame Men's Basketball Head Coach he told fans to jump on now because the train was taking off. Said recruiting train built massive momentum that ultimately materialized in Notre Dame's highest-rated recruiting class in the modern era.

Tommy Ahneman, Ryder Frost, Jalen Haralson and Brady Koehler all signed their

Athletic Aid Agreement on Wednesday and officially became Irish. The class is ranked fourth in the nation by 247Sports, fifth by ESPN, fifth by Rivals and sixth by ON3. It's also the top-rated class in the state of Indiana; second overall in the ACC.

"We are very proud of the four who signed with us this morning. They are all tremendous young men and fantastic basketball players who will represent Notre Dame on and off the court at a high level. When we as a staff began focusing on this class, we had a clear vision for what we wanted. We were looking to improve our skill level, size, and athleticism, and we were able to land four of our top priority recruits, in what can only be described as an elite recruiting class." - Coach Shrews

PRESEASON ACCOLADES FOR BURTON

Point guard Markus Burton looks to continue his ascent in collegiate basketball for his sophomore season. He went from winning Mr. Indiana Basketball as a high school senior to stepping on his home court in Purcell Pavilion and making an immediate impact with the Irish. He won the 2024 ACC Freshman of the Year Award (the first ND player to do so) and also took home Third Team All-ACC honors.

Before the 2024-25 season has officially gotten underway, Burton has collected more awards/recognition. First, the ACC named him a Preseason First Team selection.

Burton's 17.5 ppg is the third highest returning scoring average in the ACC behind North Carolina's RJ Davis (21.2) and Wake Forest's Hunter Sallis (18.0 ppg).

Next, it was the Naismith Starting 5 - Bob Cousy Point Guard of the Year Top 20 Preseason Watch List. This prestigious award honors the best point guards in men's college basketball and is presented by the Basketball Hall of Fame. Burton is the first Irish point guard to be named to the Bob Cousy Top-20 Preseason Watch List since Matt Farrell (2017-18 Watch List).

Shortly after, ESPN.com announced its top-100 players ahead of the 2024-25 season. Burton landed at No. 40. They stated: "(Burton) averaged 17.5 PPG as a freshman, finishing with 20 points or more in 11 games. If he can become a consistent threat from the 3-point line (30%), the All-ACC third

team pick could mature into one of the expanded conference's best players."

Last but not least, the Naismith Trophy added Burton to their College Player of the Year Watch List. A total of 50 players were named to the preseason list.

FROM LEAST TO MOST

When Coach Shrewsberry took over the Notre Dame job, he had to start at the ground-level. In fact, Notre Dame only returned 35 points at this point last year, which equated to 1.6% of scoring returning. That number ranked in the bottom five of Division-I schools. However, this year is quite a different story.

The Irish return the most scoring in the ACC by a landslide. With a solid young core of seven returnees (Markus Burton, Braeden Shrewsberry, Tae Davis, Julian Roper II, J.R. Konieczny, Kebba Njie, Logan Imes), Notre Dame returns 85.6 percent of its scoring. The next highest is Wake Forest at 59.8 percent.

In addition, the Irish return the third highest percentage of minutes in the country at 83.9 percent. Navy (91.3) and Wofford (84.3) hold the top two spots.

IRISH GO 3-0 IN SPAIN

Every four years at Notre Dame the program is allowed to go on a Foreign Tour. That time had come for the Irish men's hoops squad, as they went on a 10-day trip to Spain. They made stops in Madrid, Valencia and Barcelona and played a game in each city vs. a semi-pro all-star squad. Notre Dame went 3-0 on the trip and here are some highlights:

- Burton recorded 58 points, 12 assists, 11 steals and 17 rebounds in three games
- Sundra - 18 points, 24 rebounds
- Davis - 20 points, 20 rebounds
- Shrewsberry - 32 points with eight made triples
- Njie - 24 points, 21 rebounds

ACC ROOKIE OF THE YEAR RETURNS FOR MORE

The 2024 ACC Rookie of the Year Markus Burton has trained hard this summer to make year two even better. Last spring, Burton brought home the program's first ACC Rookie of the Year award and third ever Rookie of the Year award of any conference, joining Chris Thomas (2002) and Troy Murphy (1999) - who each won it in the Big East.

Below is a short recap of Burton's stellar and historic rookie campaign:

- His 17.5 ppg led all ACC freshmen
- He ranked 3rd nationally amongst DI freshmen in scoring
- His 577 points set a new ND freshman scoring record, surpassing the previous holder Troy Murphy and his 519 points (1998-99).
- Burton's 17.5 ppg ranked 3rd all-time for a freshman behind Troy Murphy (19.2) and Adrian Dantley (18.3)
- His 63 steals tied Jerian Grant for third most in a single season
- ACC play only rankings: 17.5 points (6th), 2.2 steals (1st), 4.8 assists (3rd).
- Dished out 95 assists in ACC play - ranked as the 4th most by an ND player
- Produced two games with 15+ point, 5+ assists, 5+ steals. Since 1996, only one other Irish player (Chris Thomas) had produced two games in the same regular season with at least 15-5-5.
- Burton averaged the 2nd most points in the ACC from Feb. 24 on aka to the end of the season, averaging 22.1 ppg in that span (over five games). Burton produced a whopping 6 20+ point games in that span, with one of 30+.
- Four-time ACC Rookie of the Week - set a new ND record.

BEST YOUNG BACKCOURT IN THE ACC

Freshman guards Markus Burton and Braeden Shrewsberry showed no fear in the first year in the ACC. Burton averaged 17.5 points both on the season and in league play, while Shrewsberry was the lone other Irish to finish in double figures, averaging 10.2 points on the year and 11.3 points in ACC play.

With that said, Burton and Shrewsberry became the 9th ACC freshmen duo in league history to rank No. 1 and No. 2 for their team in scoring, proving the future is bright in South Bend.

There is only one scoring duo in the ACC that returns a higher combined number than Burton's and Shrewsberry's 27.7 ppg and that's Wake Forest's Hunter Sallis and Cameron Hildreth. That duo return a combined 31.8 ppg.

NON-STOP SUMMER FOR SHREWS

There was no time off or time wasted for

Coach Shrewsberry this summer. We've already broached his recruiting efforts, but he also found time to serve as an assistant coach on the U.S. U18 squad during their gold medal run at the 2024 FIBA U18 Americup. The U18 USA squad spent the first week in June competing in Buenos Aires, ultimately downing Brazil to take the top seed in Group B. The U.S. then cruised past Canada in the semifinals to soar right into the gold-medal game where they defeated Argentina 110-70.

A day after landing back in the States, Coach Shrews hopped on a plane to Boston to catch game five of the NBA Finals. Coach got to celebrate with his former players and staff in the locker room afterwards and has the championship goggles hanging in his office. You can find a video on the NDMBB social accounts of Coach Shrews congratulating his former protegee and NBA Finals MVP Jalen Brown.

SHREWSBERRY/STEVENS CONNECTION

Celebrating Boston's NBA Title is a great segue into the long-standing friendship between the Shrewsberry and Stevens family.

The connection with Brad Stevens and Micah Shrewsberry dates back to their days at Butler. Then again for six years together with the Boston Celtics. Braeden Shrewsberry states he's been friends with Brady Stevens (Brad's son and now freshman walk-on on the team) for as long as he can remember. Braeden also claimed to be Notre Dame's top recruiter when Brady was deciding on a college.

IN-STATE TALENT

The Irish boast 5 players from the state of Indiana on the 2024-25 roster. That marks the most in-state talent since the 2015-16 Notre Dame squad, who also had five.

The Indiana ties go even further. Coach Shrewsberry grew up right outside of Indianapolis and has coaches all over the state. Kebba Njie played high school ball in Indiana at La Lumiere. Juilan Roper II played in AAU ball in Indy. Brady Stevens spent some time here as a kid when his dad coached at Butler. Plus, Development & Recruiting Coordinator Grady Eifert played at Purdue.

**2nd Season at Notre Dame
4th as a Head Coach at the DI Level**

On March 24, 2023, an Indiana native came home to kickstart a new era of Notre Dame men's basketball. Vice President and James E. Rohr Notre Dame Director of Athletics Jack Swarbrick announced Micah Shrewsberry as the 18th head coach in Fighting Irish men's basketball history.

Shrewsberry brought a wealth of experience and success to the helm of the Notre Dame program. All-in-all he's coached in six NCAA Tournaments, two NCAA Final Fours, five NBA Playoffs and two NBA Conference Finals – in addition to coaching all-NBA honorees Jayson Tatum and Jaylen Brown.

Year One with the Irish

Coach Shrewsberry achieved two of his priorities in the 2023-24 season: establish the right culture at Notre Dame and have the team playing its best basketball at the end of the season. It was a program that returned 1.6% of its scoring and was projected to finish dead last in the ACC. The young Irish team came together and doubled its ACC win total from the year prior, finishing 7-13 in league play. Coach Shrewsberry even received several votes for ACC Coach of the Year. Notre Dame finished with a 13-20 overall record and won one game (First Round vs. Georgia Tech) in the ACC Tournament.

The first key moment of the season included an emphatic 76-54 win over Virginia. What Shrews' crew accomplished had never been done by an Irish team against the Cavaliers ... ever ... it was the largest margin of victory against UVA in the all-time series. In addition, the 76 points were the most scored by an Irish squad against the Cavaliers in regulation in program history. Furthermore, right after the Virginia contest, the Irish almost pulled off the upset to two teams who made the Elite Eight in NC State and Duke.

Next, the Irish bonded together by winning five of six during the final portion of the regular season, which included the final four at home (Georgia Tech, Virginia Tech, Wake Forest, Clemson). From Feb. 1 to March 1, Notre Dame was the biggest mover in kenpom AdjEM across the Power-Five conferences. Another fun stat: when the first NET rankings came on Dec. 4, the Irish were 238. On March 10, the Irish were up to 126.

An early Coach Shrewsberry stamp on the program was the defensive intensity. Notre Dame scoring defense of 67.2 finished with a national ranking of 49th in the country, plus 3rd in the ACC. According to KenPom, Notre Dame's defensive efficiency ranked 39th nationally. In ACC play, Notre Dame

ranked 2nd in scoring defense (66.4) and 2nd in field goal percentage defense (47). Of the 20 ACC games – all but three (Virginia Tech on March 9, UNC on March 5 & Syracuse on Feb. 24) were held under their season average, with Miami, Duke and Louisville each held to season-low point totals.

Lastly – two freshman guards flourished under Coach Shrewsberry in Markus Burton and Braeden Shrewsberry. Burton became the program's first ACC Rookie of the Year. He also broke the program freshman scoring record after dropping 577 points. Burton averaged 17.5 points both on the season and in league play, leading the Irish. Shrewsberry was the lone other Irish to finish in double figures, averaging 10.2 points on the year and 11.3 points in ACC play. With that said, Burton and Shrewsberry became the 9th ACC freshmen duo in league history to rank No. 1 and No. 2 for their team in scoring, proving the future is bright in South Bend.

Prior to Notre Dame

Prior to Notre Dame, Shrewsberry produced a historic turnaround as the head coach at Penn State. After a 14-17 first season, Shrewsberry produced a 23-14 mark in 2022-23, just the 12th 20-win season in the 127-year history of Penn State basketball. Furthermore, he collected more Big Ten wins (17) in his first two seasons than any other Penn State head coach.

Shrewsberry certainly captured the nation's attention in late February and into March, going 9-3 over their last 12 games. Shrewsberry then made plenty of noise in the 2023 Big Ten Tournament in Chicago, defeating No. 7 Illinois, No. 2 Northwestern and No. 3 Indiana to reach the championship game as the No. 10 seed. It marked the program's second-ever Big Ten title game appearance. Penn State was just the third double-digit seed to reach the Big Ten Tournament championship game and the first since 2008.

The Nittany Lions then made their first appearance in the NCAA Tournament since 2011. In the first round, Shrewsberry and the Nittany Lions knocked off No. 7 seed and SEC Tournament runner-up Texas A&M, winning the program's first NCAA Tournament game since 2001.

In year one at Penn State, Shrewsberry engineered the Big Ten's best scoring defense and guided the squad to their best defensive season (65.0 points allowed per game) in 11 years. The Nittany Lions advanced to the quarterfinal round of the Big Ten Tournament after winning two postseason games, making Shrewsberry one of just two first-year Big Ten coaches since 2008 to win two Big Ten Tournament games.

Recruiting-wise, Shrewsberry made an instant splash in Happy Valley. In his first year, Shrewsberry signed the highest-ranked recruiting class in program history, a consensus top-30 class. A year later, he signed his second-straight top-30 recruiting class, marking the first time in program history that the Nittany Lions had signed back-to-back top-30 recruiting classes.

Development-wise, Shrewsberry proved himself there as well, turning Jalen Pickett and Seth Lundy into 2nd Round NBA Draft picks. It marked the first time in program history that two Nittany Lions were selected.

Statistically speaking, the 2022-23 squad set the BIG and Penn State single-season team record for three-pointers made in a season with 385. The Nittany Lions compiled a total of five top-15 national statistical rankings. In addition, Shrewsberry tutored an Associated Press All-American in Jalen Pickett and a total of three All-Big Ten players during the 2022-23 season.

Prior to his time with Penn State, Shrewsberry experienced two separate stints at Purdue – one as assistant coach from 2011-13 and another as associate head coach from 2019-21. Highlights include the 2020-21 season, in which Shrewsberry helped lead the Boilermakers to a 13-6 fourth-place finish in the Big Ten and an 18-10 overall mark, culminating in an NCAA Tournament at-large bid. Trevion Williams claimed first-team All-Big Ten honors, while Zach Edey and Jaden Ivey were All-Freshman Team selections. Shrewsberry played a major role in recruiting Ivey, who grew up in South Bend and is the son of Karen and Kevin Keyes Family Head Women's Basketball Coach Niele Ivey.

Another highlight from his time in West Lafayette includes the 2011-12 squad that produced a 22-13 record and reached the second round of the NCAA Tournament. Under Shrewsberry, Terone Johnson was one of the most improved players in the BIG, netting accolades from conference and

national entities.

In between his Purdue stints, Shrewsberry spent six seasons (2013-19) with the NBA's Boston Celtics as an assistant coach under Brad Stevens. During his tenure, the Celtics reached the playoffs in five consecutive seasons, including back-to-back appearances in the Eastern Conference Finals in 2017 and 2018.

Shrewsberry played a key role in the development of current NBA stars Brown and Tatum, who were the No. 3 picks in the 2016 and 2017 NBA Drafts, respectively. Tatum was an NBA All-Rookie Team first-team selection, while Brown earned second-team All-Rookie honors.

The Brad Stevens connection was previously made at Butler University, where Shrewsberry spent one year as the director of operations then three as an assistant coach. With Shrewsberry on the sidelines, the Bulldogs compiled an 87-21 record, won two Horizon League regular-season championships and two Horizon League Tournament titles and made three NCAA Tournament appearances – which included back-to-back runs to the national championship game in 2010 and 2011.

Also at Butler, he aided in the development of Gordon Hayward, who was the 2009 Horizon League Newcomer of the Year, the 2010 Horizon League Player of the Year and a 2010 Final Four All-Tournament Team selection. Hayward was the ninth overall pick in the 2010 NBA Draft by the Utah Jazz.

Continuing on Shrewsberry's basketball journey, he spent time as the director of basketball operations at Marshall University (2003-05) and an assistant coach at DePauw University (2001-03) and Wabash College (2000-01). At DePauw, Shrewsberry led the Tigers to a 42-12 record with a pair of conference championships.

Shrewsberry was also the first men's basketball head coach at Indiana University South Bend. Shrewsberry started his coaching career as a graduate assistant at the University of Indianapolis in 1999-2000.

An Indianapolis area native, Shrewsberry earned his bachelor's degree from Hanover College in 1999 and a master's degree from Indiana State in 2003. As a player at Hanover, Shrewsberry was a three-year starting guard and team tri-captain.

He and his wife, Molly, have four children, Braeden, Nicholas, Caitlin and Grace.

- Exited the Rutgers game on Nov. 26 with a knee injury and made his return to the court against UNC on Jan. 4. And what a gutsy performance it was against the Tar Heels, dropping 23 points in 23 minutes.

- He has produced four straight games of 20+ points - if he were to get to five it'll mark the first time since Ben Hansbrough in February of 2011.

- Burton is averaging 21.7 ppg in the month of January which is second only to Duke's Cooper Flagg (25.0).

- Shooting 47.8% from two-point range. Really thriving in the midrange where he is sinking 48.8% (20-41) - 13.2% above the DI average.

- Scored the team's first nine points at Virginia (1/25) before finishing with a team best 21. He tied his season high of 4 made threes for the third time.

- Dropped a first half career best 22 points at Syracuse on Jan. 18. Finished with 28 points, 1 shy of his season high.

- A bucket shy of a career-high and a rebound shy of his first career double-double against North Dakota (11/19). Burton dropped 29 points & tied his career high of 9 rebounds.

- Burton flirted with what would have been just the program's second ever triple-double. The sophomore recorded 19 points, a career high nine rebounds and a career-high tying eight assists.

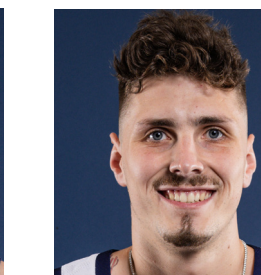
