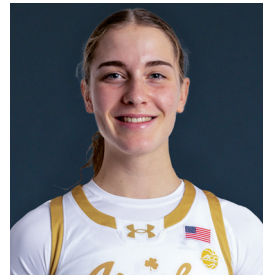

Glimpses of the 2010s

Notre Dame continued its winning ways last week, downing Stanford and No. 21 Cal by 49 and 39 points, respectively. The win over Cal was the largest margin of victory over a ranked ACC team since joining the conference, and the combined 88 point differential over the two games is the largest over a two-game span in conference play since 2012 when Notre Dame was in the Big East. It was also the first time ND has had back-to-back ACC wins of at least 35 points since 2019.

Notre Dame is now 12-0 in ACC play for the first time since 2015-16 when they went undefeated in the conference. Additionally, 11 of the 12 wins have come by 10+ points.

The Thursday evening drubbing was the **largest margin of defeat in Stanford history**, and it started on defense for the Irish. Notre Dame forced a **season-high 29 turnovers and scored 45 points off of those Cardinal blunders**.

"Our defense," Hidalgo said in a postgame interview with ESPN when asked about what

came together for the Irish on Thursday after a slower first quarter. "Our rotations are a lot better and something that we work on every practice. We've been trying to put it together, and it looked a lot better today."

Hidalgo led the Irish with 24 points, and Miles had 20 herself for the fifth time this season. She started **4-4 from deep** and also had 7 rebounds and 4 assists on the night.

Sunday was more of the same. Notre Dame and Cal traded baskets for the first few minutes before the Irish exploded for a 22-8 second quarter. **In true ND fashion this year, the first eight baskets of the game were scored by eight different players.** Hidalgo ultimately lead the crew with 24 points, and Miles and Citron had 16 each. Miles had 6 assists and 7 rebounds, while Citron and Hidalgo each had 5 assists as well.

Must See TV

Hannah Hidalgo became a household name in women's basketball during a record-breaking freshman season a year ago, and the sophomore has picked up right where she left off.

The eye-popping stat lines continue to drop jaws. She stuffs the stat sheet nearly every time she sees a top-25 opponent, averaging 23.1 ppg, 6.6 rpg, 4.8 apg and 3.2 spg against 17 ranked opponents in her career.

This season against six ranked opponents, Hidalgo has posted 26.3 points, 6.3 rebounds, 5.8 assists and 3.3 steals per game. She leads all players this season against ranked teams in ppg and spg while shooting 51.3 from deep (min. 3 games).

Hidalgo's stats are also incredible when it comes to games on major networks (NBC, ESPN/2). In six contests this season, Hidalgo is averaging 27.5 ppg, 5.8 rpg, 5.8 apg and is shooting 45 percent from deep and 49.1 percent from the field.

Naismith and Notre Dame

As award season quickly approaches, Notre Dame is well-represented across the board as the watch lists narrow. Last week made that extremely evident.

The Naismith Basketball Hall of Fame

released a top 10 for each of the five basketball positions, and an Irish player was on four of the five lists –

- Olivia Miles – Nancy Lieberman (point guard)
- Hannah Hidalgo – Ann Meyers Drysdale (shooting guard)
- Sonia Citron – Cheryl Miller (small forward)
- Liatu King – Katrina McClain (power forward)

Notre Dame is the only team in the nation with four players to make the lists.

Pick Your Poison

What a statistical showing for Notre Dame so fast this year. **Through 23 games, Notre Dame has a player ranked in the top 10 nationally in four of five major statistical categories:**

- Hannah Hidalgo: 25.9 ppg (second) and 4.0 spg (third)
- Olivia Miles: 6.4 apg (sixth)
- Liatu King: 10.8 rpg (10th)

Miles is also the only player in the nation with three triple-doubles this year.

As a team, **Notre Dame leads the nation in 3FG percentage (41.3)** and ranks in the top 10 in the following categories:

- Blocks/game: 5.8 (eighth)



- FG%: 50.4 (third)
- Rebounds/game: 44.2 (fifth)
- Rebounding margin: 10.8 (sixth)
- Scoring offense: 87.6 (third)
- Scoring margin: 26.6 (third)

They lead the ACC in all of those categories with the exception of scoring offense and blocks (second).

Backcourt Big 3

You don't want to mess with the trio of Citron, Hidalgo and Miles.

Notre Dame's three guards have combined for a total of 1197 points, 363 rebounds, 291 assists and 158 steals. **Those marks are 59.4%, 35.7%, 68.3% and 59.4% of Notre Dame's totals this season, respectively.**

Miles is shooting 52.5% from the floor and 43.1 from deep, while Hidalgo sits at 50.4% and 43.5, respectively. They are two of just three ACC guards averaging 15+ points and shooting 50% from the floor this year.

Also of note, they have assisted each other on 58 occasions this year, including a season-high six at Southern Cal and Syracuse.

Finally, there are only two active major conference guards in the country with more than 10 double-doubles on the same team over the past three seasons – Miles has 16, Hidalgo has 11.

Sophomore Sensation

Twice this season, Hidalgo has been named AP National Player of the Week, one of five USBWA Players of the Week and ACC Player of the Week. She earned the accolades after posting a near triple-double against **then-No. 2 UConn** (29p, 10r, 8a) and after dropping 24p, 6r, 8a and 5s at **then-No. 3 USC** on Nov. 23.

In total, Hidalgo has been the ACC Player of the Week four times this year.

Additionally, Hidalgo scored her 1000th

career point at Syracuse Dec. 8, becoming the fastest player in Notre Dame history to reach the mark. She did it in just 44 games. The previous record was 60 and held by Beth Morgan. **She has now played 56 career collegiate games and has scored in double-figures in all 56.**

In total this year, Hidalgo ranks second in the nation with 25.9 points per game and third with 4.0 swipes per game.

Back By Popular Demand

She's back.

All-American point guard Olivia Miles has returned to the court for Notre Dame nearly two years after tearing her ACL in February 2023. Miles picked up right where she left off against Mercyhurst. The graduate guard put on a show in first game back, posting a 20-10-10 triple-double. **In doing so, she became the first ACC player to post one in three different seasons. Miles also became the first player in the history of the NBA, WNBA and college basketball to sit out for a year with an injury and post a 20-point triple-double in their first game back on the court.**

As a result of her performance, she was the ACC Player of the Week (for the third time in her career) and was one of five players across the country named to the USBWA National Players of the Week list. Miles was also the runner-up for AP Player of the Week.

Then she took it up a notch.

Miles had 18 points, 11 rebounds and 10 assists against Loyola MD on Dec. 22, notching the fifth triple-double of her career. She followed that performance with 11 points, 10 rebounds and 14 assists against Virginia, becoming the **first player in ACC history with back-to-back triple-doubles. She now has six career triple-doubles, which is tied for the most in ACC history.**

Miles earned ACC Player of the Week and USBWA Player of the Week honors for the performances.

Miles' name peppered the ACC rankings two years ago, as she led the conference with 6.9 assists. She was the only ACC player who ranked in the top 10 in points (9), rebounds (7) and assists (1) in 2022-23. She is the NCAA's active leader in assists/game with 6.7. She is the only player in the nation averaging 16 points, 6 rebounds and 6 assists per game. She is also one of just three ACC guards shooting at least 50 percent from the floor and averaging at least 15 points per game.

Additionally, Miles added the 3-pointer to her resume during her injury recovery. She entered this season shooting 24.6 percent from deep in her career. **She's 50-116 this season (43.1 percent) and those 50 triples are tied for the team lead with Hidalgo.**

King Of The Castle

Liatu King arrived in South Bend after a breakout senior year. She was named to the 2023-24 All-ACC First Team and earned Most Improved Player honors after averaging a double-double (18.7/10.3) last year at Pitt.

A 6-0 forward that plays much bigger than that, **King is one of four players in the nation averaging 12 points, 10 rebounds and 2 steals per game this year.**

King wasted no time in her Irish debut. She led the team in scoring (24) and rebounds (11) against Merchyurst, and had a 15-rebound game at Purdue. In doing so, King became the first Irish player since November 2020 to post a double-double in back-to-back games to start the year. She has led Notre Dame in rebounds 18 times this year. She is the first player in Notre Dame history with at least 10 rebounds in seven of her first eight games of the season, and **she reached 100 boards in her first nine**

games of play this year, the fastest player in the last 25 years of NDWBB to do it. King also has two games with 15 points and 15 rebounds this year, becoming the first player since Brianna Turner and Jessica Shepard accomplished the feat in 2018-19. She had 15 boards against UNC as well.

King was a brightspot three weeks ago when she recorded her eighth double-double of the season with 23 points and 11 rebounds at Clemson and had 17 points and 6 rebounds against Wake Forest. She was named a USBWA Player of the Week and went 18-27 from the floor (66.7 percent). She added a 16 point, 12 rebound showing at Louisville for her **ninth double-double of the season.**

King's name is all over the current ACC and national rankings — FG% (57.3 — 1 ACC/24 NATL), total rebounds (238 — 3/17), rebounds/game (10.8 — 2/10 and steals/game (2.3 — 4/82) top the list. She is also averaging 12 ppg and has nine double-doubles this year.

Return of the Mad

After missing the first 13 games of the season, All-ACC forward Maddy Westbeld returned to the court against UNC on Jan. 5. She played 13 minutes on a minute restriction and recorded a rebound, a block and a steal.

Her home return was a memorable one, as you could see the weight lifted off her shoulders when Miles dished a pass to her on the wing and she nailed a triple. She finished the game with 14 points and 6 boards.

Westbeld got back into the starting lineup against Georgia Tech, notching her 121st career start. She had a season-high 20 points and went 8-11 from the floor.

Westbeld ranks eighth in school history with 918 rebounds. She is also part of the only sister duo in program history to both reach 1000 points (Kat Westbeld).

Not In Kate's House

Freshman Kate Koval joined the Irish as the No. 5 overall recruit in the 2024-25 class according to ESPN (No. 1 post). Her 6-5 height suggests she's a back-to-the-basket post, but her skillset extends well beyond that. Koval can dish the ball outside, take a shot from the elbow, and even shoot the occasional trey.

She had 18 points and 5 blocks in the season opener, marking the first time since 2007 an ND player had 5 blocks to start a season.

But it was performances No. 3 and No. 4 that turned some national heads. Koval had a 14/16 double-double and added 6 blocks against JMU, and she had 11 points, 19 rebounds and 7 blocks at Lafayette. Nineteen rebounds is a Notre Dame freshman record. At the time, she was also just the 40th total player since 1999 to record a game with 19 rebounds and 7 blocks.

As a result of her performances, Koval was named both the ACC Co-Rookie of the Week and the USBWA National Freshman of the Week.

Through three games, Koval had totaled 40 points, 33 rebounds, 8 assists and 15 blocks. According to OptaSTATS, the last DI freshman (male or female) to reach those numbers in any three-game span is Anthony Davis (Kentucky).

Currently, Koval ranks third in the ACC in blocks/game (2.2) and had a 5-block contest against Texas. She is just the fifth ND player since 1999 to notch 5+ blocks against a top-five team.

Five Straight

The Irish have been giant killers over the last three years. There's no other way to put it.

On Dec. 12, No. 8 Notre Dame defeated No. 2 UConn, 79-68. It is the fifth straight game against a top-five opponent the Irish have

won, with three of them coming this season:

- No. 2 UConn — 79-68 (12/12/24)
- No. 4 Texas — 80-70 OT (12/5/24)
- No. 3 USC — 74-61 (11/23/24)
- No. 5 Virginia Tech — 71-58 (2/29/24)
- No. 3 UConn — 74-60 (12/4/24)

In the last 10 years of men's and women's college basketball, no team has won five consecutive games against top-five competition by double-digits. Until now.

Additionally, it's the first time in program history that the Irish have toppled three top-five programs during the regular season.

Best Ticket in Town

Notre Dame's game against Cal on Sunday was the program's fourth sellout of the season already, the most regular season sellouts of the Ivey Era.

Notre Dame is filling up 87.3 percent of the Joyce Center at home games this season, which ranks seventh nationally. Currently, upcoming games against both Duke and Louisville are sold out with limited tickets remaining for Florida State.

Race to 100

Niele Ivey recorded her 100th career win with a victory over Virginia on Dec. 29. In doing so, Ivey became the fastest coach in program history to reach the milestone and is now the fastest coach in ACC history to reach 100 wins to begin a head coaching career.

Impressive Start to Ivey Era

When Ivey took over the program from HOFer Muffet McGraw, she wanted to put her own spin on it. Mission accomplished.

In the last five years (Ivey is in her fifth year), Notre Dame, UConn and Iowa are the only major conference teams to average over 76 ppg, shoot 34+ percent from deep and 46+

percent from the floor.

Also in the Ivey Era, Notre Dame leads the ACC with 76.8 ppg, 2410 assists, 695 blocked shots and a FG% of 46.4.

One of the finest point guards ever to wear the Notre Dame uniform, Niele Ivey (first name pronounced knee-elle) was announced as the fourth Karen & Kevin Keyes Family Head Women's Basketball Coach on April 22, 2020, just mere minutes after Muffet McGraw stepped down.

Ivey's list of accolades since Year 1 is lengthy, including being the fastest coach in program history to reach 100 wins and the fastest ACC coach to reach 100 wins to start a head coaching career. She also won the 2024 ACC Tournament, was the 2023 ACC Coach of the Year, and led her team to the ACC regular season title. Ivey has posted three-consecutive Sweet 16 appearances despite losing multiple starters during both seasons to injury. Notre Dame was the only ACC team to have four women earn individual ACC honors at the end of the 2023 season, and the only school with three athletes on the All-ACC Team in 2024. Ivey was also the only coach in the country to sign three five-star recruits in the 2023 cycle — Cassandre Prosper, Hannah Hidalgo and Emma Risch.

In her first year at the helm, Ivey not only had to balance settling into her new role with a young roster but also navigating the waters of a national pandemic. In a shortened season due to Covid-19, Ivey's squad went 10-10 (8-7). In her first week on the job, Coach Ivey received verbals from now-juniors Sonia Citron and Olivia Miles, who made up a top-five nationally ranked recruiting class.

As an assistant, the Irish went 386-55 (.875) during Ivey's time patrolling the sidelines. Notre Dame's recent decade of dominance (2010-19) had Ivey's handprints all over it — no other program had produced more trips to the national title game (six), and the Irish posted the third-most wins in that span as well (339).

Ivey is the common link to all nine of the program's Final Four appearances, two as a player and seven as an assistant coach, logging a combined 21 years on Notre Dame's campus (16 as a coach and five as a player).

That decade also consisted of 14 conference championships (eight regular-season plus six tournament titles split between the BIG EAST and ACC), seven Final Fours and a 2018 national championship.

Ivey expanded her basketball prowess when she stepped away from Notre Dame to accept an assistant coaching position with the Memphis Grizzlies for the 2019-20 season. Ivey proved to be a true trailblazer, becoming the ninth active female coach in the NBA.

Over that year, Ivey helped develop a young team, with a new coaching staff, into a playoff contender. Ivey worked with several different position groups with the Grizzlies, but primarily with standout guards Jarlen Jackson and Ja Morant, as the latter won 2020 NBA Rookie of the Year honors.

Ivey originally joined the Fighting Irish women's basketball coaching staff in May 2007 (she added the title of recruiting coordinator in 2012 and was promoted to associate head coach in the summer of 2015). She spent 12 seasons under Coach McGraw.

Over her last eight years as an assistant, Notre Dame ranked in the top-12 in field goal percentage (led the country in 2013-14 season), scoring offense and assists. In fact, Notre Dame's offense over its back-to-back title game runs in 2018 and 2019 was one for the record books. The 2018 championship squad ranked in the top five in all the aforementioned categories. Meanwhile, the 2019 Irish took home the statistical championship for top-scoring offense in the country, averaging a program-record 88.6 points per game. In addition, they broke the program record for assists (804) while finishing second in shooting percentage (50.8 percent). The stat that is the icing on the cake to all of this — the 2019 starting five of Ogunbowale, Mabrey, Shepard, Turner and Young went down as the most prolific scoring fivesome in the history of NCAA Division I basketball (men's or women's), amassing an astonishing 10,230 combined career points.

In addition to her achievements in player development, Ivey emerged as a rising star on the recruiting trail, with a sharp eye for young talent. In fact, she helped Notre Dame attract top-12 incoming classes in nine of her last 10 years.

What's more, Ivey displayed brilliant prowess when it came to scouting and in-game strategy. In her last six years as an assistant, she was directly responsible for creating the game plans that led to victories over Duke (12 times), Tennessee (8 times), Florida State (7 times), Connecticut (5 times), Maryland (three times), Louisville (8 times), Syracuse (7 times), UCLA (three times), Baylor (twice), Texas A&M (3 times) and South Carolina, among many others.

In fact, Notre Dame is 5-3 all-time against UConn in the NCAA Tournament, which more than doubles the next best team's win total. Overall, over her last 12 years, the Irish knocked off the Huskies nine times, while all other Division I teams combined for 10 wins.

Most notable players under Ivey's tutelage: Arike Ogunbowale, Jewell Loyd and Skylar Diggins-Smith. Ogunbowale was a two-time All-American, two-time Ann Meyers Drysdale Award finalist and the 2018 Final Four MVP after her famous Ice Twice. Ogunbowale graduated as the program's all-time leading scorer.

Ivey helped mold Loyd into one of the country's top players from 2012-15. Loyd finished with 1,909 points and a 17.0 career points-per-game average. Loyd's best performances came against Top 25 teams, in which she averaged 22.8 points, 6.5 rebounds and 3.2 assists per game, including a school record-tying 41 at DePaul.

Under Ivey's guidance, Skylar Diggins-Smith made a seamless transition from shooting guard to point guard during her final three seasons, emerging as one of the nation's elite players to become one of just three two-time recipients of the Lieberman Award and a two-time consensus first-team All-America and BIG EAST Player of the Year selection. Diggins-Smith graduated in 2013 as the holder (or co-holder) of no fewer than 32 game, season or career records at Notre Dame, and ranks among the top five on an astounding 105 of the program's game, season or career charts.

Ivey sat out most of her freshman season at Notre Dame (1996-97 Final Four campaign) after suffering a season-ending knee injury five games in. However, she was awarded a fifth year of eligibility in 2000-01 and made the most of it, earning third-team AP All-America honors, the first Fighting Irish point guard to be so recognized. She also was the recipient of the 2001 Frances Pomeroy Naismith Award and was a finalist for the 2001 Lieberman Award. Ivey made the 2001 NCAA Women's Final Four All-Tournament Team after averaging 16.5 points and 5.5 steals per game as the Irish defeated UConn and Purdue to win their first national title.

All told, Notre Dame went 109-22 (.832) during Ivey's last four seasons, reaching the NCAA Sweet 16 three times (1998, 2000, 2001) and rolling up a (then) school-record 34 wins in 2000-01. The Fighting Irish also won a share of their first BIG EAST regular-season championship in 2000-01 and were ranked in the top 10 of either or both the Associated Press and WBCA/USA Today polls for all but two weeks during her final three campaigns. While at Notre Dame, Ivey was a three-time all-BIG EAST selection (1999-2001), collecting first-team honors in 2001, and was tapped as the BIG EAST Player of the Week five times. She also led the Fighting Irish in steals in each of her final four seasons (1997-98 to 2000-01) and was the team's assist leader in her last three years, setting school records with 95 steals in 1999-2000 (since topped by Diggins) and 247 assists in 2000-01, along with a school-standard 2.67 assist/turnover ratio the latter season.

Ivey went on to play five seasons in the WNBA, beginning with her selection by the Indiana Fever in the second round (17th overall pick) of the 2001 WNBA Draft. She spent four seasons with the Fever, helping them to the first playoff berth in franchise history in 2002. Ivey signed with the Detroit Shock as a restricted free agent in 2005, and subsequently was acquired by the Phoenix Mercury later that season.

A native of St. Louis, Ivey graduated from Notre Dame's College of Arts and Letters in 2000 with a bachelor's degree in history.

25th Year at Notre Dame**

One of the nation's premier post coaches, Carol Owens finished her 24th year at Notre Dame and her 15th as associate head coach for the Fighting Irish last year, having originally been elevated to that position by Muffet McGraw prior to the 2002-03 season (holding

that role through the 2004-05 campaign), and then again in the summer of 2012.

Throughout her tenure at Notre Dame, Owens has focused on working with the Irish post players, while also assisting with the program's nationally-ranked recruiting efforts. She has been a part of two national championship teams while in South Bend.

Owens was named the 2019 WBCA Division I Assistant Coach of the Year along with being inducted into the inaugural STEP UP Assistant Coach Hall of Fame. In 2014, she was chosen as the inaugural recipient of the A Step Up Assistant Coach of the Year Award. In 2001, she was named one of the top five assistant coaches in the country by Women's Basketball Journal, and in 2011, ColleagueInsider.com named her as one of the top 15 active assistants in the nation.

Owens has had the magic touch when it comes to developing elite post players over the years, with no fewer than seven of her pupils (Natalie Achonwa, Jacqueline Batteast, Katryna Gaither, Ruth Riley, Devereaux Peters, Jessica Shepard and Brianna Turner) earning a combined 34 All-America honors during their college careers.

Between her coaching runs at Notre Dame, Owens spent five seasons (2005-10) as head coach at her alma mater, Northern Illinois University. Owens originally came to Notre Dame in 1995 following two seasons as an assistant at Michigan, where she began her coaching

career after enjoying a three-year professional playing stint in Japan, Spain and Italy.

As a standout player at Northern Illinois from 1985-90, Owens compiled a very impressive resume. A two-time Kodak (now WBCA) Coaches' All-District IV Team selection (1989 and 1990), Owens scored 2,102 points and averaged 18.0 points per game over four campaigns, covering 117 games. She also captained the Huskies for four seasons and, in her final collegiate campaign (1989-90), she guided NIU to the best record in school history (26-5), as the Huskies went undefeated in North Star Conference play (12-0) and earned the school's first-ever NCAA Tournament bid.

Owens finished her NIU career with 13 school records, most notably standing as Northern Illinois' all-time leader in scoring, blocked shots, free throws made, free throw attempts and field-goal percentage scoring games. In addition, she was the first player (male or female) in school history to score 2,000 points and grab 1,000 rebounds.

A native of Chicago, Owens received her bachelor of arts degree in communications in 1990. She was selected by the faculty of the College of Liberal Arts and Sciences to serve as Commencement Marshal of her graduating class and was named Northern Illinois' Outstanding Woman. In addition, Owens was the recipient of the Student Leadership Award.

**Alma Mater: Notre Dame '16
Sixth Year at Notre Dame**

On August 26, 2019, Michaela Mabrey came home, joining then-Muffet McGraw's staff as an assistant coach. Now under Karen & Kevin Keyes Family Head Coach Niele Ivey, Michaela just

completed her fifth season in 2023-24. She also added the title of recruiting coordinator in 2022.

Years three through five have been extremely successful for Mabrey after bringing in Olivia Miles and Sonia Citron and serving as their position coach. Last season, Citron helped lead the Irish to a third consecutive Sweet 16 and an ACC Tournament title despite missing nine games with a knee sprain. In 2022-23, Mabrey and the Irish won the regular season ACC title. Miles was the ACC Player of the Year runner-up, and Citron made the All-ACC First Team.

In 2021-22, Notre Dame was the only program with two freshmen on ESPN's top-10 freshman list (Miles No. 2 / Citron No. 6). Additionally, the Irish were just one of two programs in all of Division I who had two freshmen both average double-digit points.

As a freshman, Miles ranked 2nd in the entire nation in assists per game (7.4), led the team in scoring (13.7 ppg), posted nine double-doubles, including two triple-doubles, and was a Nancy Lieberman Award Top 5 Finalist. Not to mention, she was First-Team All-ACC. Citron was the 2022 ACC Freshman of the Year after averaging 11.8 points, 6.6 rebounds. In fact, she was one of two freshmen in the entire country who averaged at least 11 points, 6 rebounds, 2 assists and 1.5 steals.

In her first year with the Irish, Mabrey was instantly recognized by the WBCA, landing on their Thirty Under 30 honoree list. Each honoree has exemplified their involvement in community service, mentorship and impact on others, professional manner, and attitude and professional association involvement.

Part of the winningest class in Notre Dame women's basketball history (2012-16), Mabrey's squads advanced to three Final Fours, including two title game appearances (2014 & 2015). The Irish also swept regular season and conference tournament titles all four years in which Mabrey was on campus (one Big East + three ACC). In addition, Mabrey served as a team captain in her final two seasons.

Over her time at Notre Dame, Mabrey emerged as one of the elite three-point shooters in the country. The New Jersey native finished her career with 228 made three-pointers (fifth all-time), a 39.6 three-point shooting percentage (sixth all-time) and played in 142 total games (ninth all-time). Michaela and her sister Marina were the only two Fighting Irish players to make at least 60 three-pointers in three seasons.

After graduation, Mabrey became the coordinator of program and player development at the University of Miami for the 2016-17 season, aiding the staff in preparing scouting material and conducting on-campus recruiting visits. The following year, Mabrey moved to Miami (Ohio) as an assistant, where the Redhawks went on to produce a 21-11 record and recorded the biggest turn-around that year in NCAA Division I by a first-year coaching staff.

For the 2018-19 season, Mabrey accepted a Director of Recruiting position at LSU. There she coordinated the daily recruiting operational and logistical processes for the women's basketball program.

Third Year at Notre Dame

This past year was Allen's second season as an assistant coach at Notre Dame. She was critical in developing ACC Rookie and Defensive Player of the Year Hannah Hidalgo, serving as her position coach and helping lead her to breaking nearly every

freshman program record on the books. Hidalgo led the nation with 4.6 steals per game and was the country's No. 2 scoring freshman with 22.6 points per contest. Both of those marks are also Notre Dame single-season program records across all classes.

During her inaugural year back on campus, the former Irish guard helped lead Notre Dame to a regular season ACC title using elite guard play. Along with Mabrey, Allen helped coach All-American Olivia Miles and All-ACC shooter Sonia Citron, leading Notre Dame to a second straight Sweet 16 berth.

Niele Ivey announced Charel Allen as a new assistant coach on July 20, 2022. Allen graduated from Notre Dame in 2008, becoming one of three current Irish coaches to have graduated from the school.

Allen was a two-time All-American, two-time First Team All-Big East selection and served as team captain over her final two seasons at Notre Dame. Allen averaged team bests 17.0 points and 6.2 rebounds as a junior then led the Irish to a Sweet 16 berth during her senior year, scoring a career-high 35 points in a second-round overtime win over Oklahoma – which still stands tied for the second-best Irish scoring performance in the NCAA Tournament.

She was the first player in school history to amass 1,000 points, 500 rebounds, 200 assists and 200 steals

in her career. In fact, she still ranks 15th on the all-time scoring list with 1,566 career points.

Allen was selected in the third round of the 2008 WNBA Draft by the Sacramento Monarchs, helping the team advance to the '08 WNBA Playoffs.

In 2009, Allen made the leap overseas and played professionally in Bulgaria for eight seasons. She was a five-time Bulgarian League champion in addition to being named a four-time All-Bulgarian League First Team selection, with Player of the Year honors in 2014.

In the summer of 2017, Allen made the shift to the coaching ranks and joined the staff at Cal State Fullerton. She was then promoted to associate head coach in May of 2021. At Fullerton, Allen helped with recruiting along with coaching the wings for the Titans. In her first year, Allen saw her shooting guard Hannah Thompson average 12.4 points per game and convert 72 three-pointers. A year later, freshman Amiee Book went on to win the Big West Sixth Player of the Year.

In January, Allen was announced as part of the Western Pennsylvania Interscholastic Athletic League Hall of Fame Class of 2025. She helped lead her high school, Monessen, to a 100-19 record and the 2004 WPIAL and PIAA Class 1A girls' basketball championships. She was named Associated Press Pennsylvania Class 1A Player of the Year in 2003 and 2004 and averaged 26.1 points, 8.1 rebounds, 5.4 assists, and 5.1 steals per game for the Greyhounds as a senior.

Second Year at Notre Dame

Knox joined the Irish as the new player development program director on June 12, 2023 and had an immensely successful first season in South Bend. Individually, he primarily worked with Irish forward Maddy Westbeld, who posted her best all-around

season on the court to date. Westbeld finished the season averaging 14.4 points and 8.7 rebounds per game, and she was named to the All-ACC Second Team. With 297 total rebounds, Westbeld's season on the boards now ranks eighth in program history. Knox's role in Westbeld's life was arguably even bigger off the court, as he augmented her work ethic and leadership skills helping her find her voice.

Prior to coming to Notre Dame, Knox spent nearly a decade working with the Indiana Fever as an interim head coach, assistant coach and player development coach. During his tenure in Indianapolis, Knox helped lead the team to eight consecutive WNBA playoff appearances and was a 2012 WNBA champion. He wore many hats for the program throughout his time, helping with everything from scouting to rehabilitation training to practice preparation. He has worked with many notable players, including Olympic gold medalist and former Irish guard Skylar Diggins, four-time Olympic gold medalist Tamika Catchings and five-time WNBA All-Star Katie Douglas.

"I'm super excited to add Carlos Knox to our coaching staff," Ivey said after his hire. "He has been instrumental in the development of some of the best players in both the WNBA and NBA, and he brings a wealth of knowledge and expertise to our team. My vision for our program is to continue developing NEXT LEVEL pros, and I believe Carlos will help continue and elevate that mission!"

Knox has also had stints as an assistant coach at the University of Cincinnati (2020-21), University of North Texas (2017-20) and San Diego State University (2010-11). Finally, Knox spent time from 2015-16 as the director of training at the Jonathan Byrd Grand Park Fieldhouse, Indiana's state-of-the-art basketball facility.

The former point guard had a lengthy and decorated career as a collegiate player after attending high school outside of Dayton, Ohio. While earning a degree in communications from IUPUI from 1994-98, he was a two-time NCAA scoring champion, NCAA All-American and NCAA Player of the Year. His jersey has been retired at IUPUI, and the team became a Division I program just after his graduation due in part to Knox's contributions. He was inducted into the IUPUI Hall of Fame in 2004.

Knox went on to play for the Indiana Pacers from 1998-99 and played overseas in Croatia, Germany, Venezuela and Italy. He has also served as a head coach in the International Basketball League, Continental Basketball Association and American Basketball Association.

The newest member of the Notre Dame staff comes to South Bend from Dallas.
